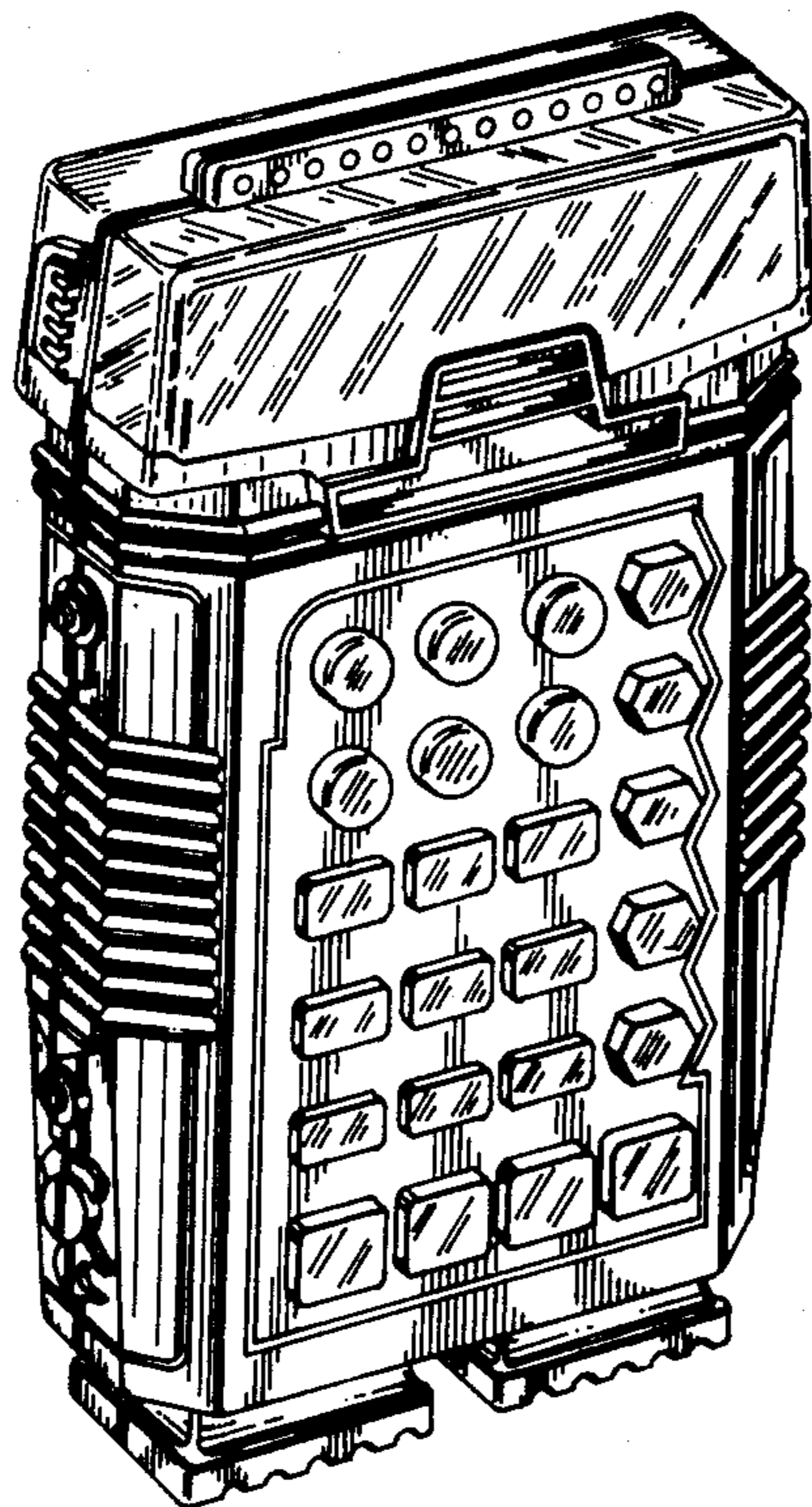

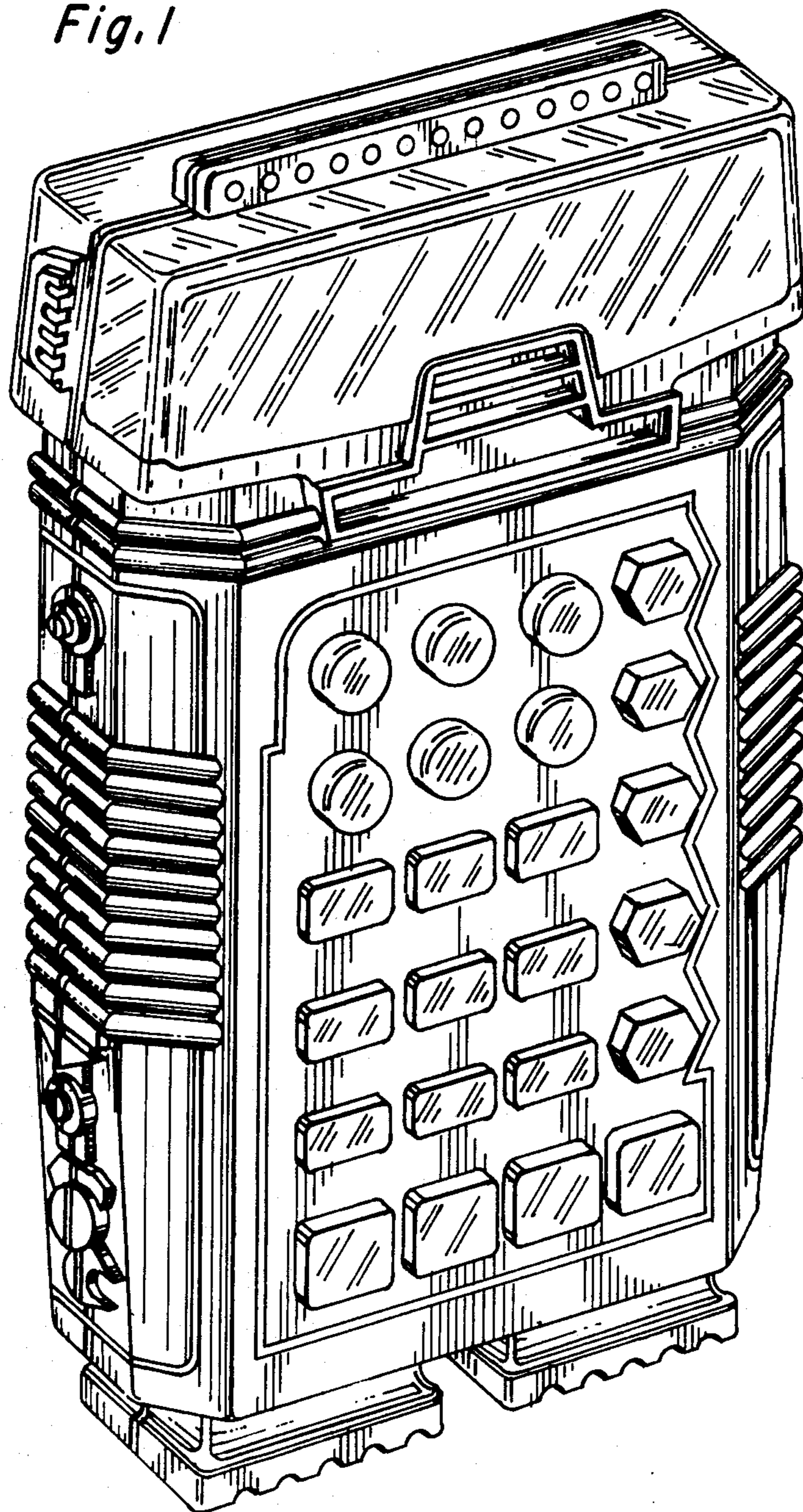
