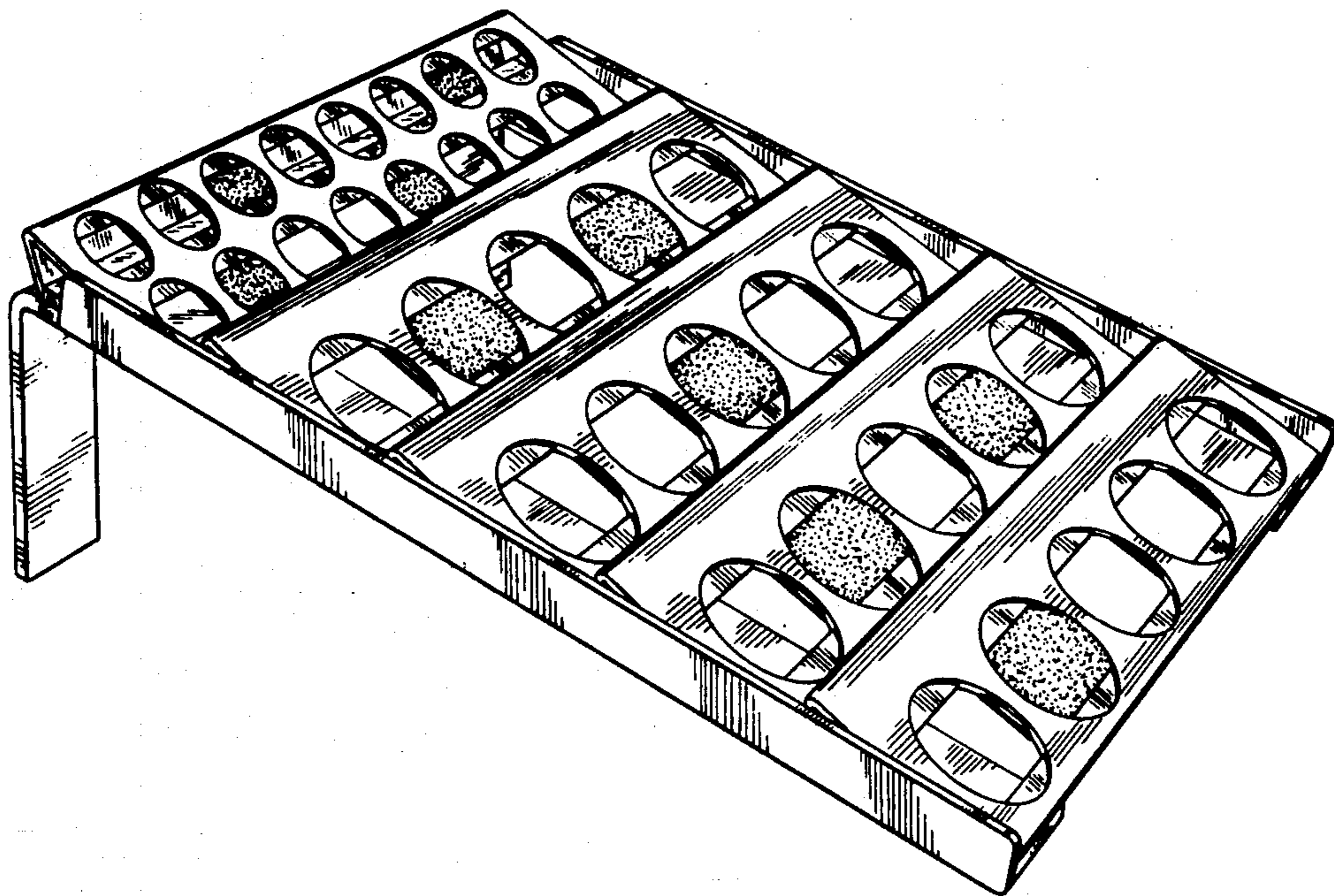

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewelry display stand, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view of a jewelry display stand showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 3.



