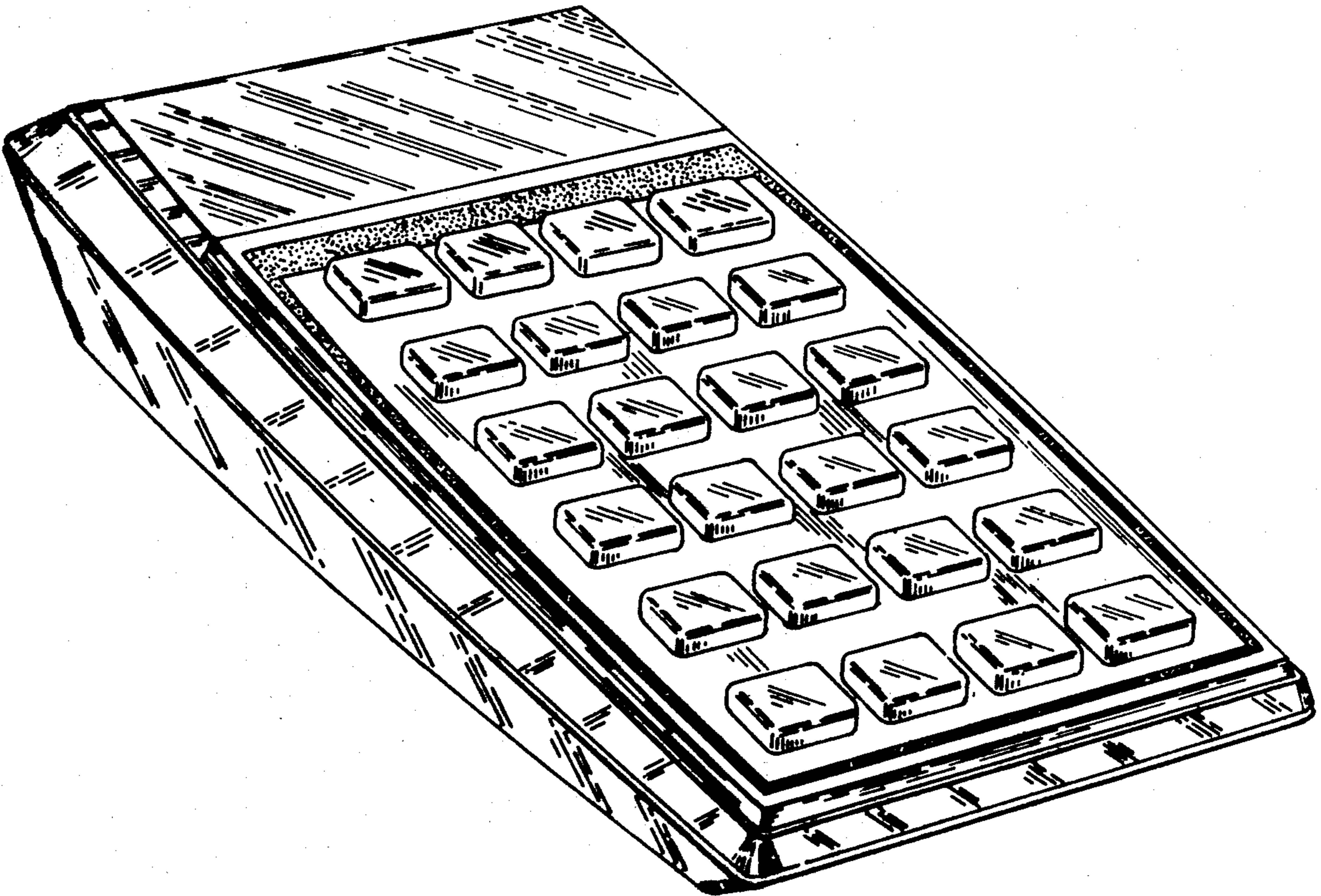

The ornamental design of a case for an electronic calculator or the like, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective showing our new design of a case for an electronic calculator or the like; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a plan view thereof.



