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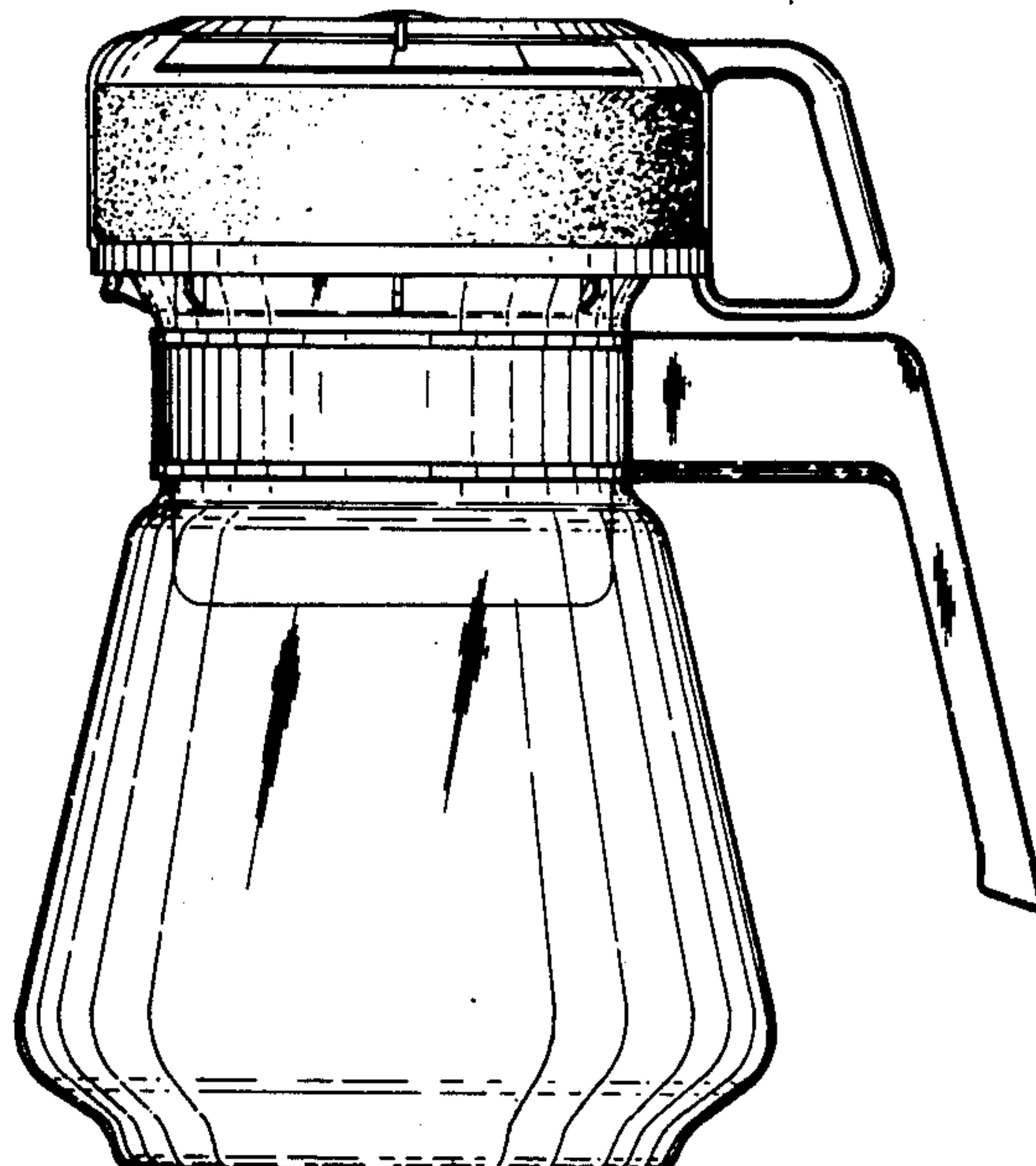

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view