The ornamental design for a case for a learning aid or calculator or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

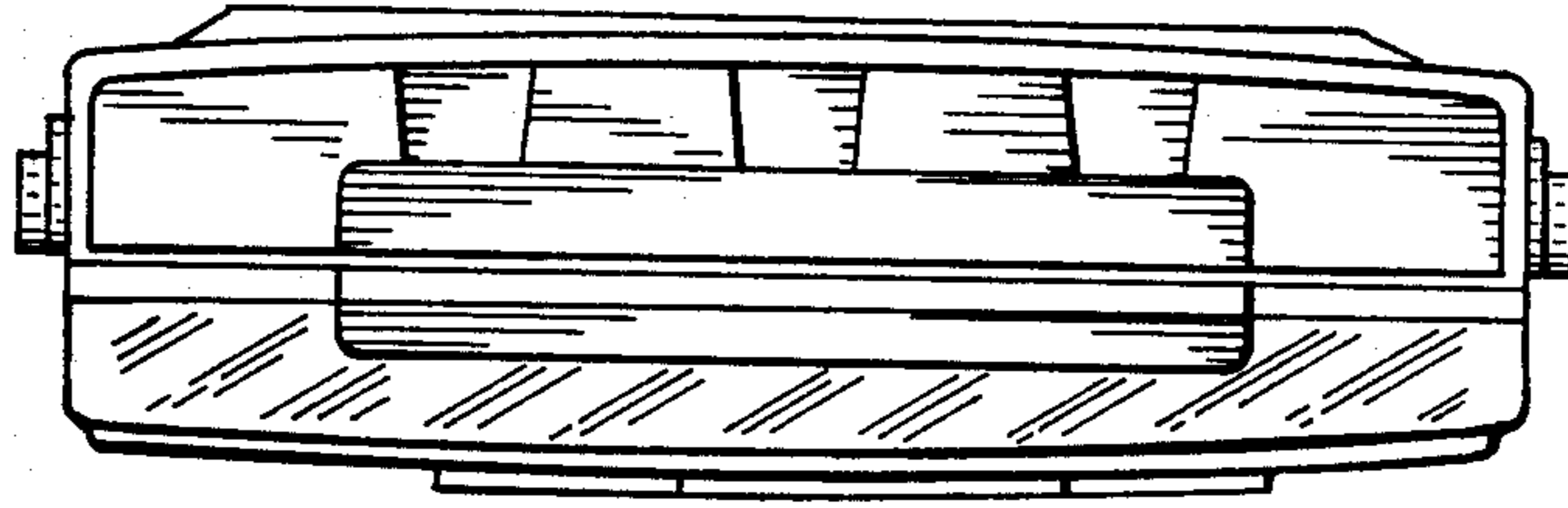

