DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a belt holster showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

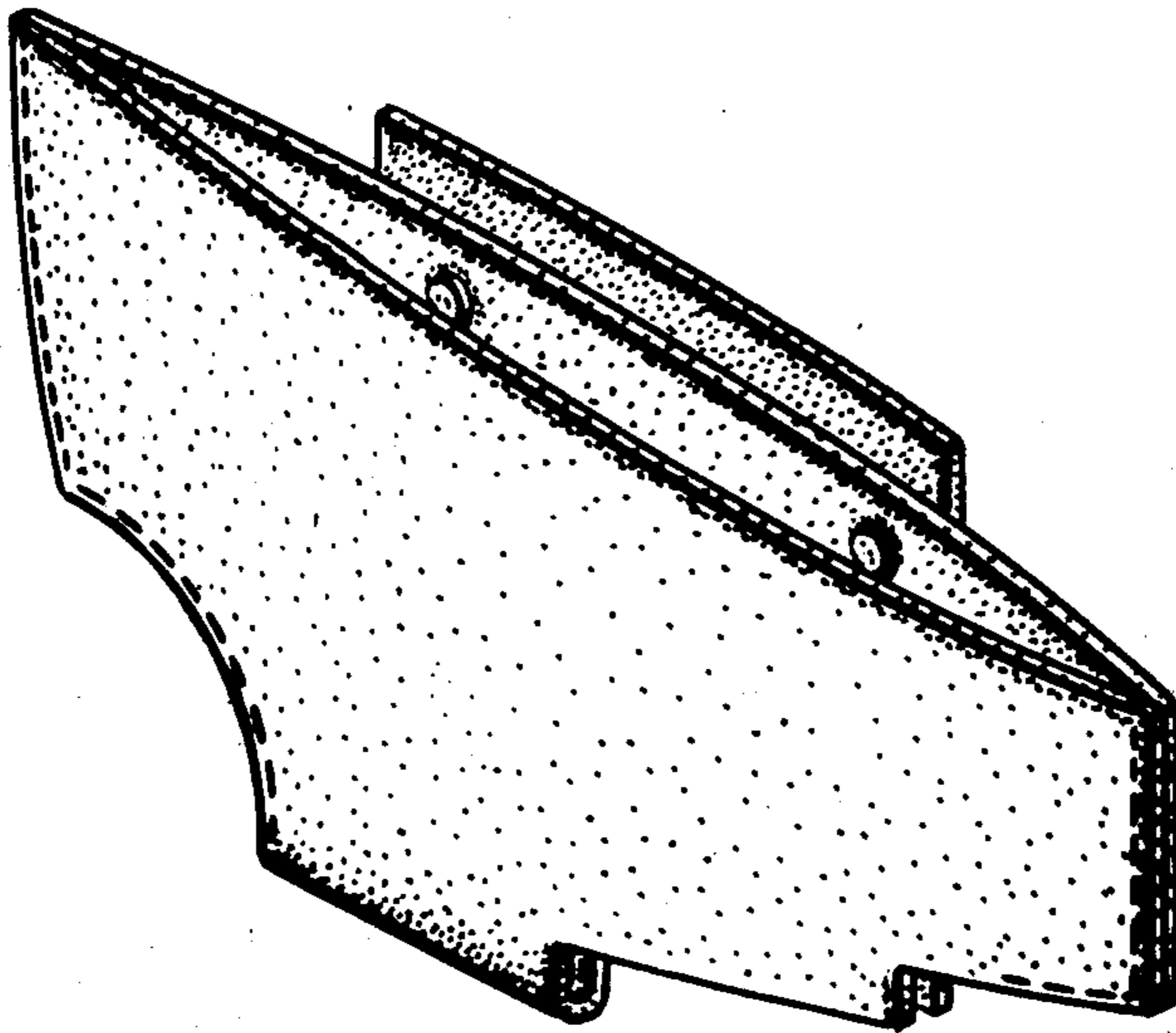

