FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the right-hand side of FIG. 1;

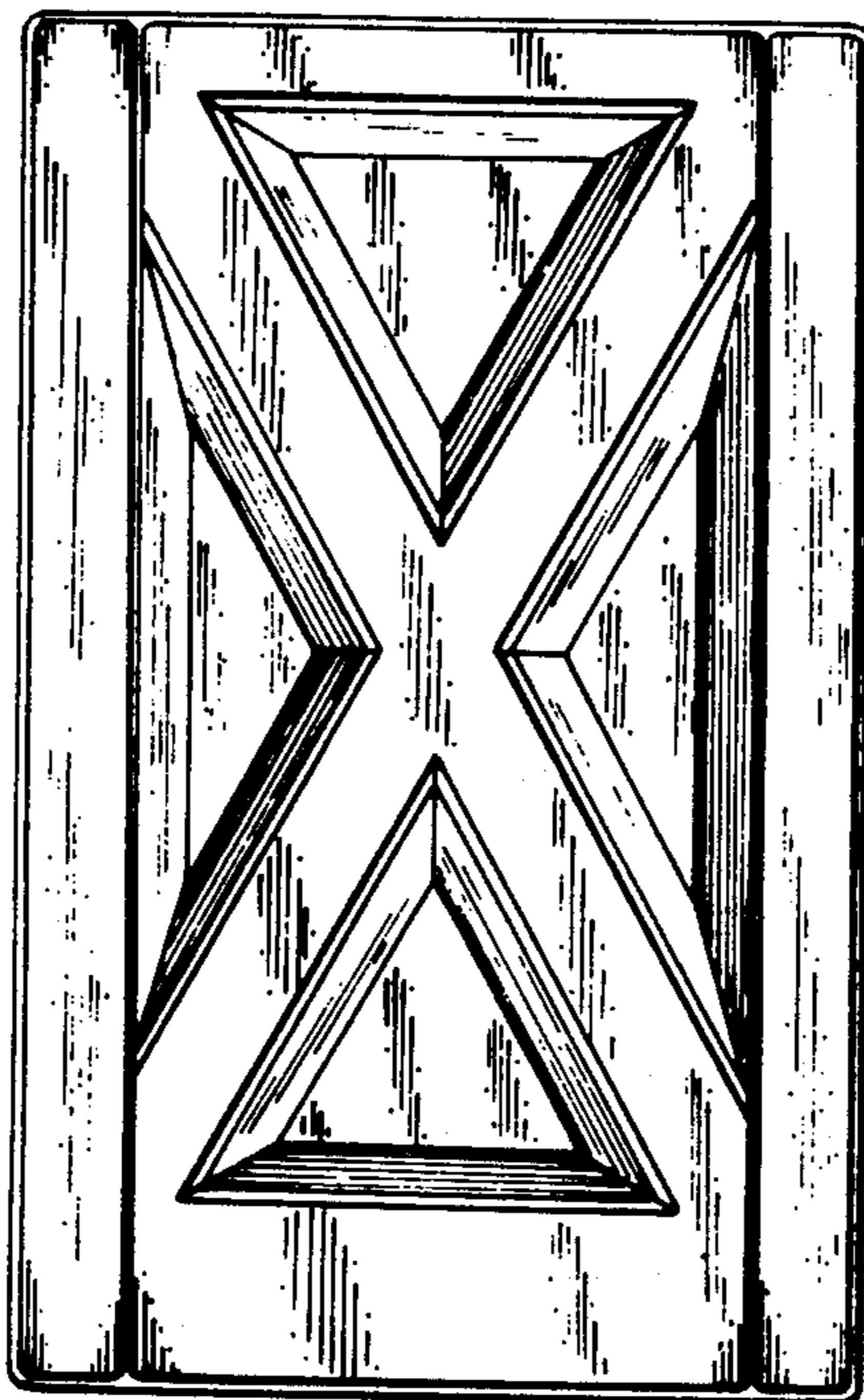
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof as seen from the bottom