FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an escutcheon incorporating my new design.

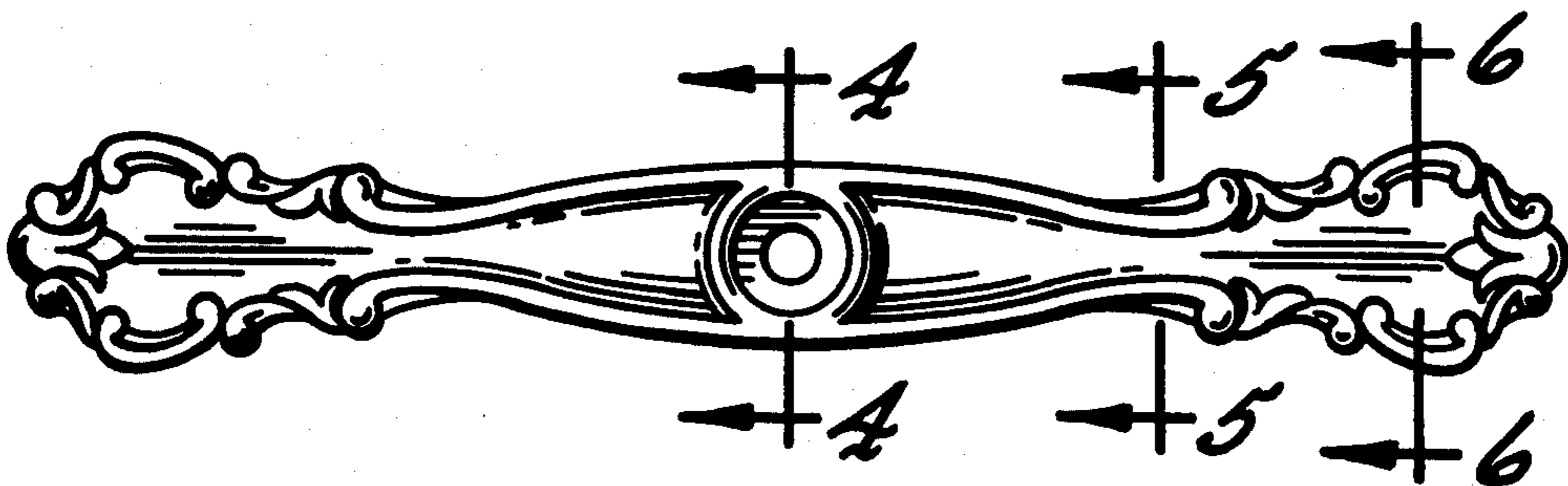
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged sectional view taken along the line 6-6 in FIG. 1.



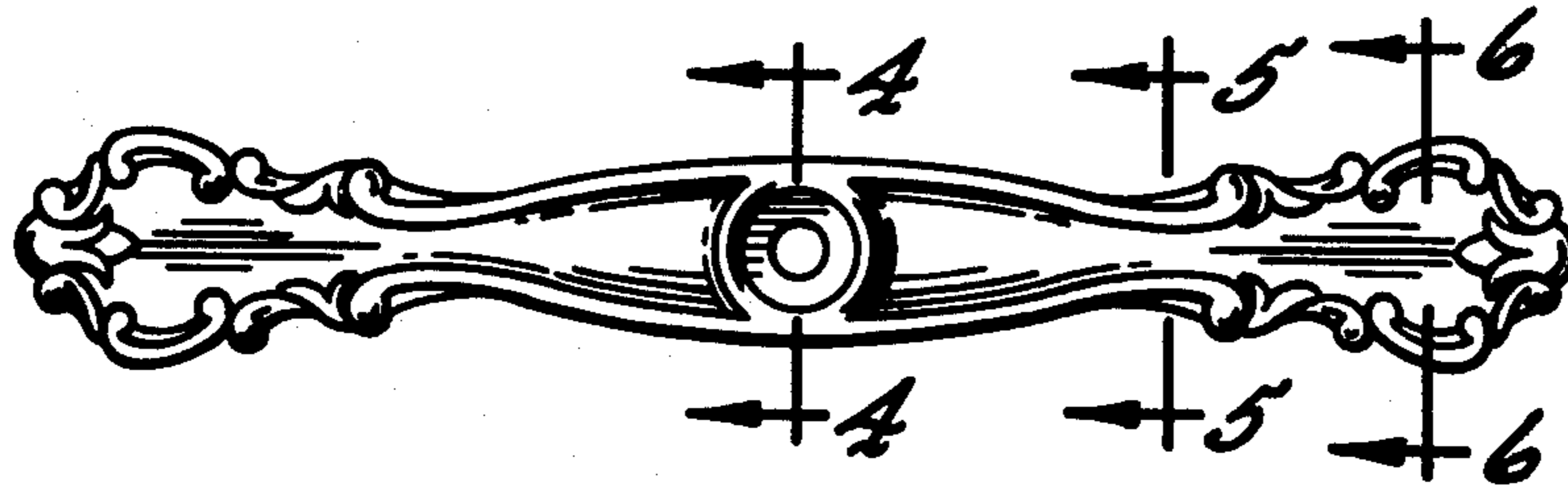
