FIG. 6 is a right edge view thereof.

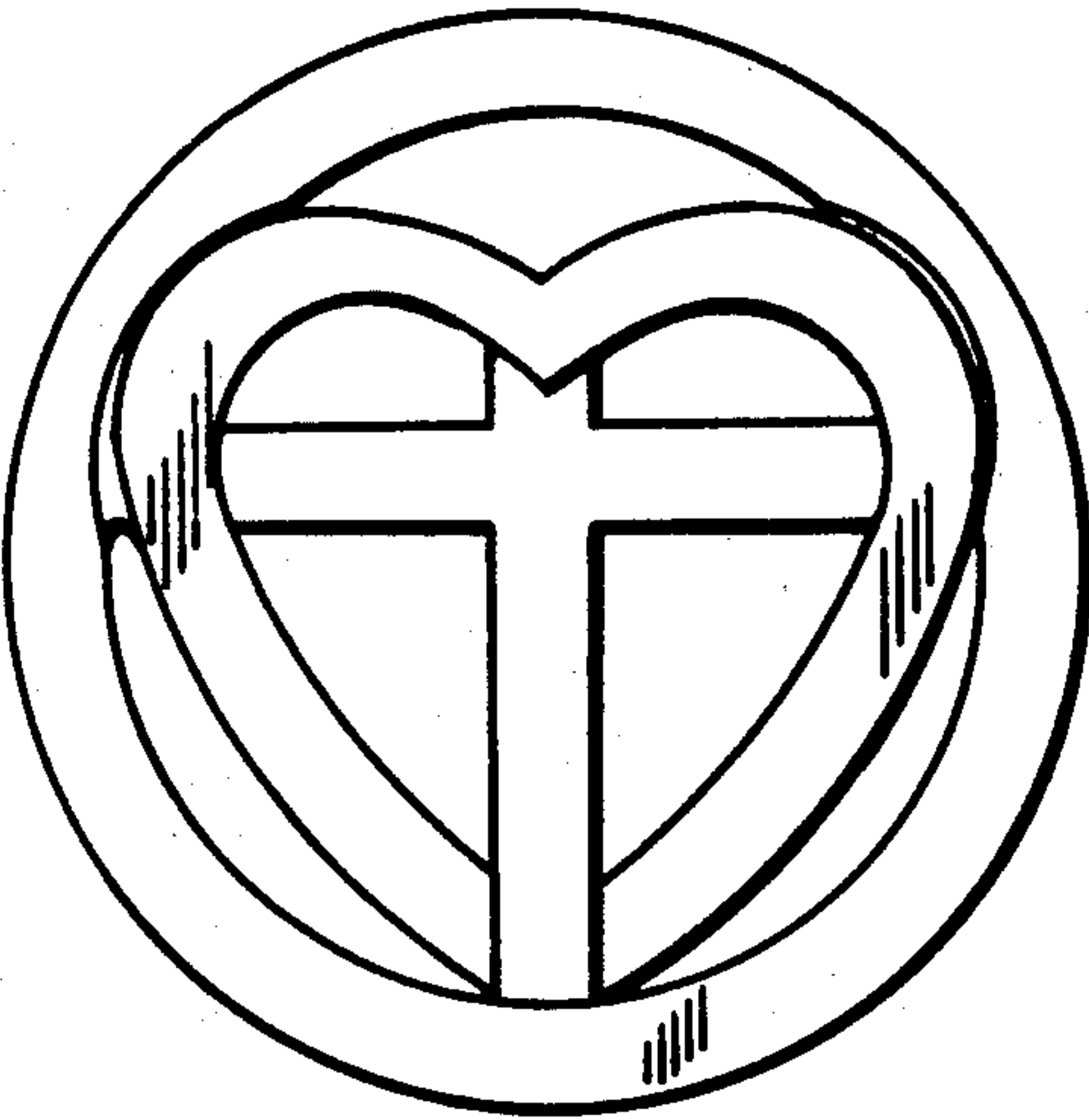

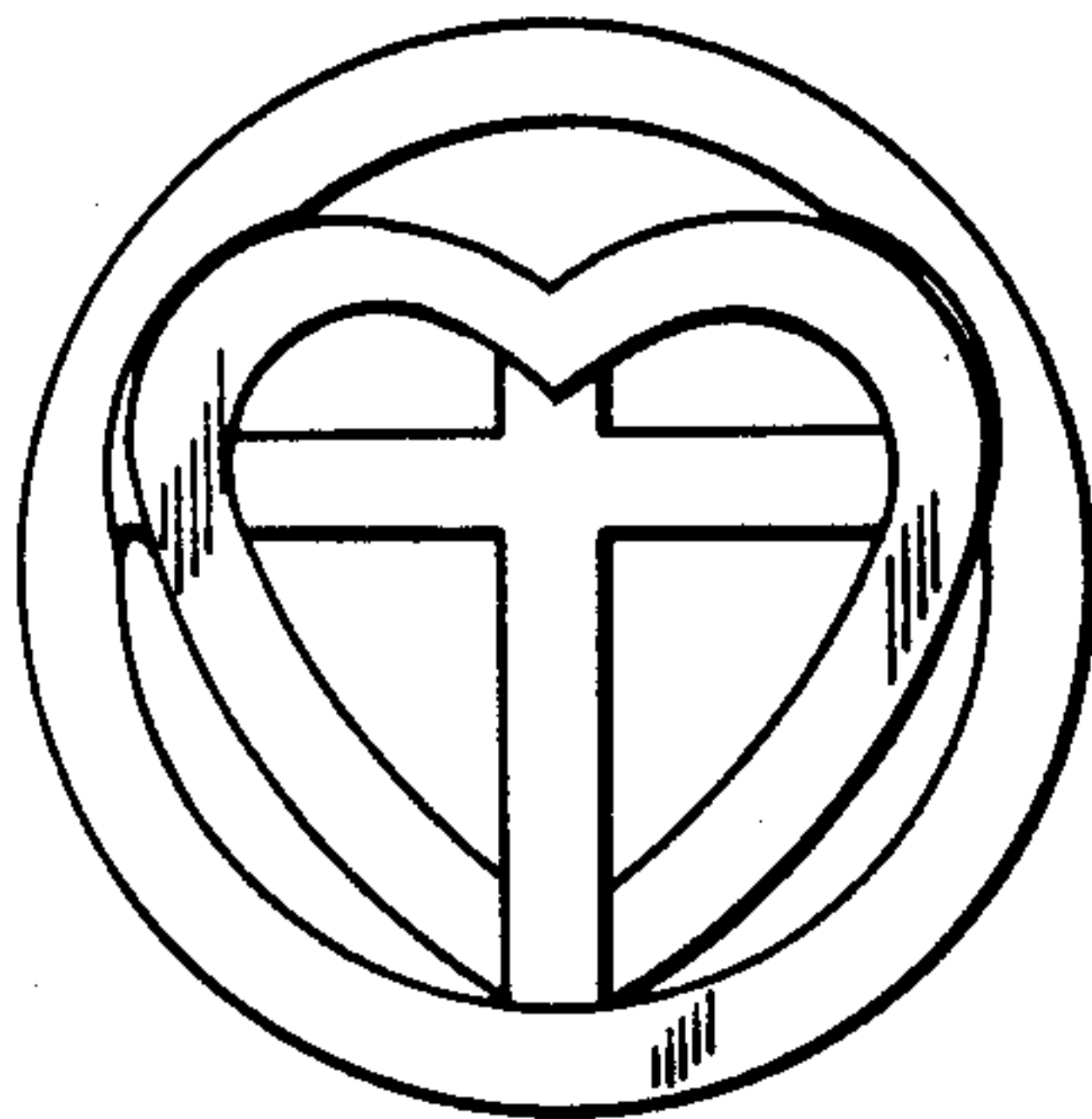

