FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

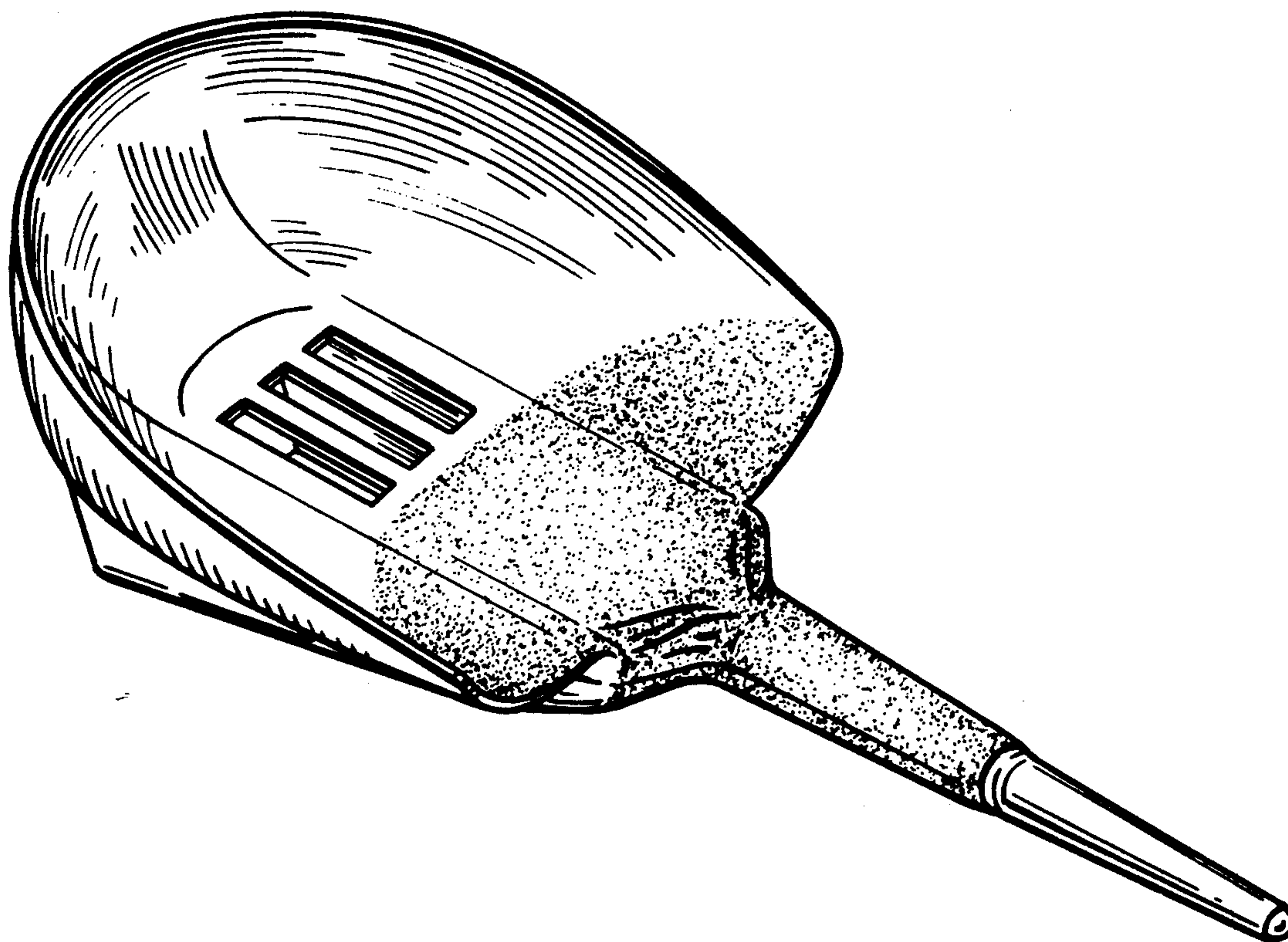
FIG. 4 is a side elevation thereof;

The side of the sheath which is undisclosed is a mirror image of the side which is shown.