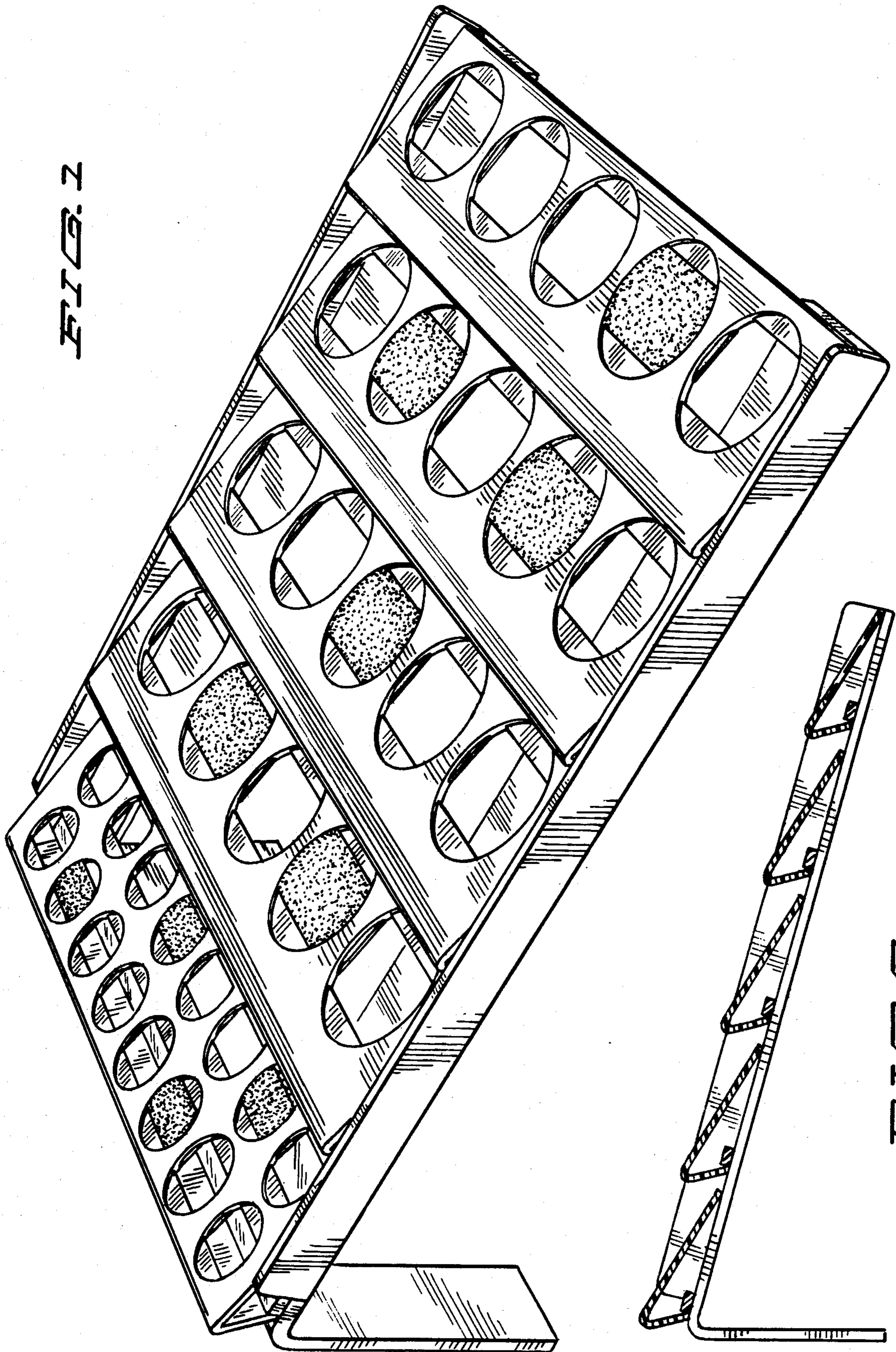

