The ornamental design for a window component extrusion or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective top view of a window component extrusion of indeterminate length comprising our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective bottom view of the window component extrusion; and

FIG. 3 is an end elevation of the window component extrusion.
