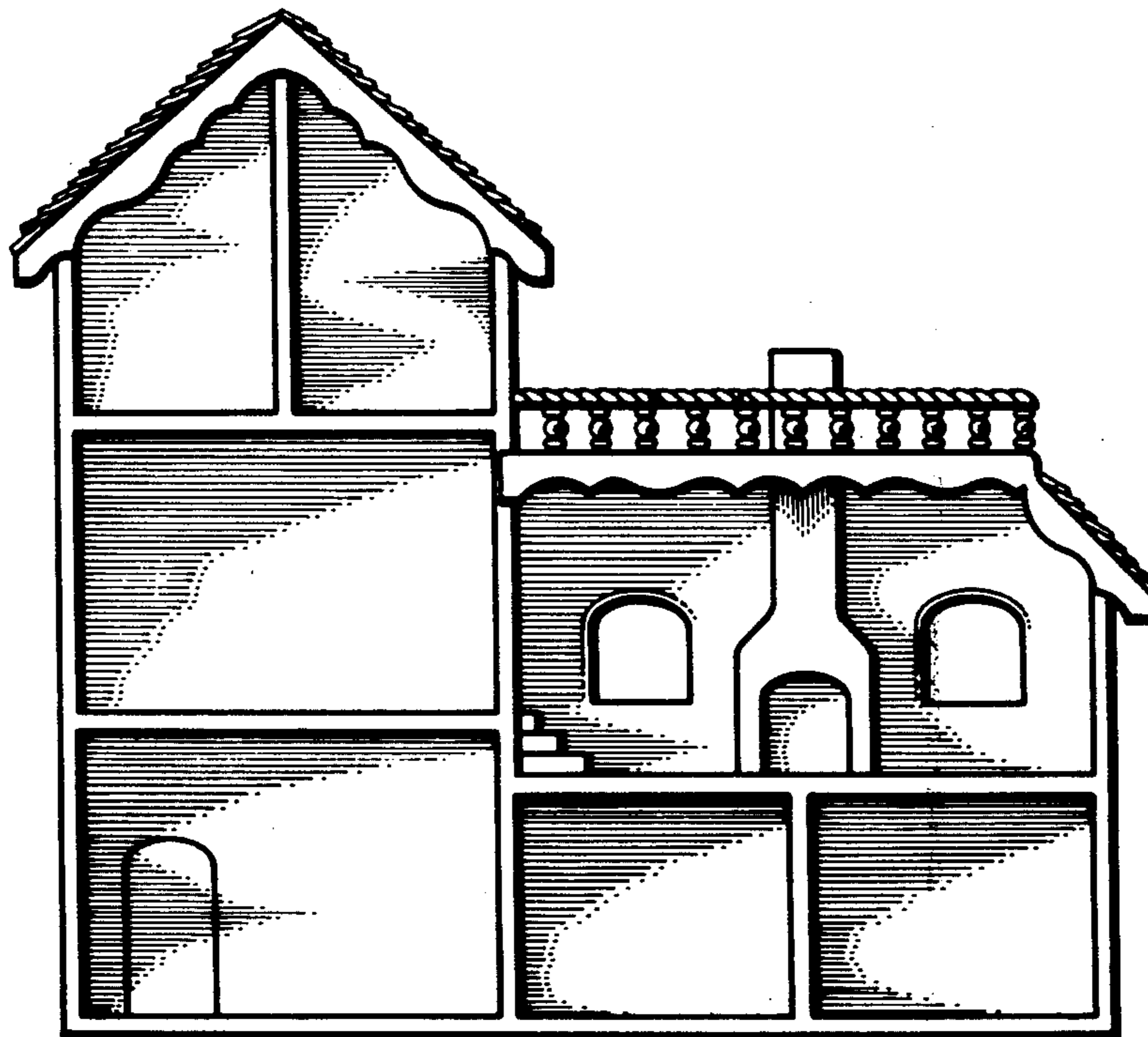

 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 4.



