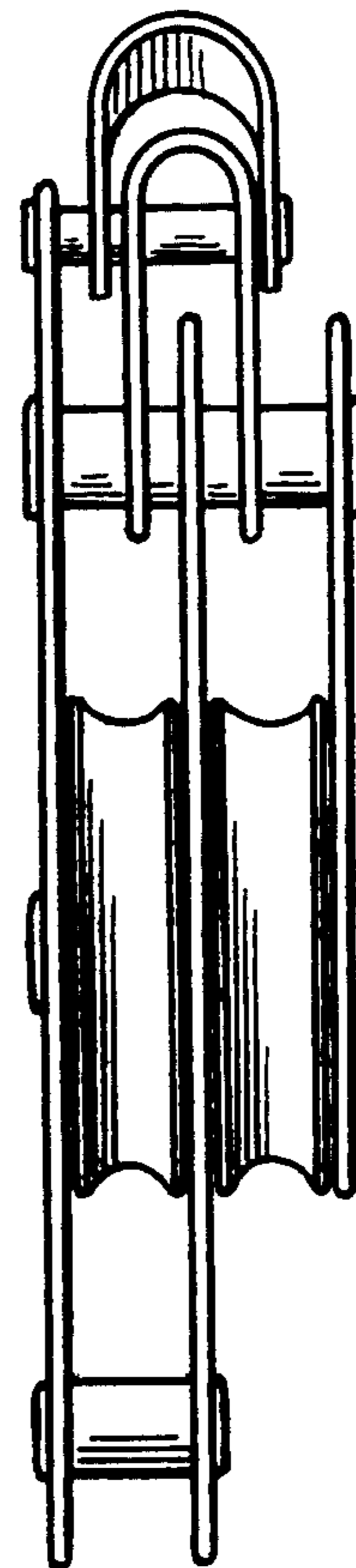
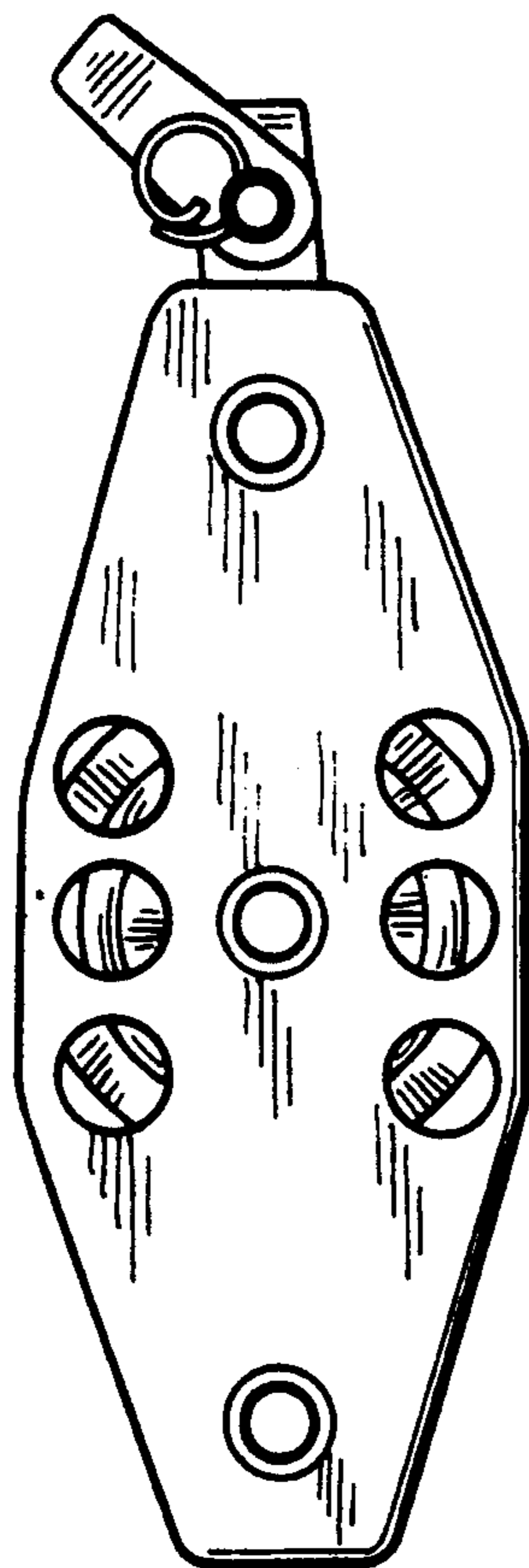

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of the double block for boats; FIG. 2 is a side view of the double block for boats, opposite to that shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a view from below of the double block for boats; FIG. 4 is a view from above of the double block for boats; FIG. 5 is a front view of the double block for boats.



