DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a partial front and right side perspective view of a harp showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the harp drawn from a position slightly to the left of that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is another enlarged fragmentary view of the harp drawn from approximately the same position as that of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the harp.

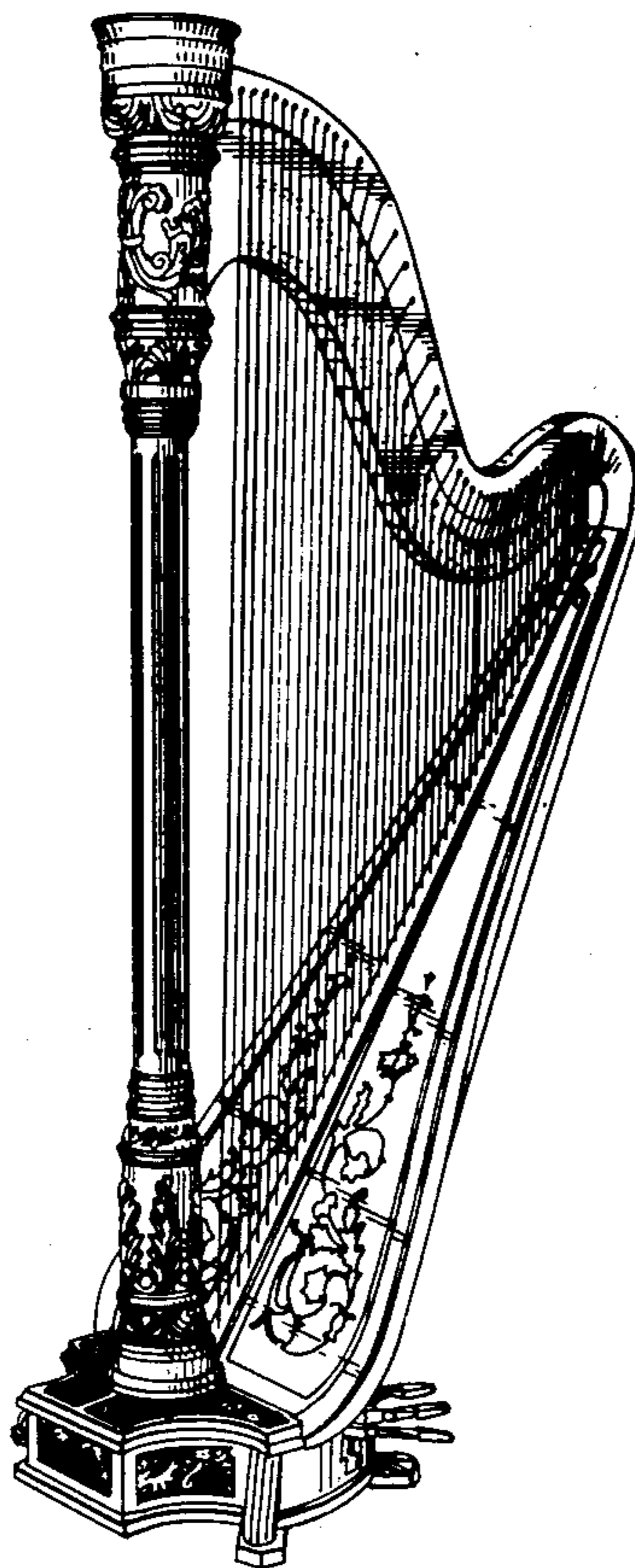
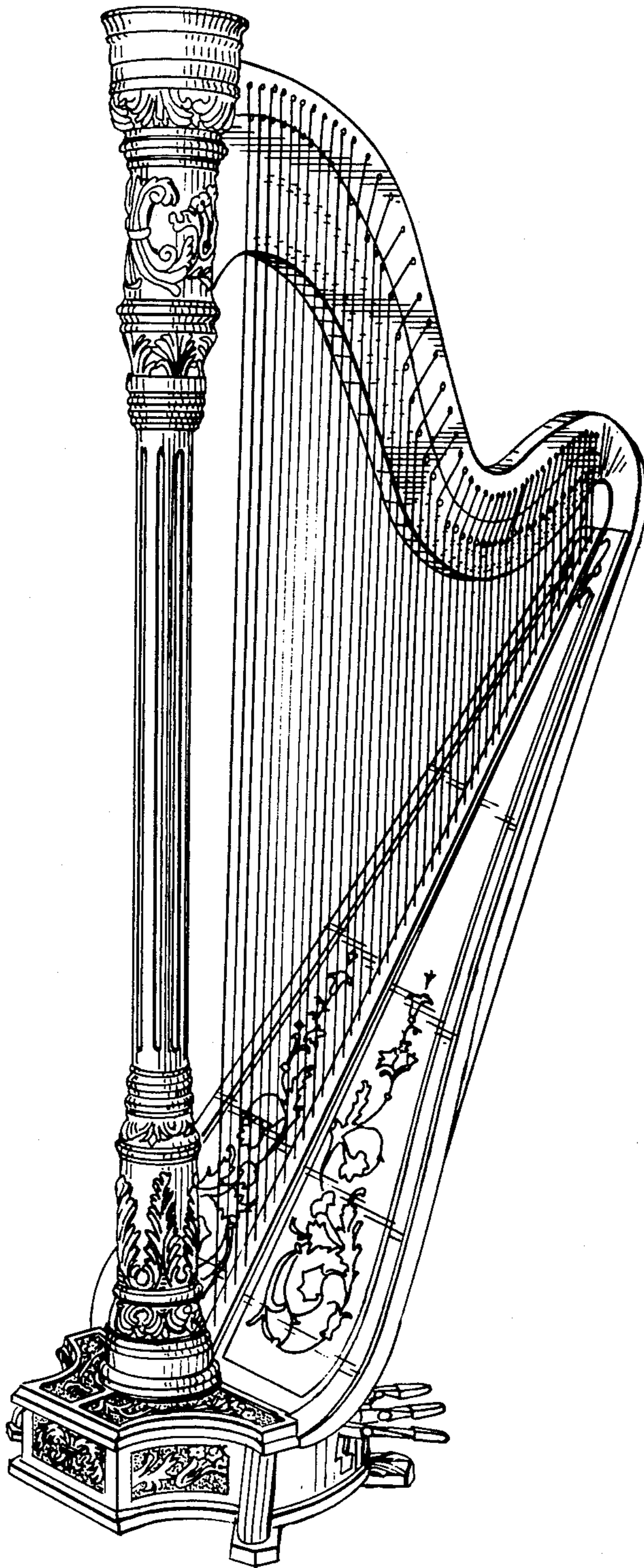
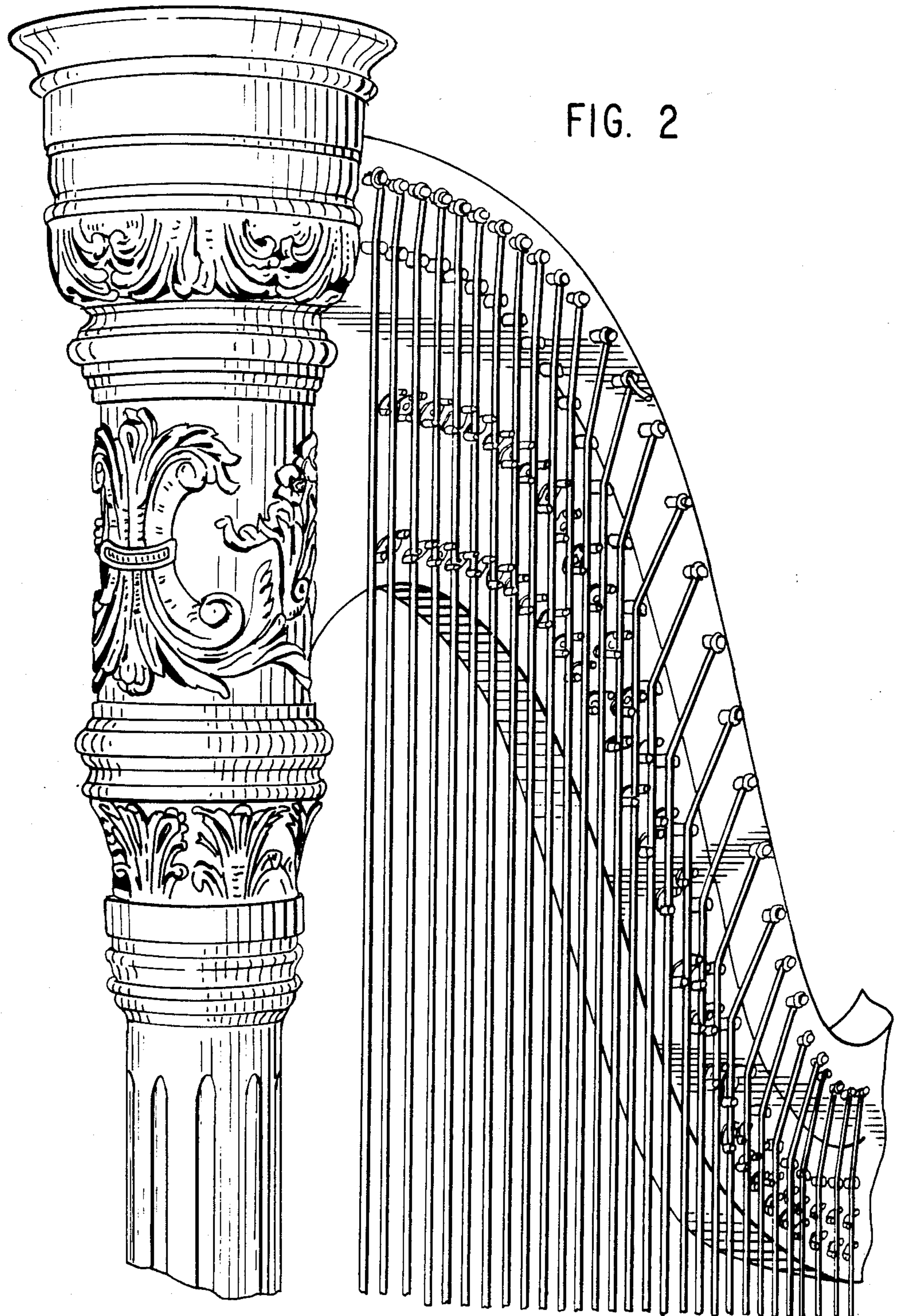

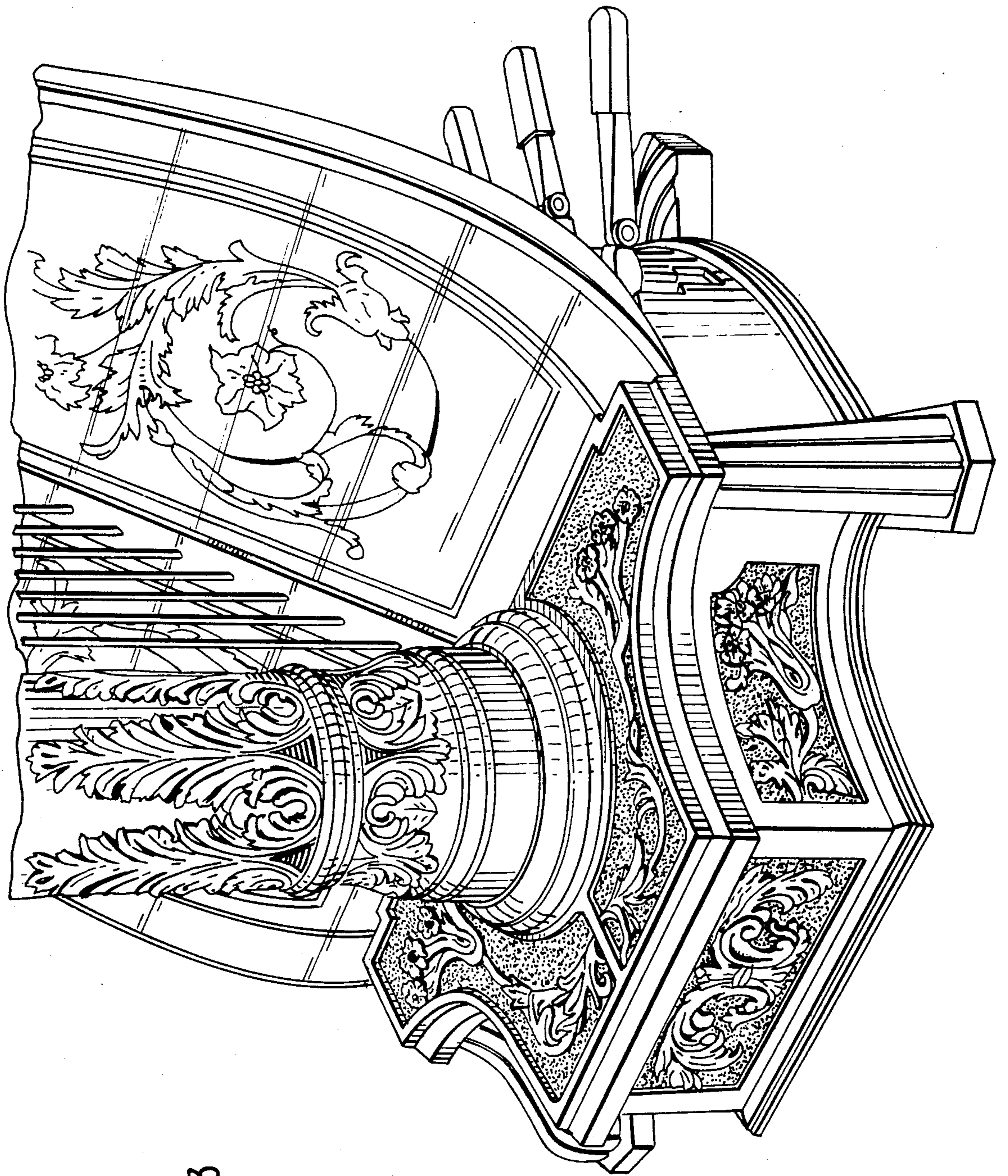