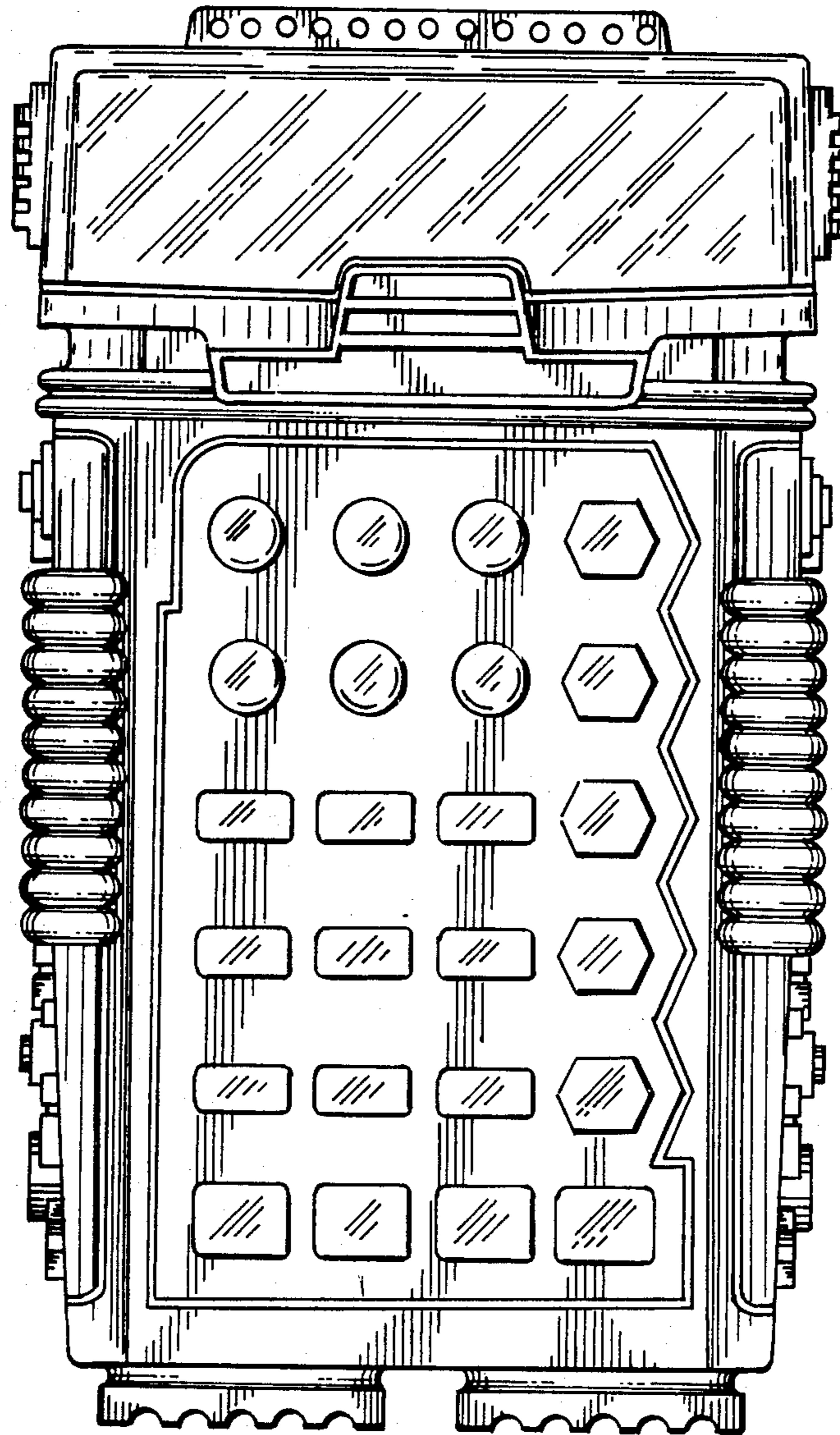

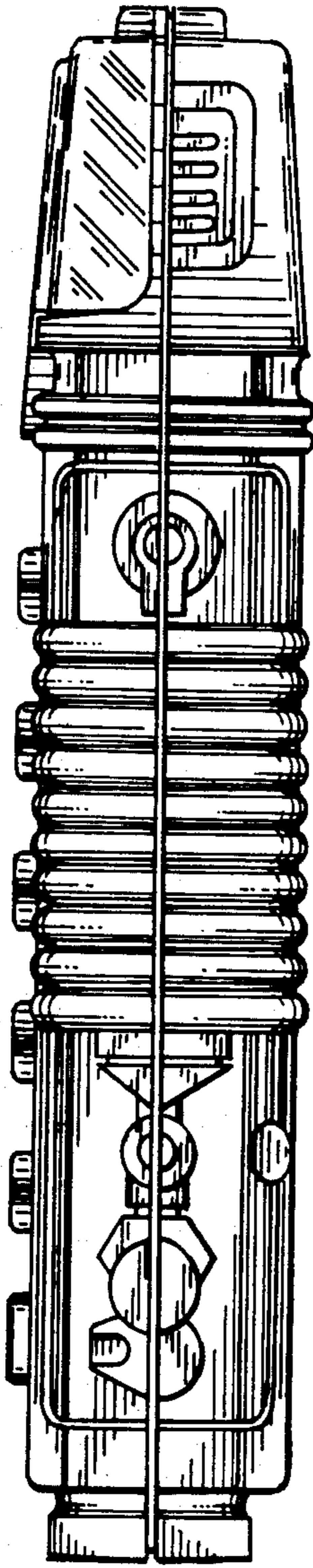