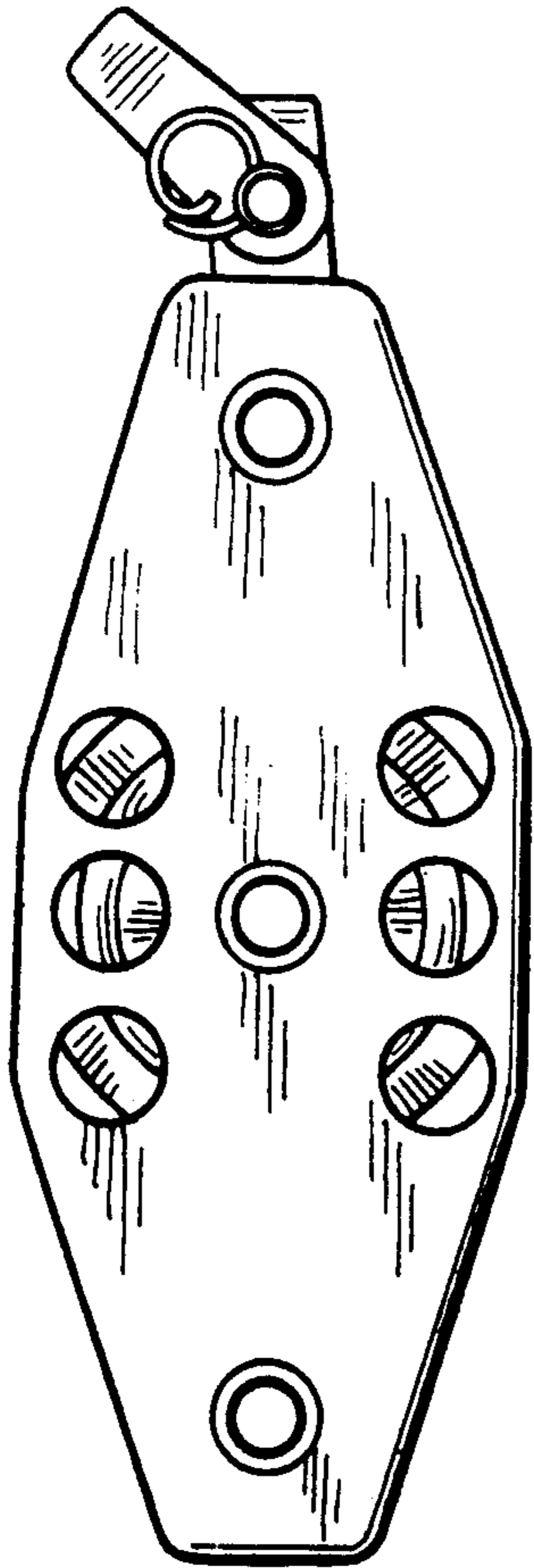

