FIG. 4 is a plan view of my design for a console for a data processing system.

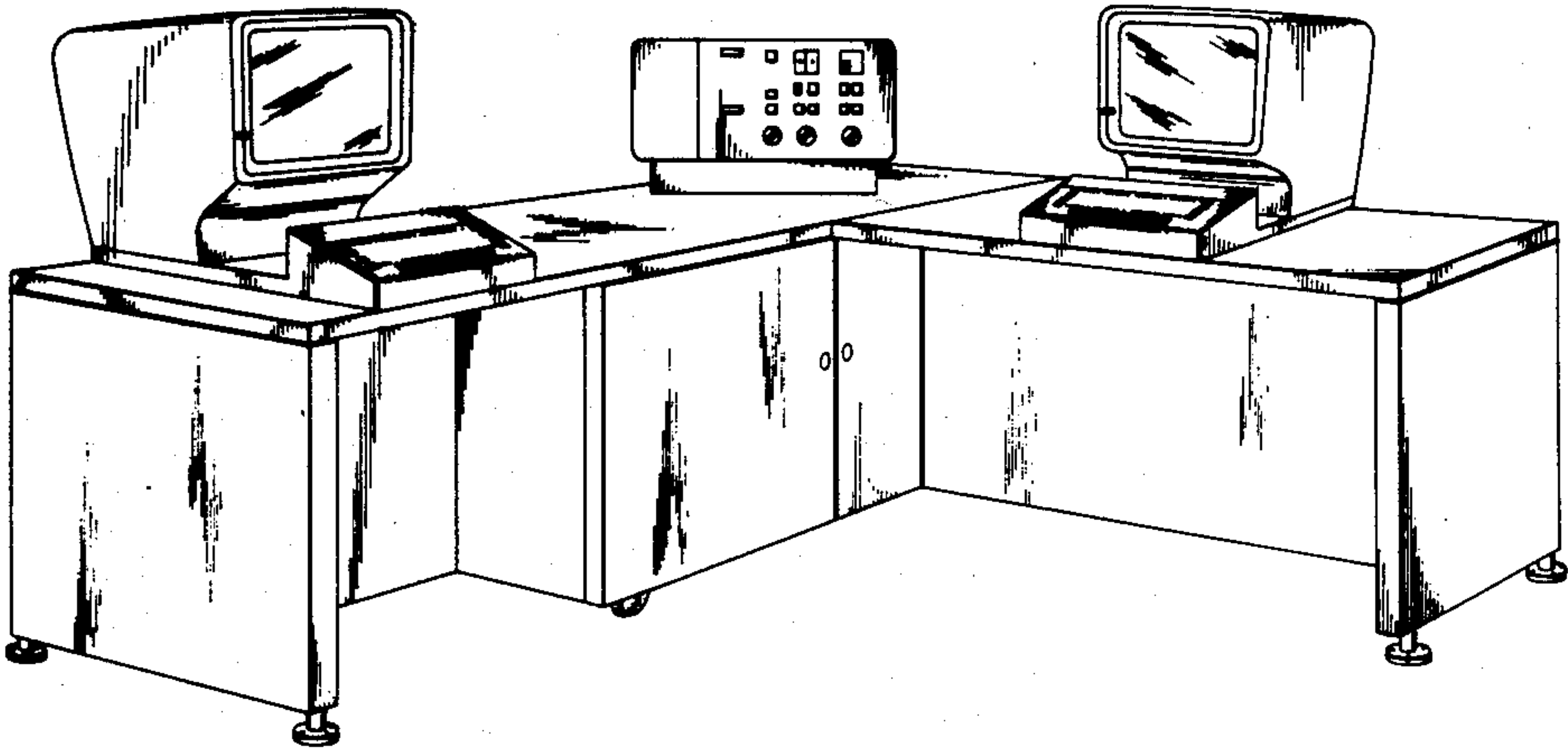
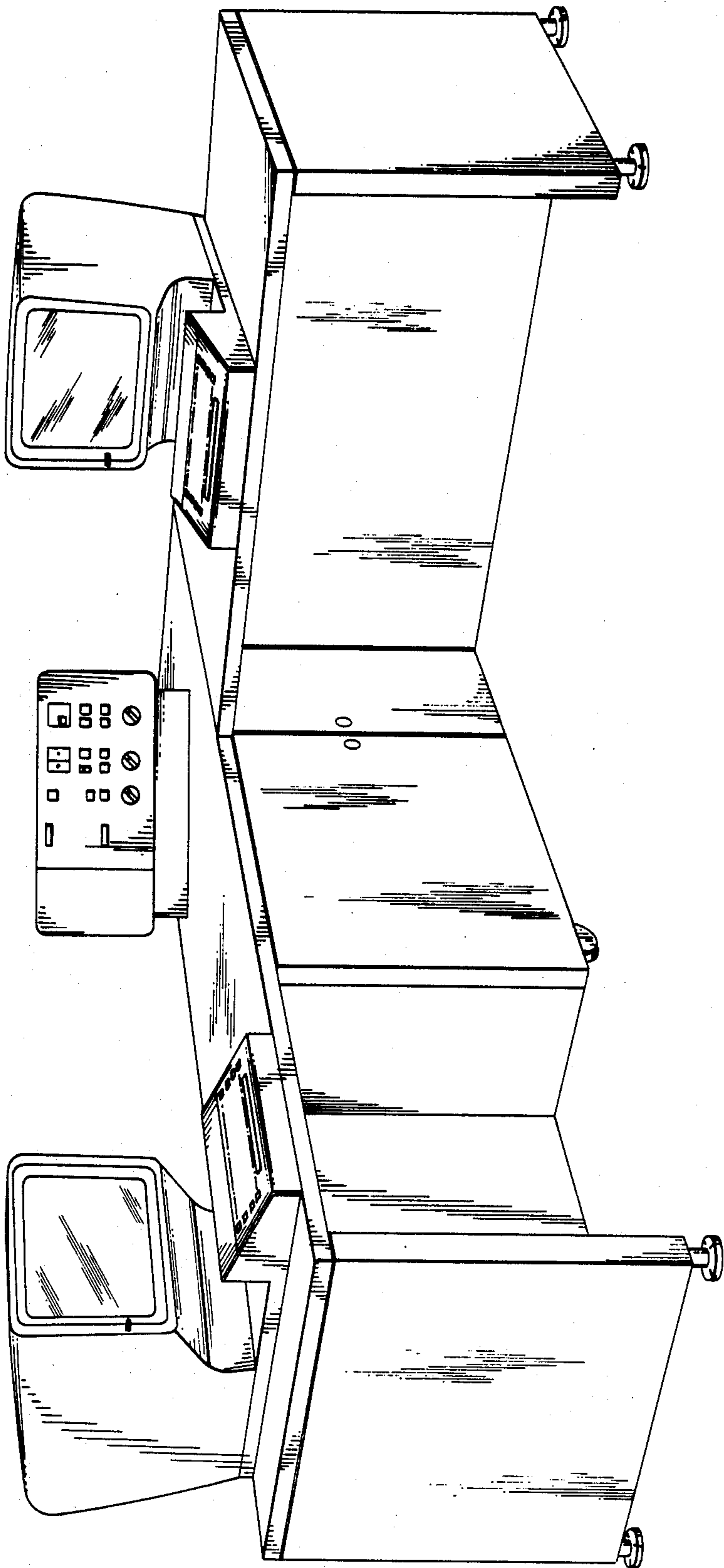

