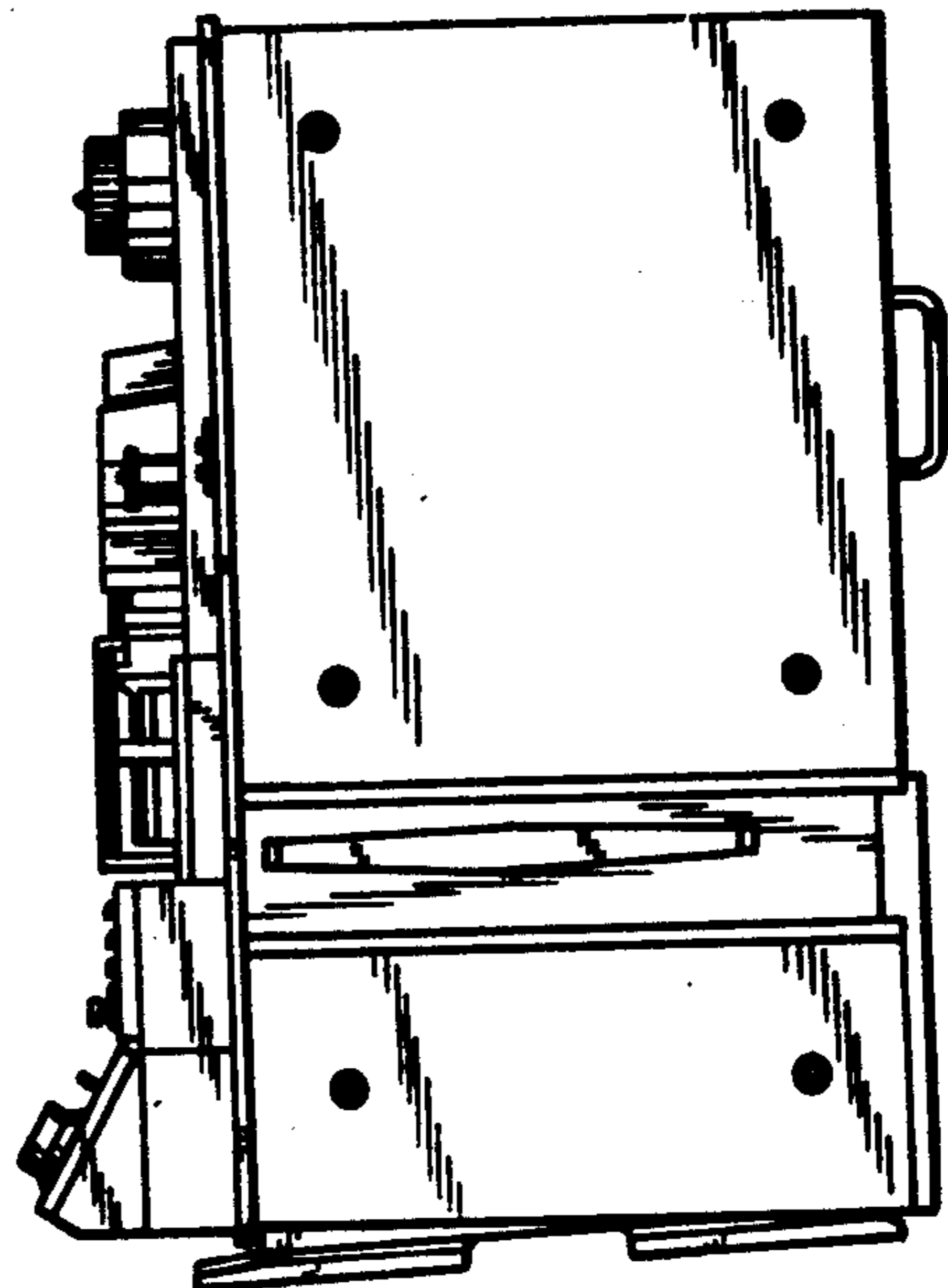
