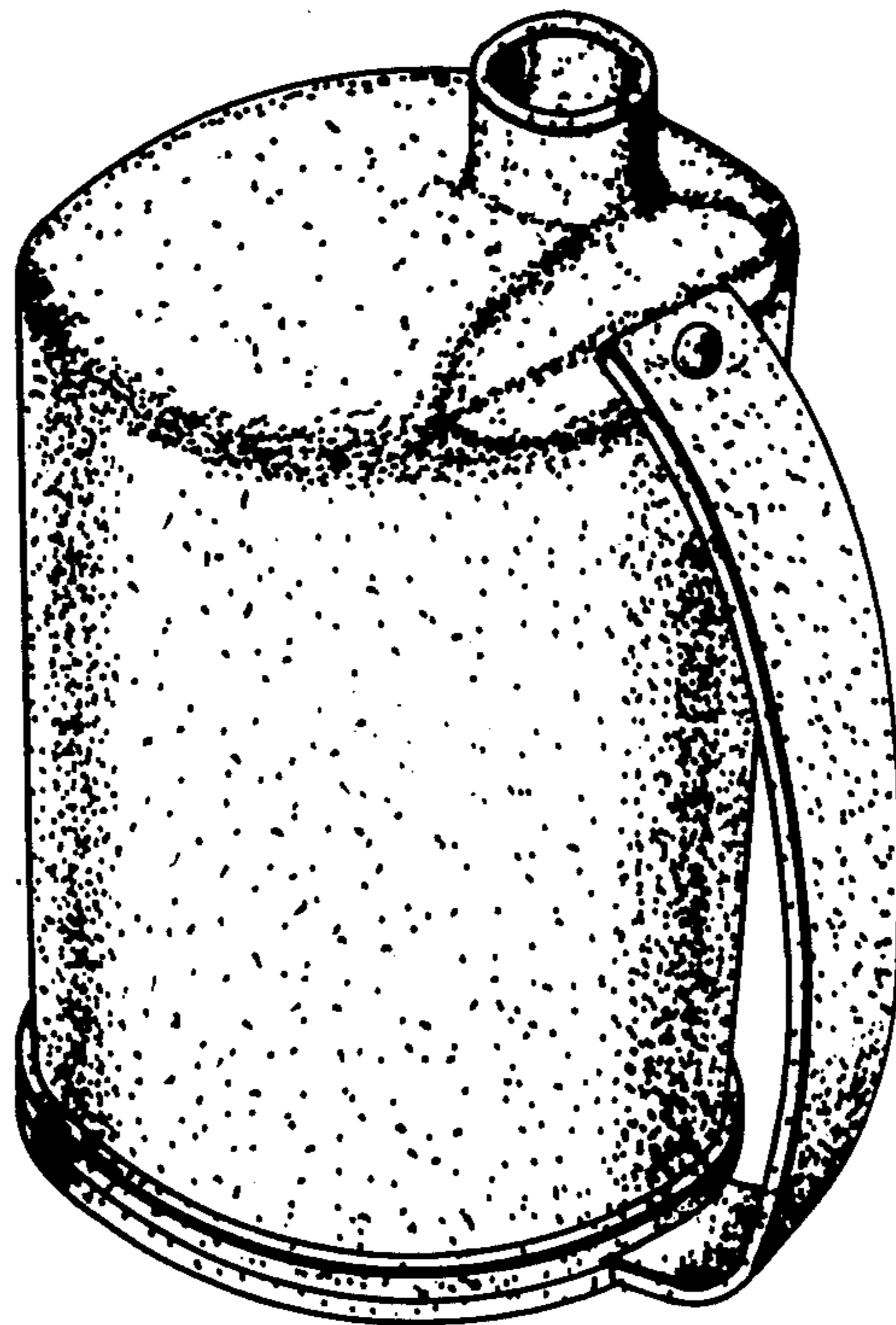

CLAIM

The ornamental design for a