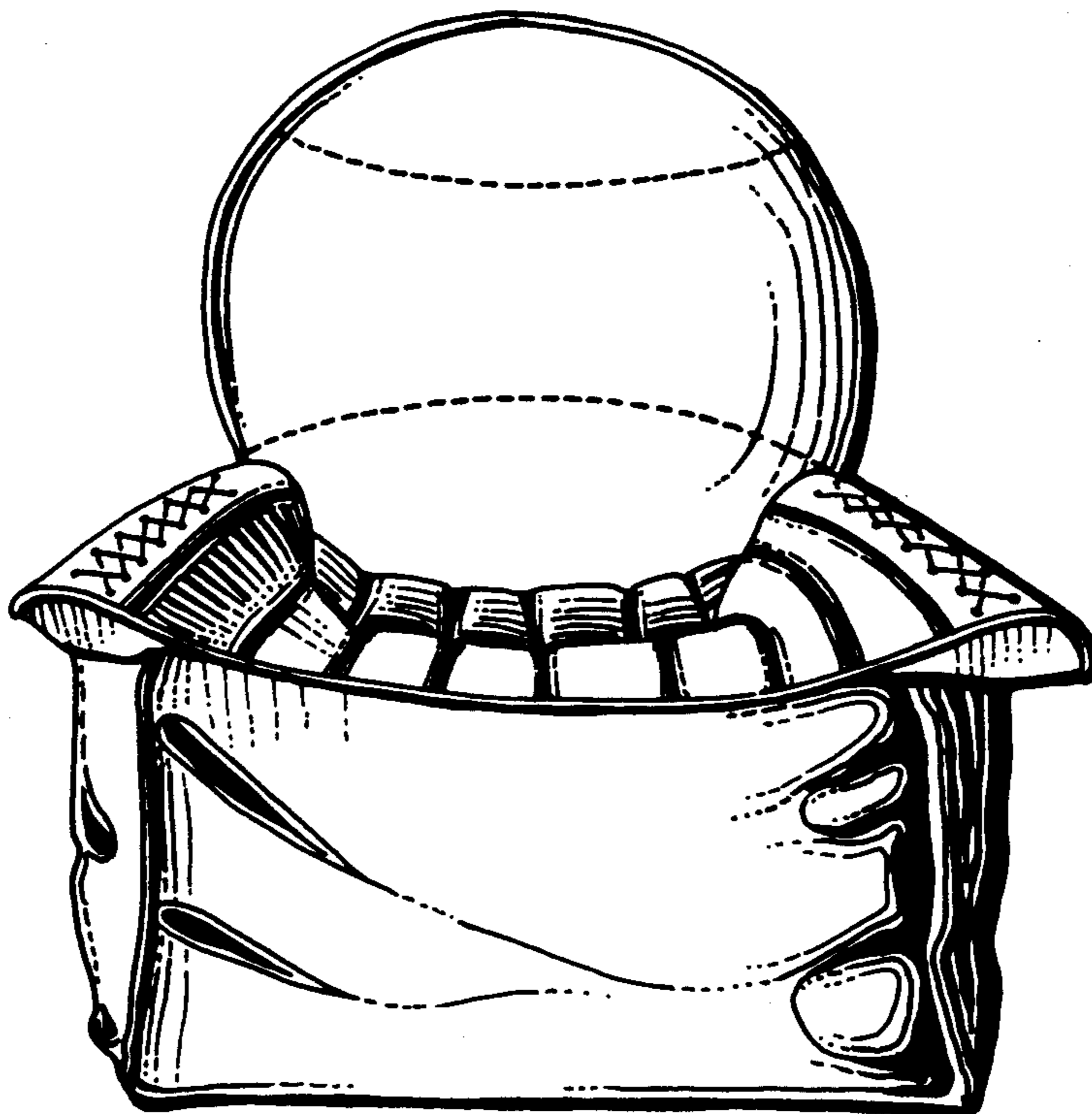

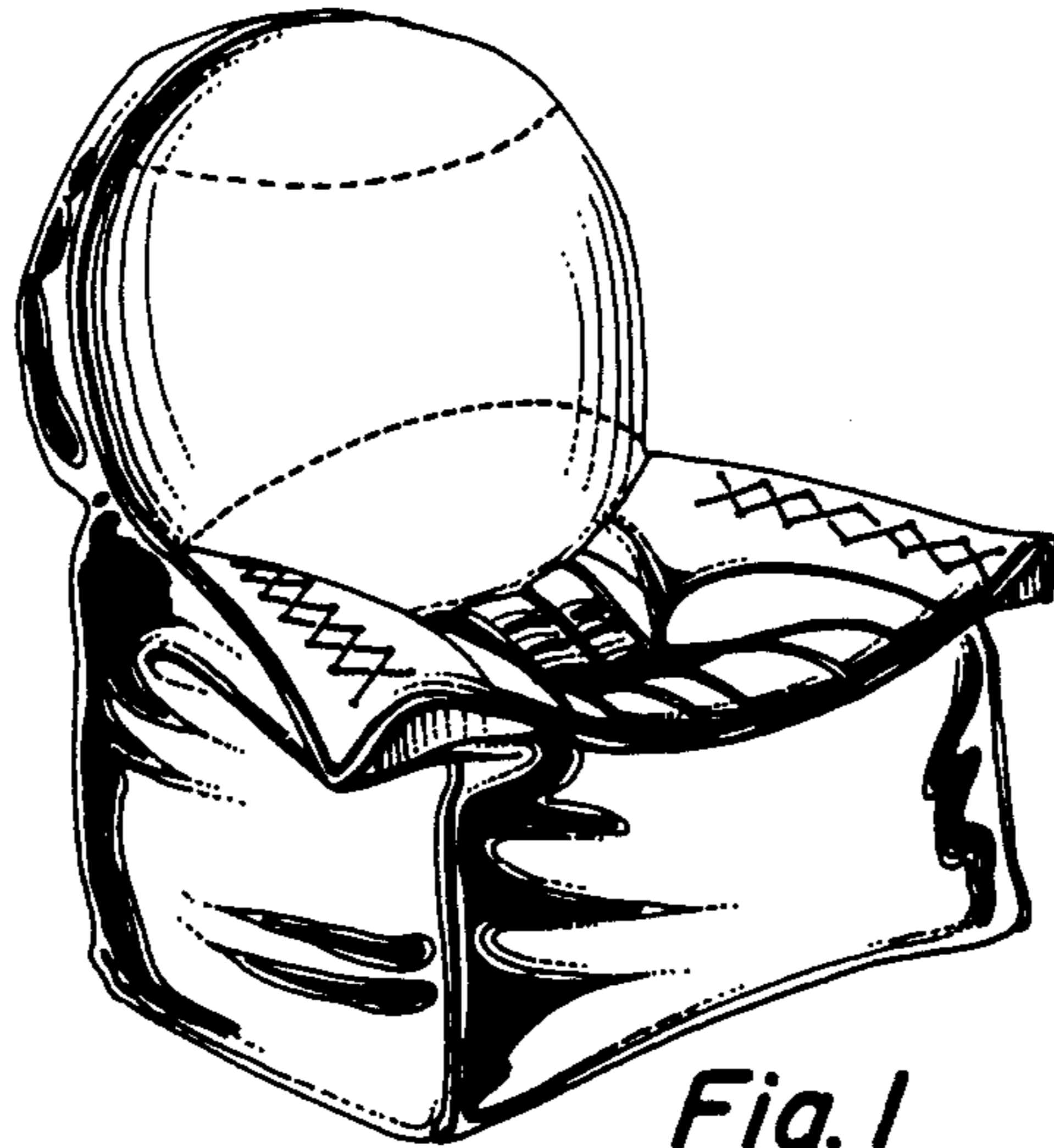
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a novelty chair, substantially as shown and described.

