## **DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the side and top portions of the chair or similar article embodying the novel design;


FIG. 2 is a top view of the chair or similar article of FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the chair or similar article of FIG. 1; and

The members supporting the upholstered seat portions in spaced position above the base are plain and unornamented.