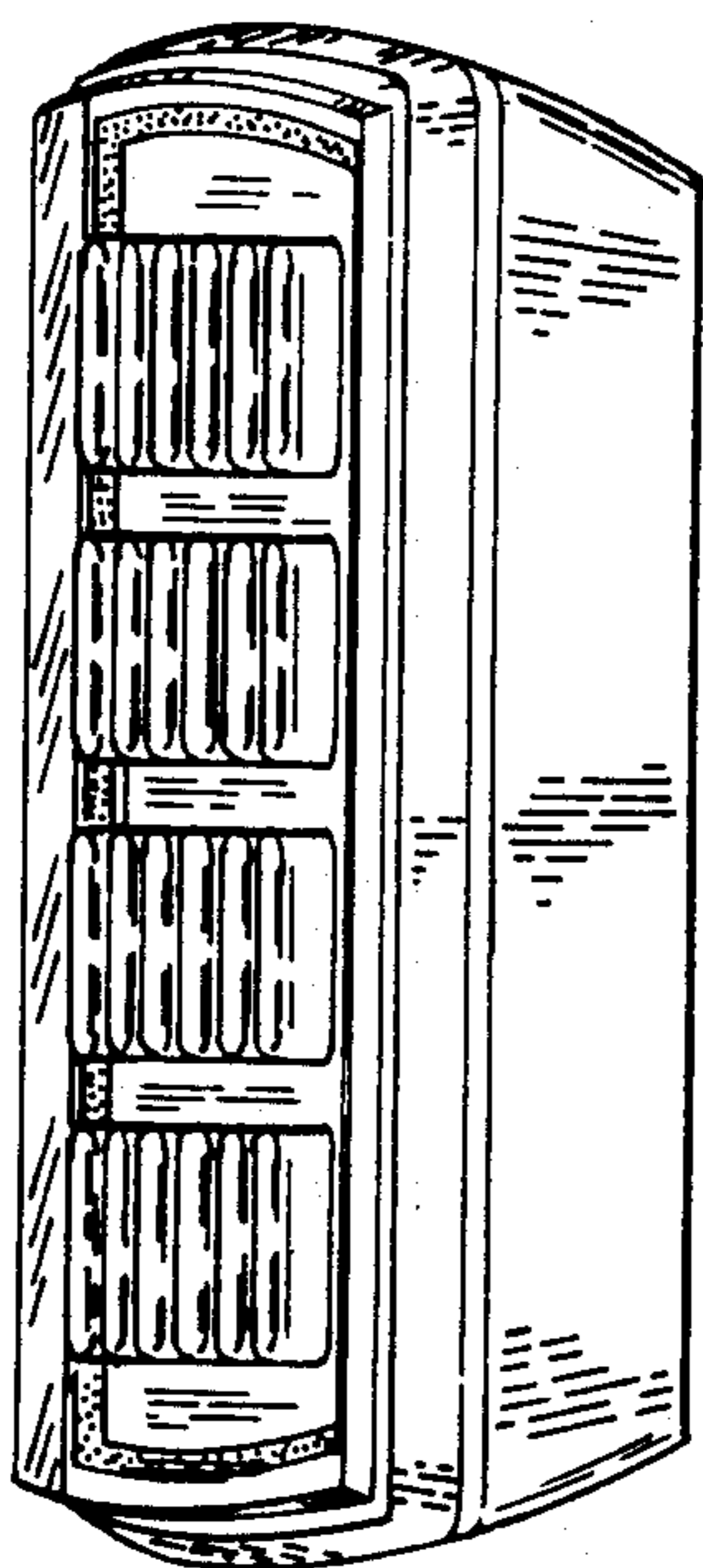

