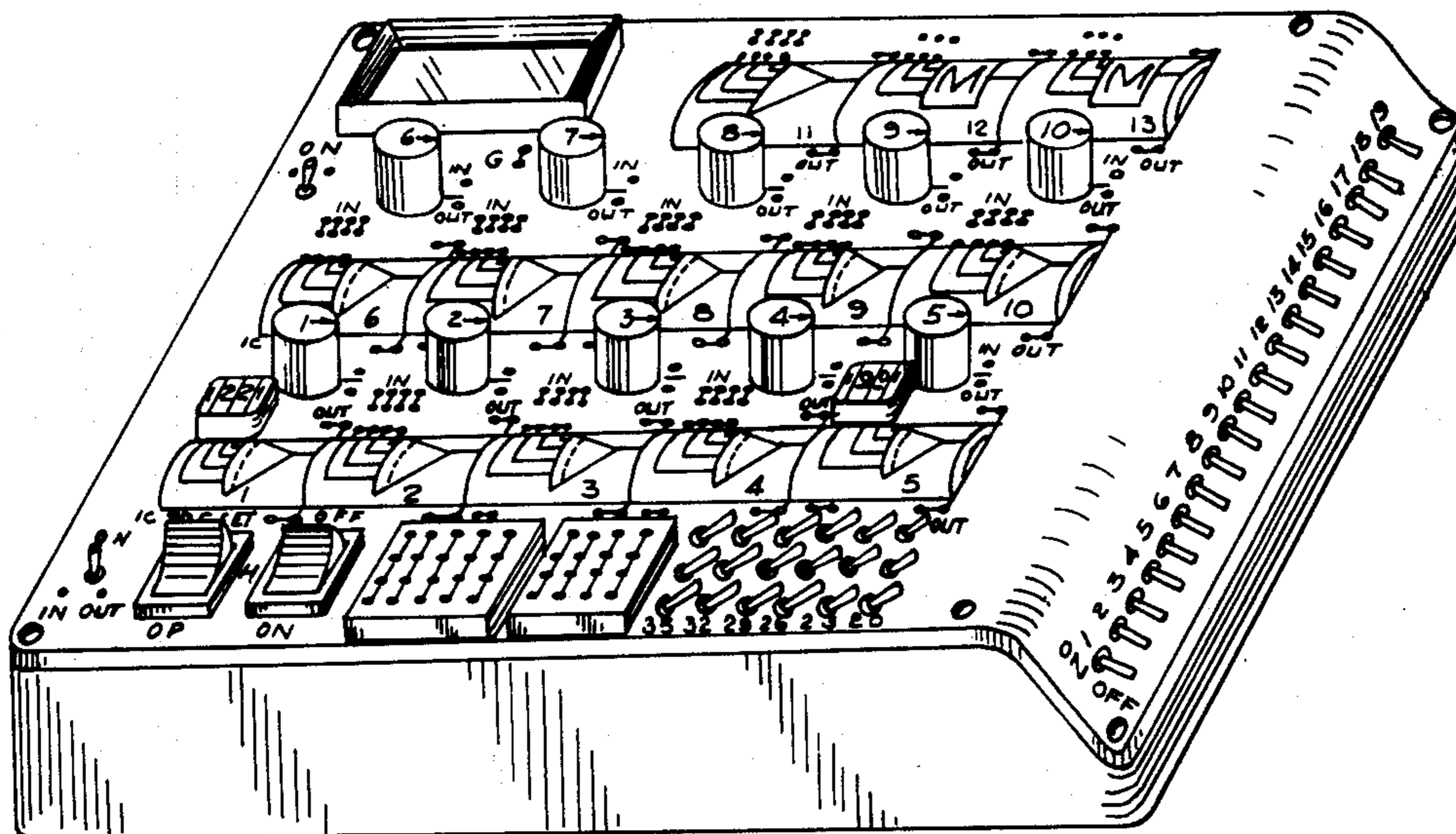

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of an electronic analog computer showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.