on a reduced scale of a coffee maker showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the brewing basket thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 7 is a left-side elevation view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 8 is a right side elevation view of the coffee maker, the left side elevation of the server thereof being a mirror image;
FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the server thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9.



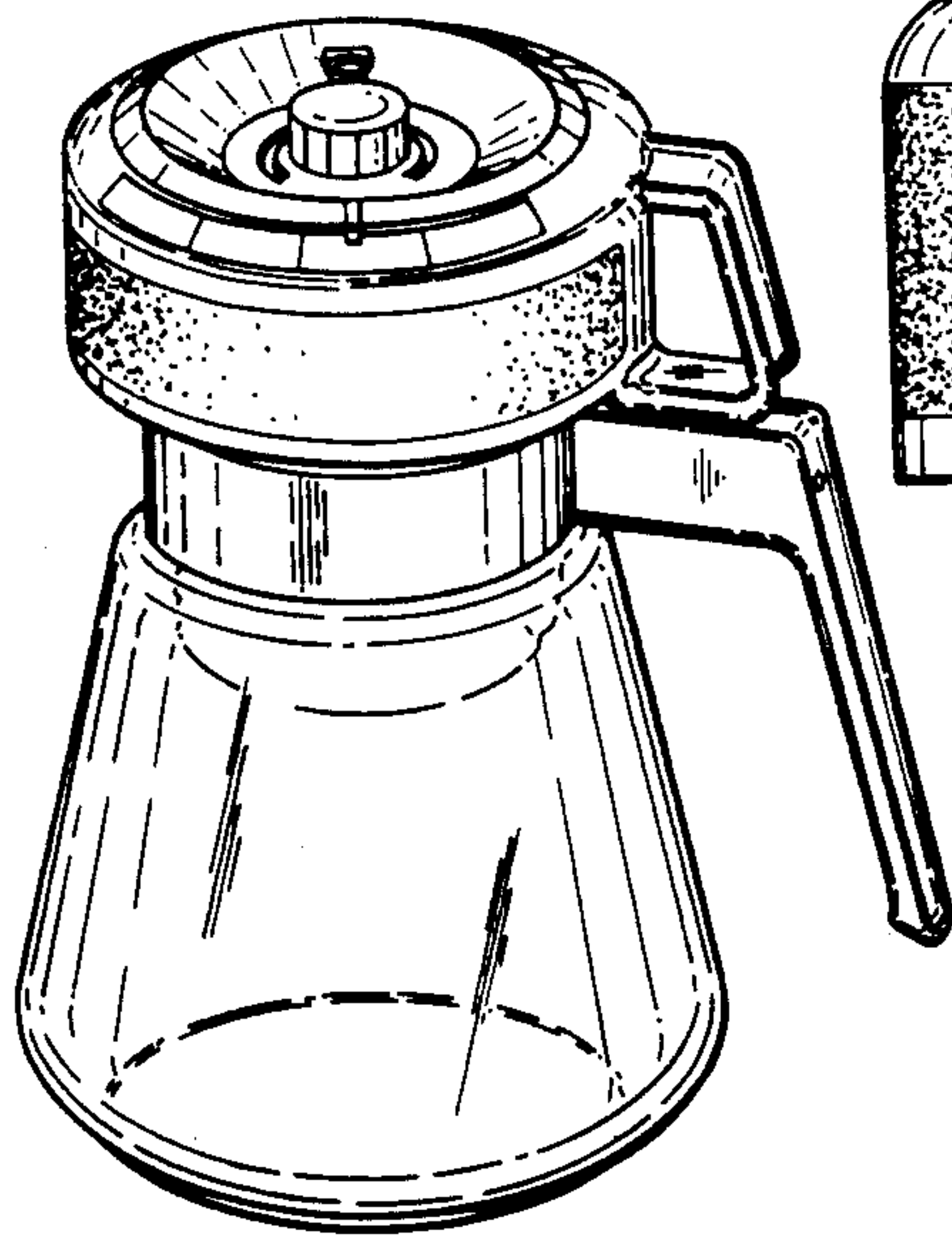

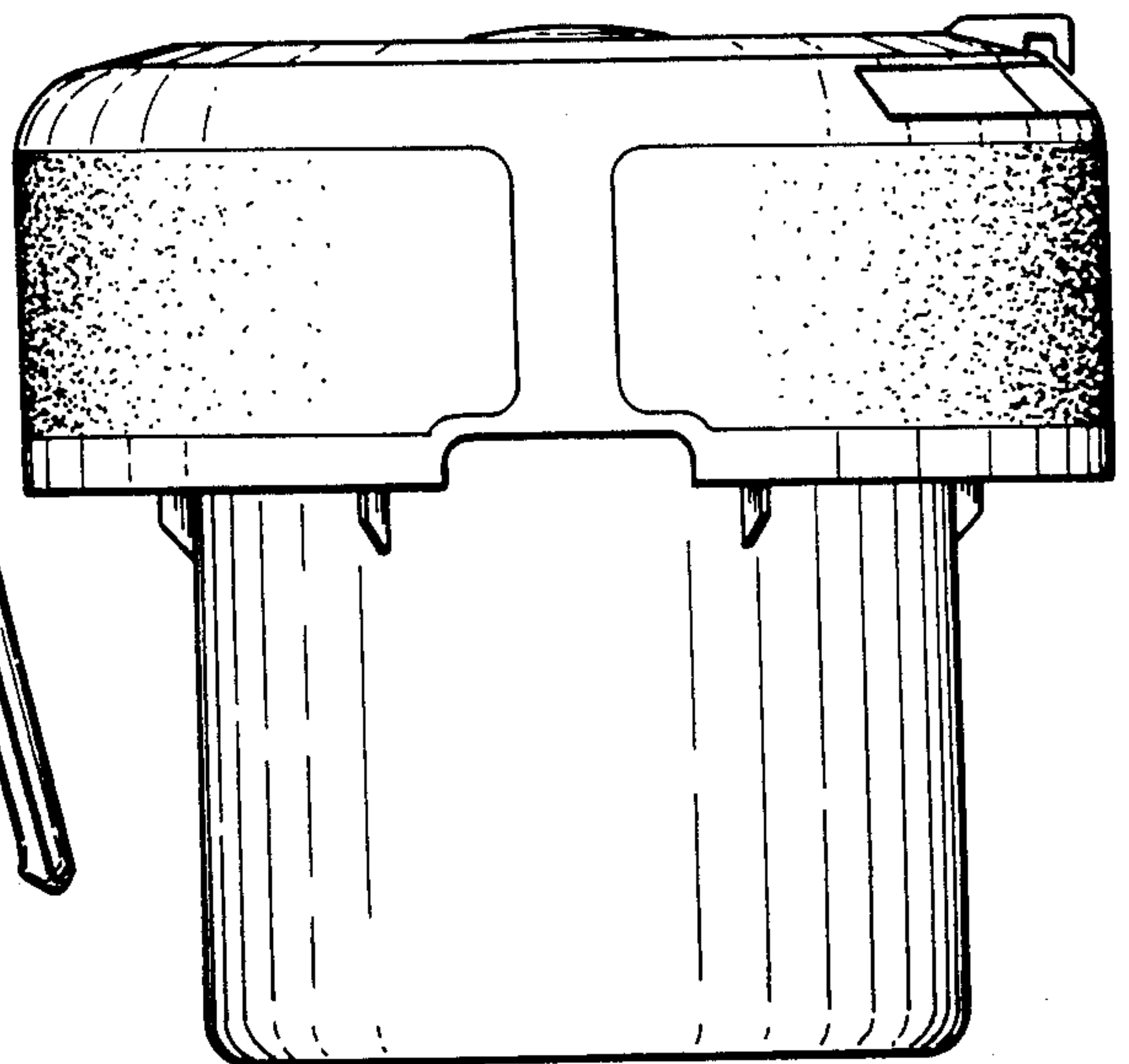