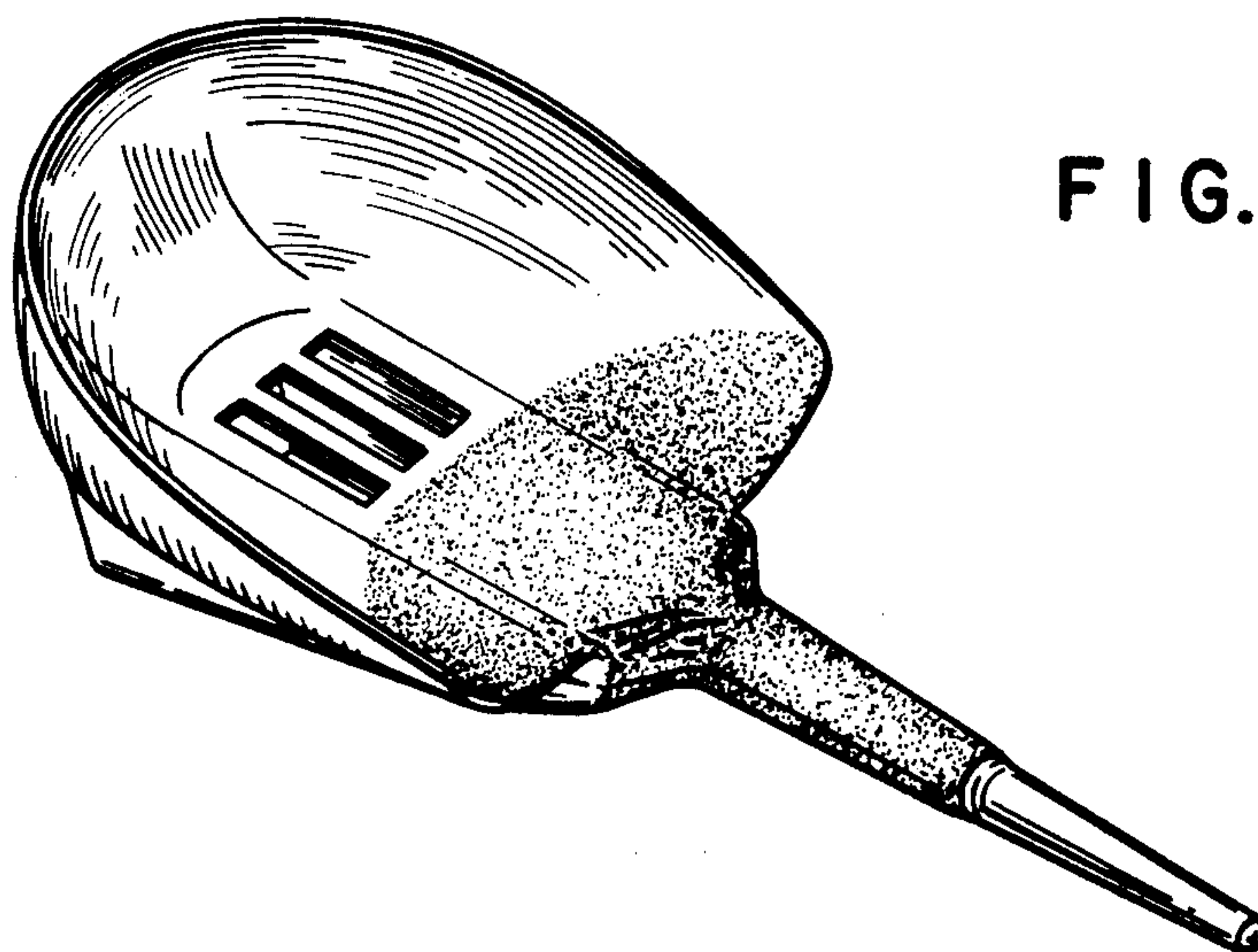