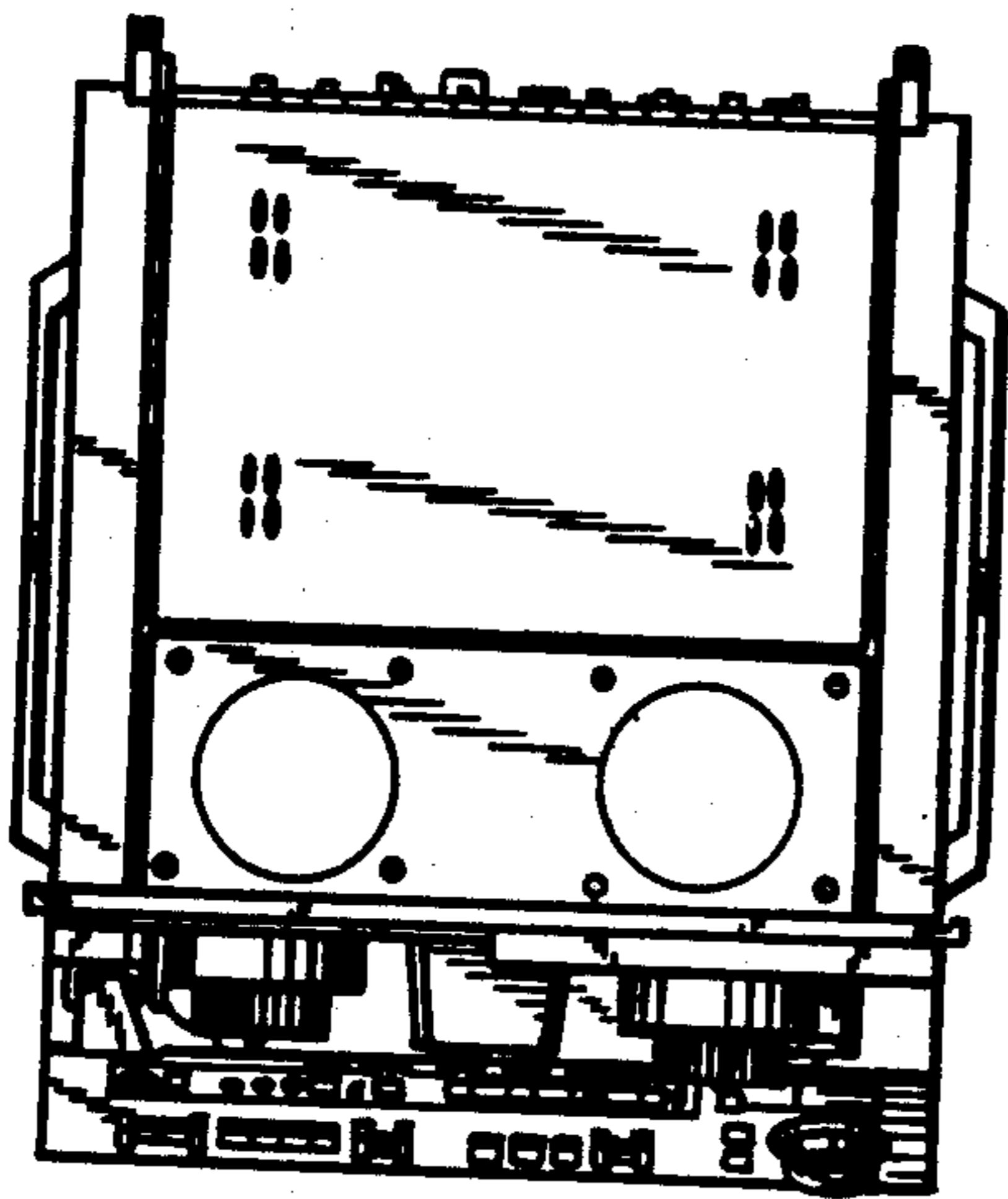