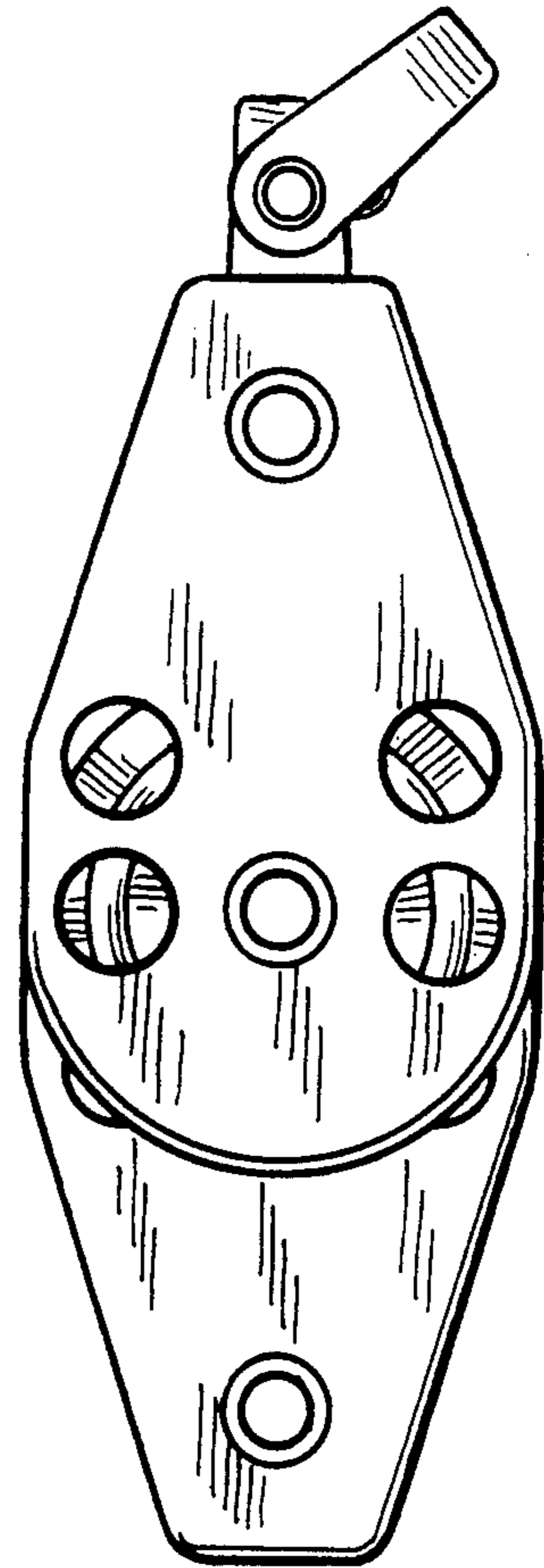