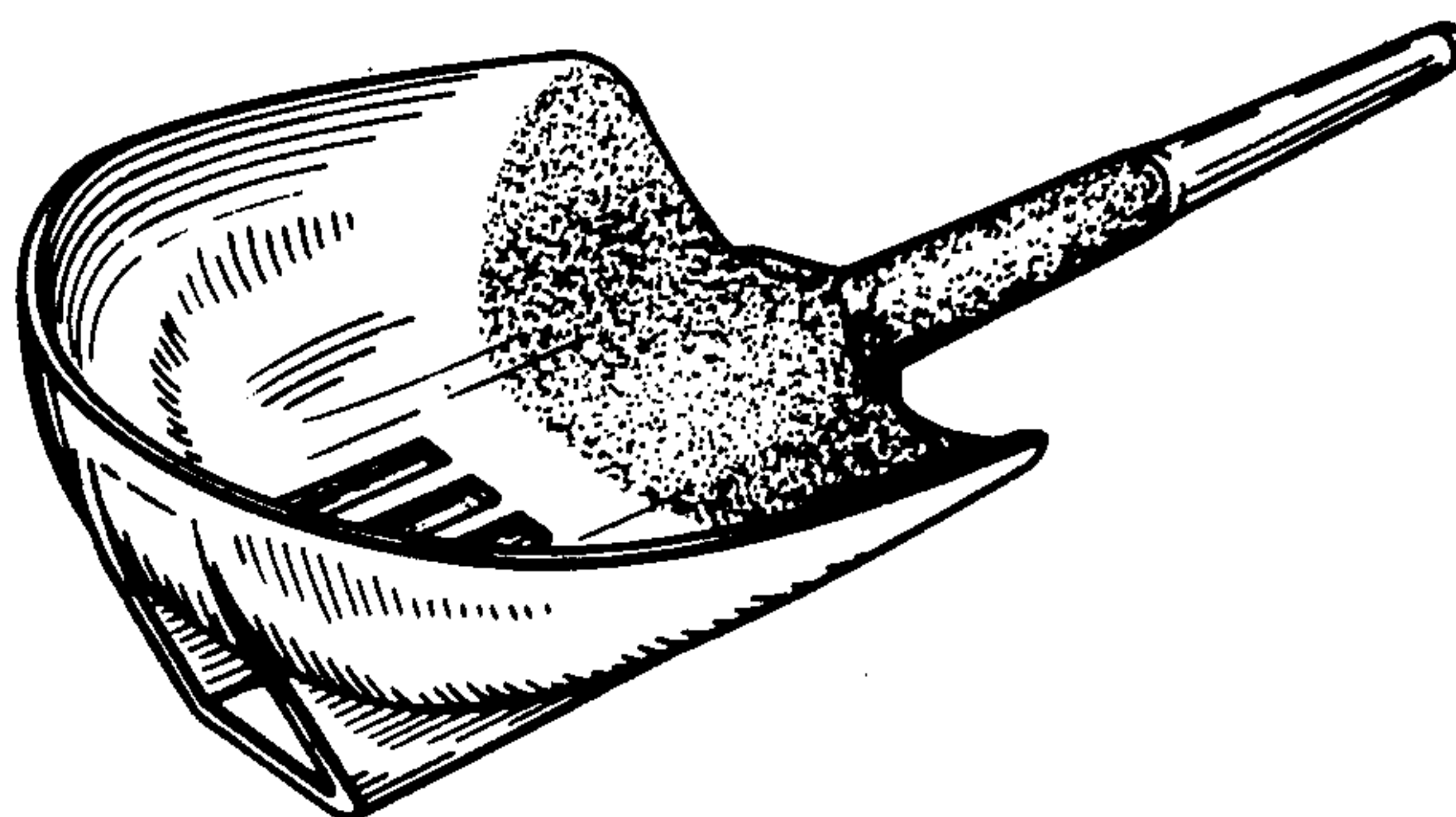