squeeze bag for resuscitators and the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a squeeze bag for resuscitators and the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



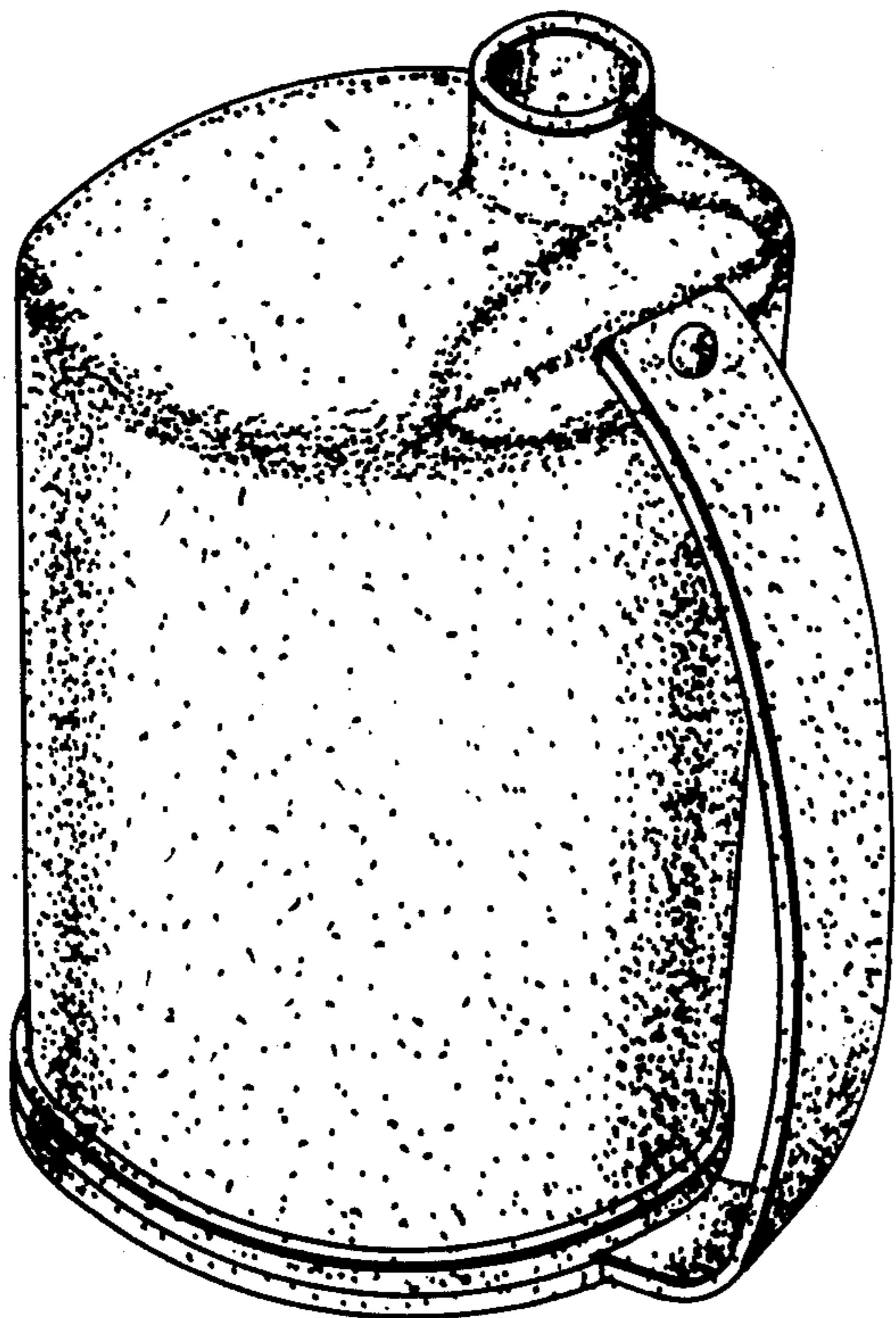