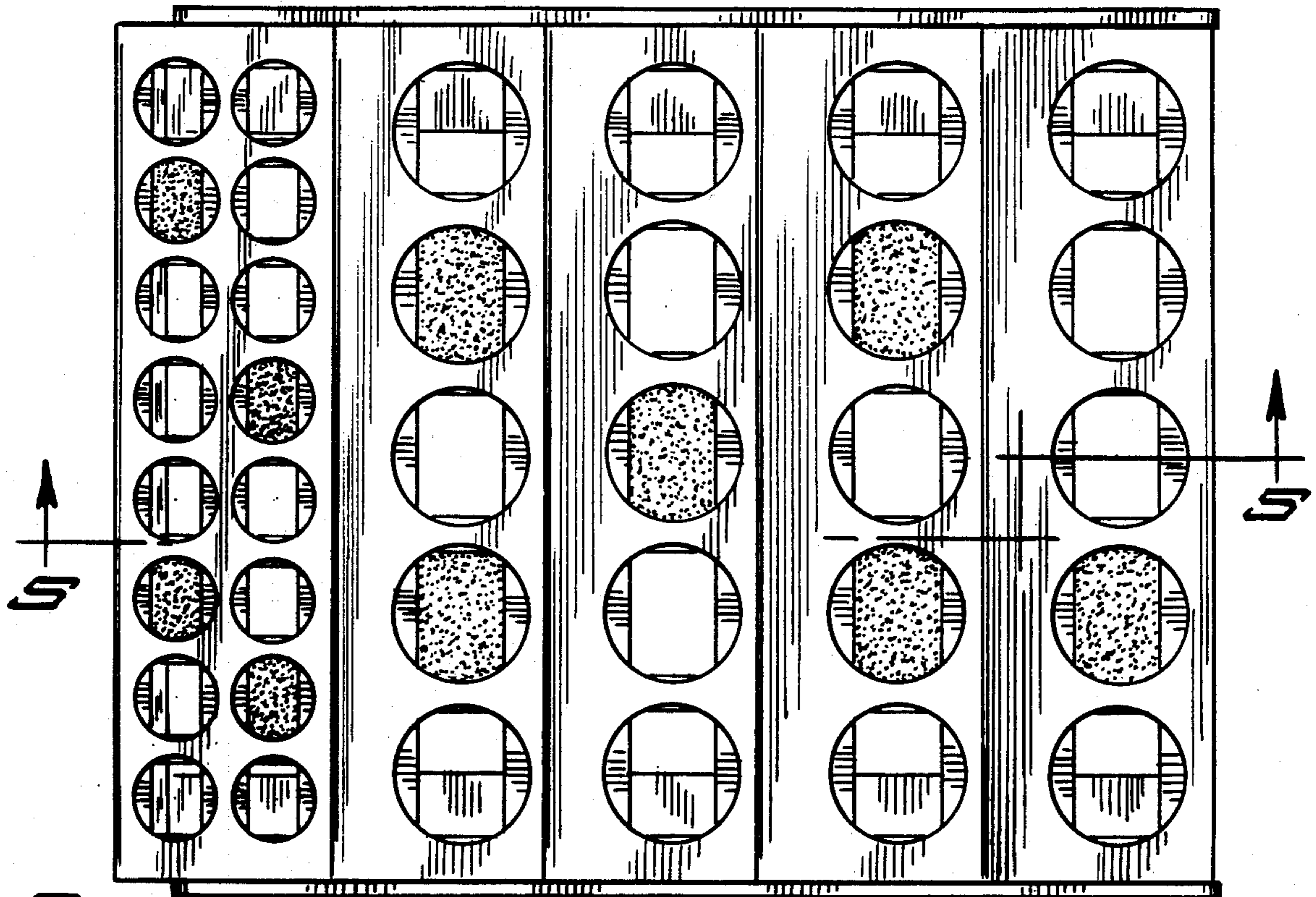

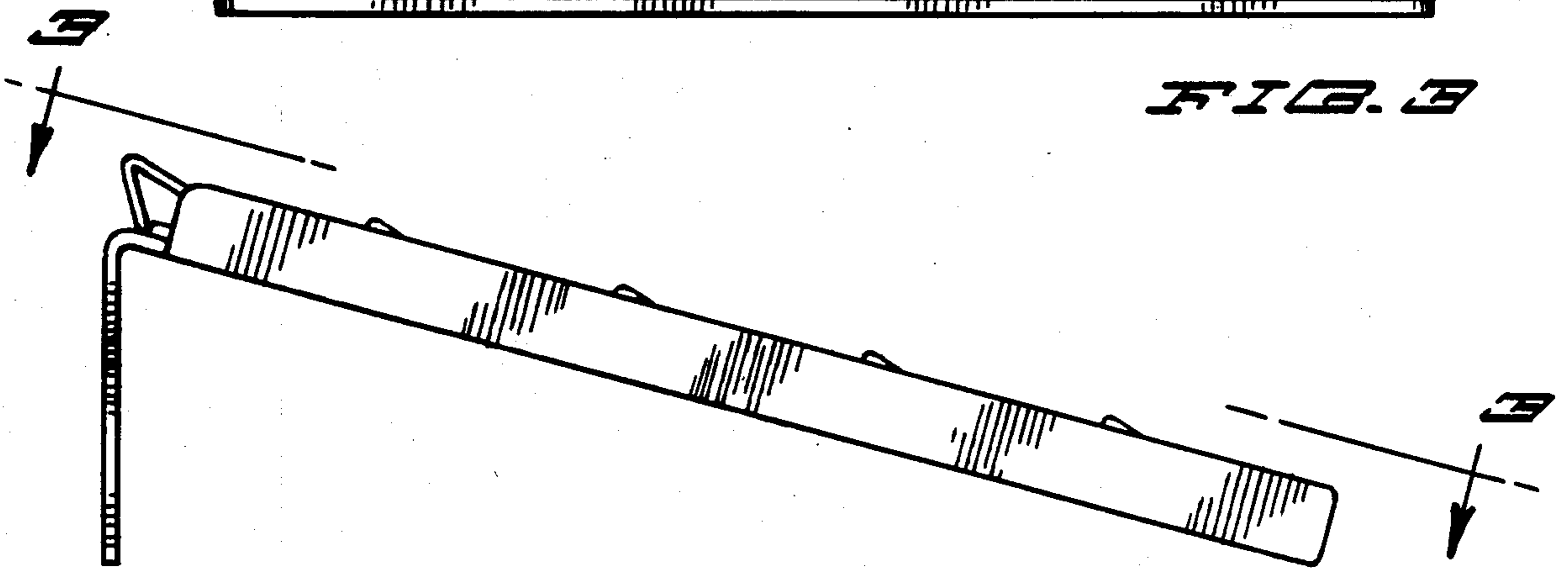