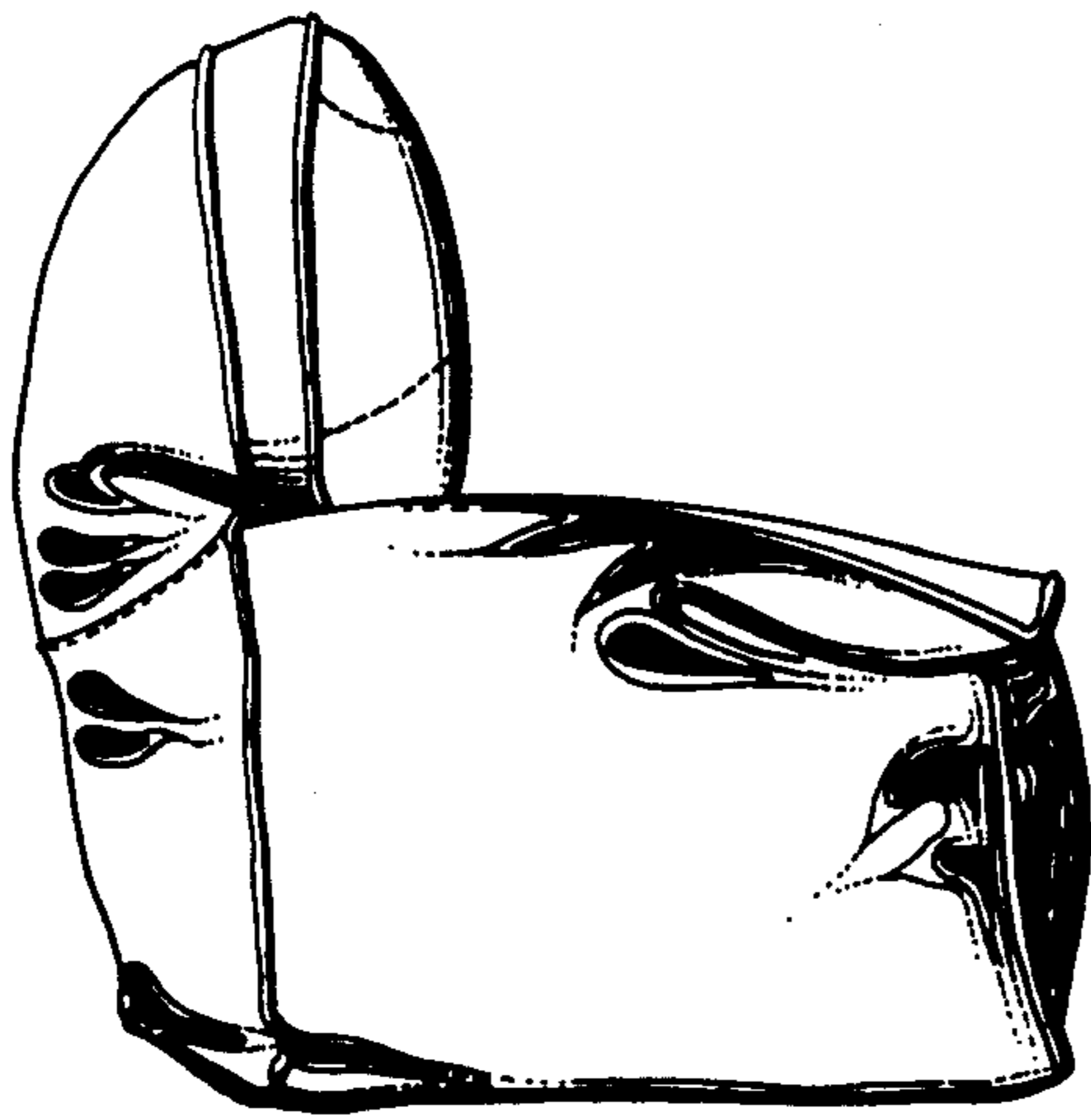
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the novelty chair showing my new design;

 The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the chair shown in FIG. 2.