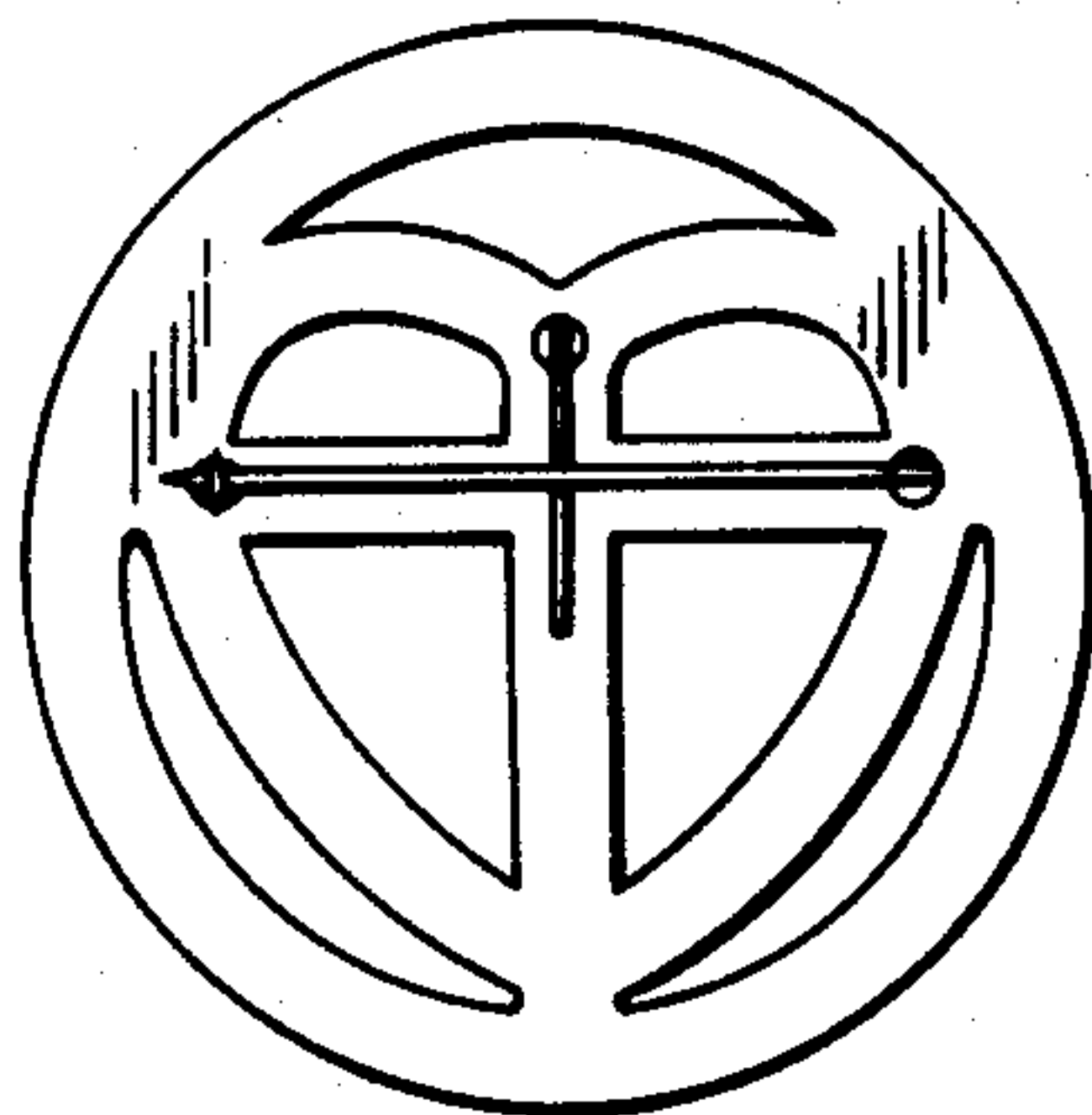