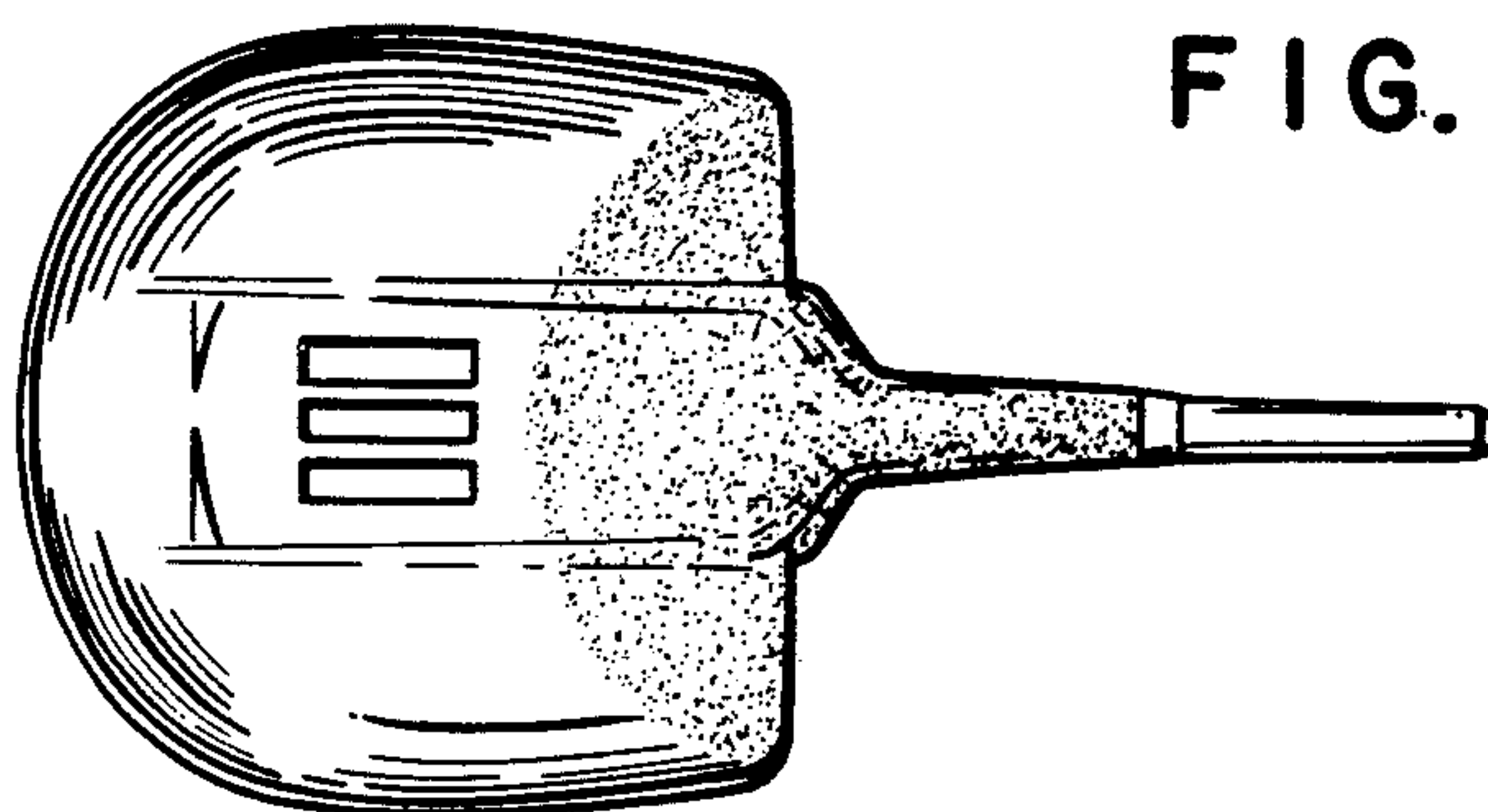

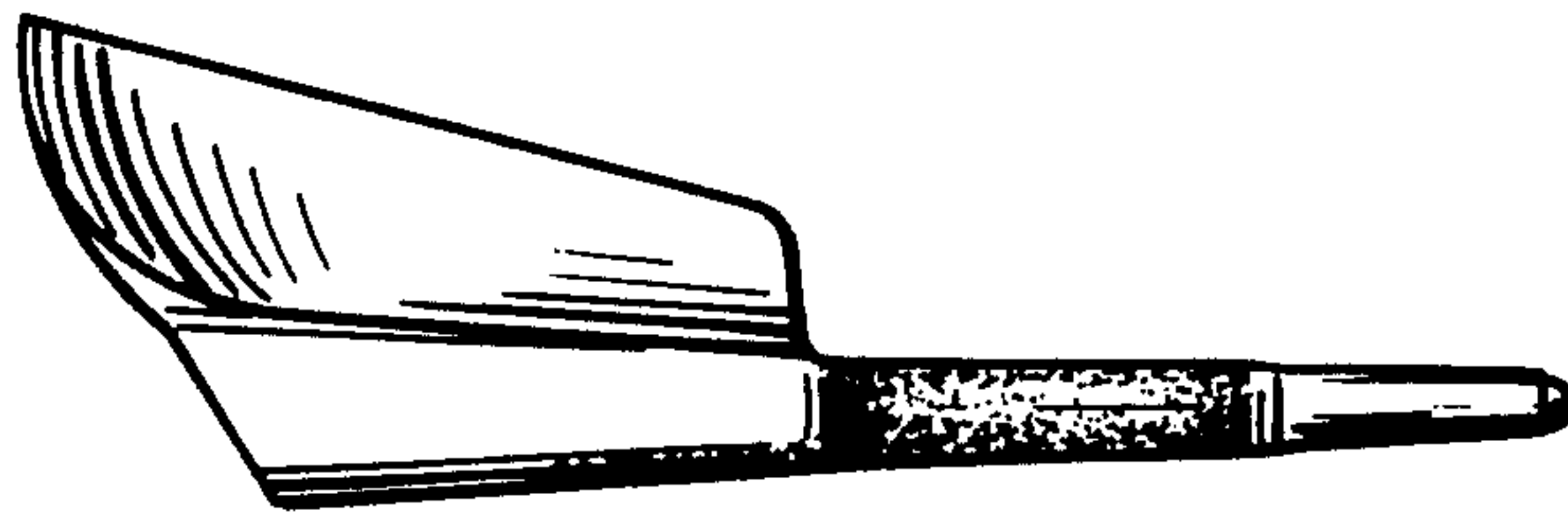

