[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a food processor, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a food processor showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view on an enlarged scale of the plunger thereof;
FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the plunger; and
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the plunger, the bottom of the plunger being substantially flat.

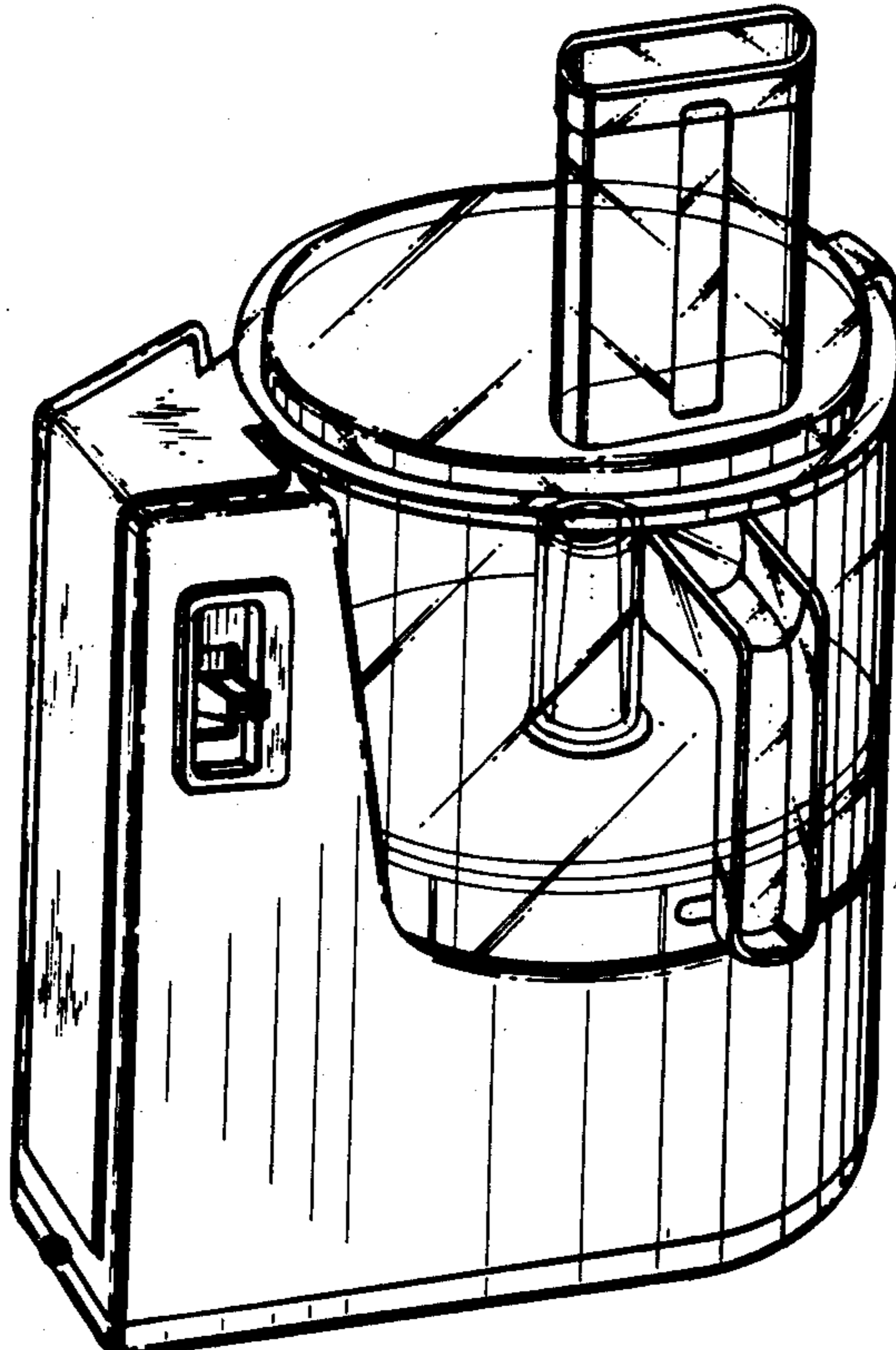

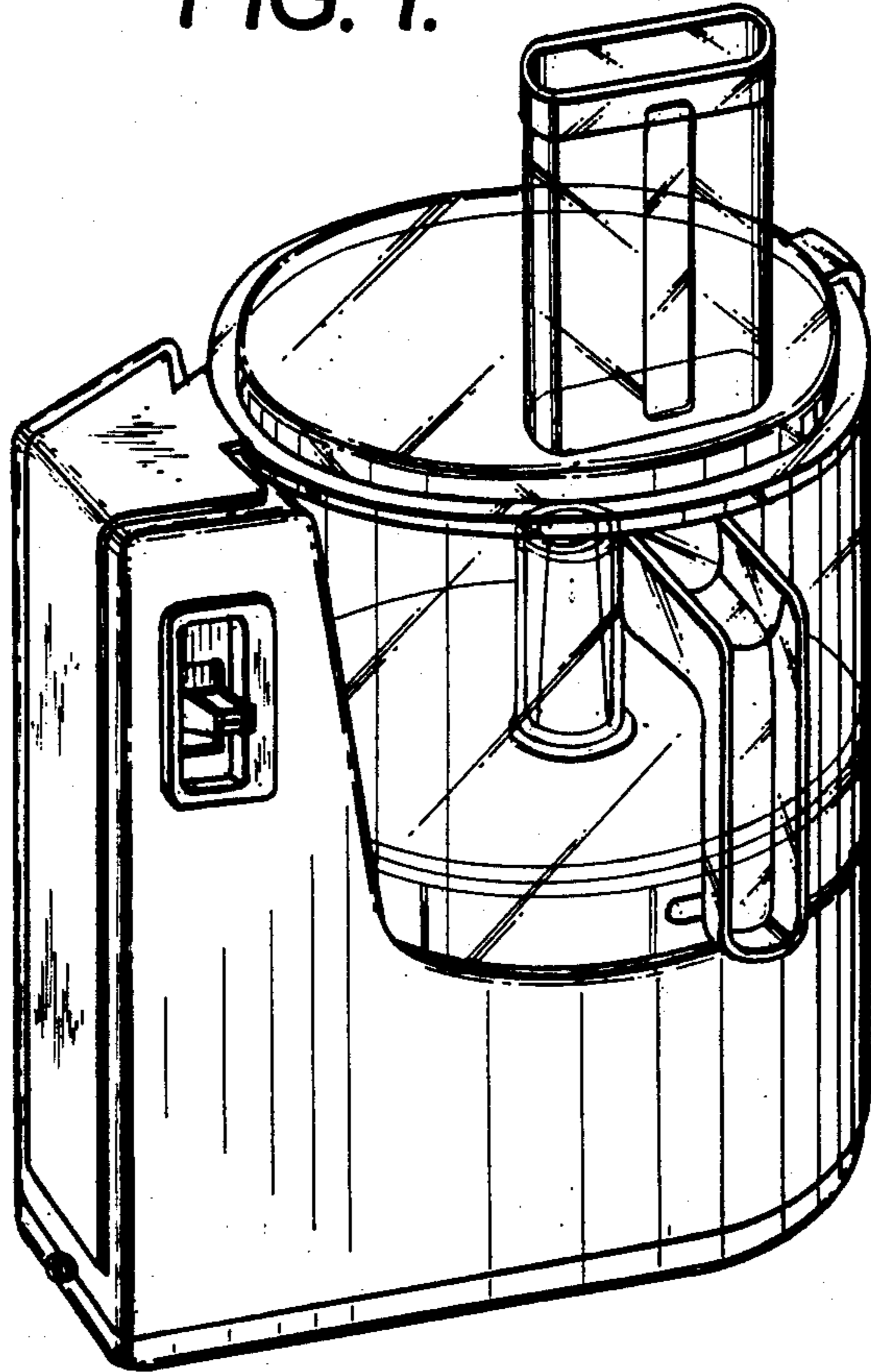