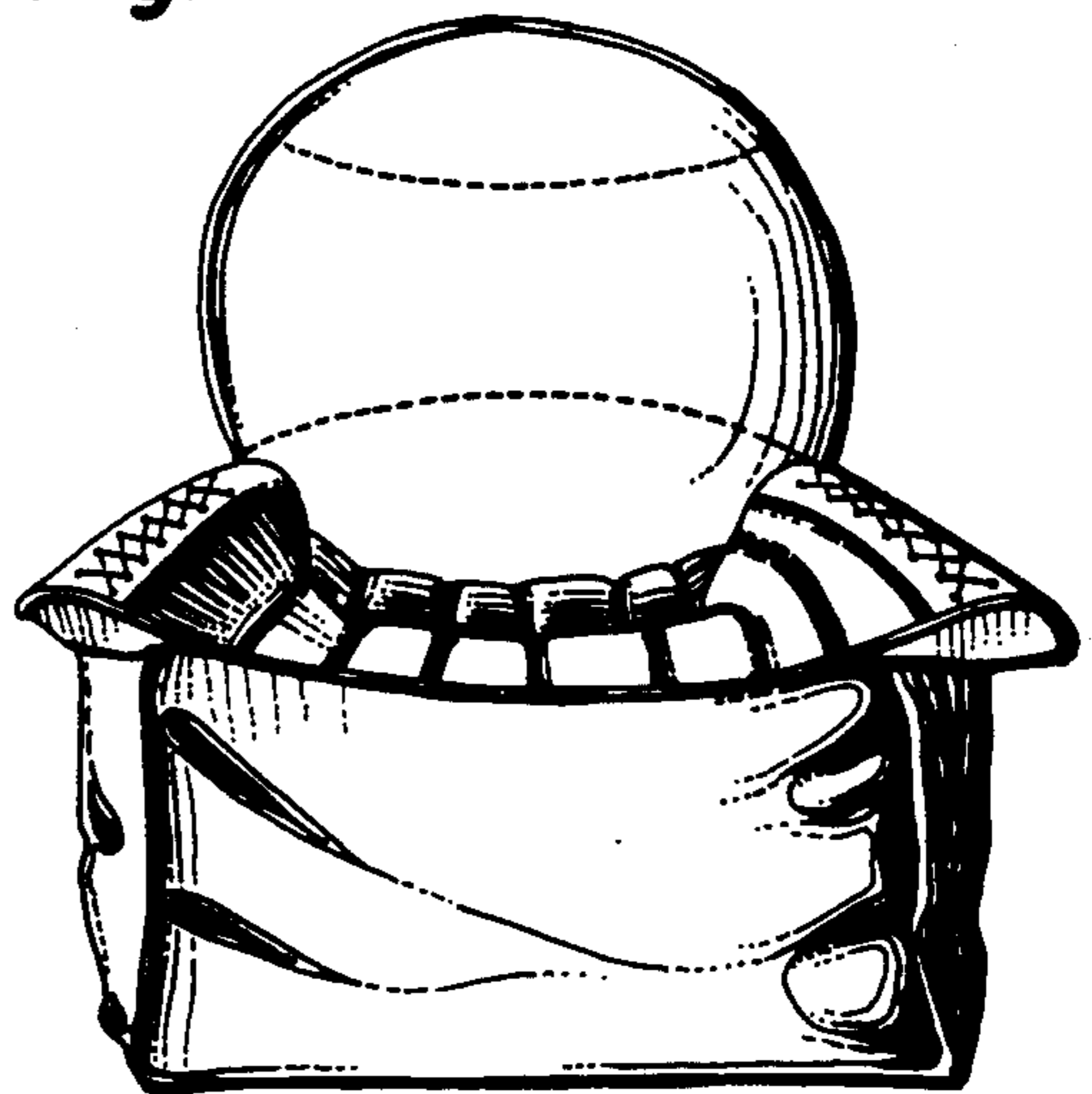