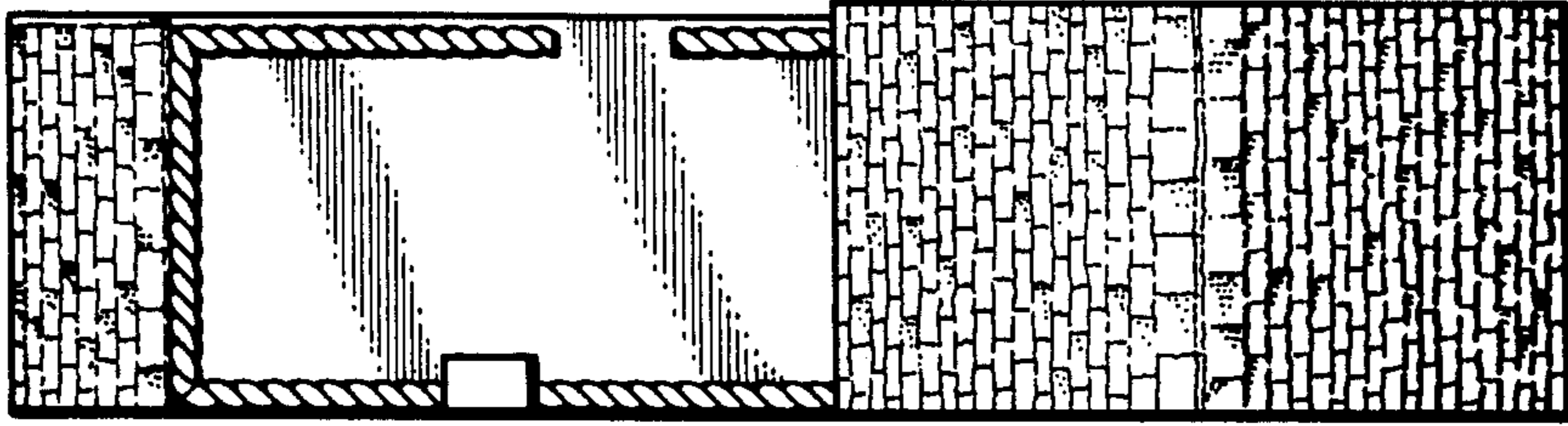

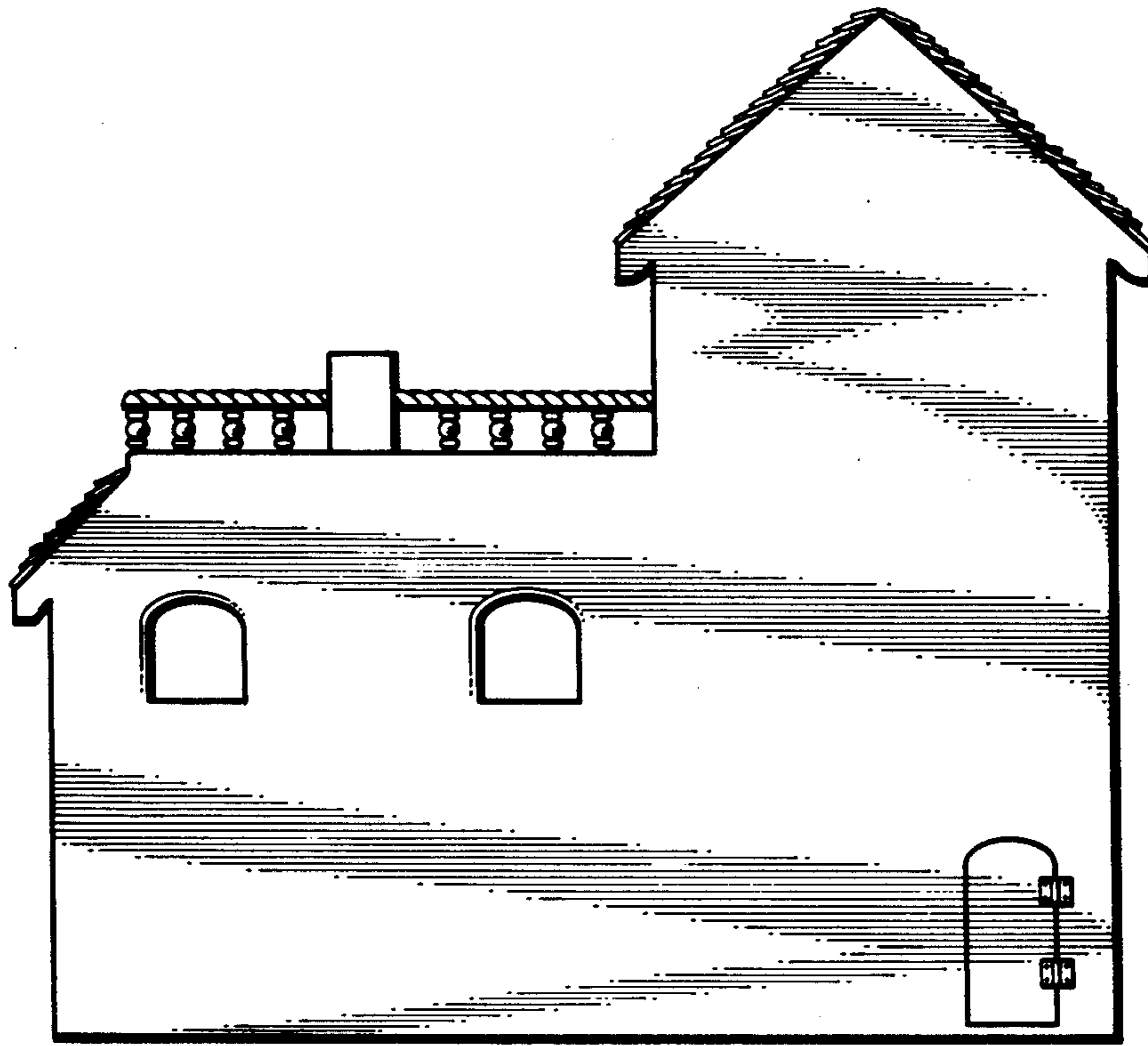

