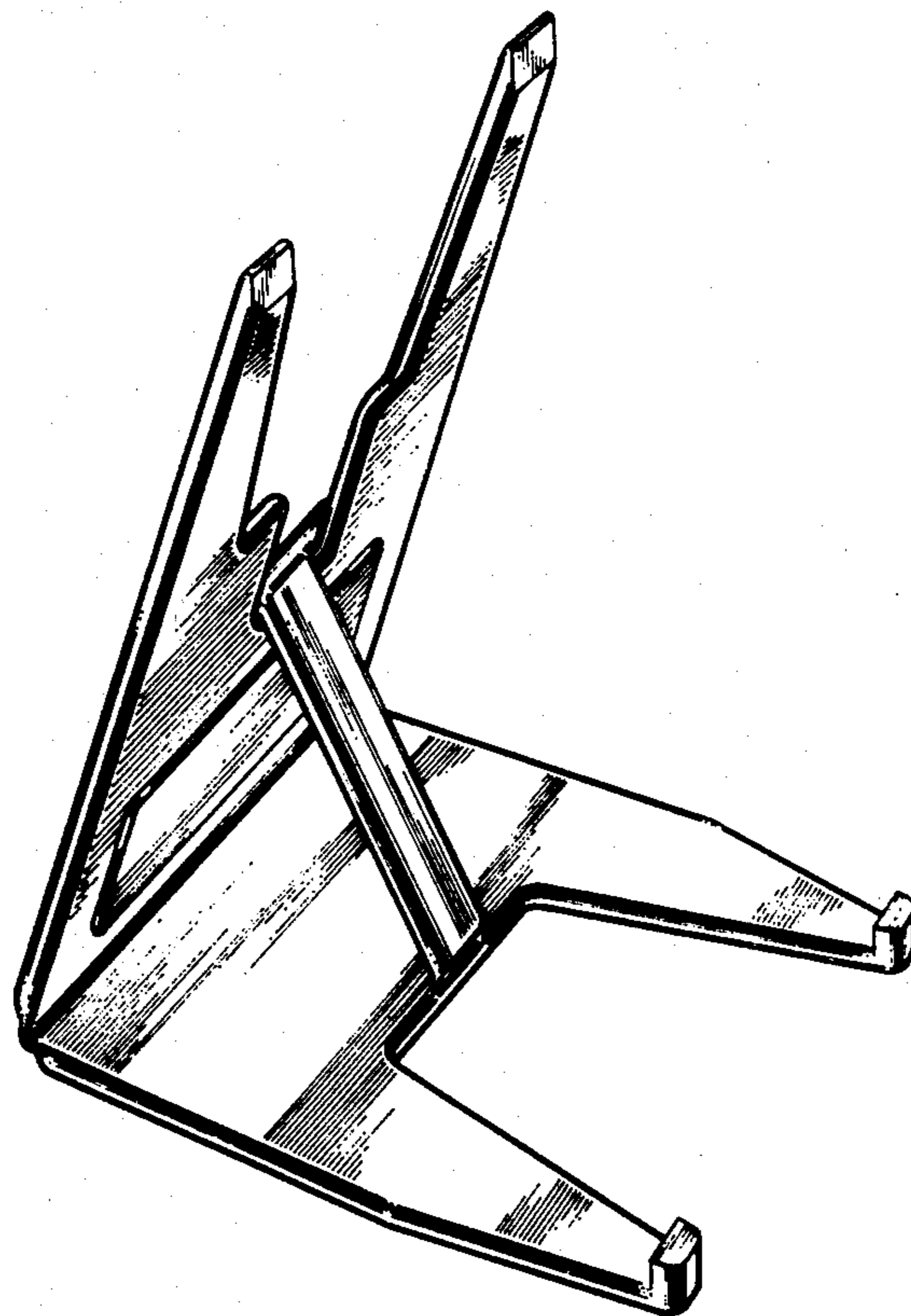

The ornamental design for a plate display stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged front perspective view of the plate display stand showing my new design in the operative position;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view in the opened position;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2.