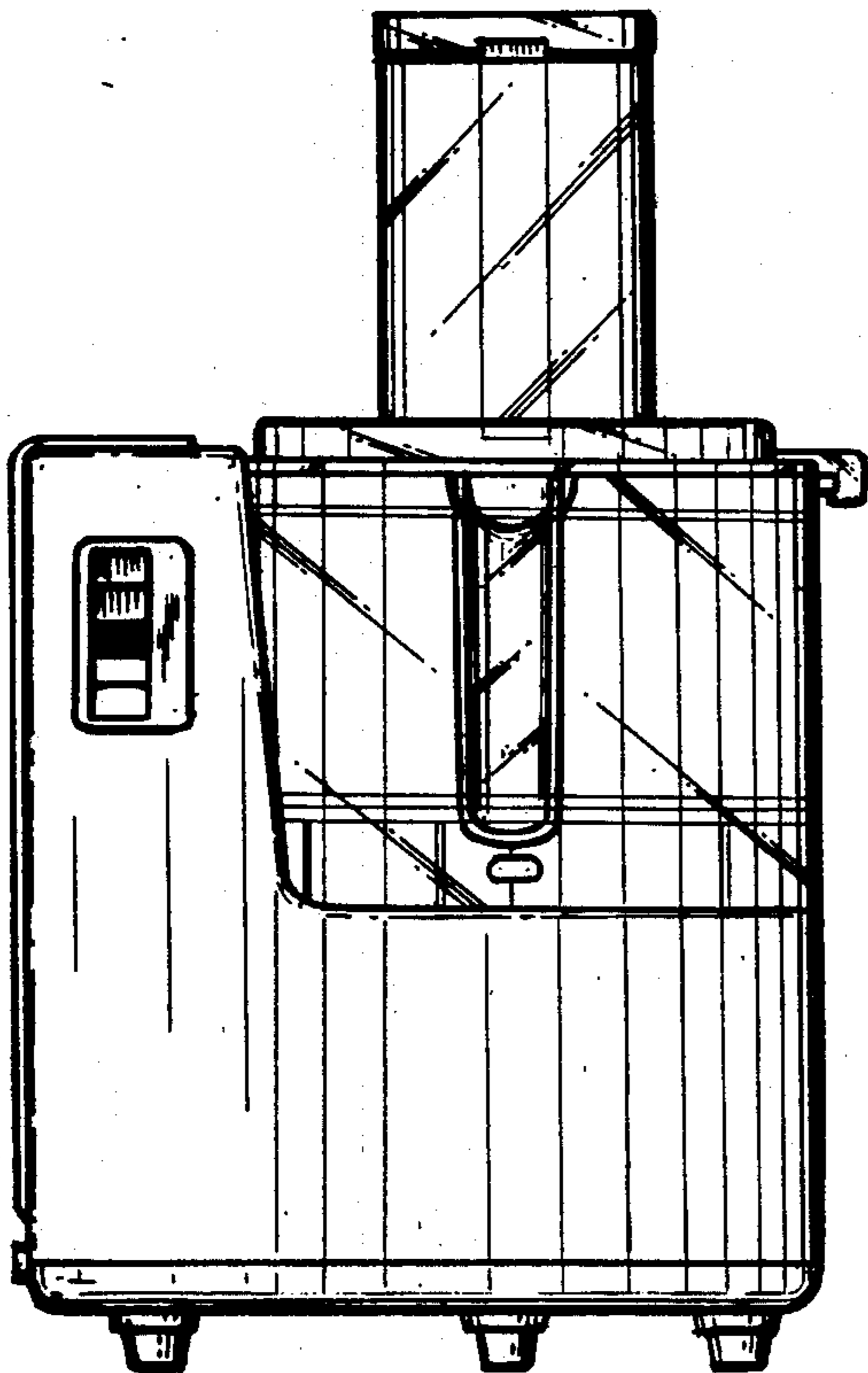
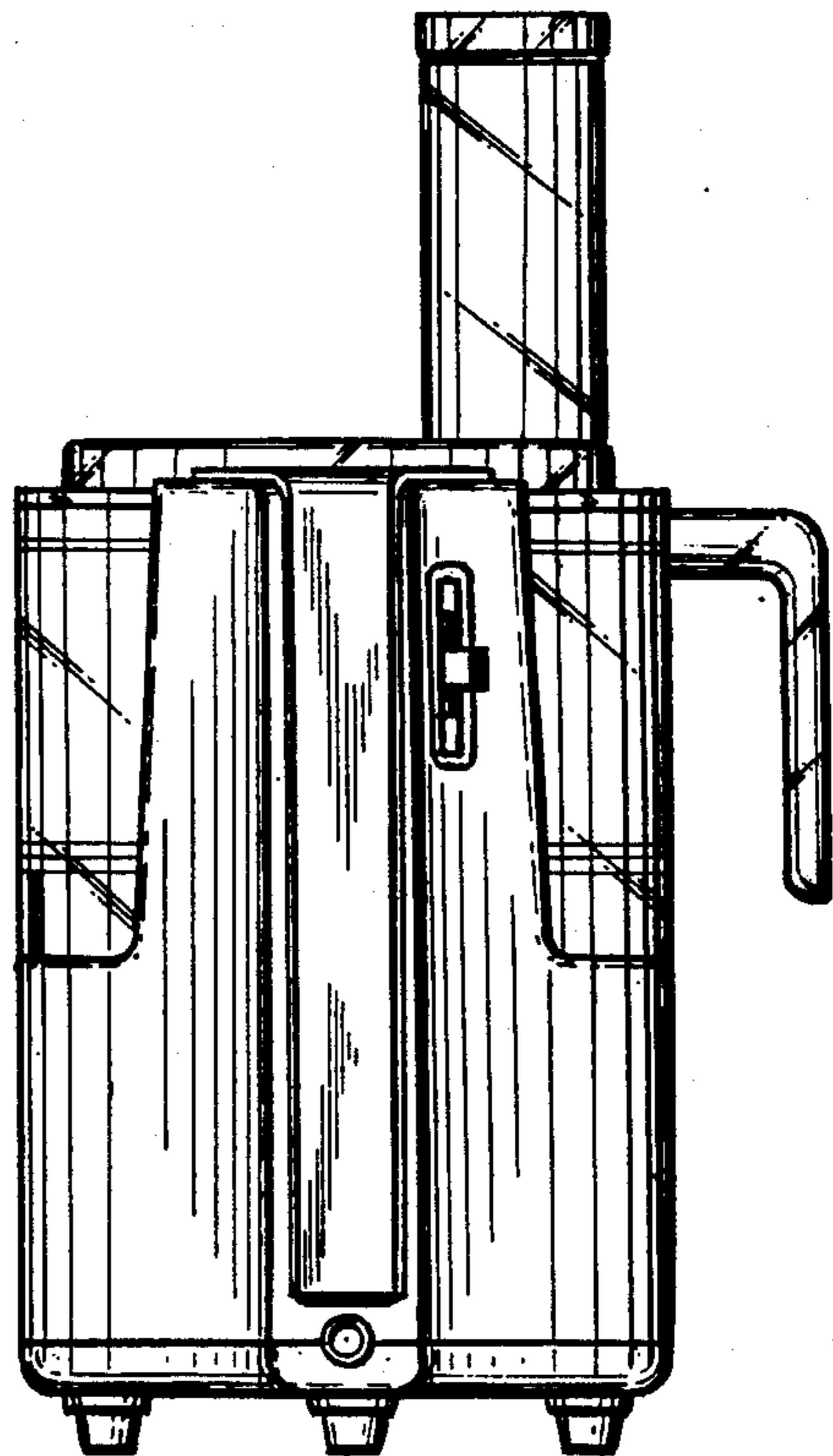

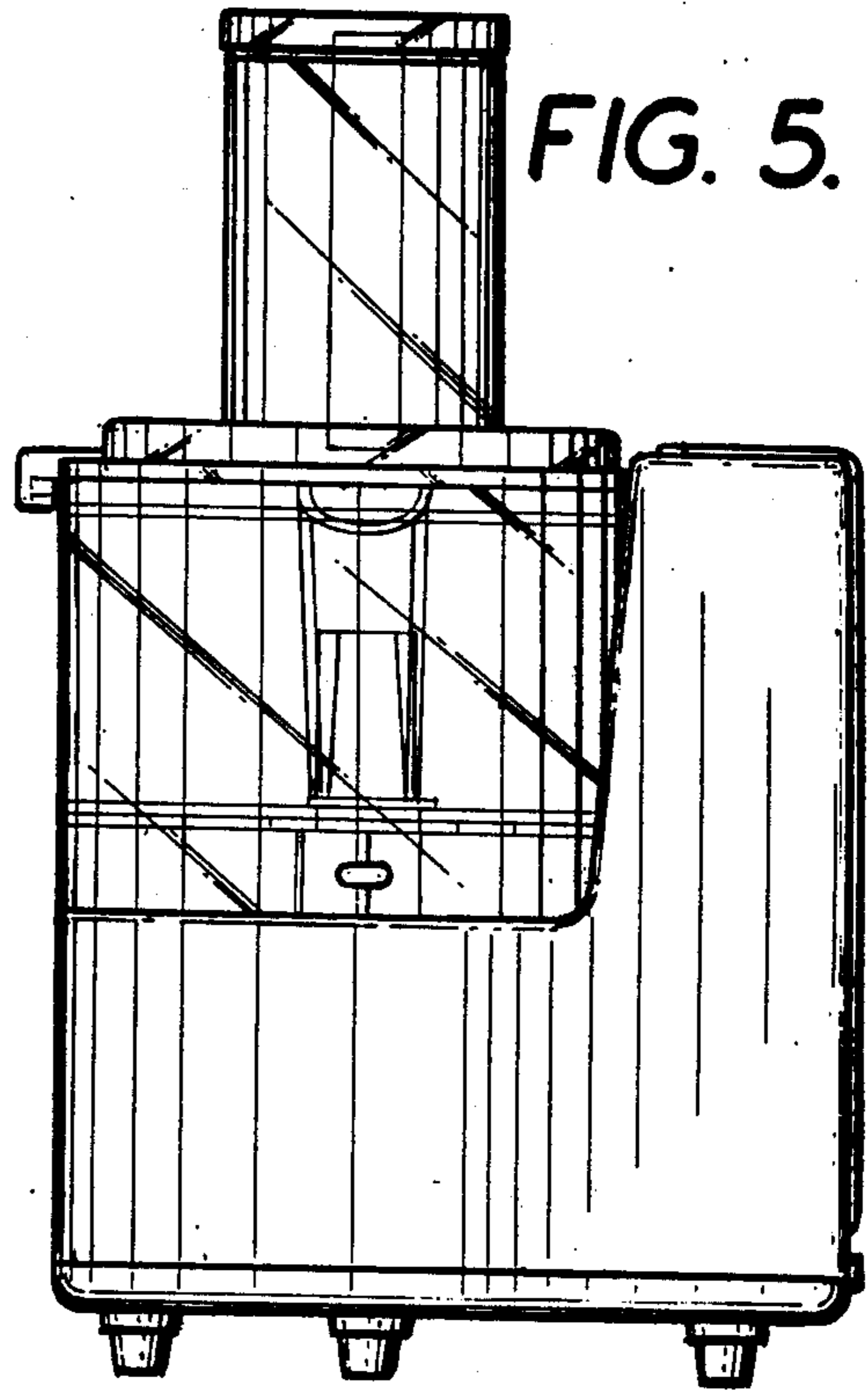