of FIG. 1; and

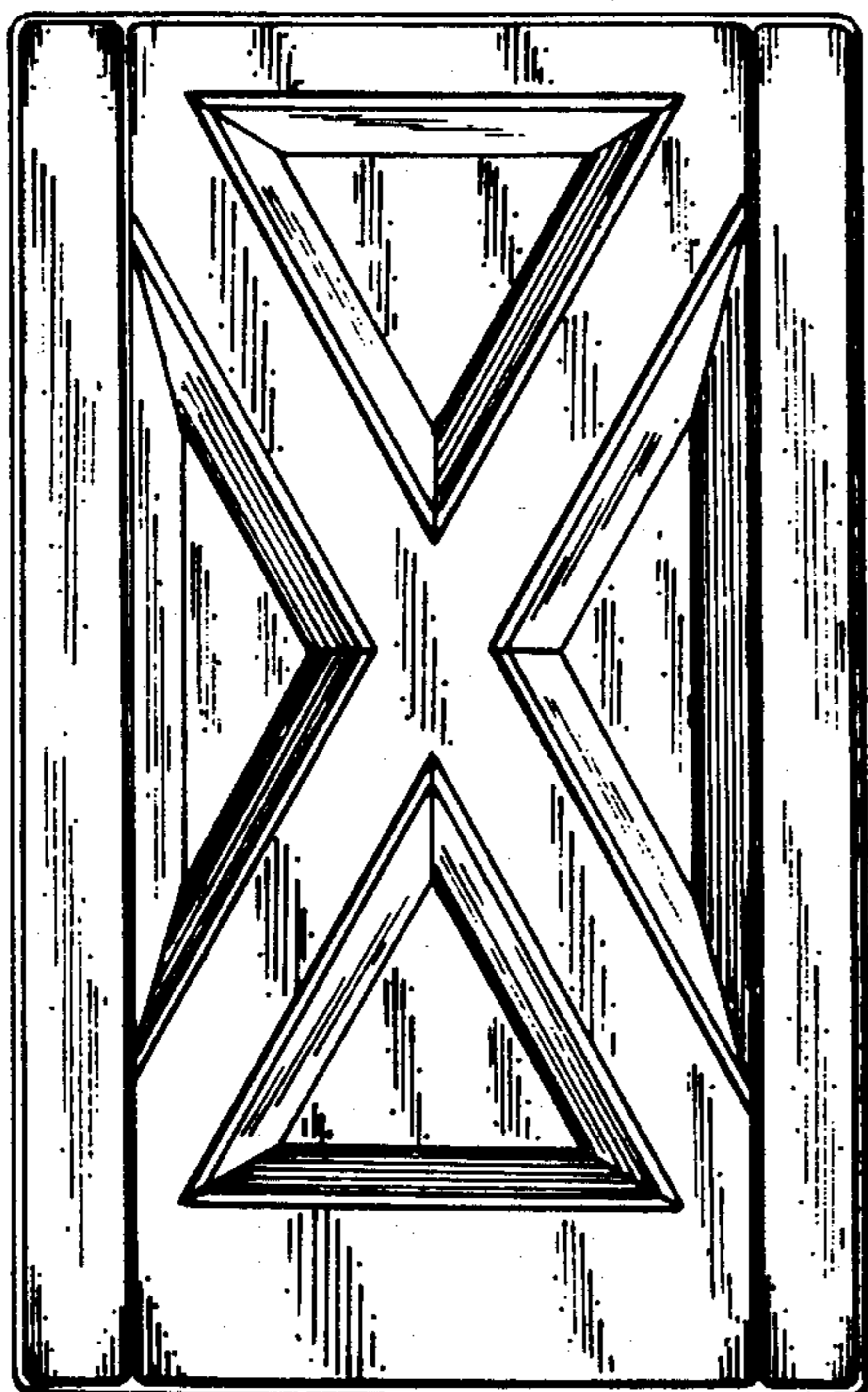

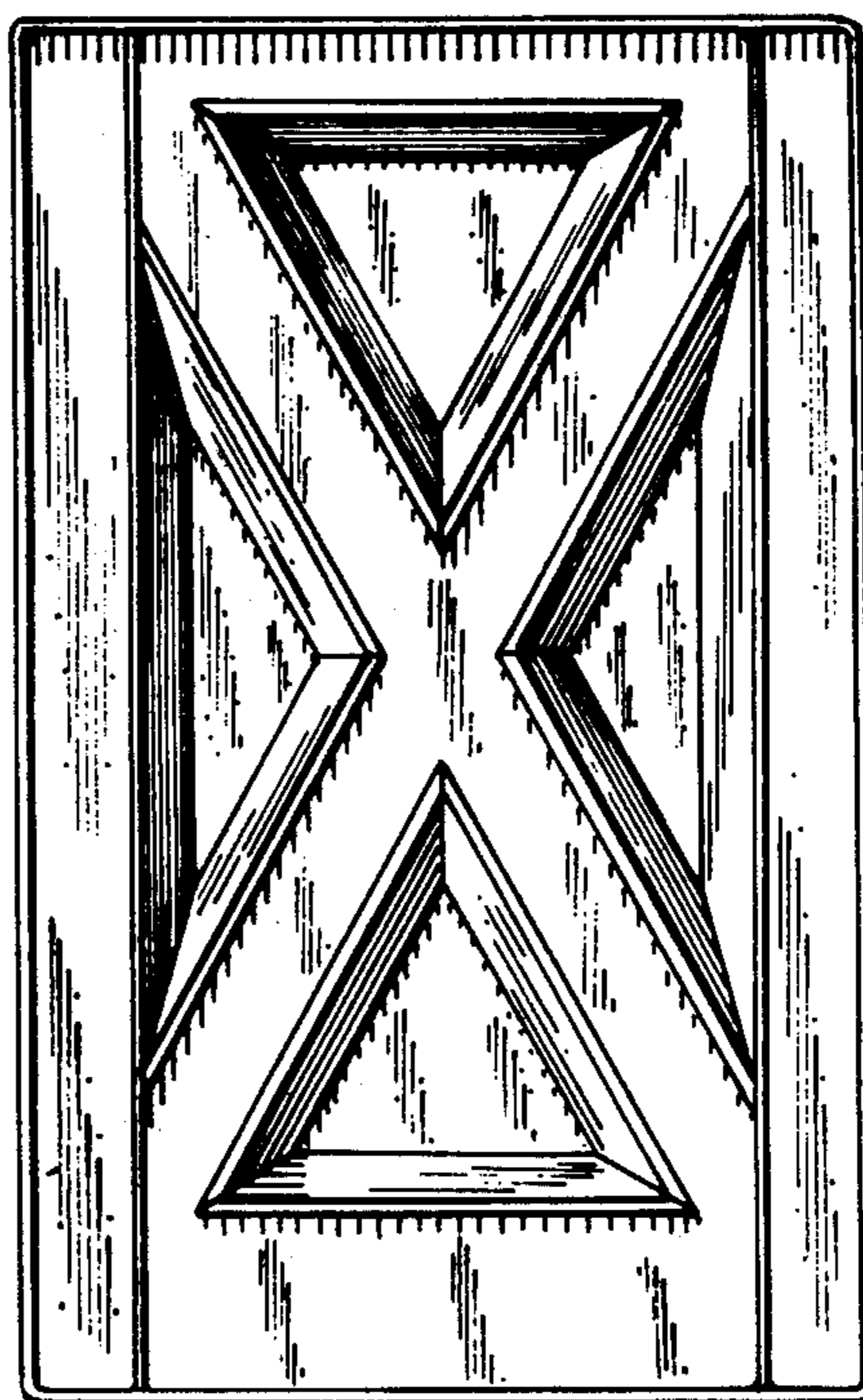