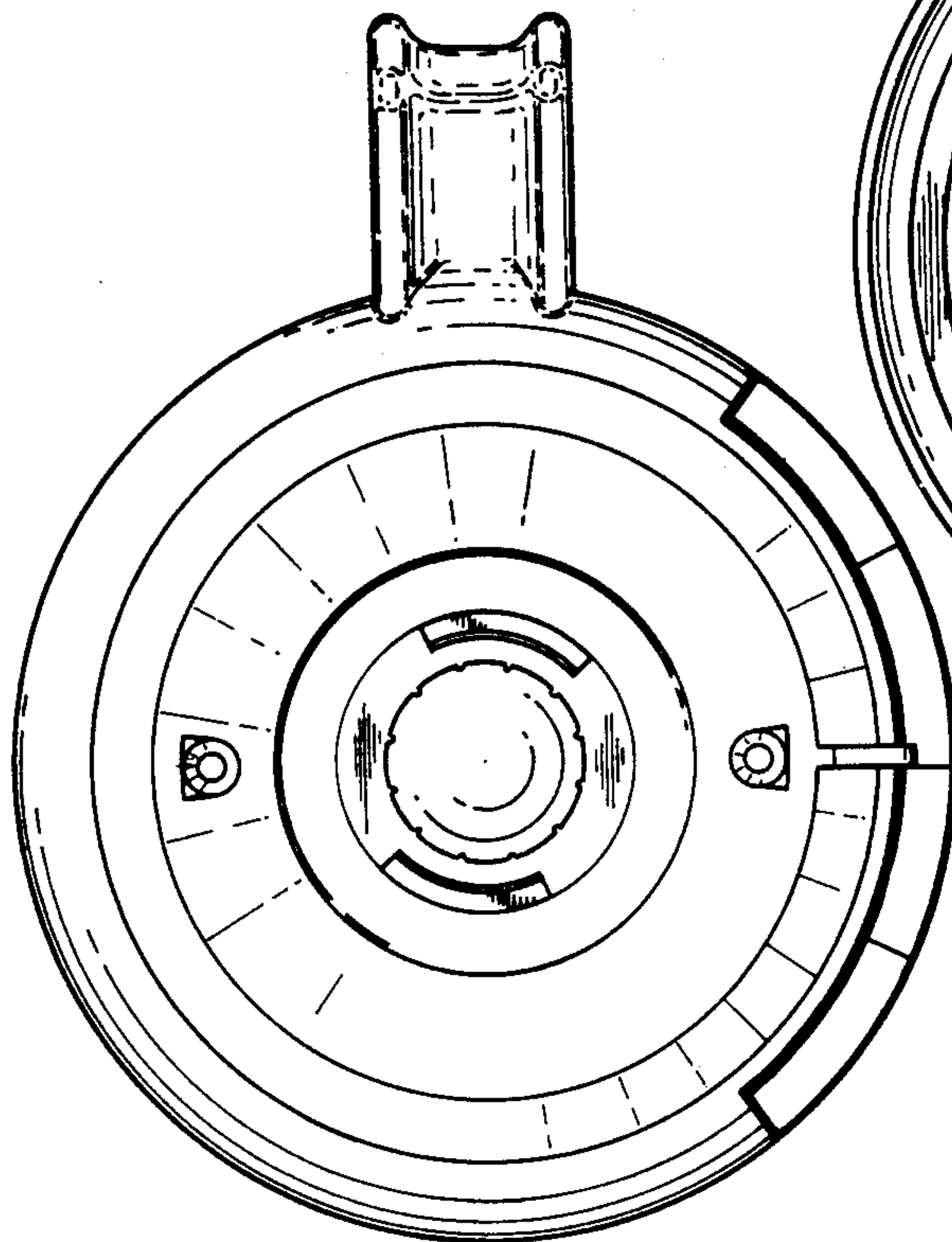

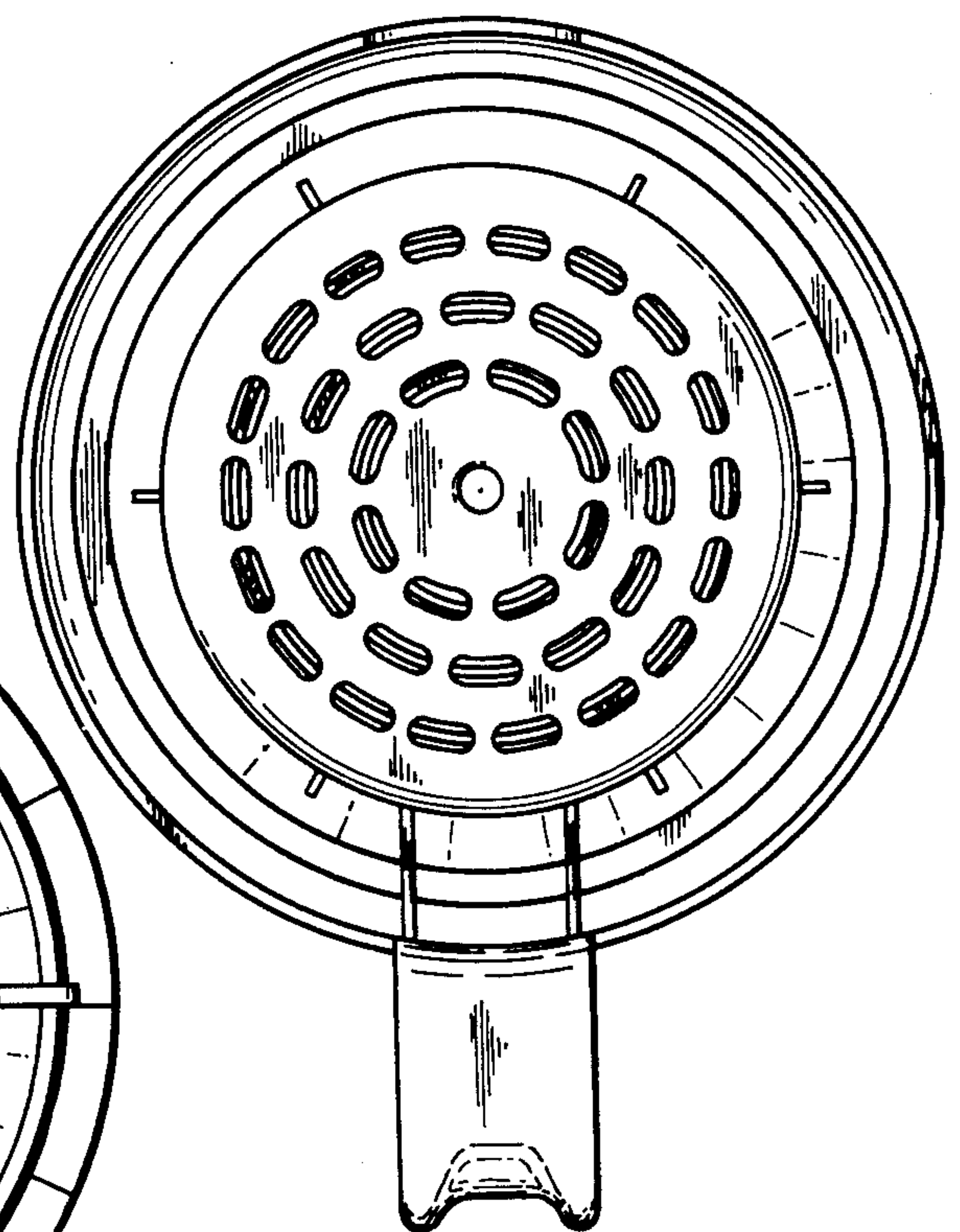

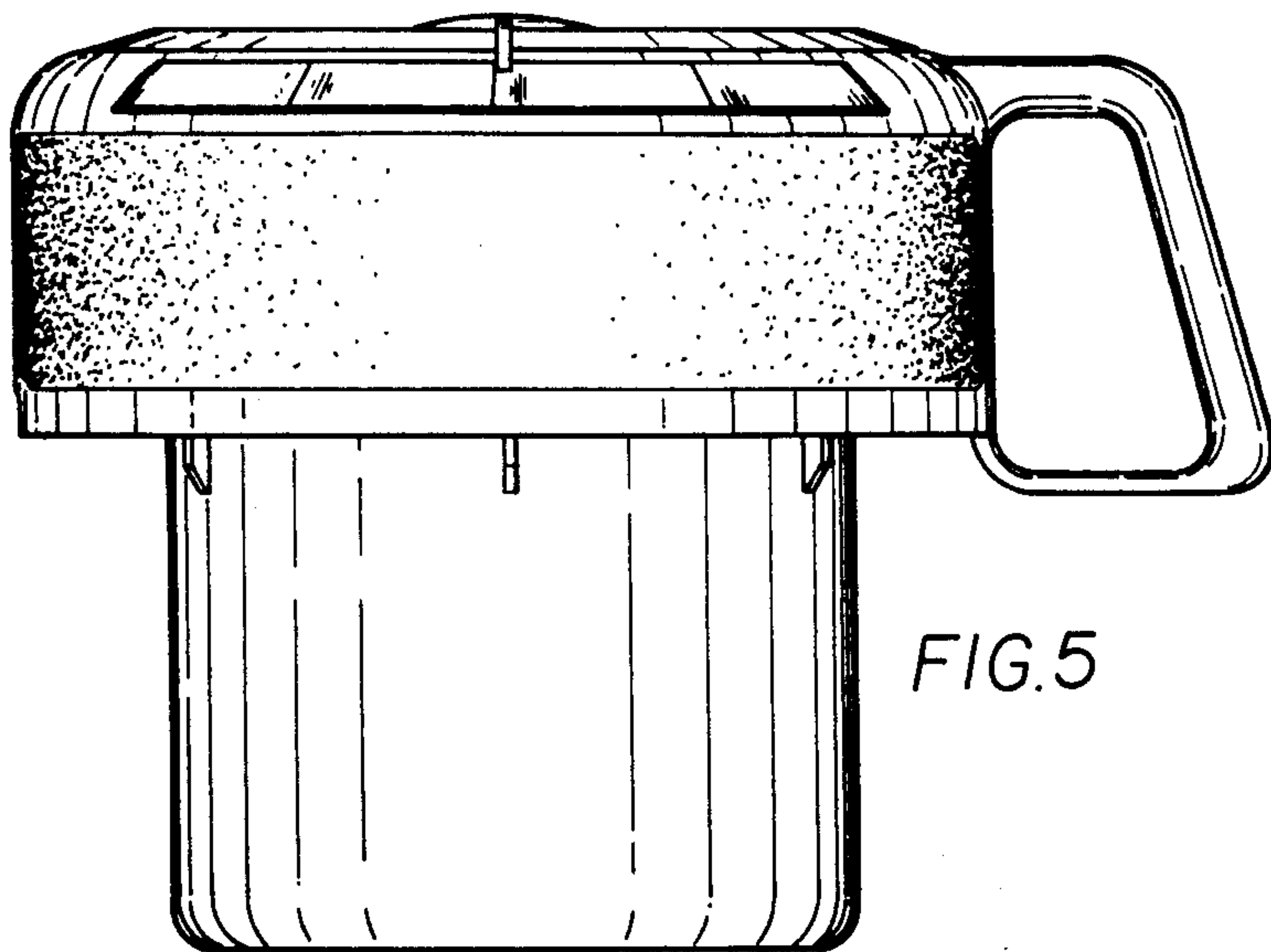