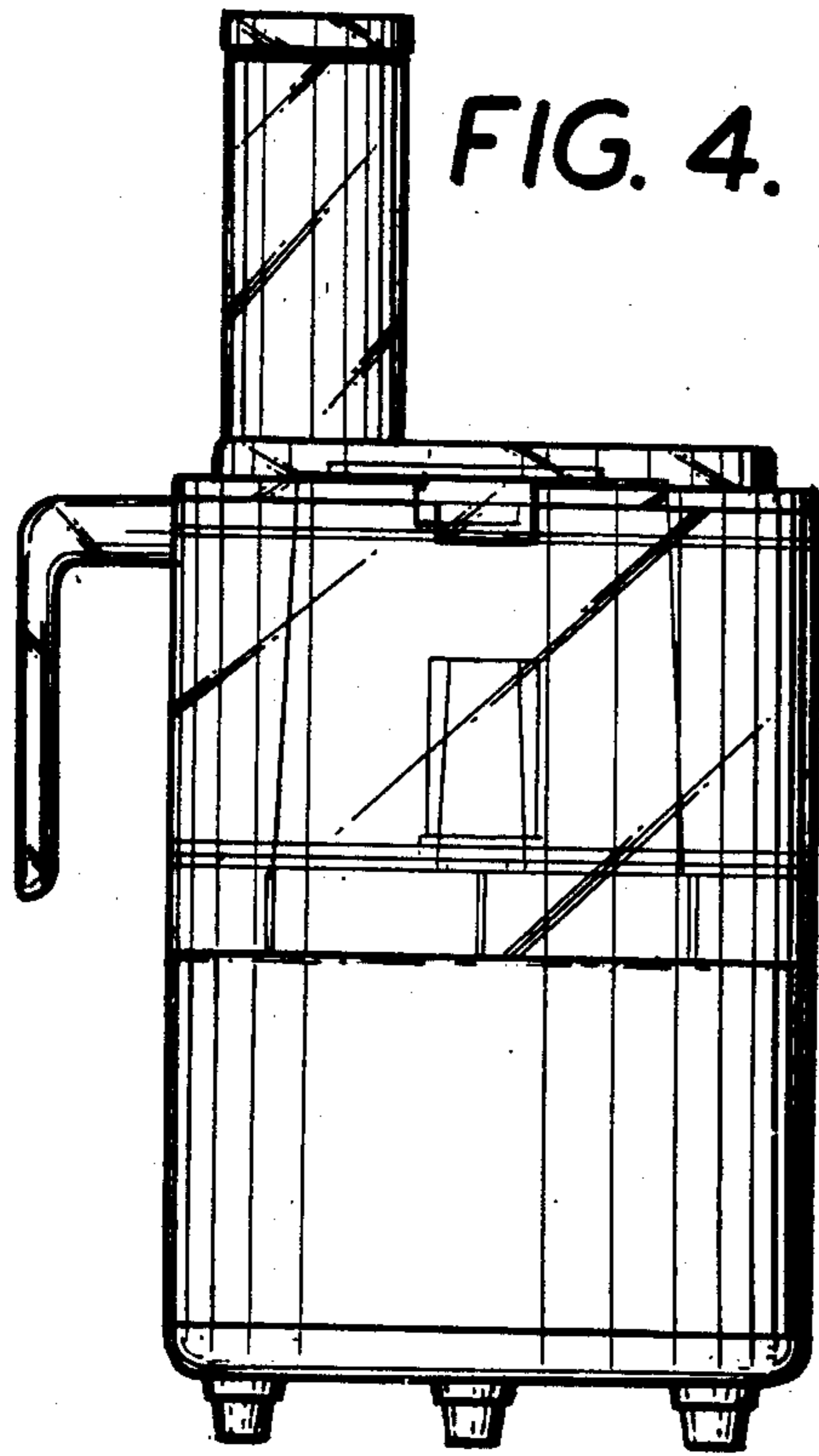

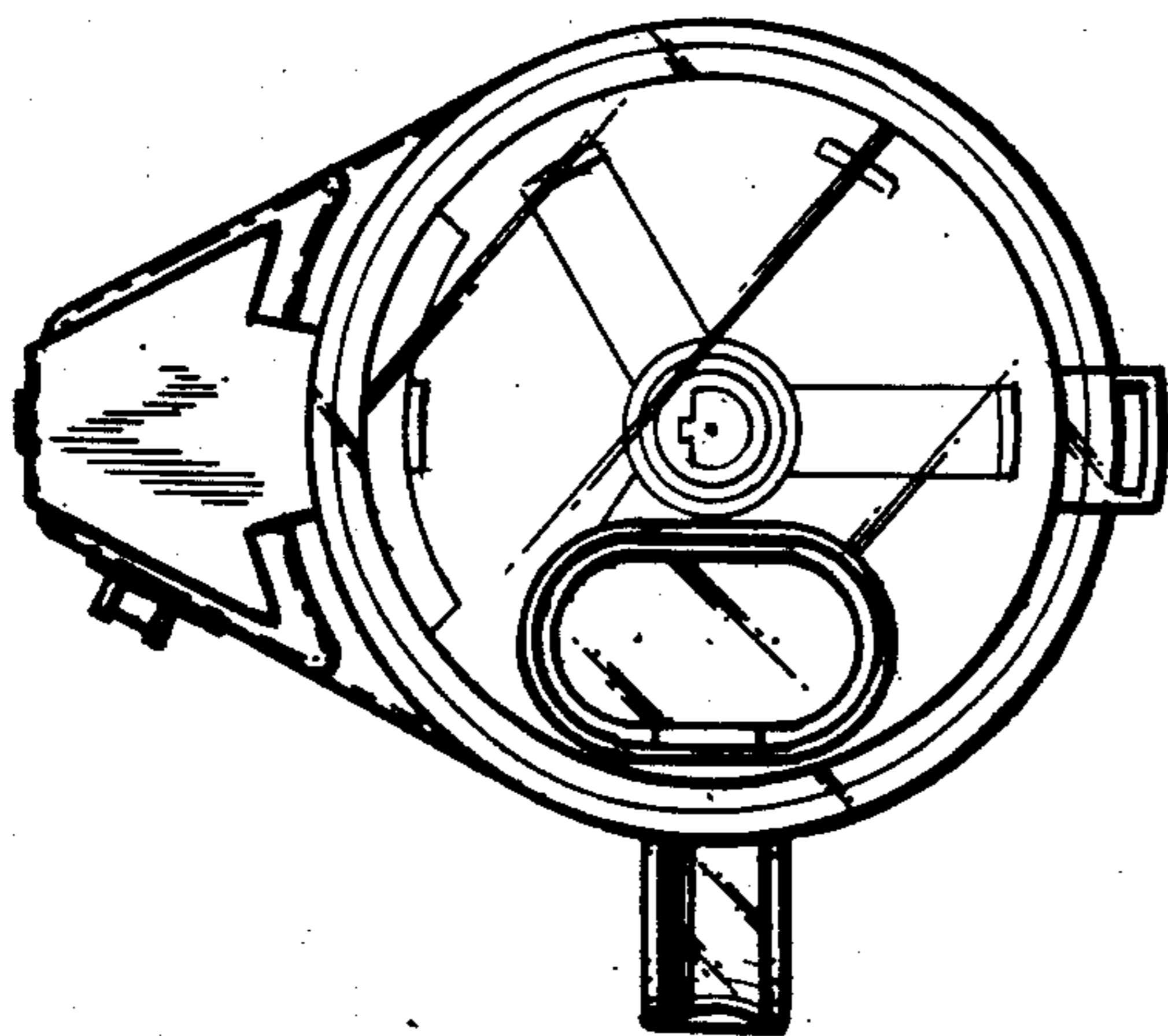