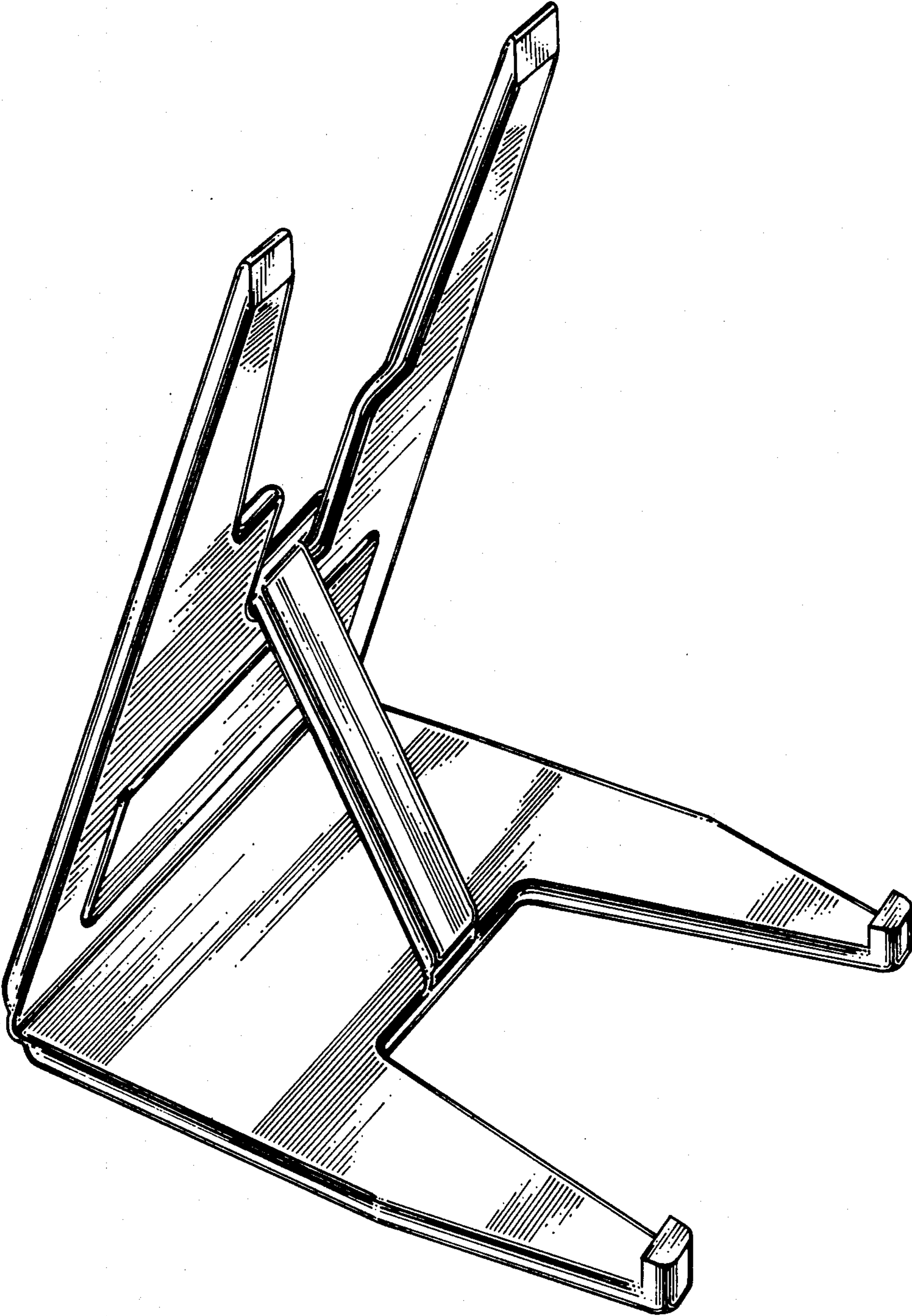