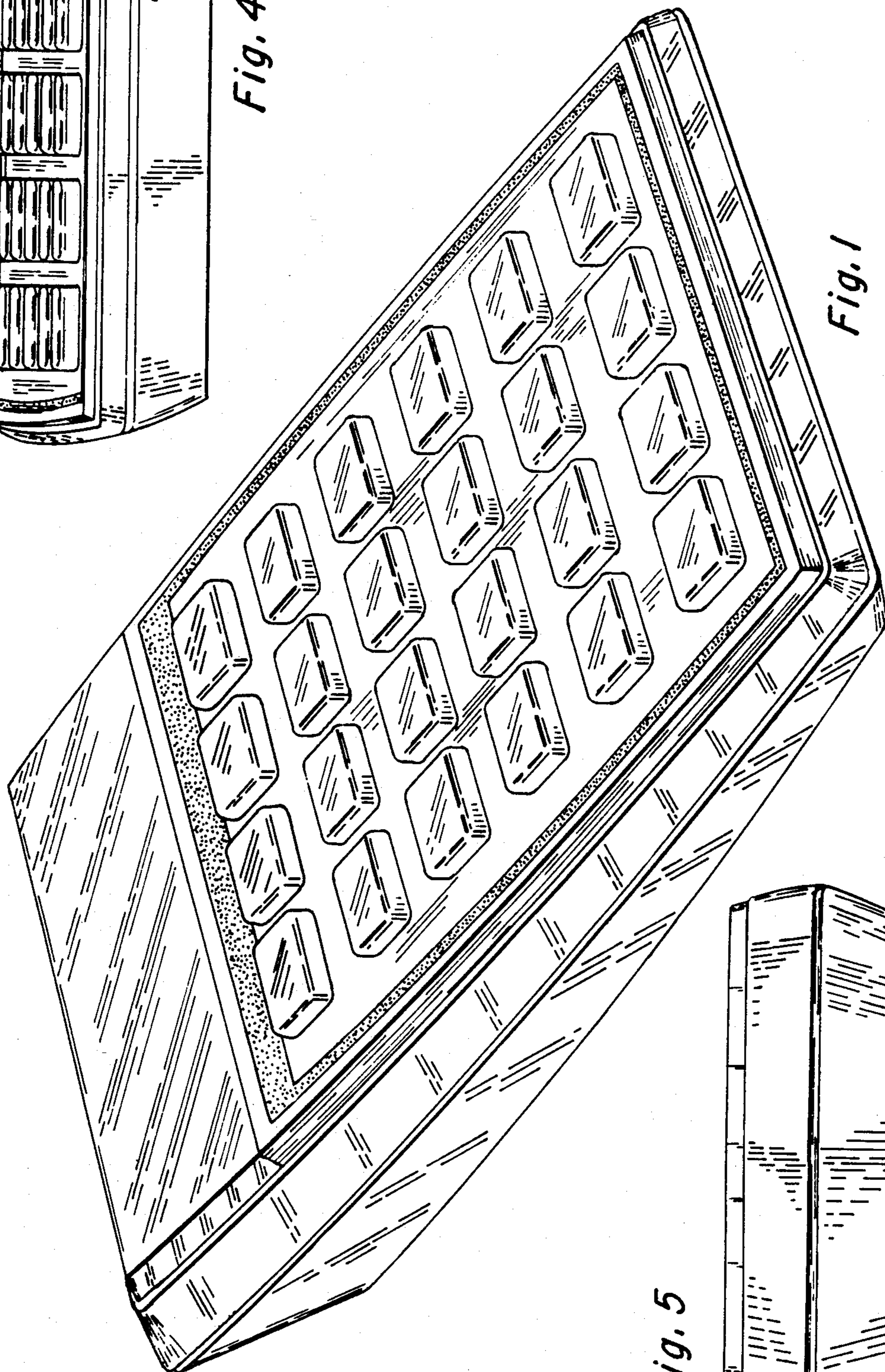