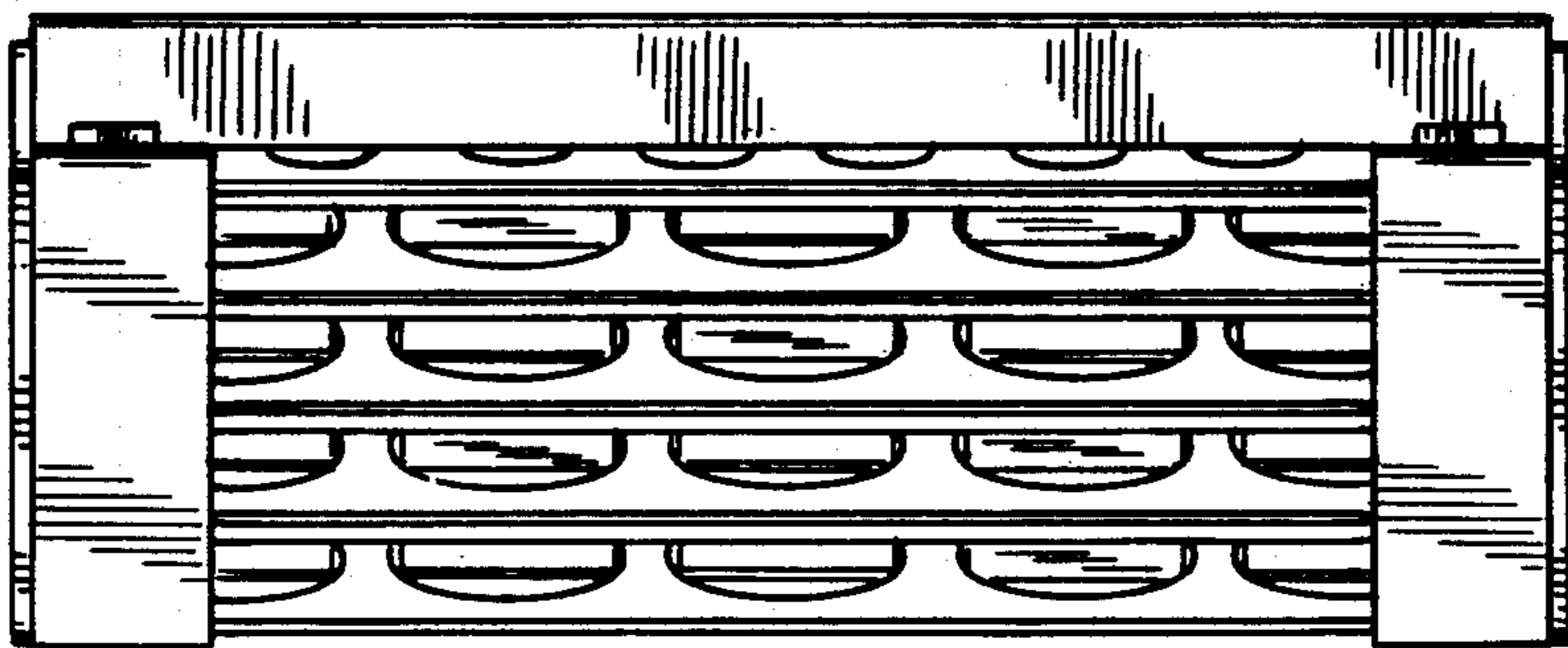