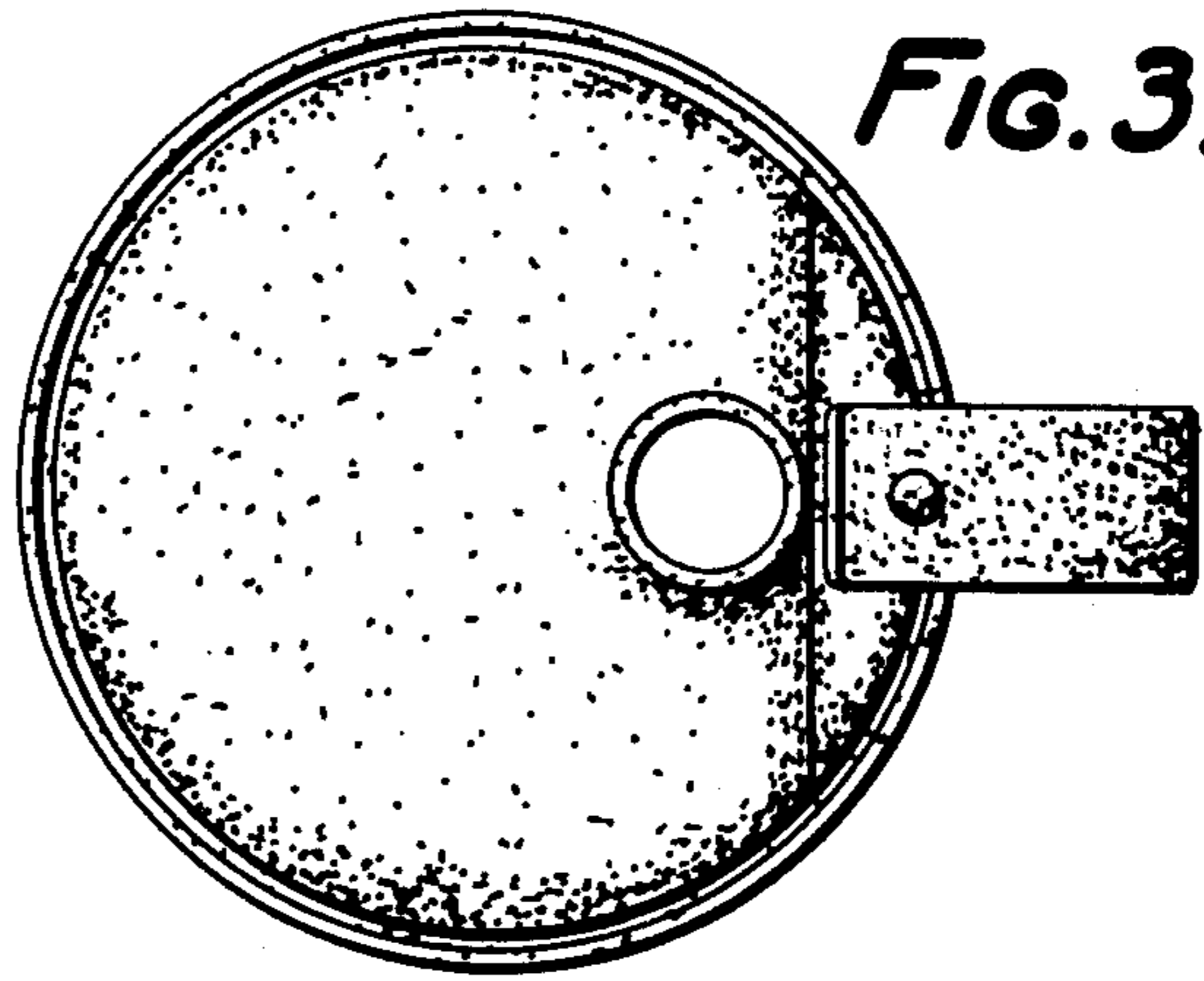

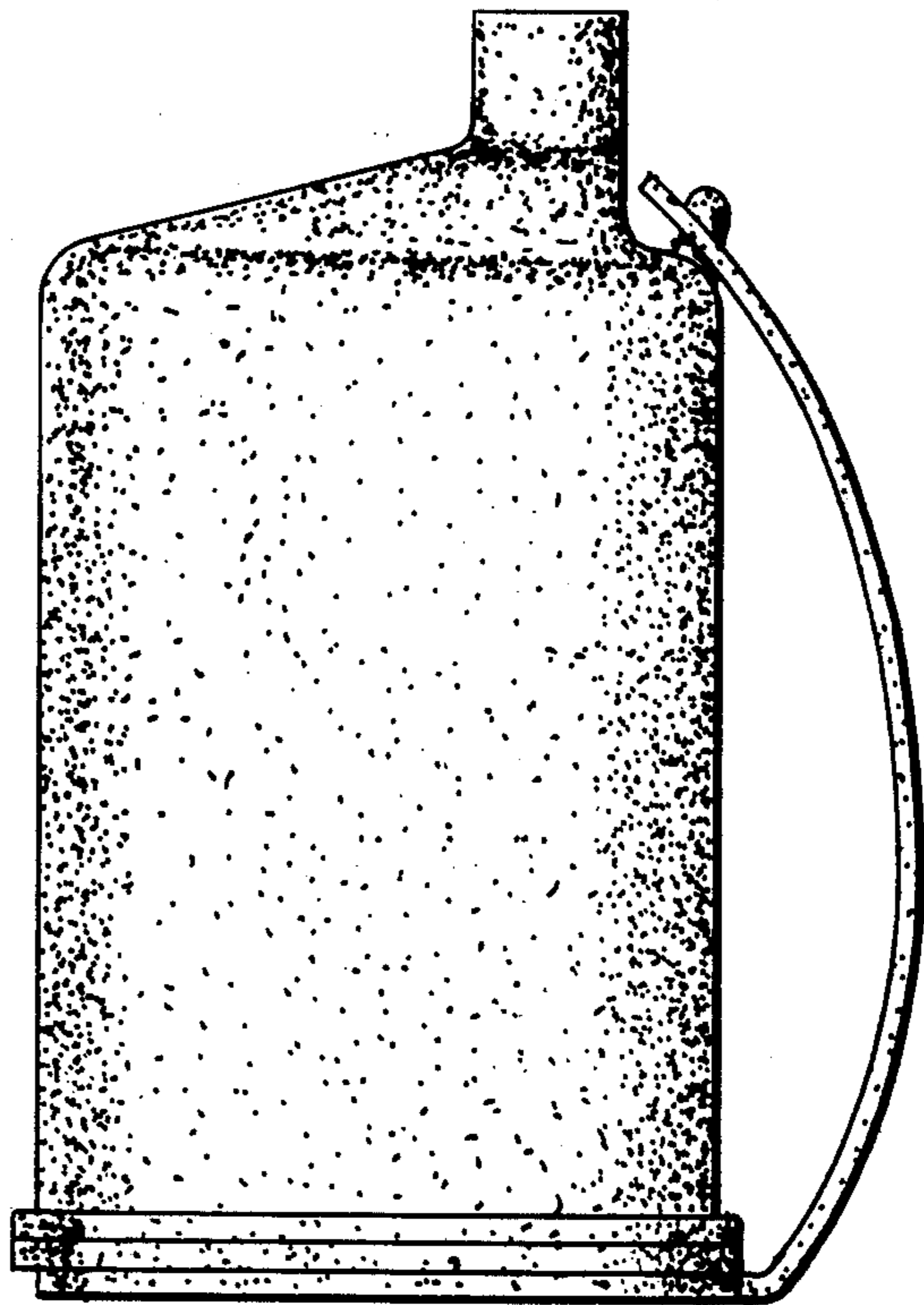