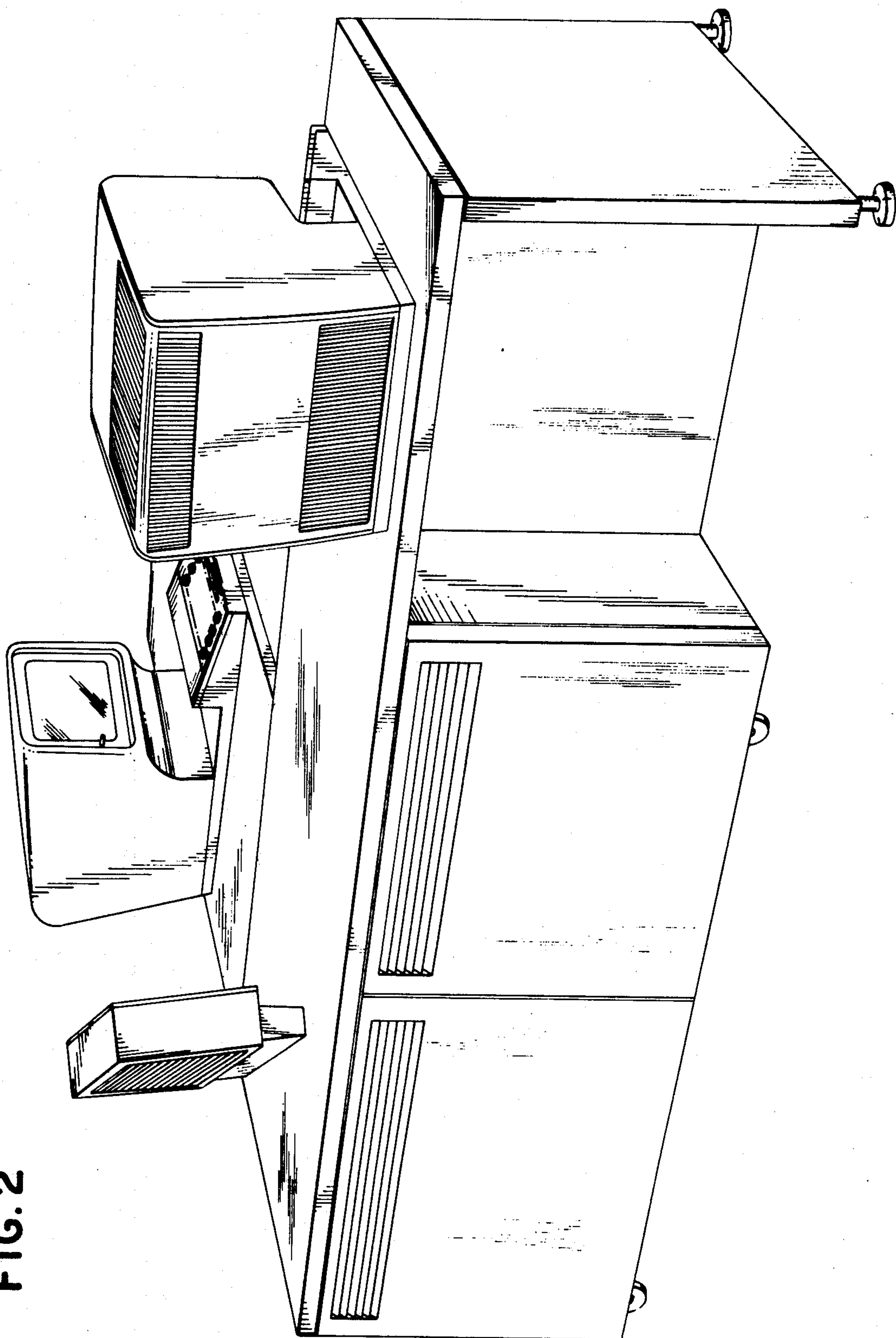

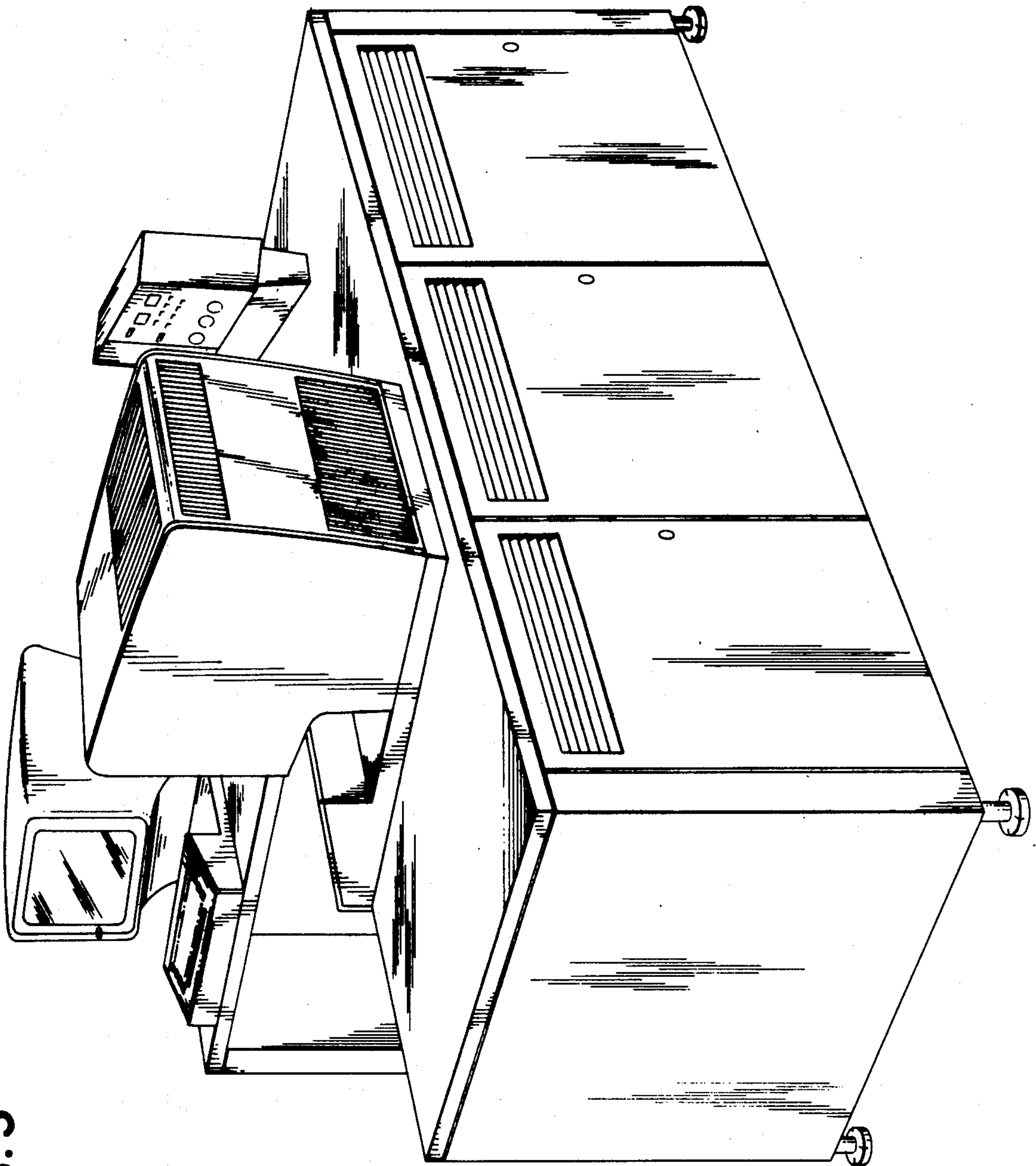