[57] CLAIM

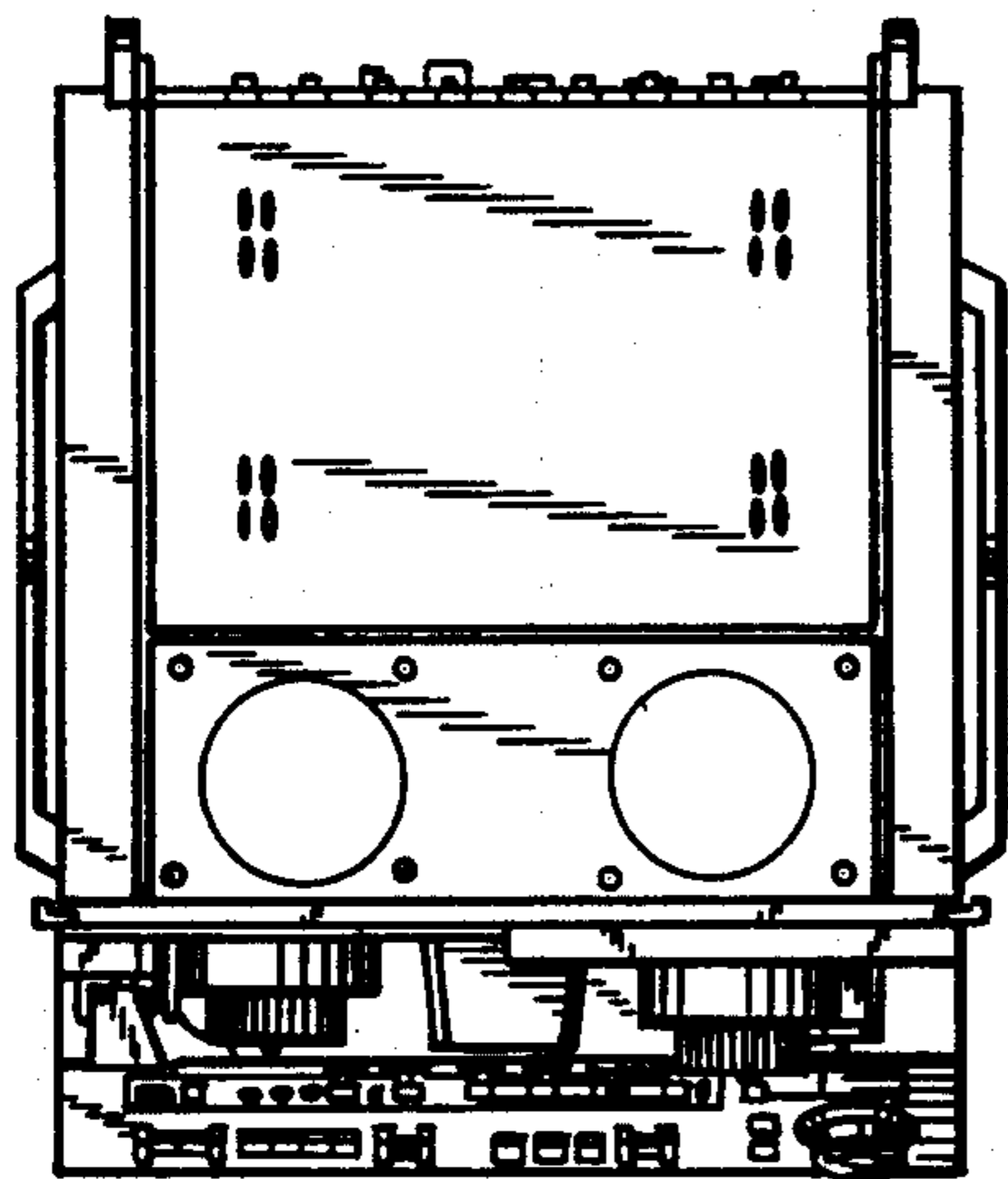