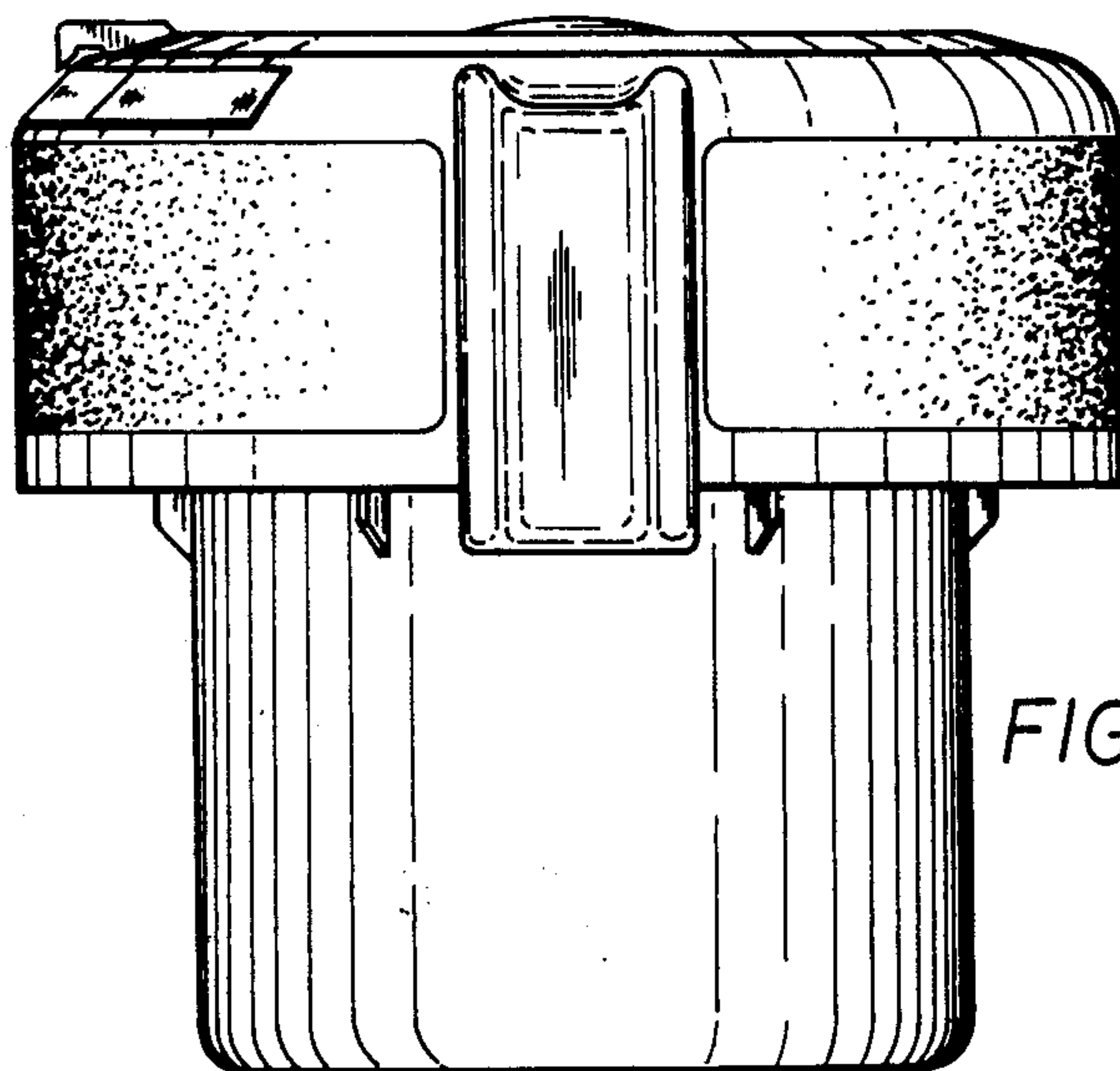

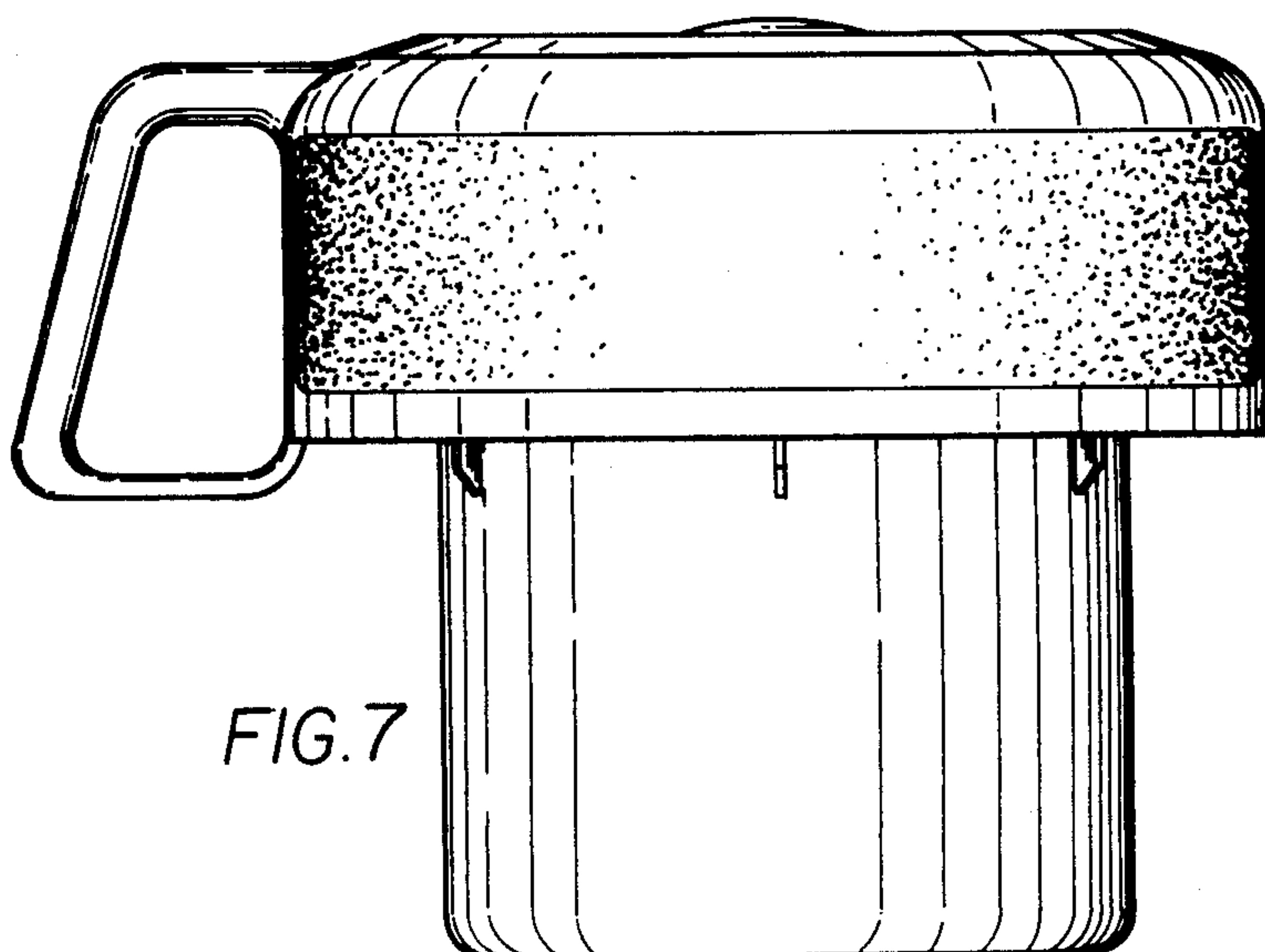

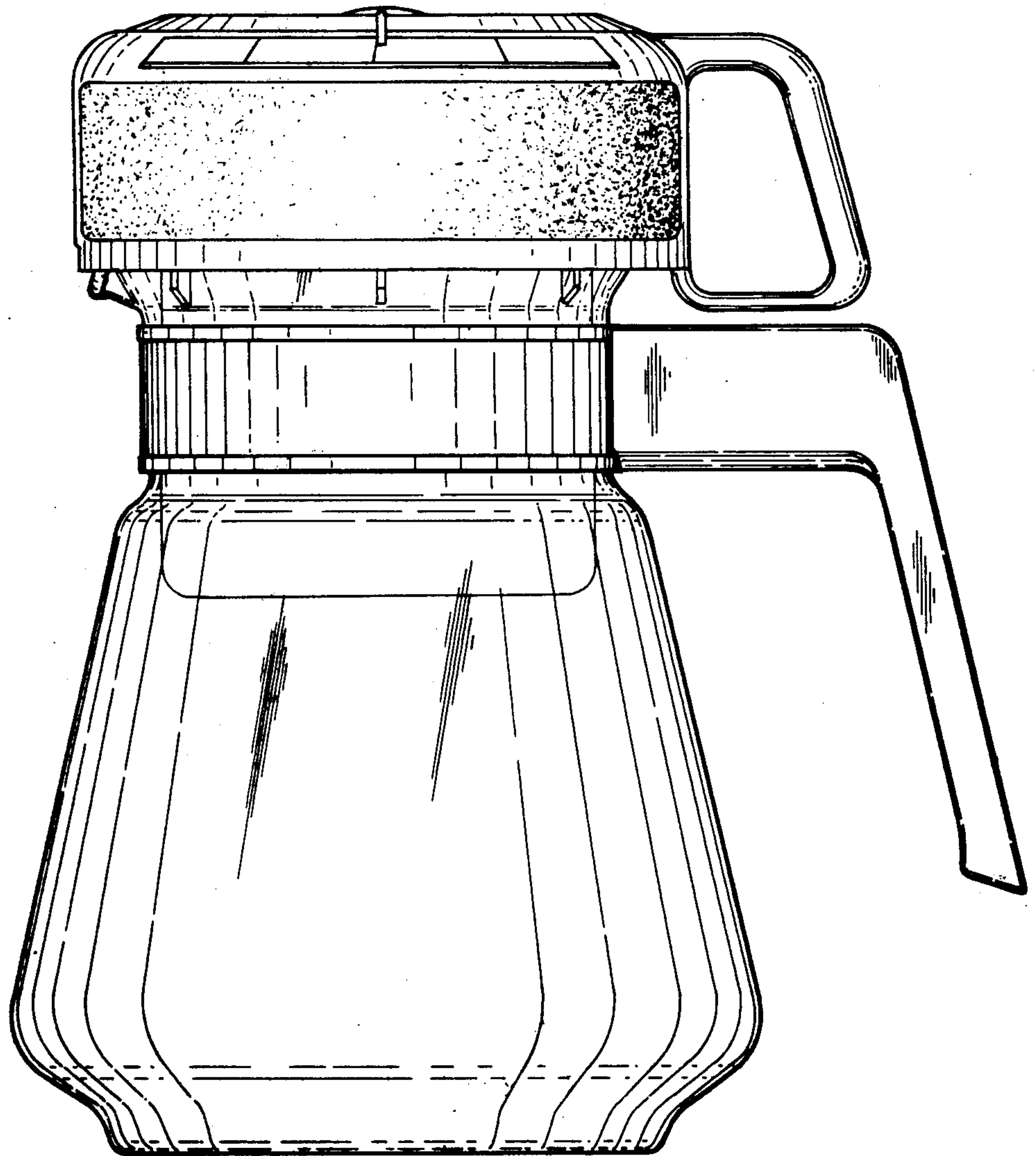

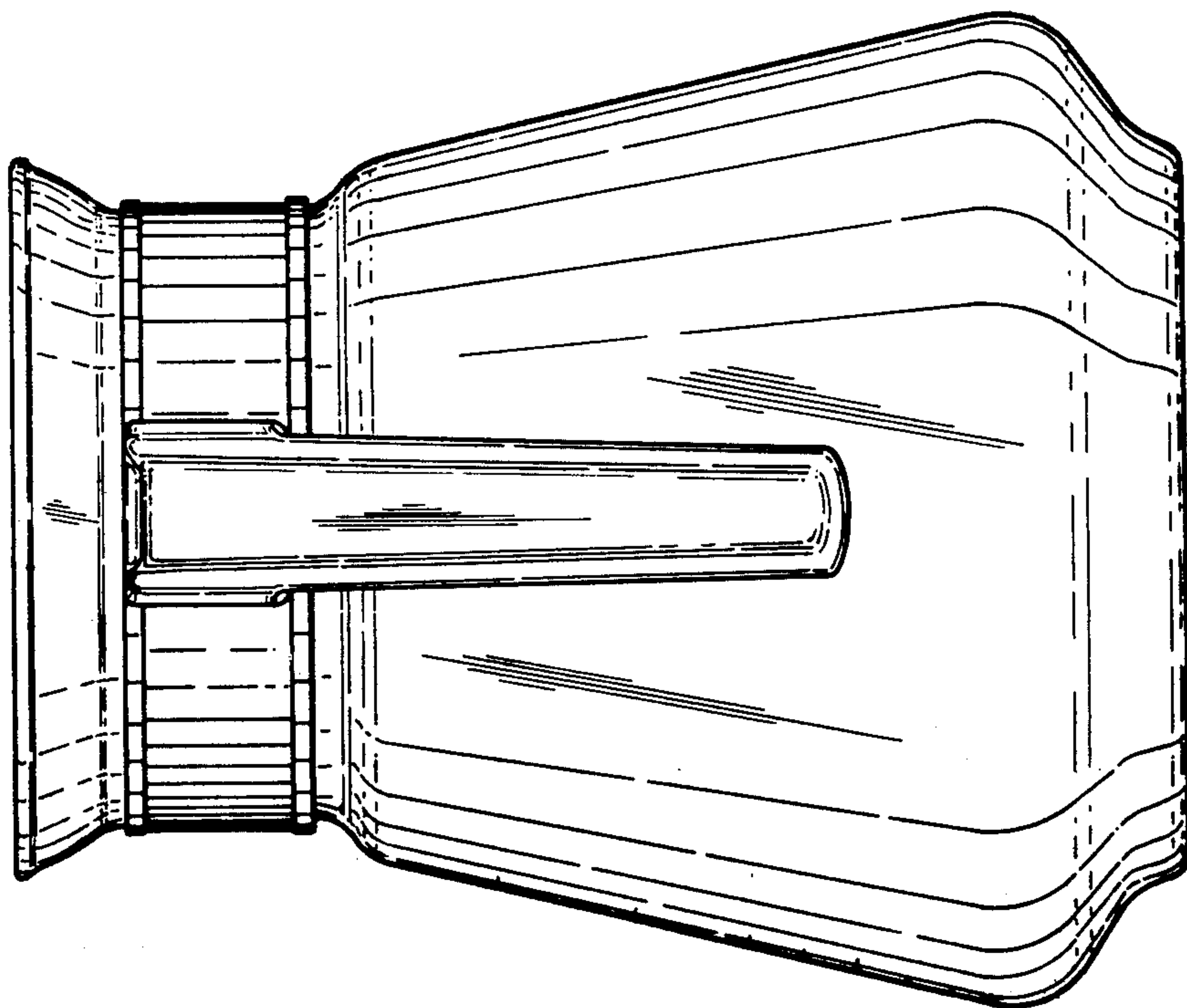