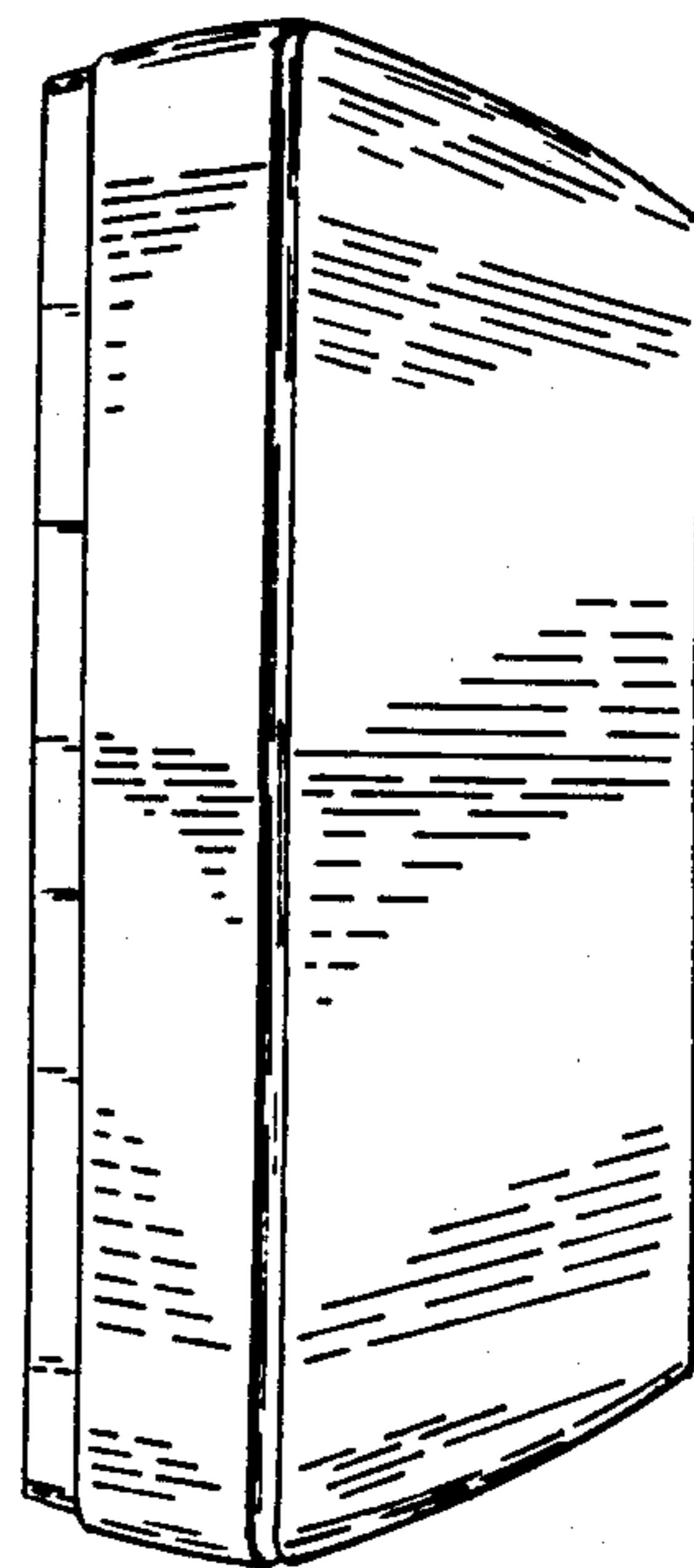

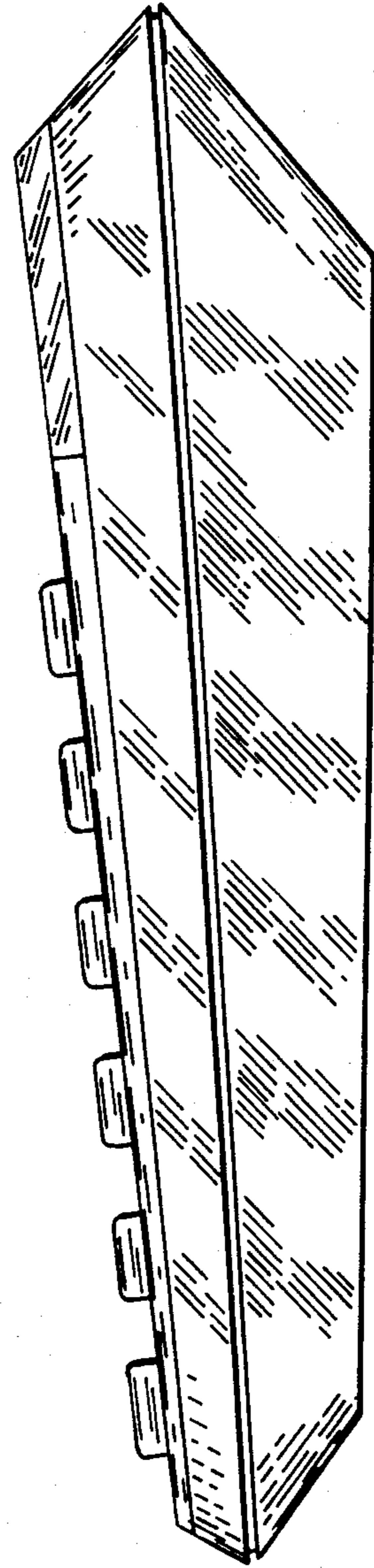