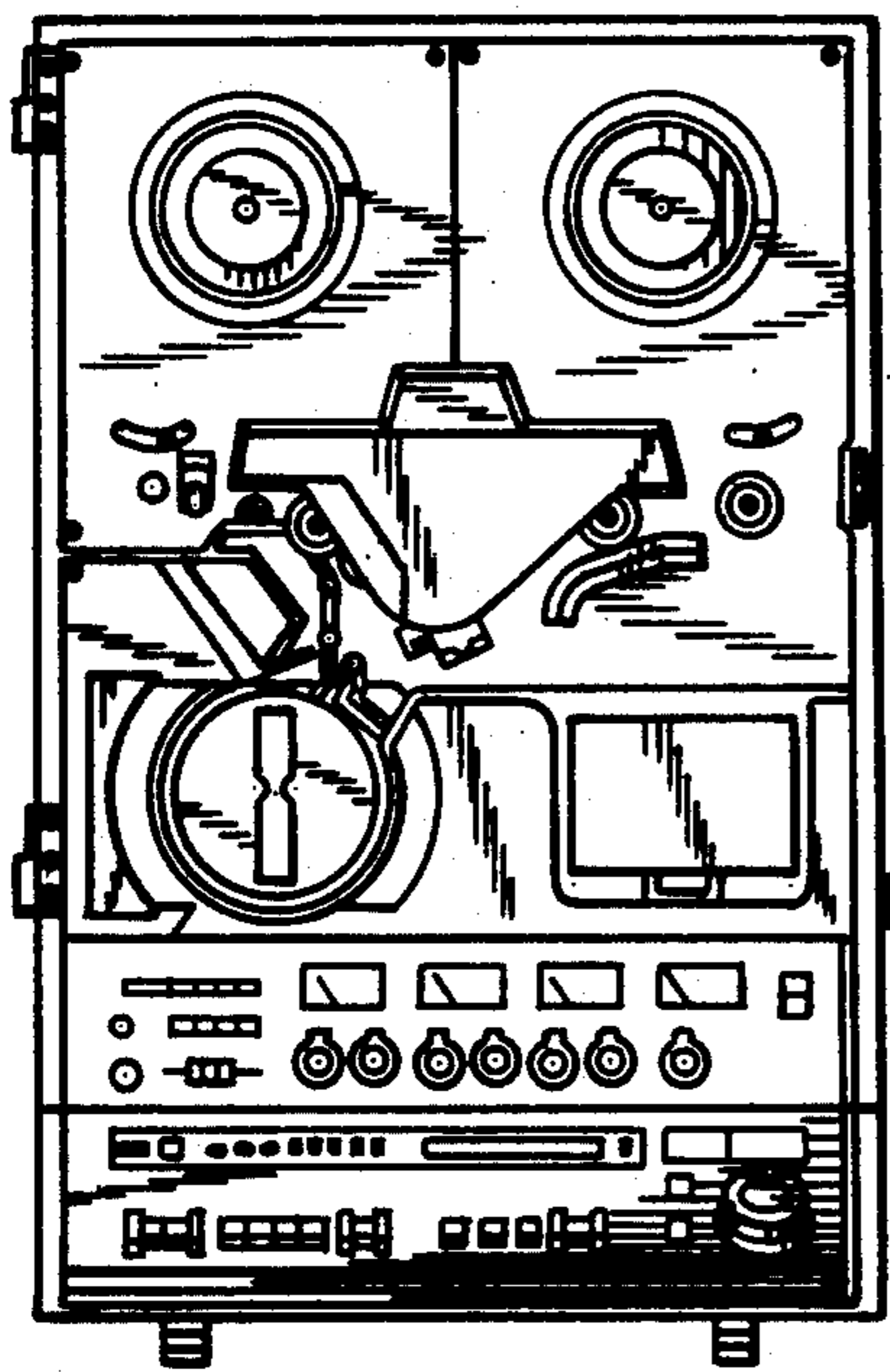