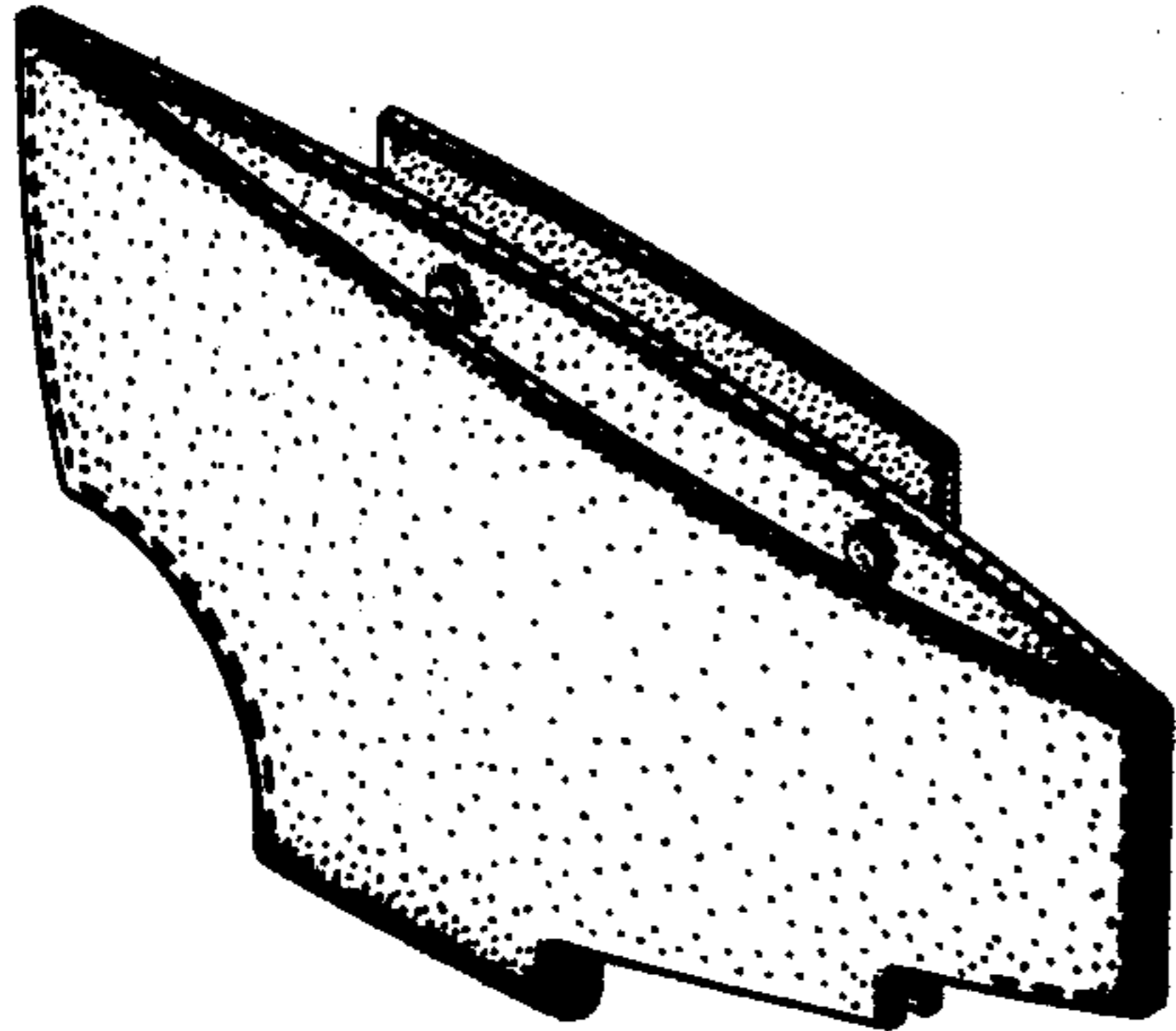