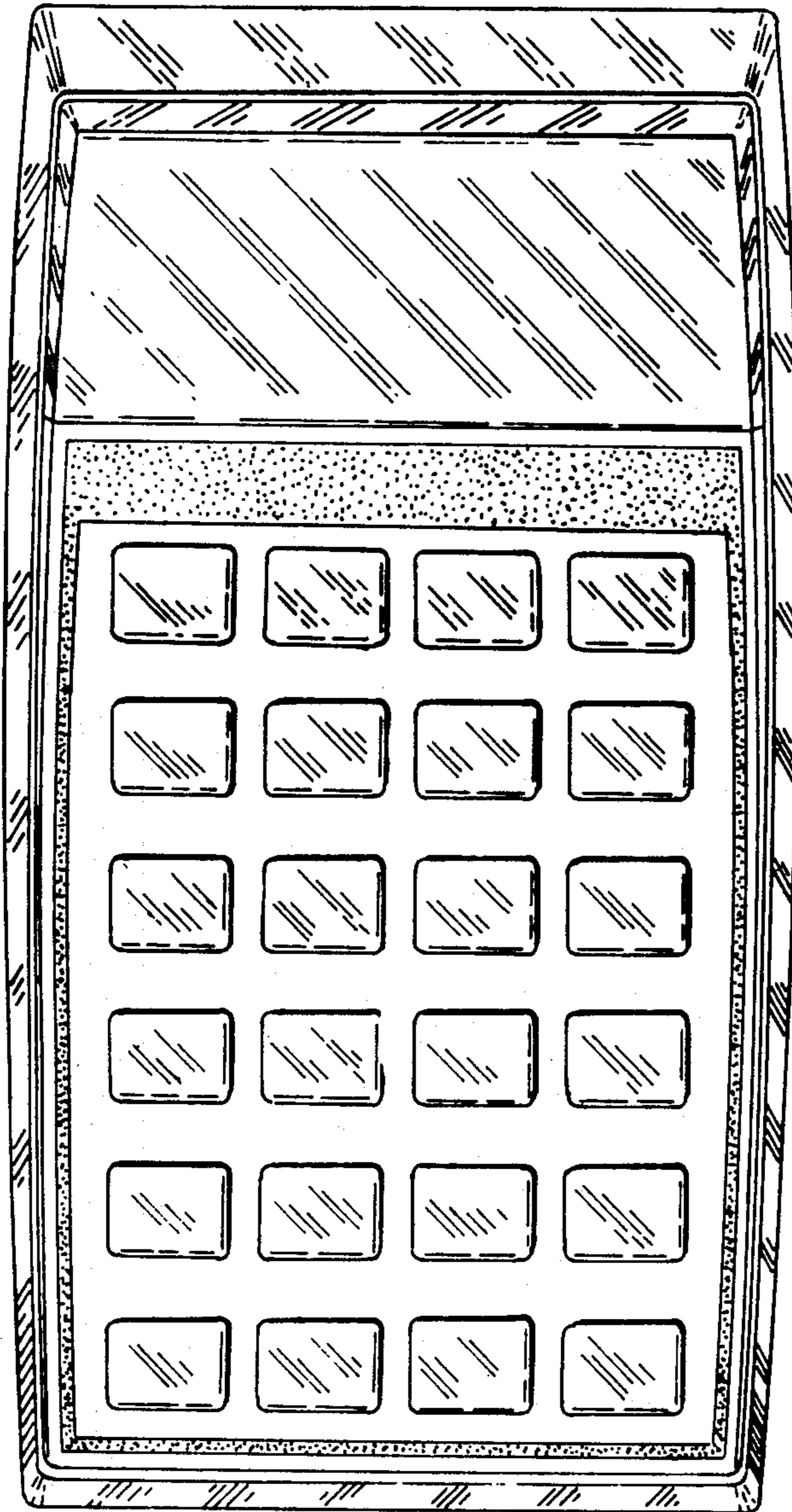