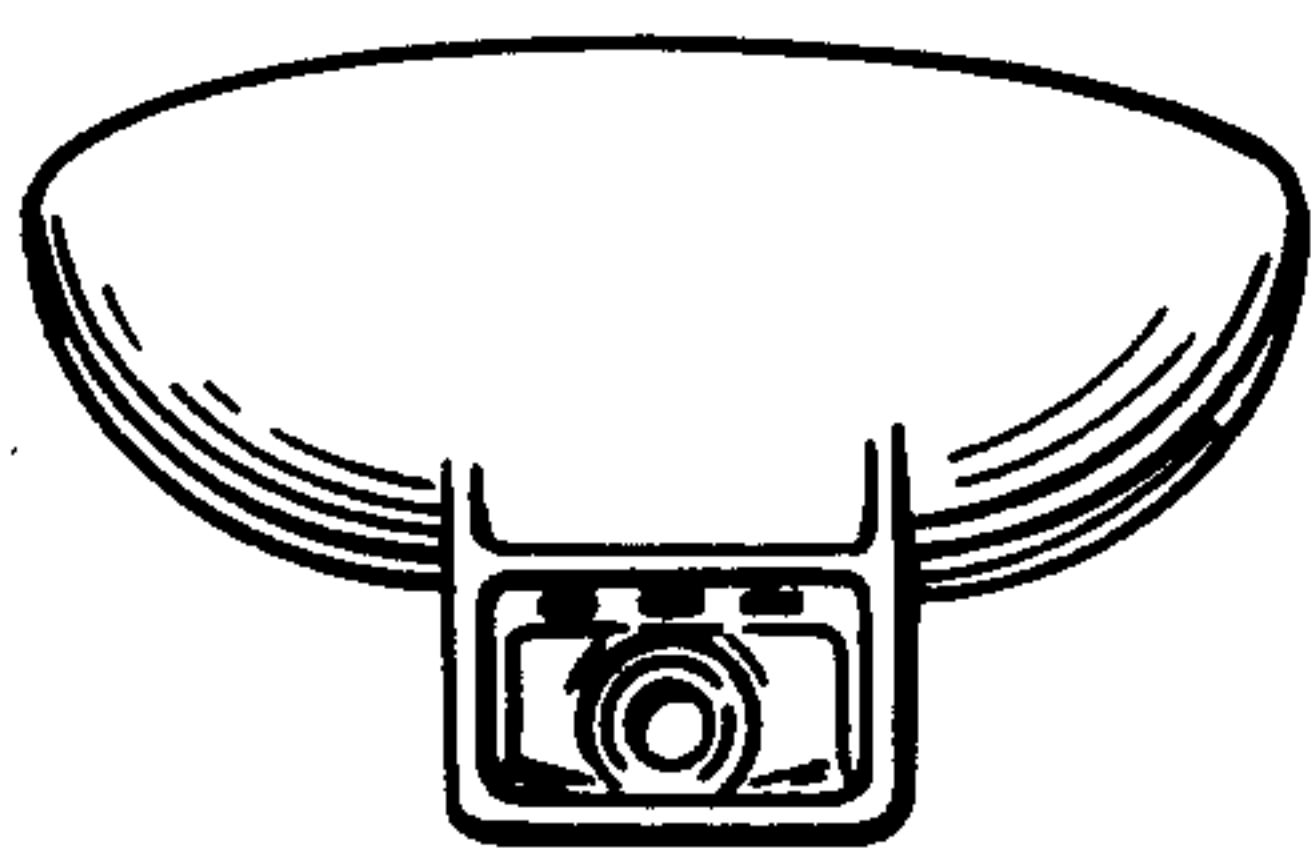