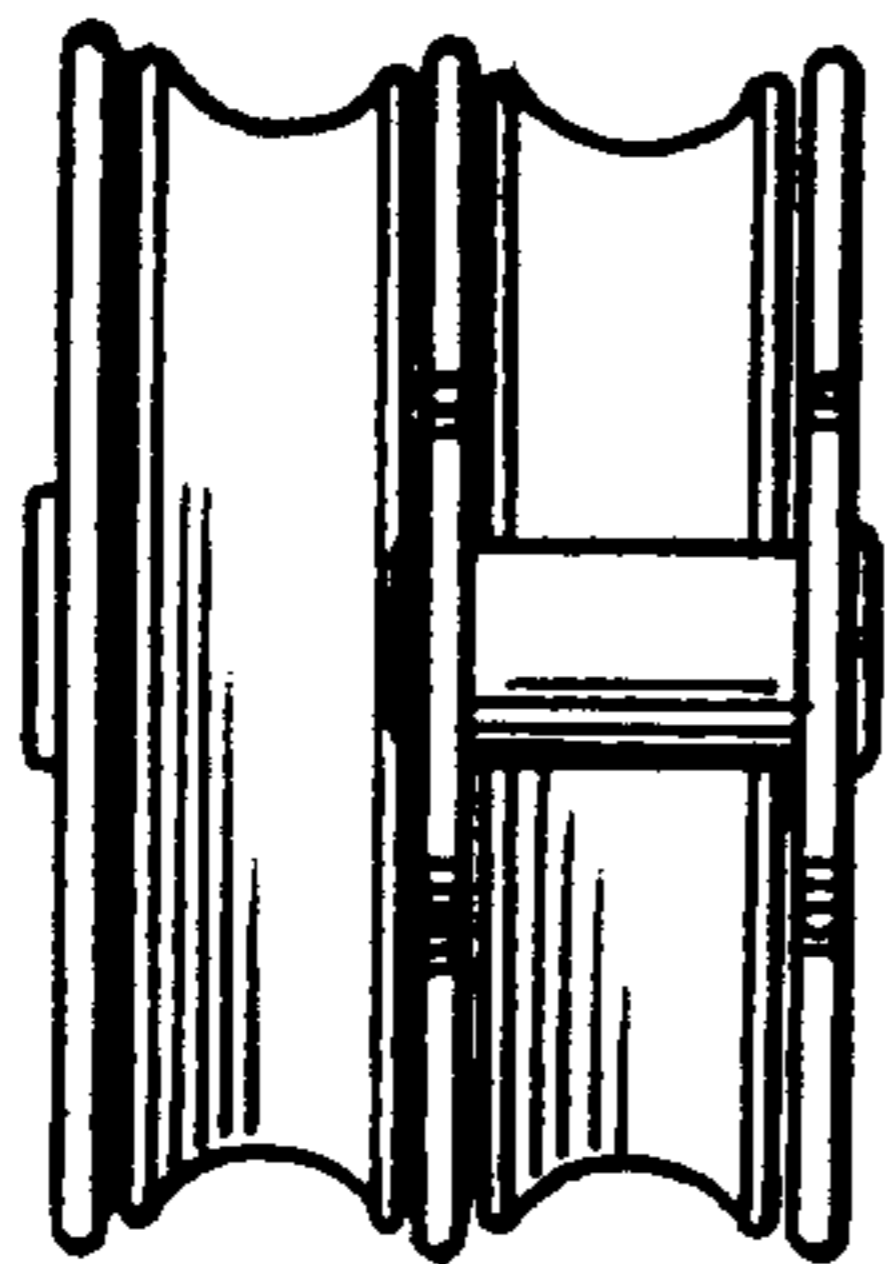

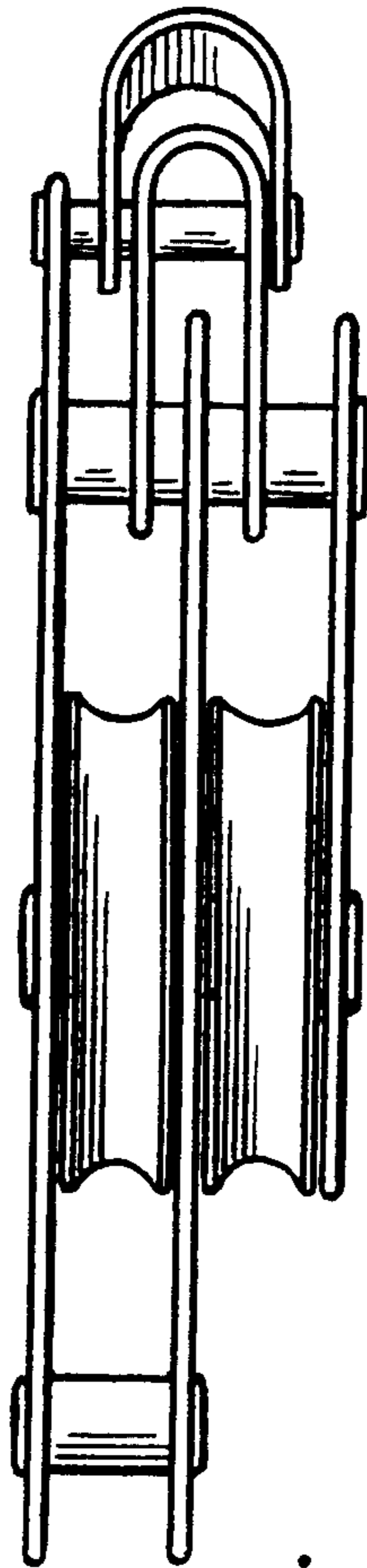