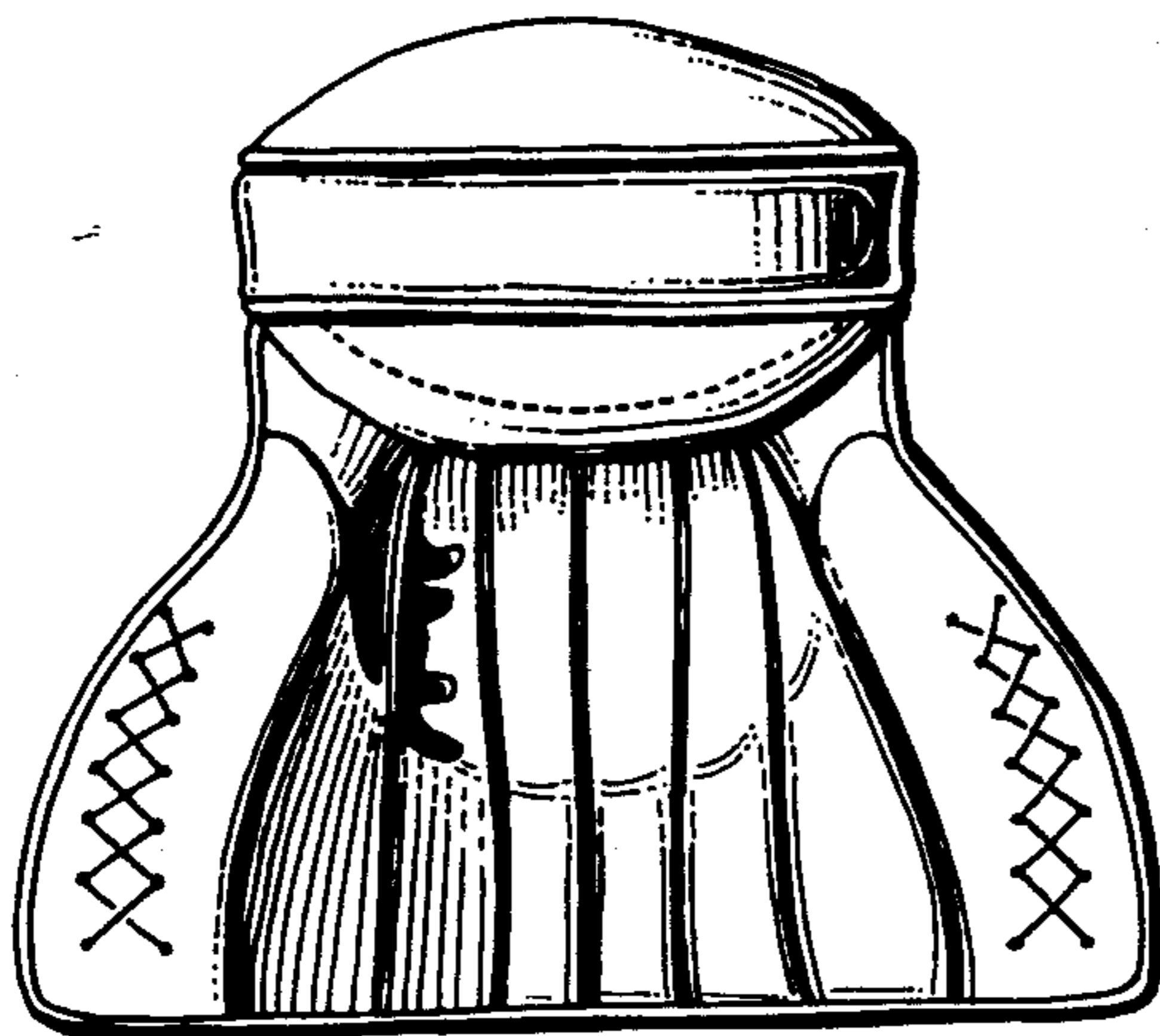