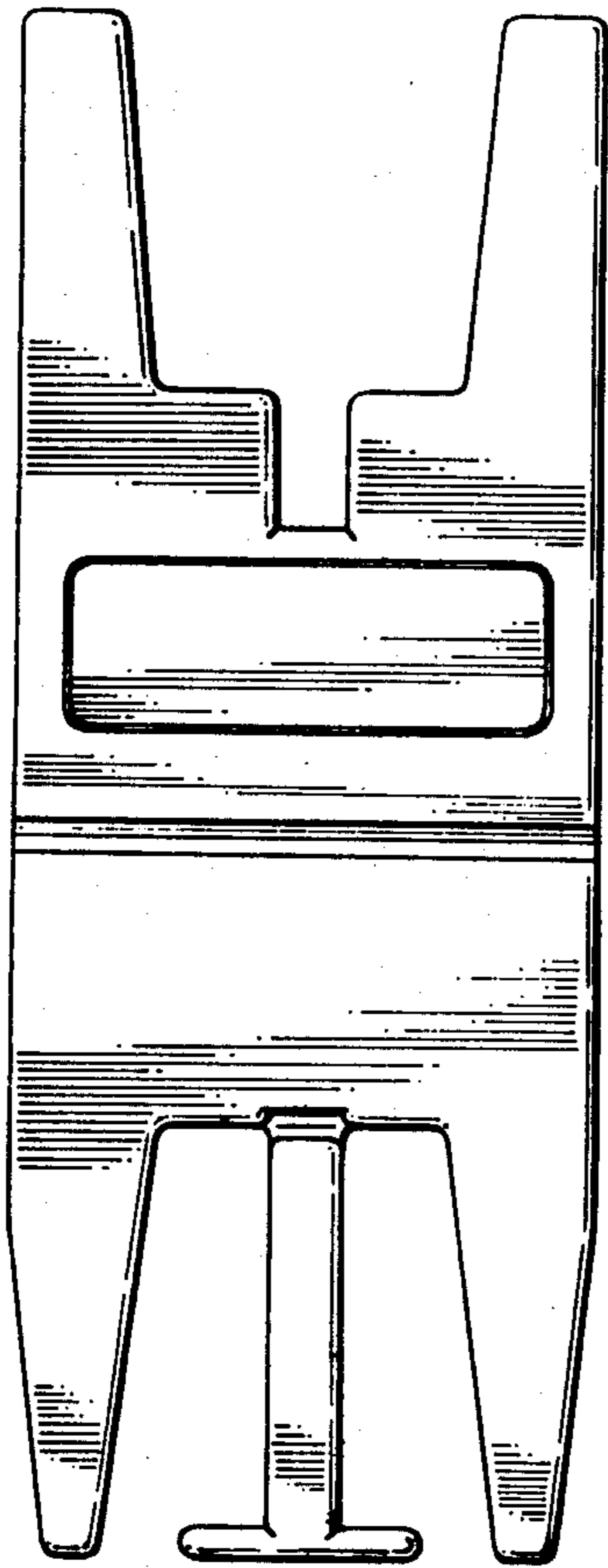

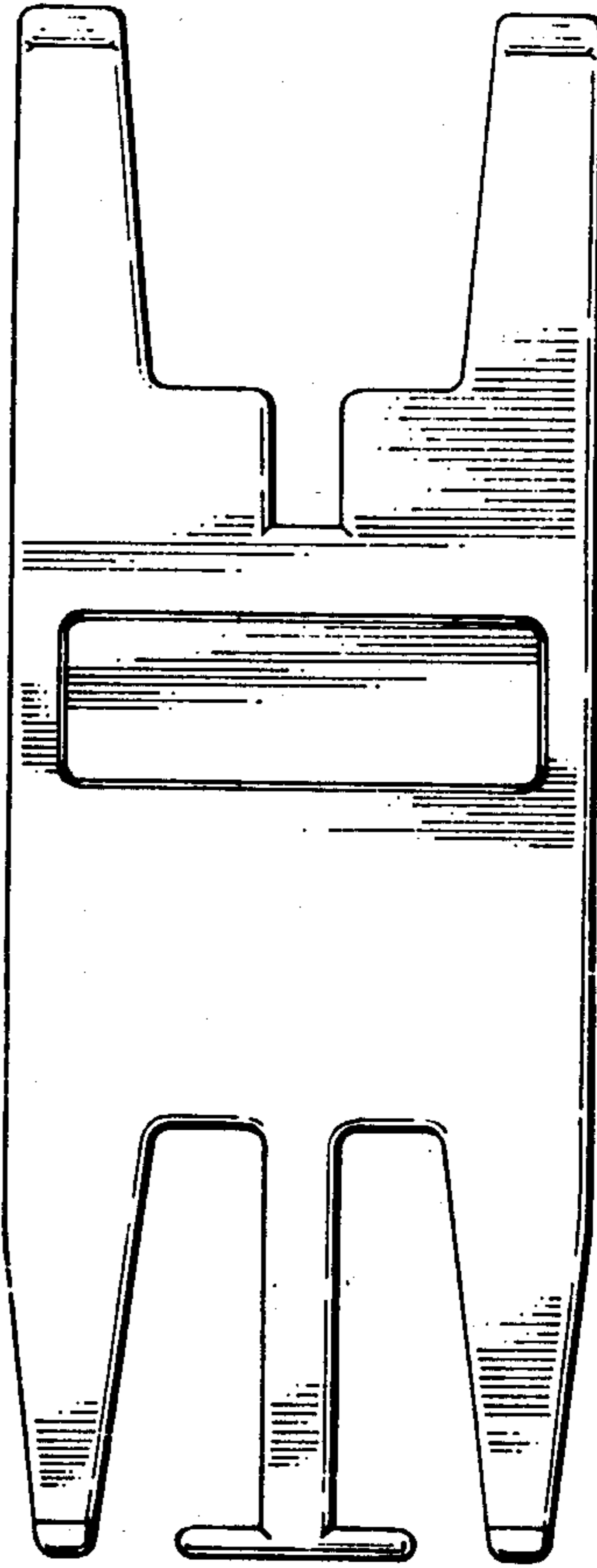