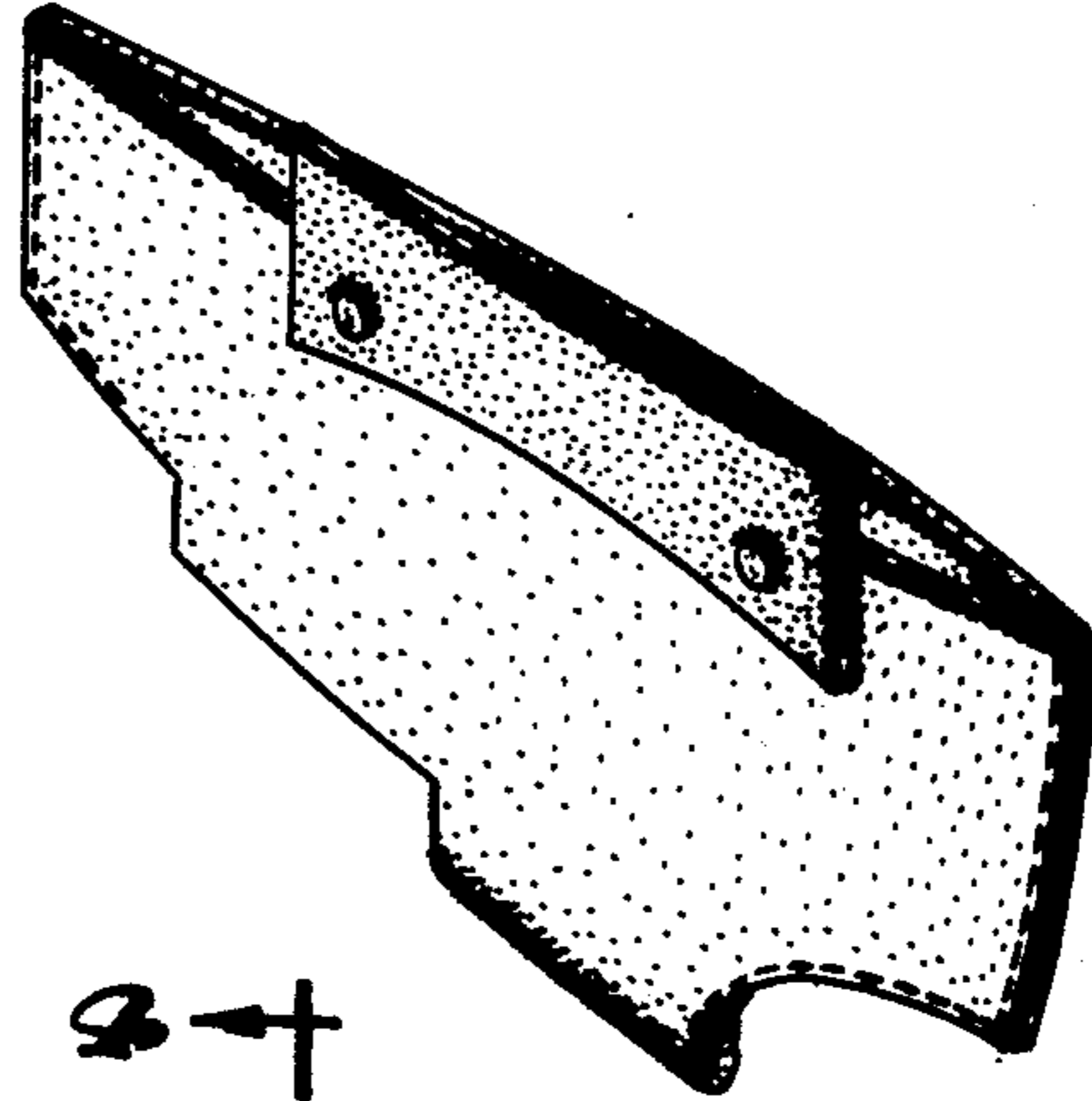

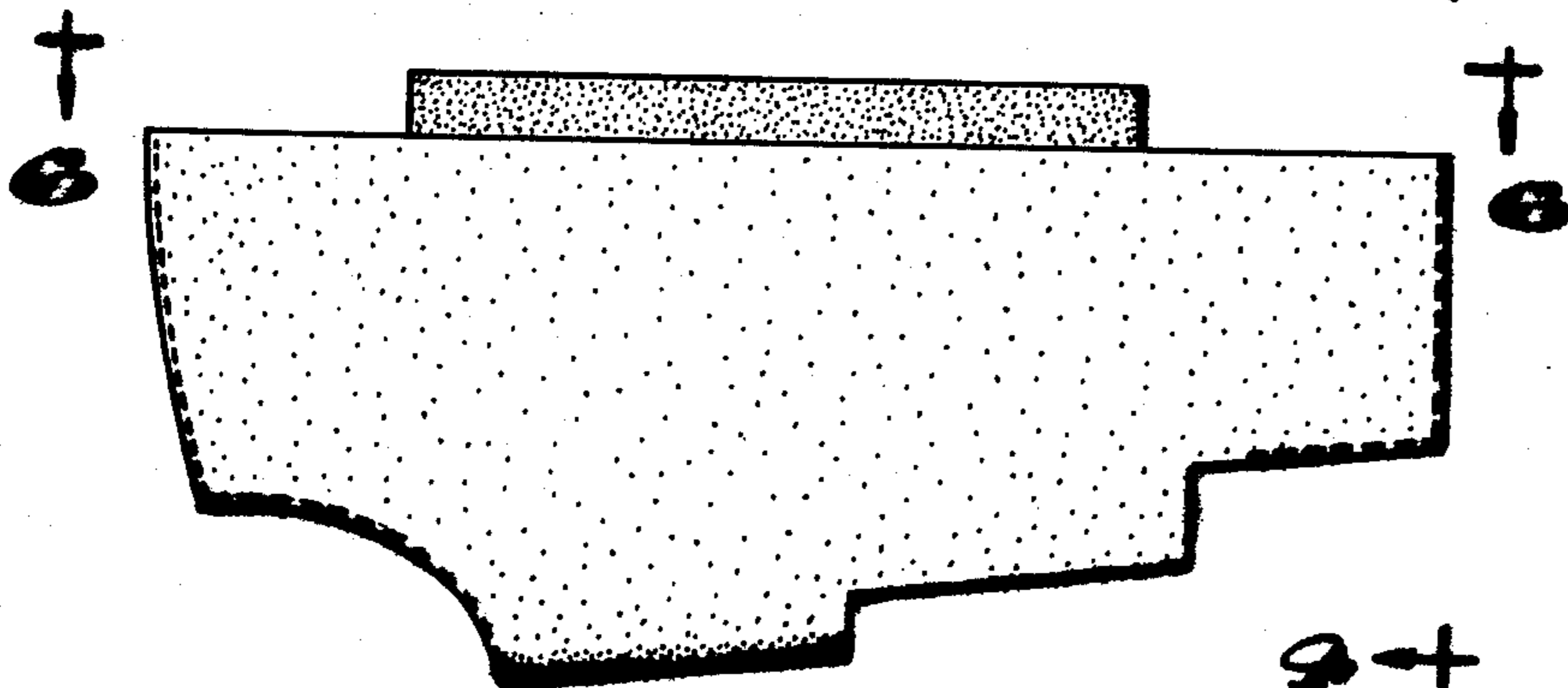