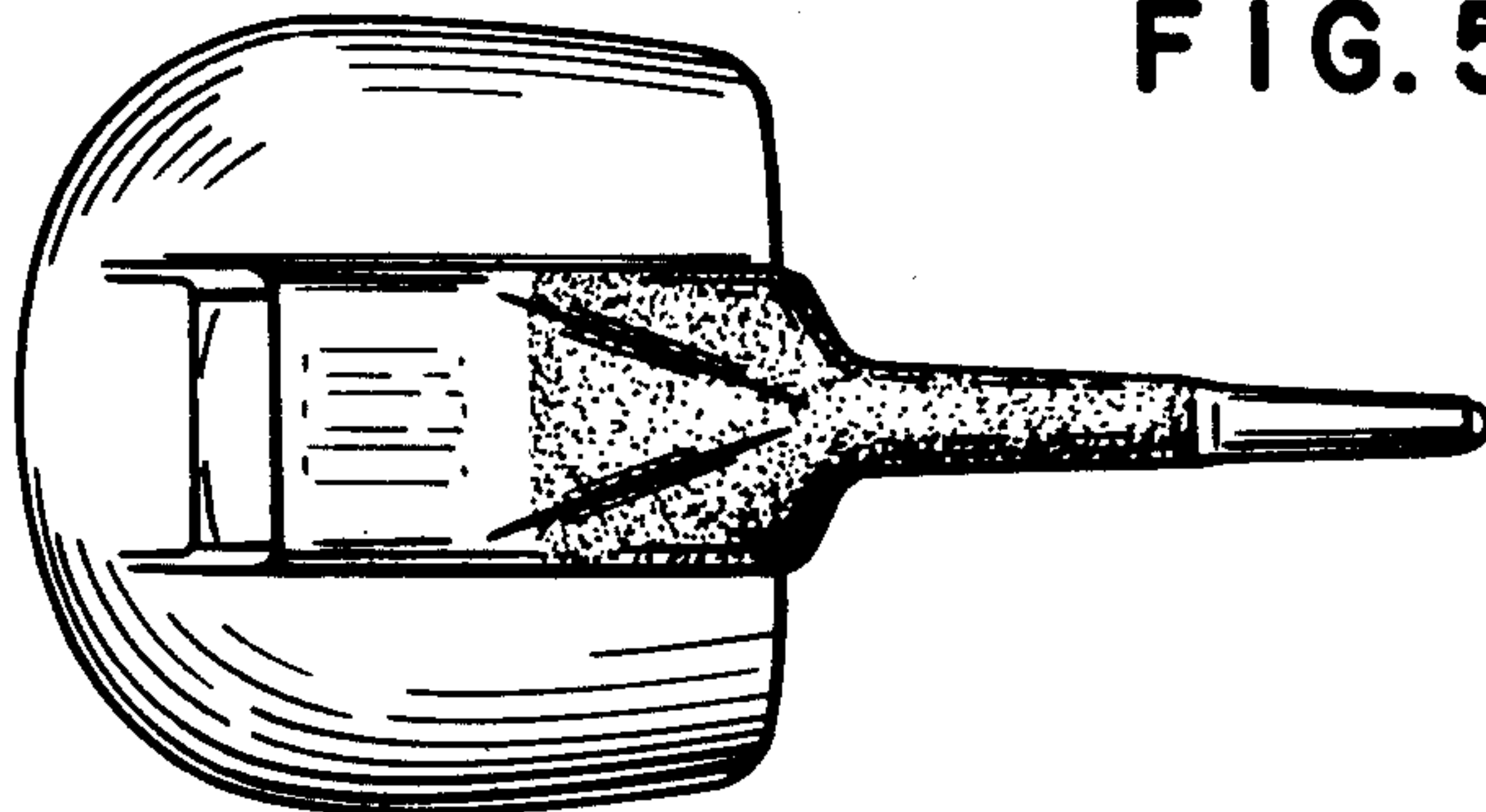