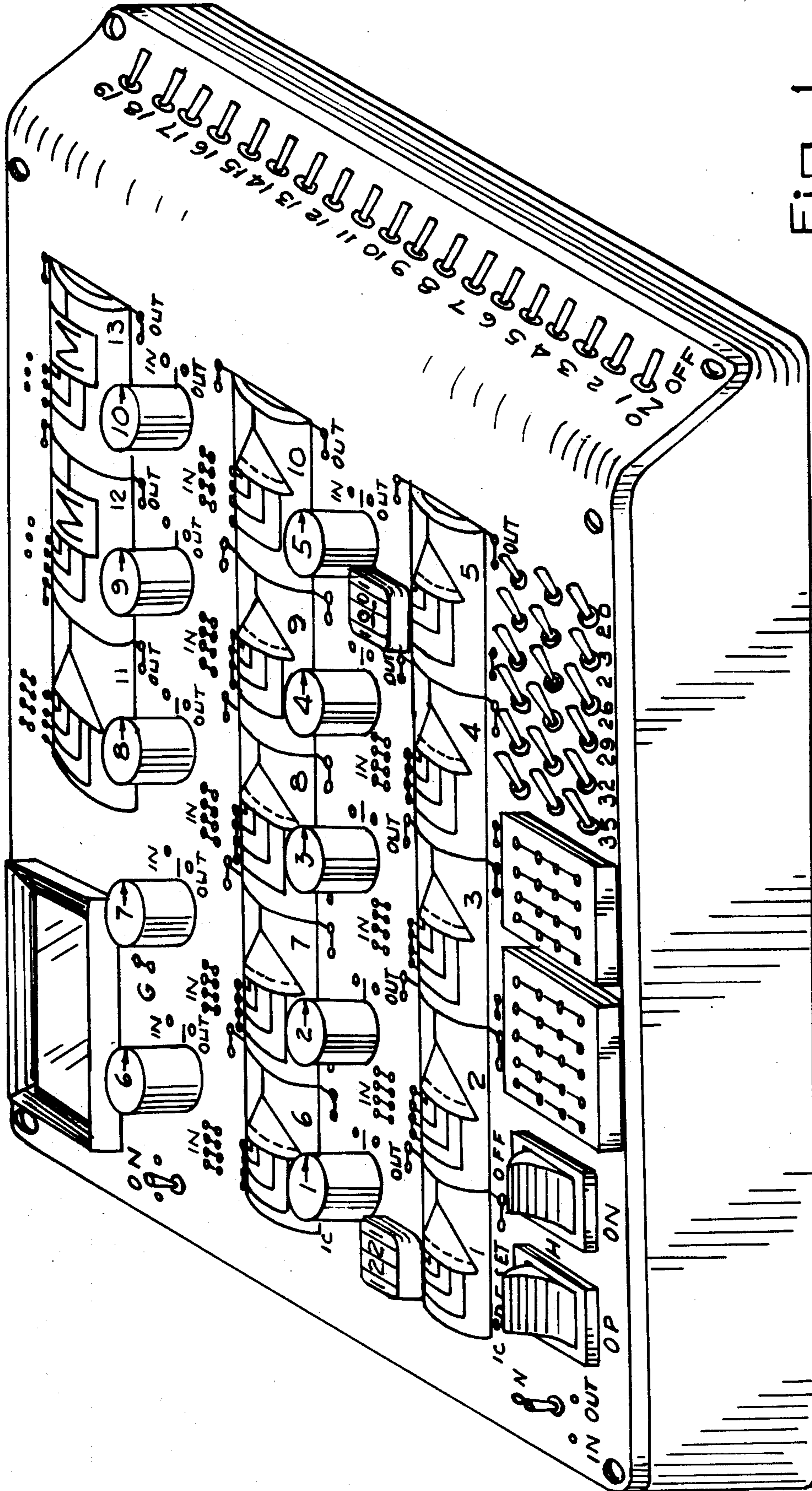

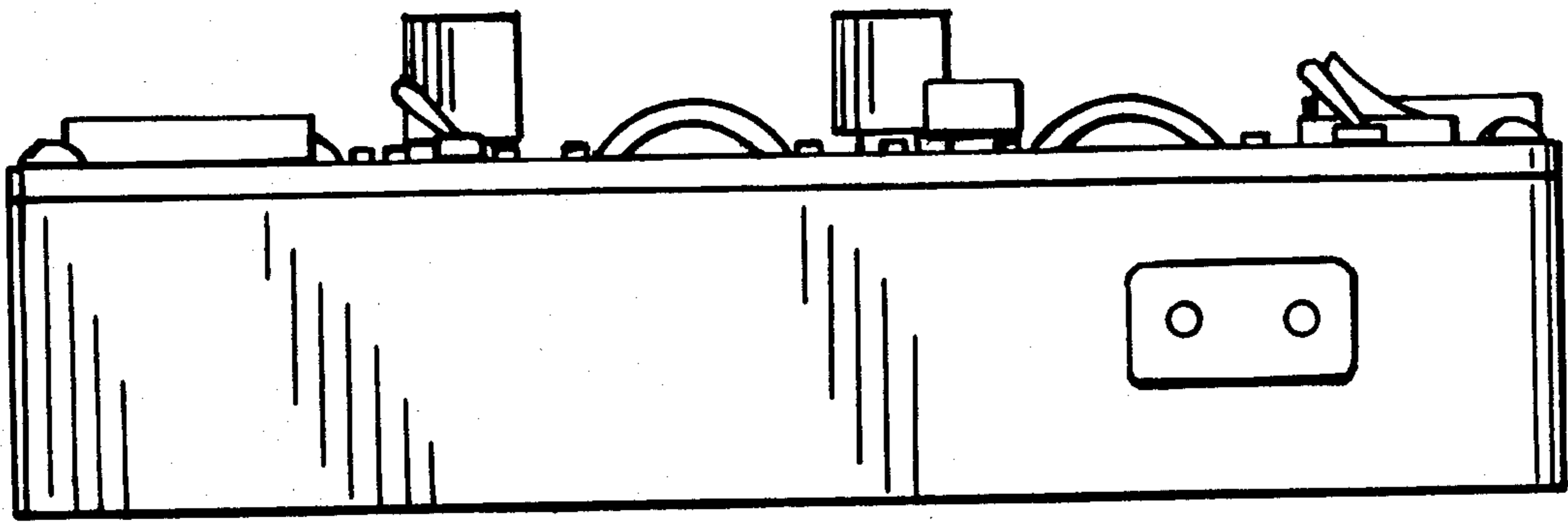
