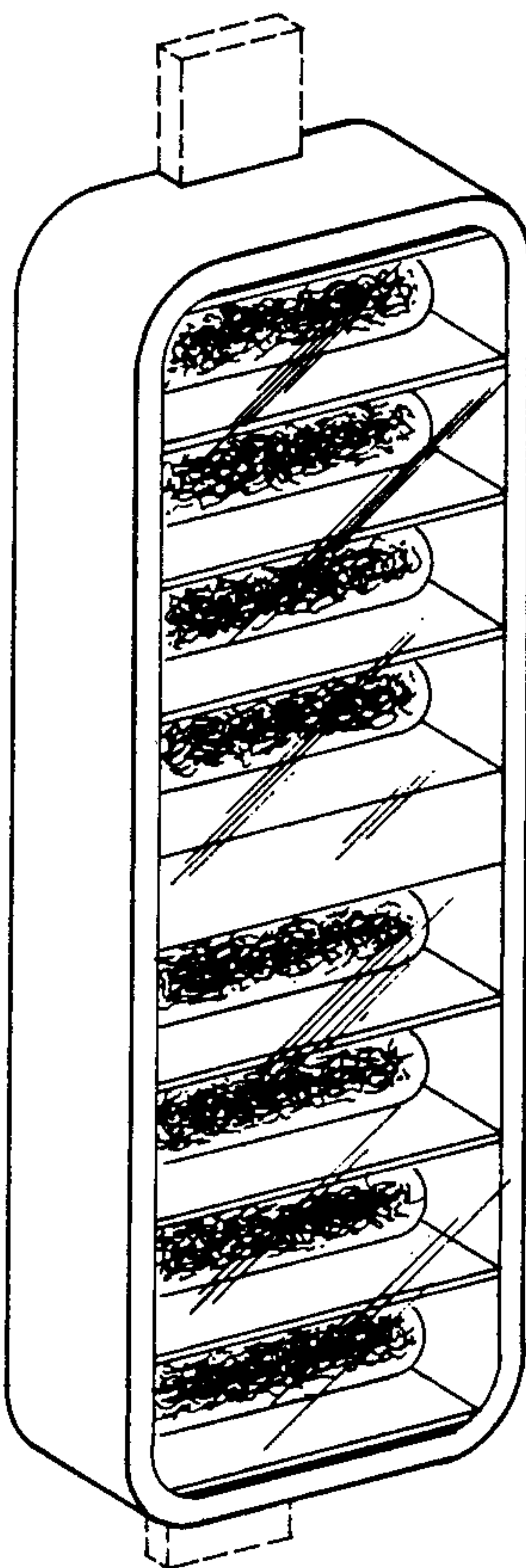
The ornamental design for a photoflash lamp unit, as shown and described.