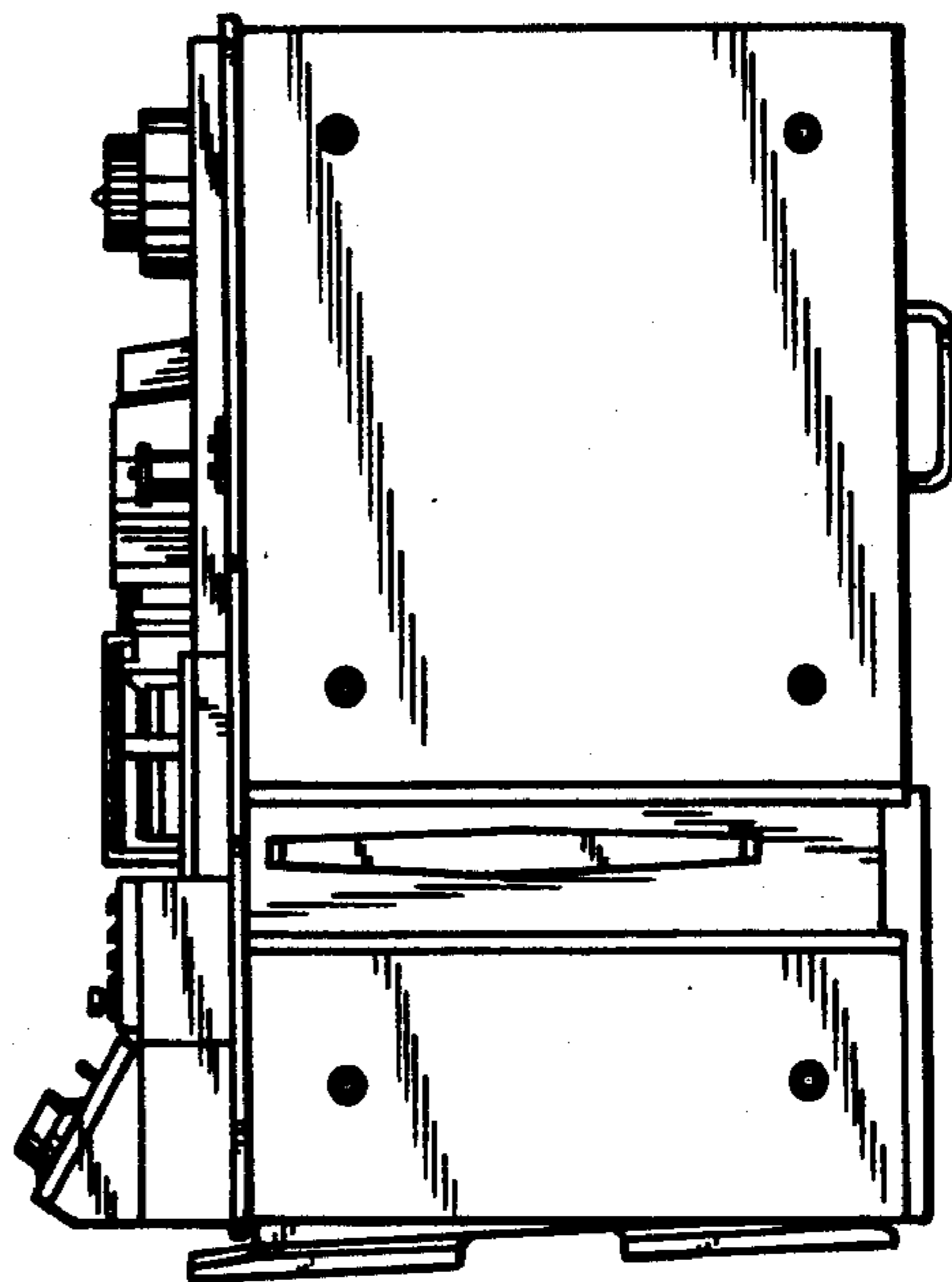