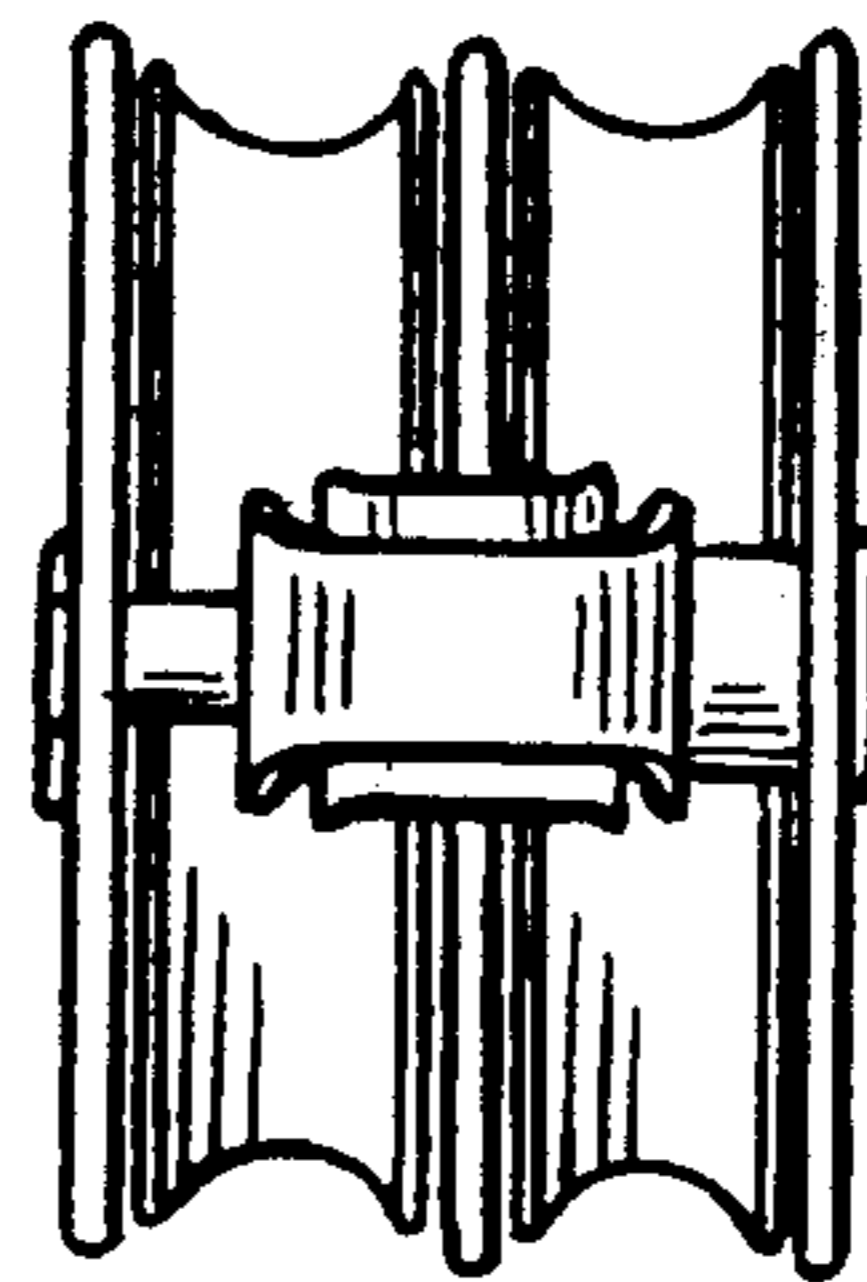