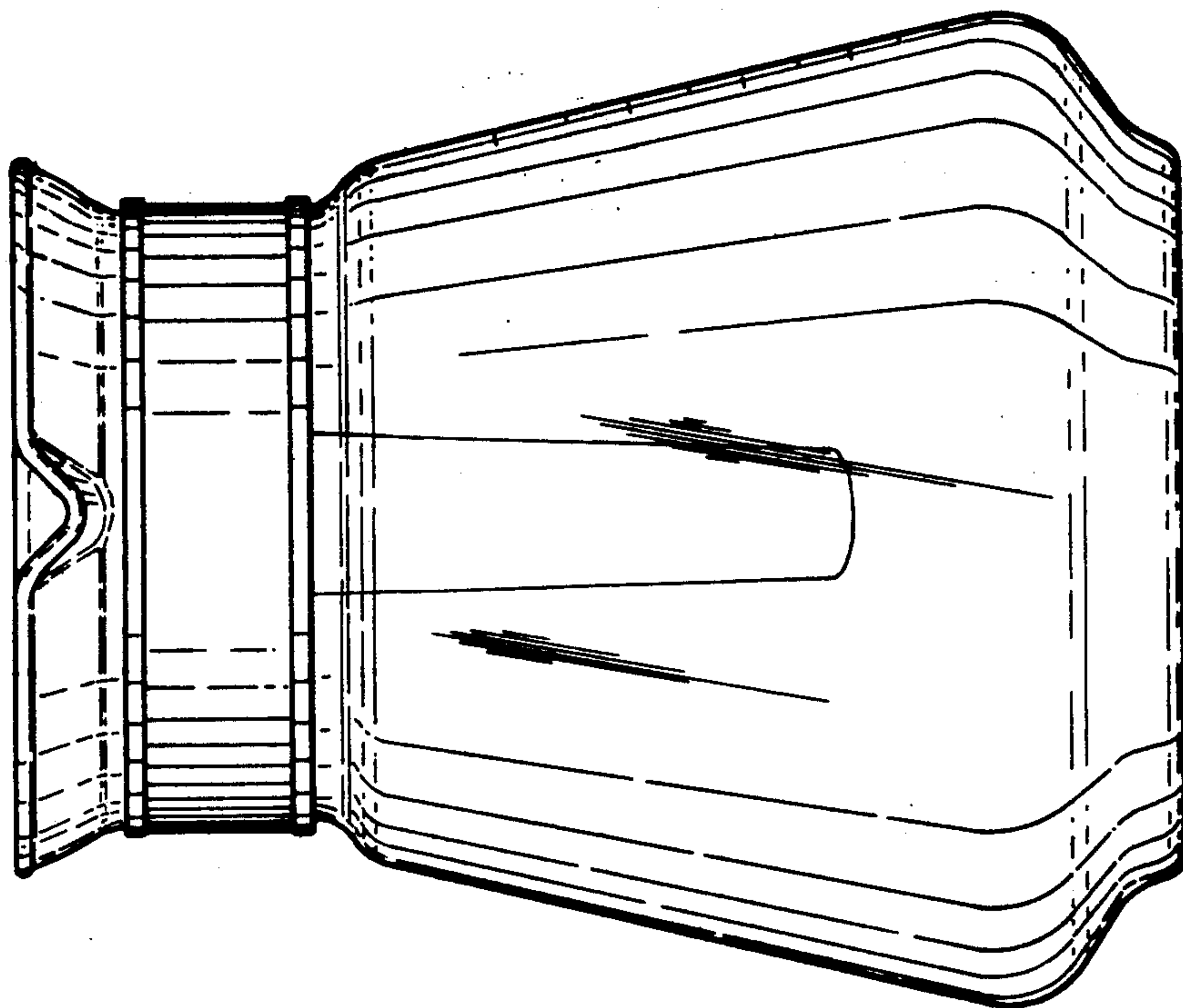

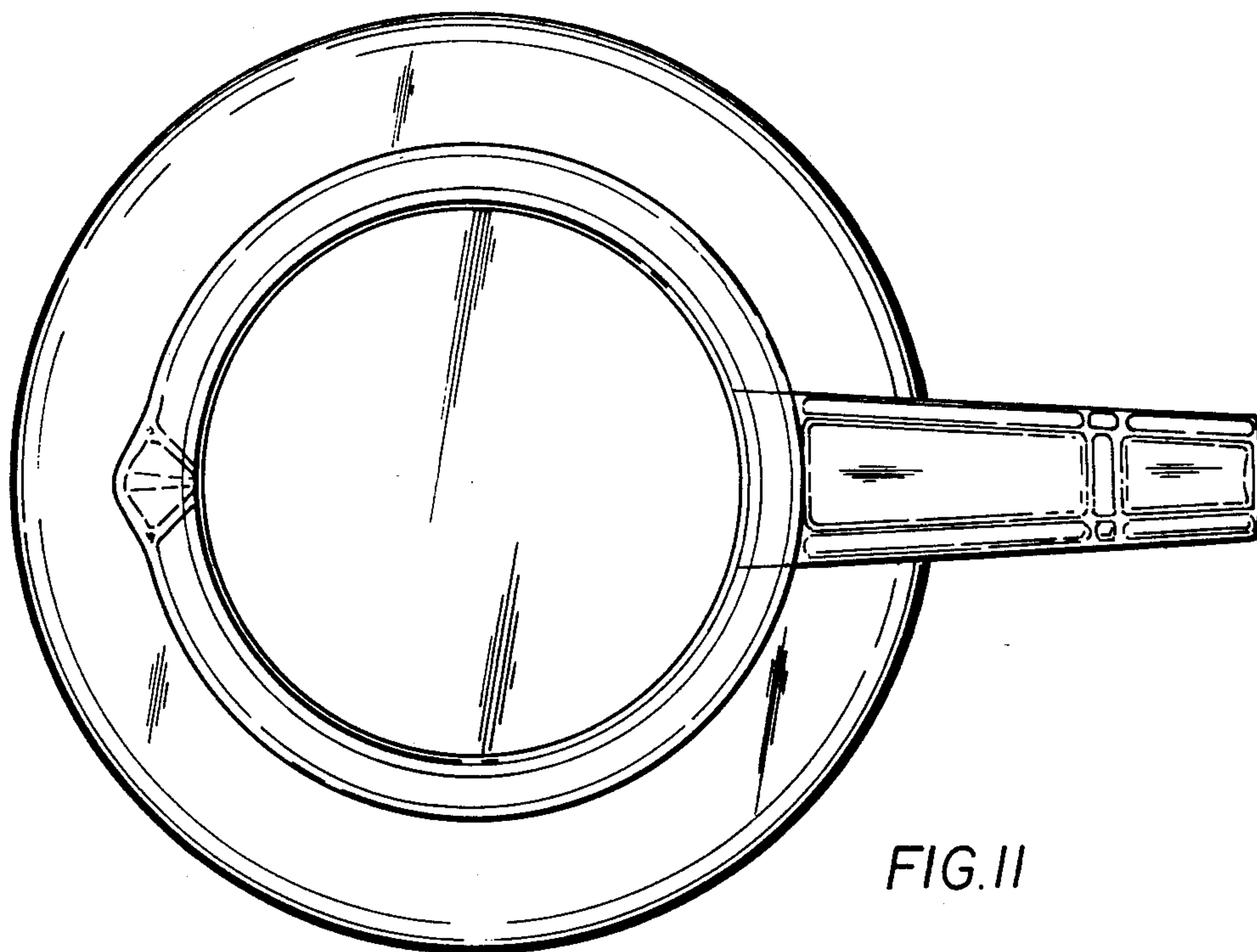

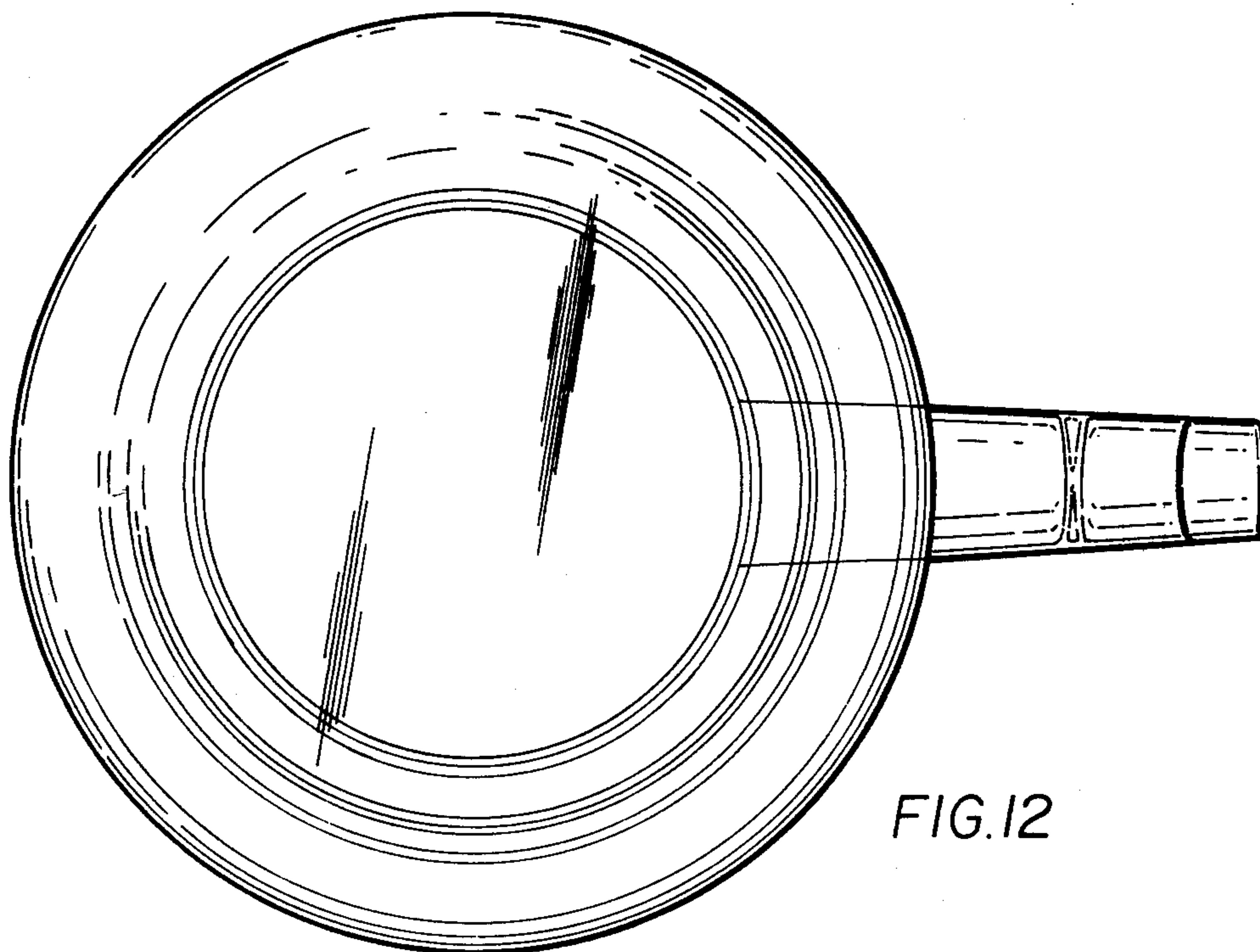