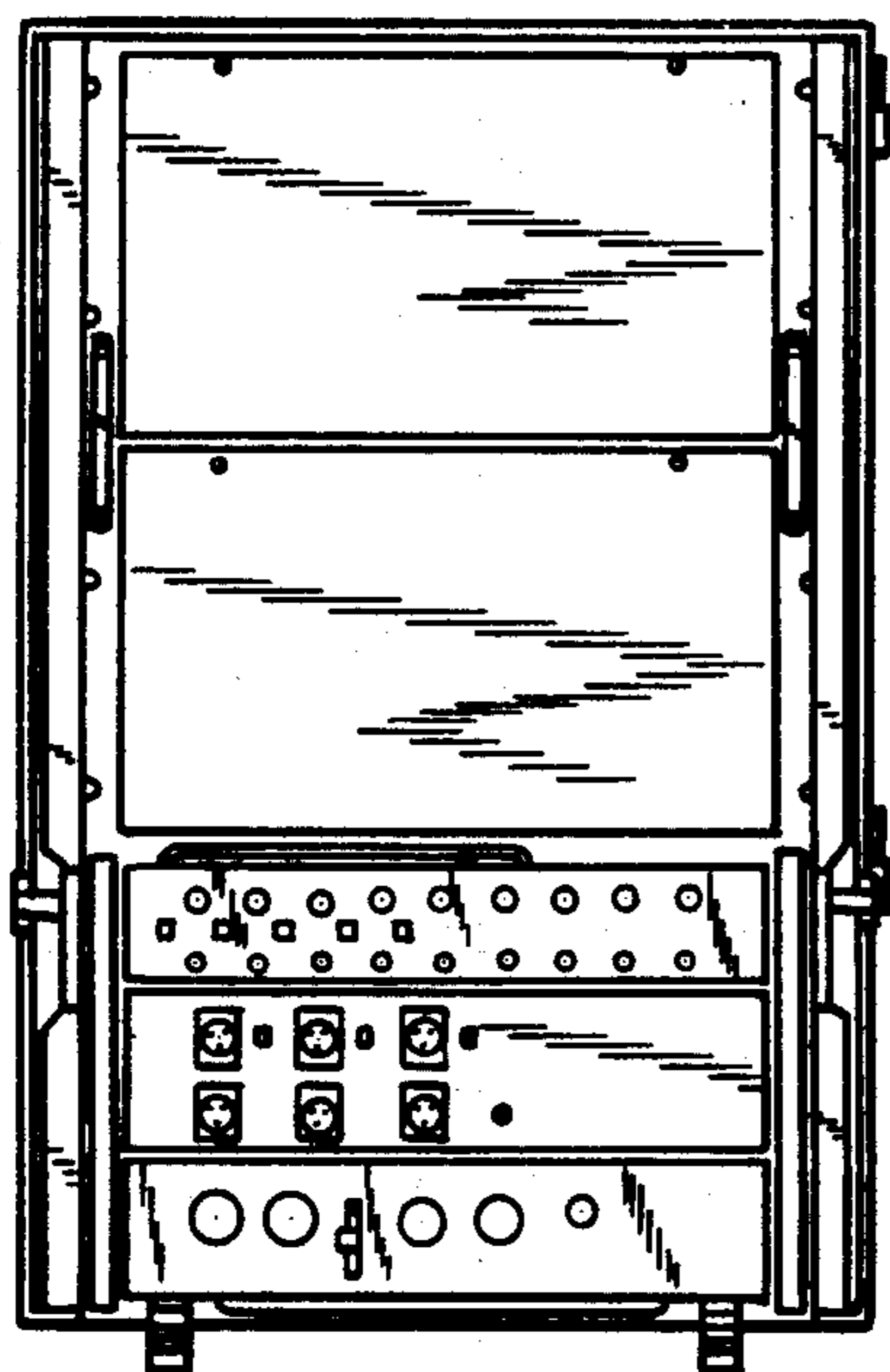