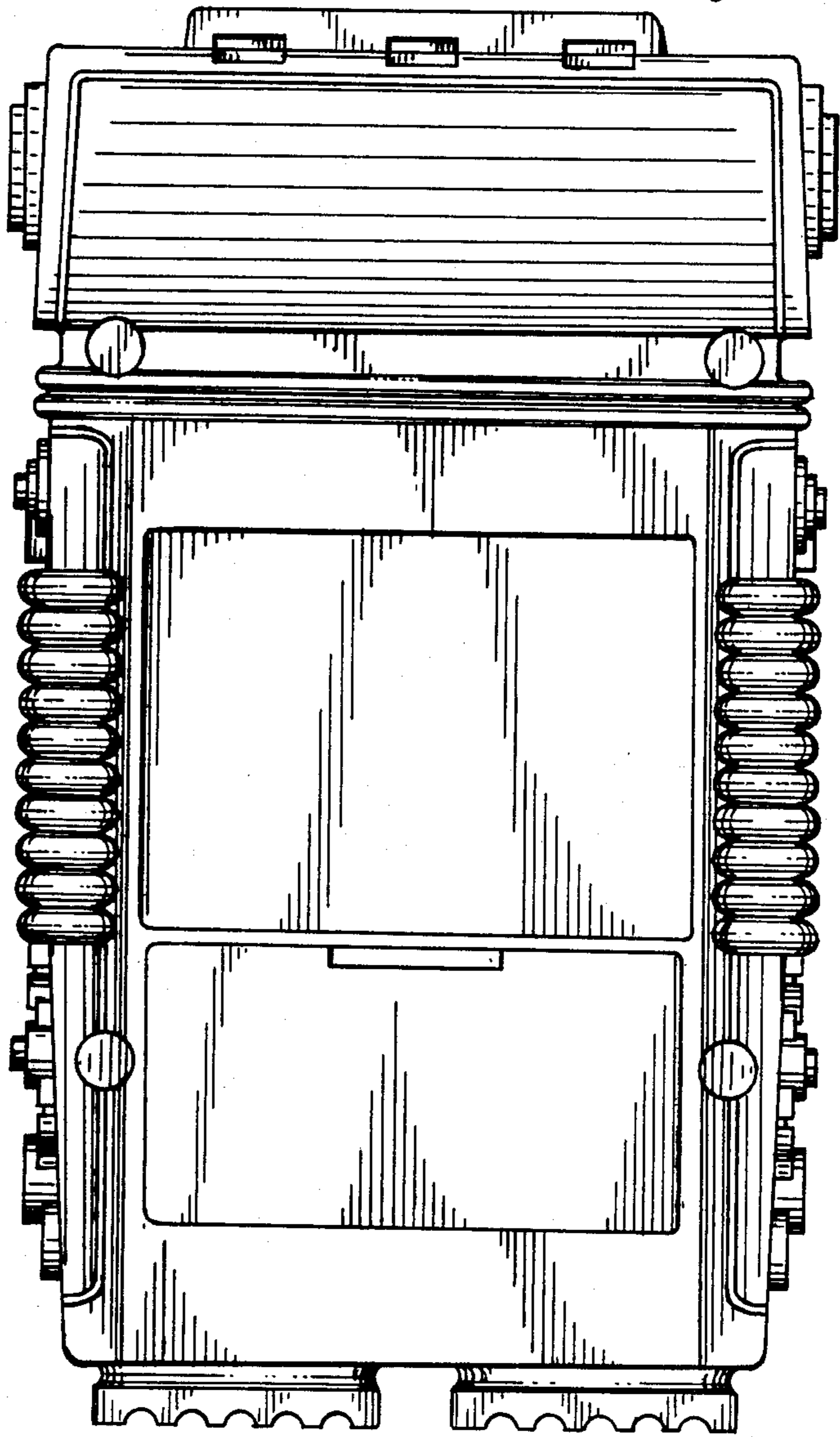

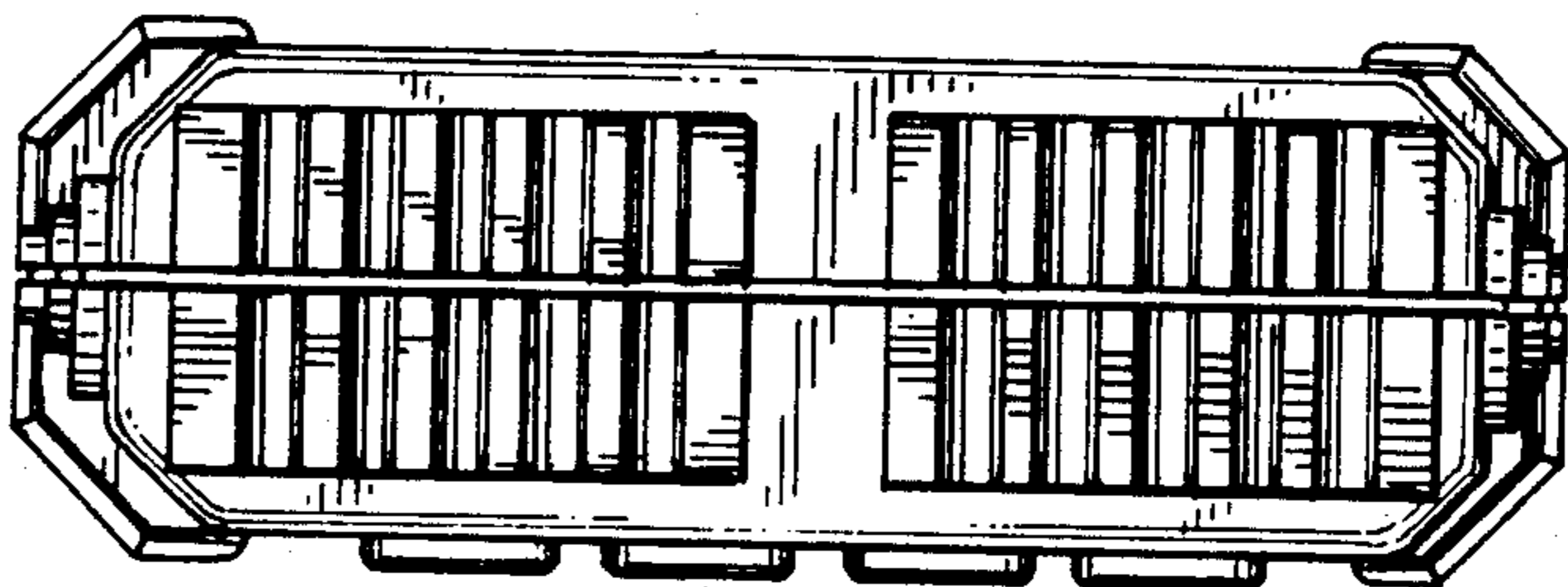