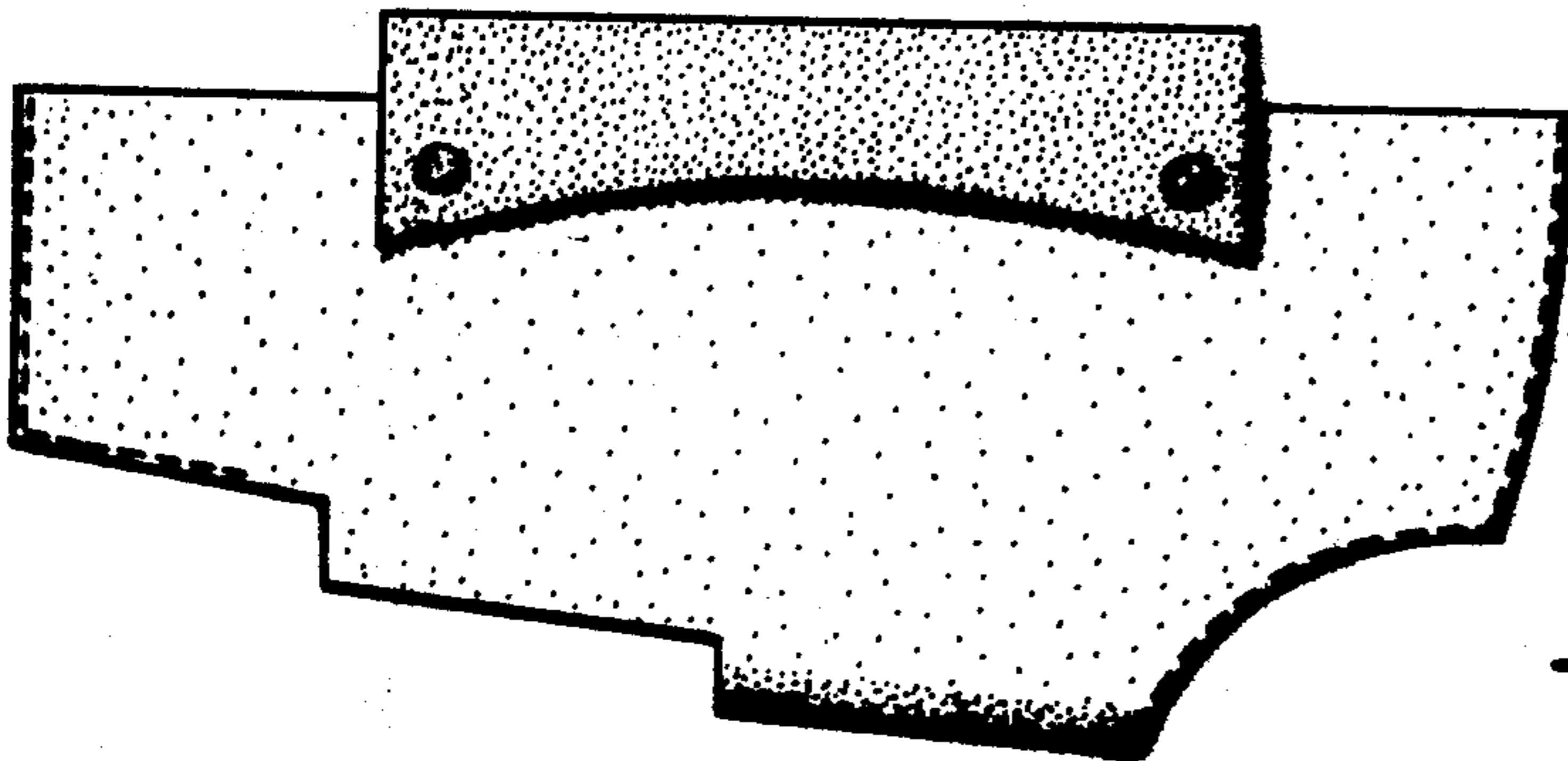

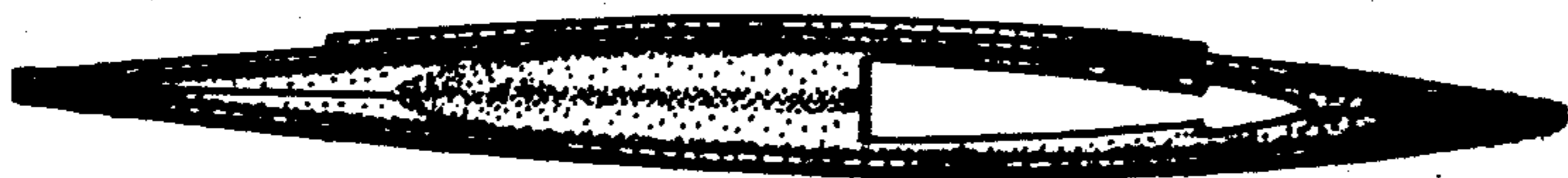