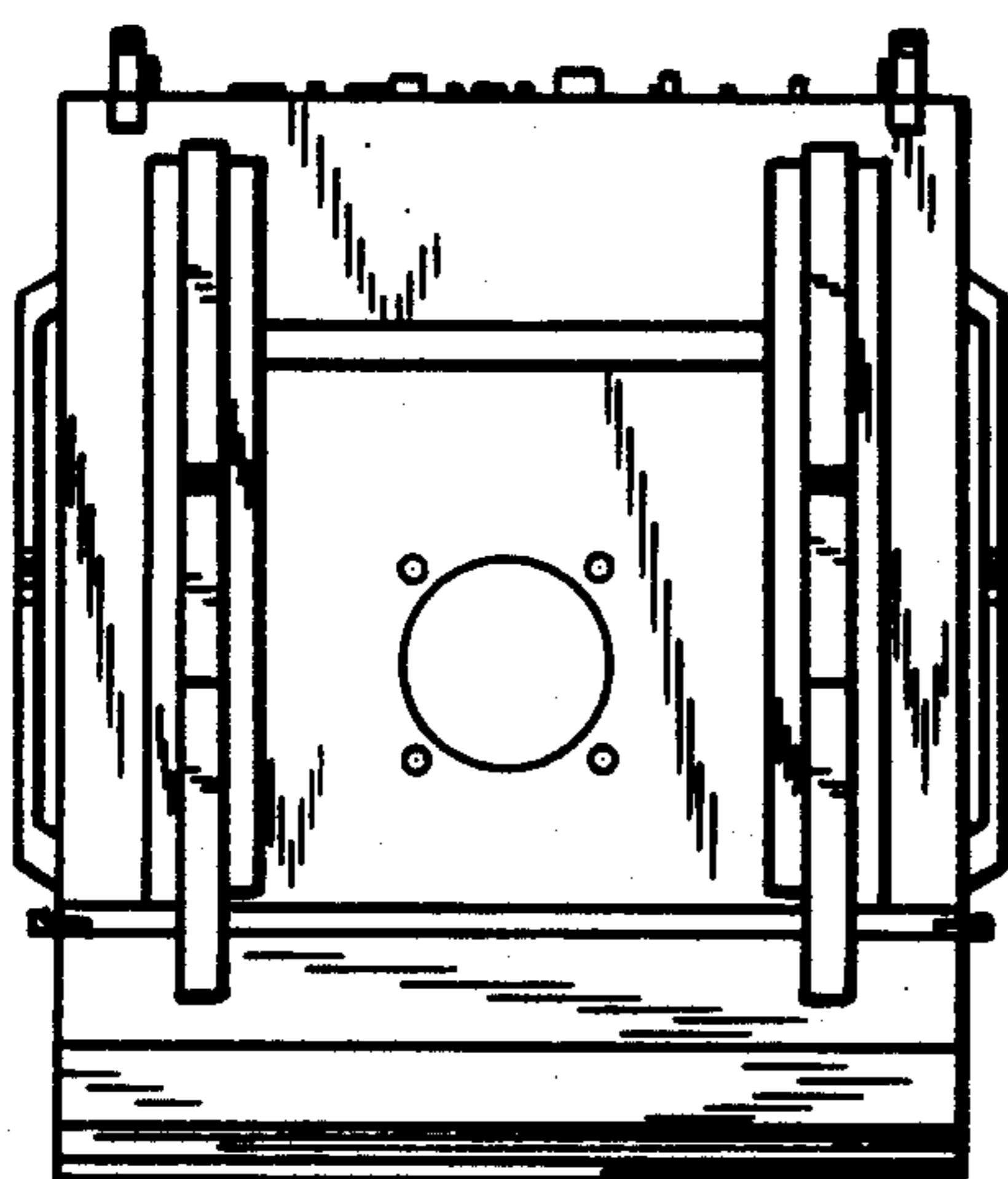