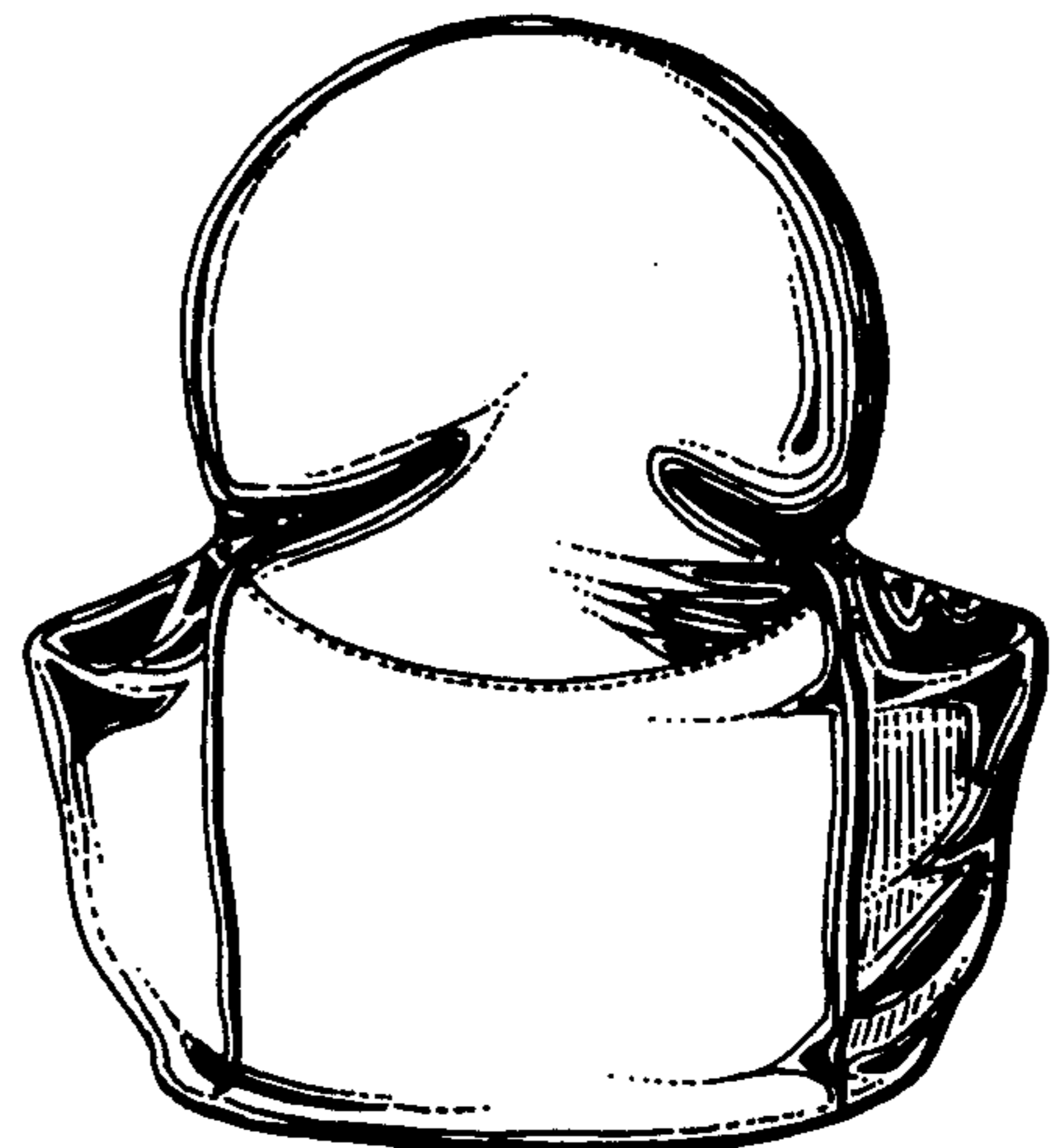