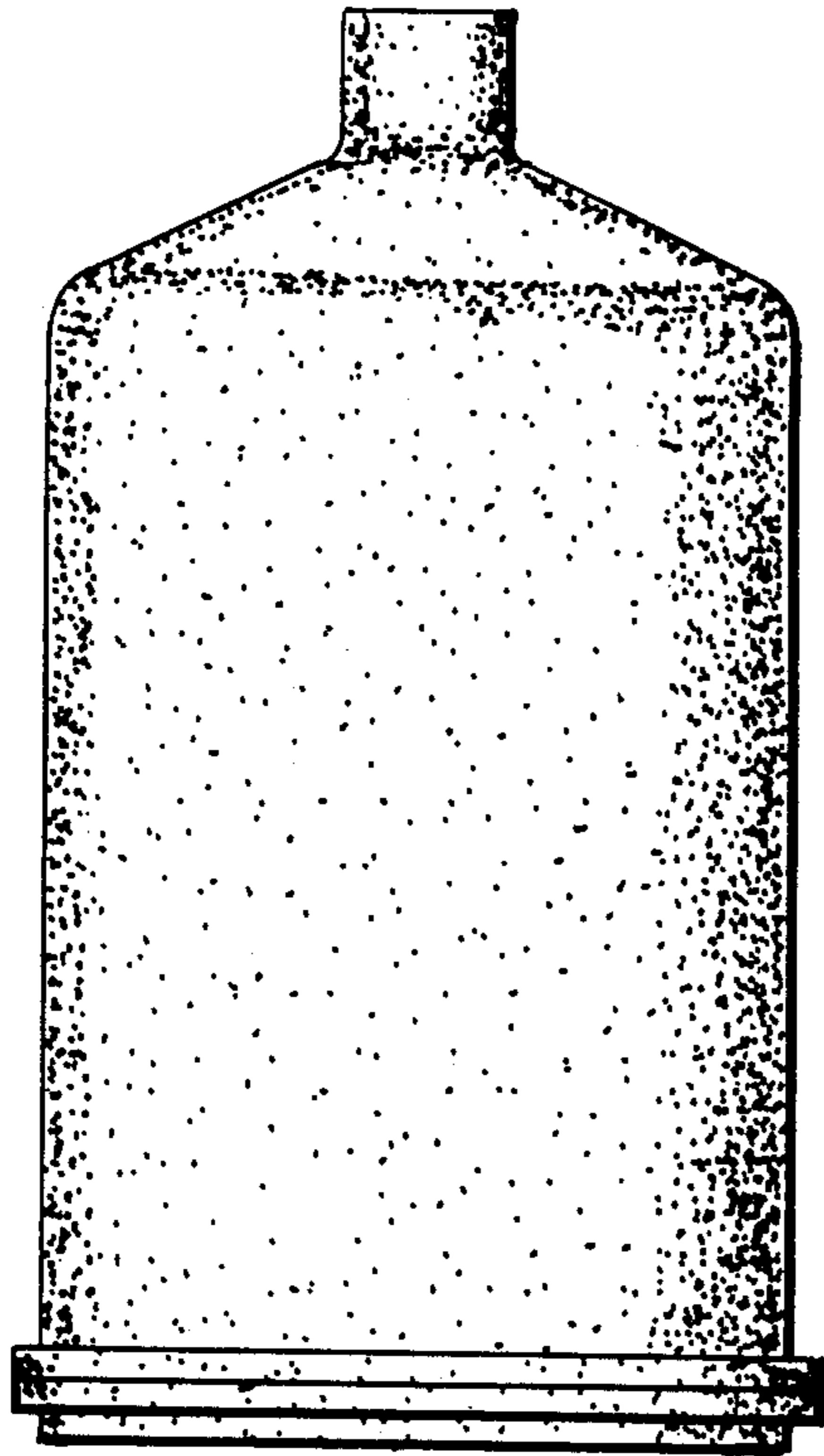

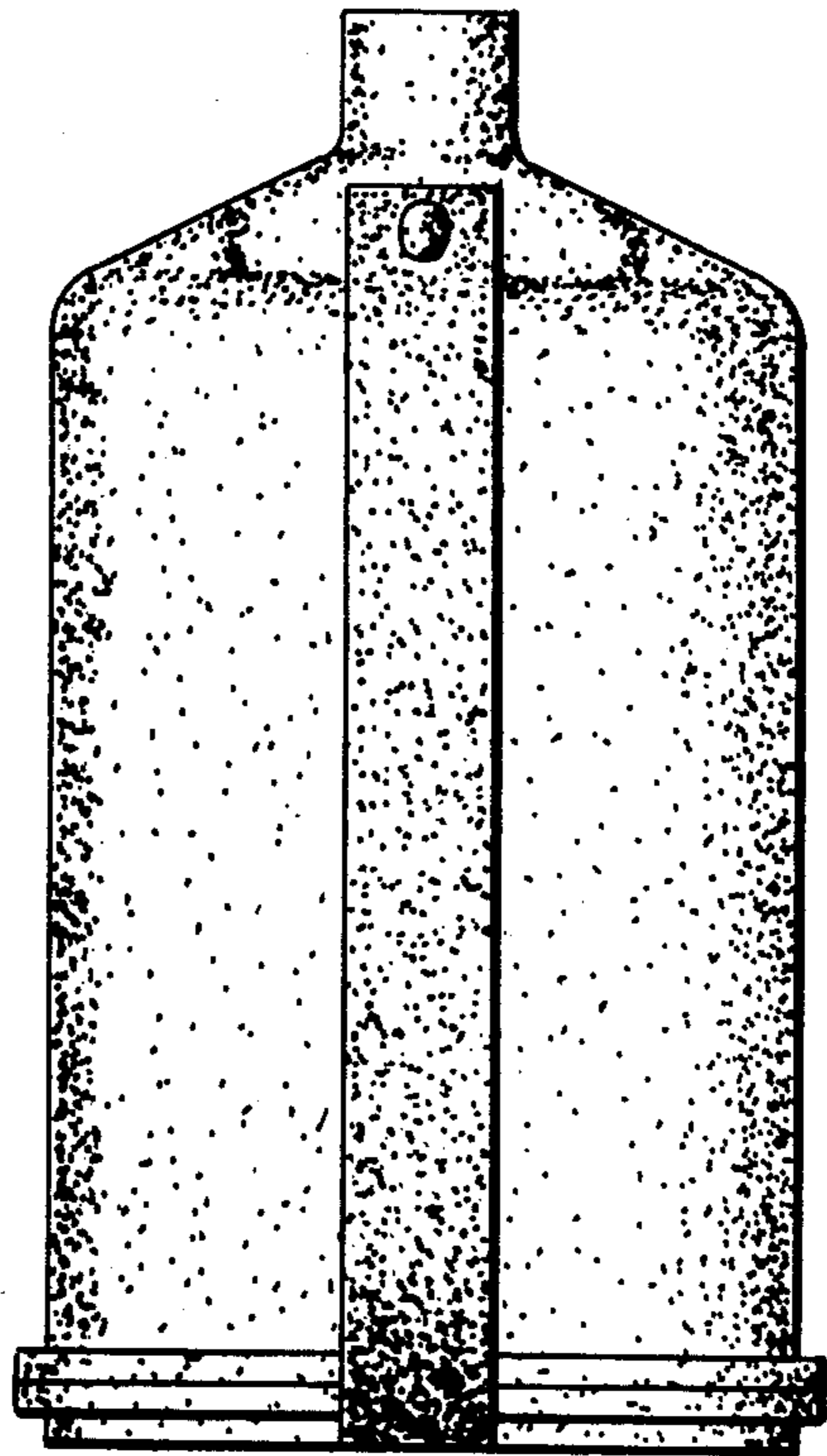