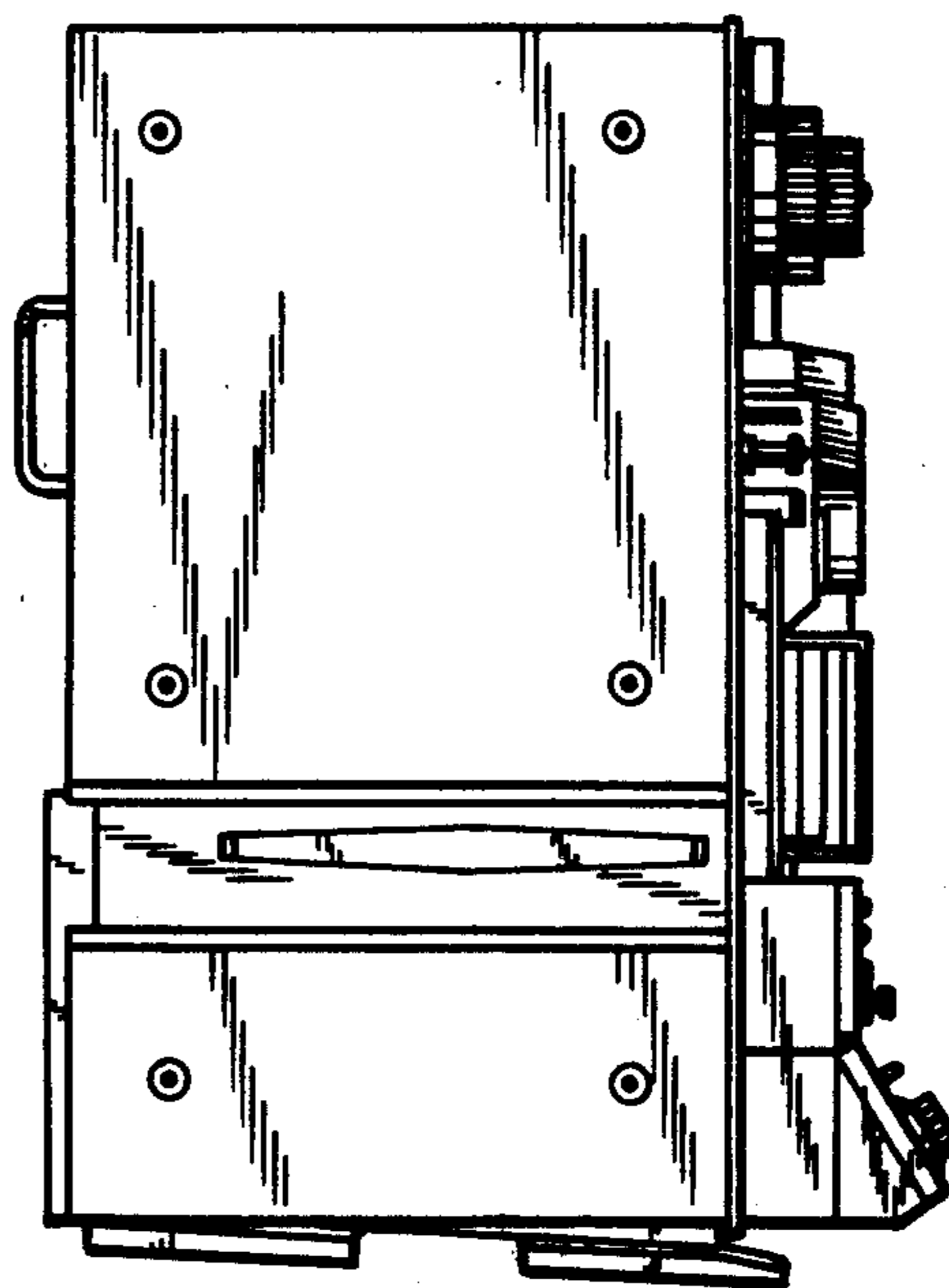