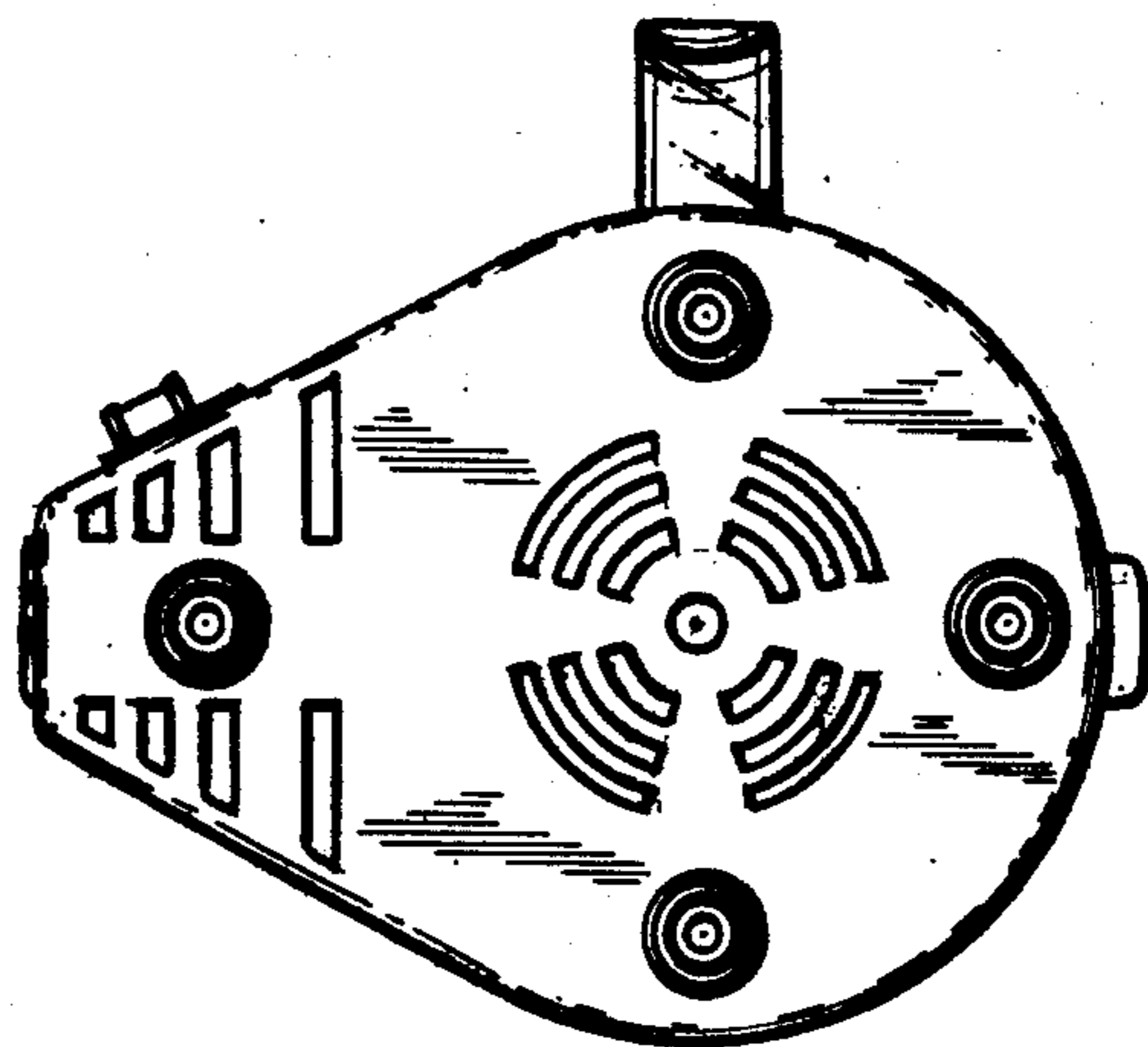

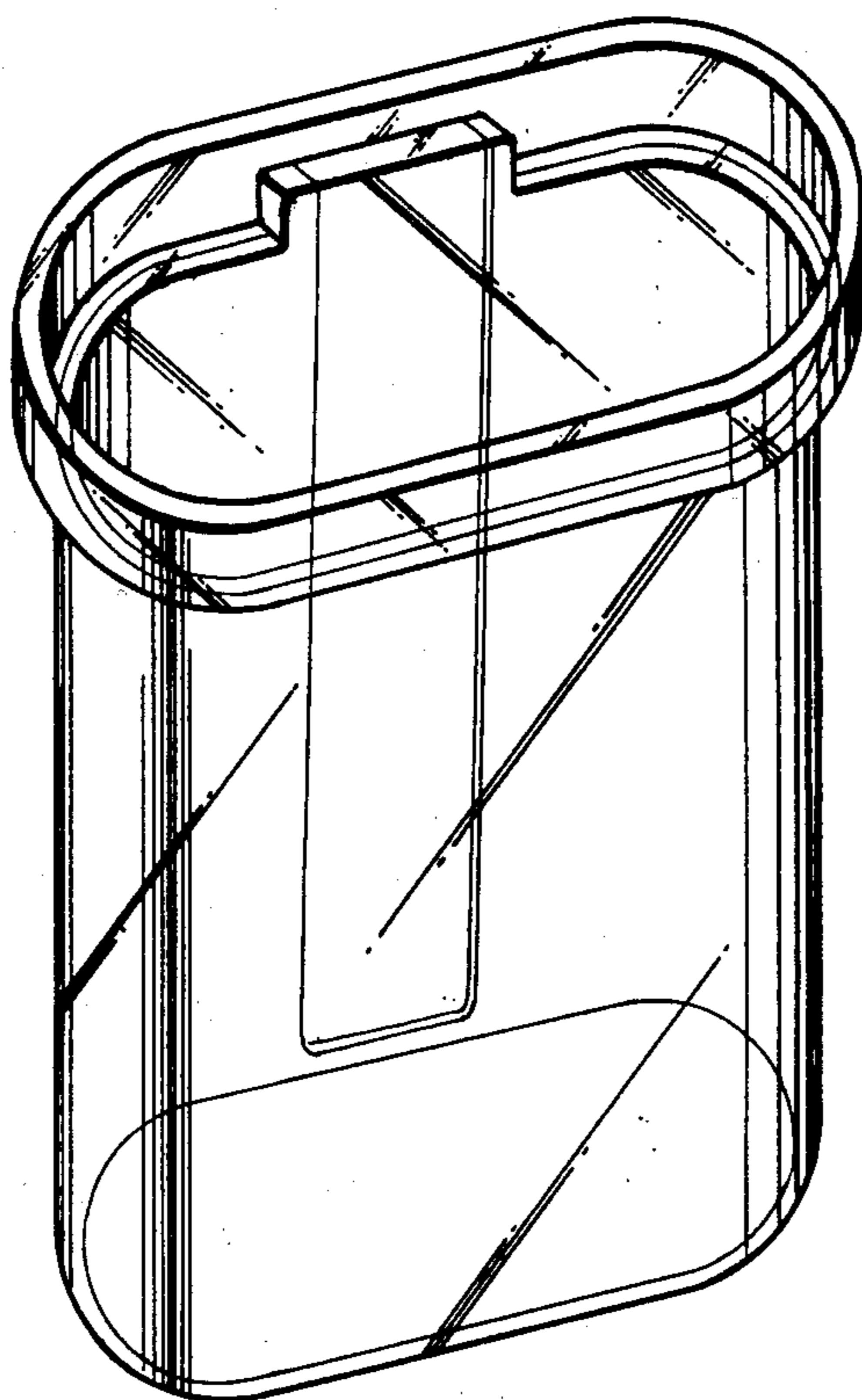

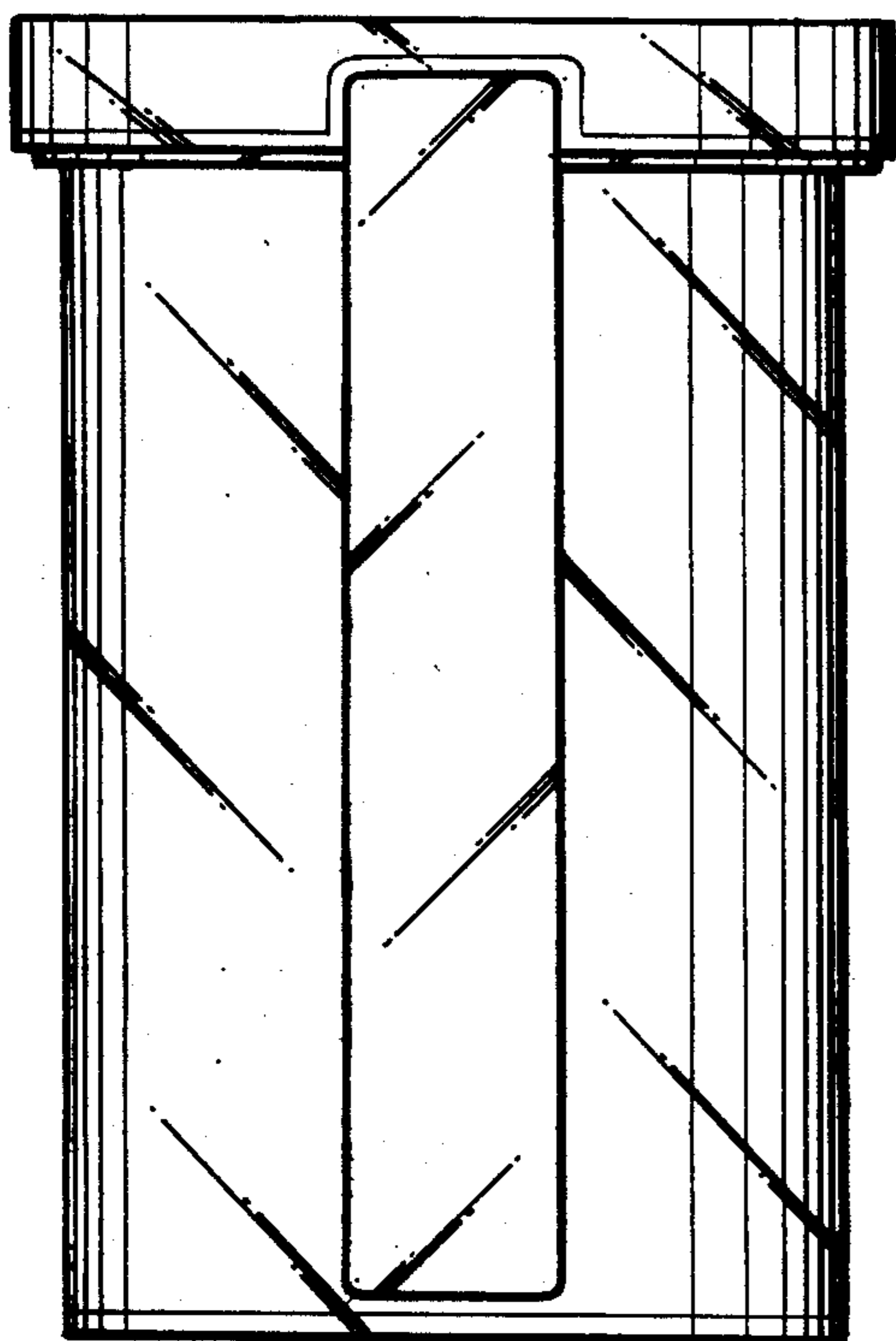