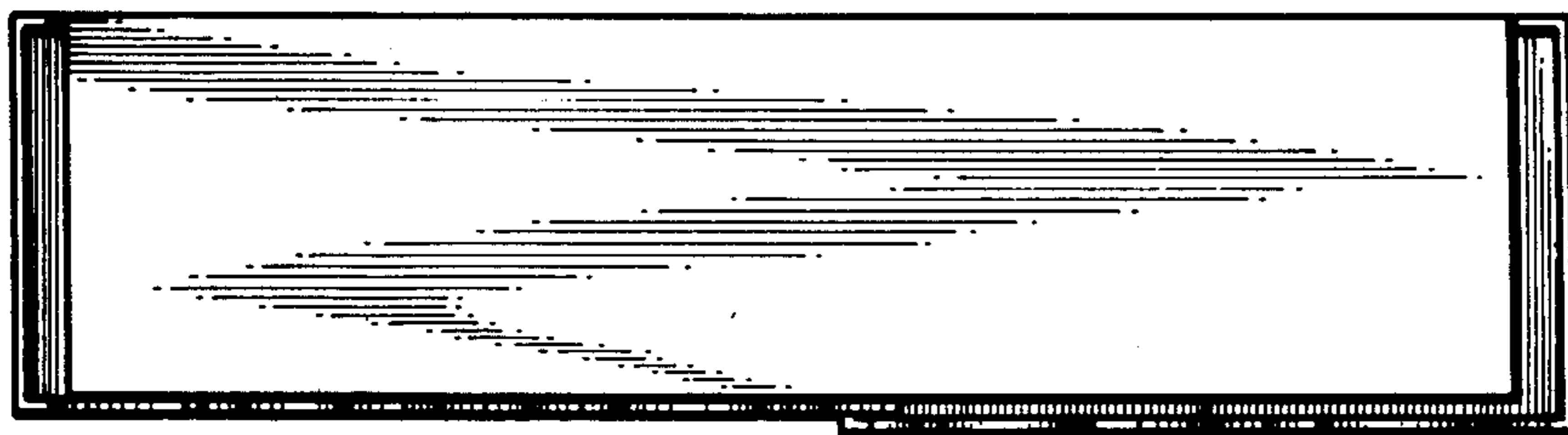

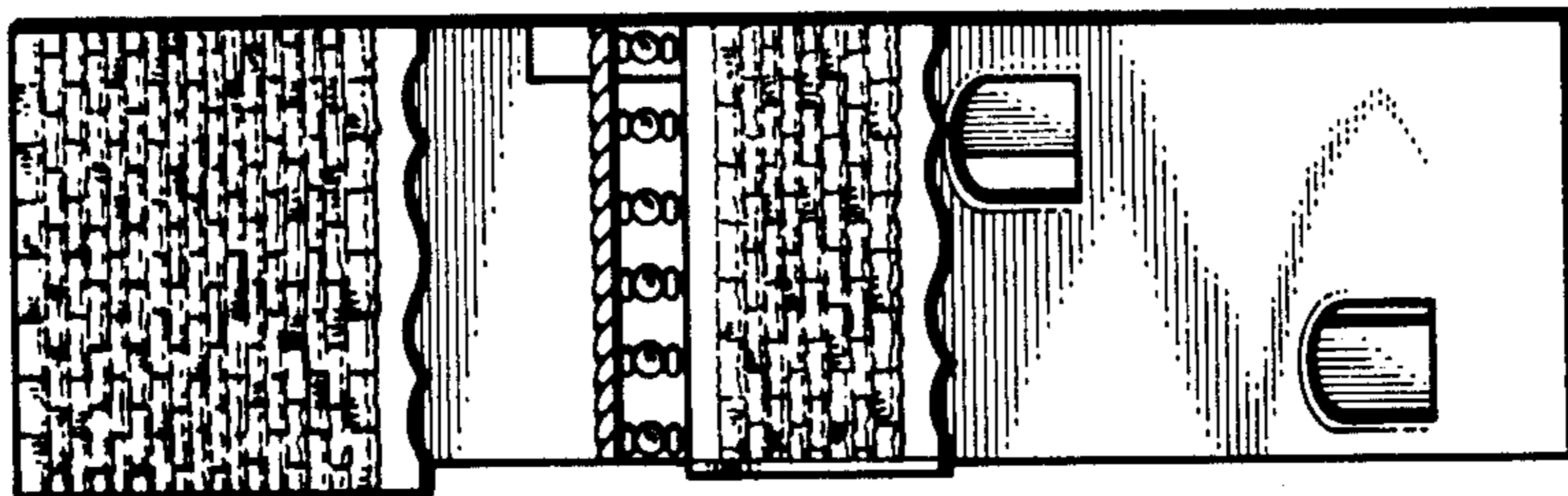

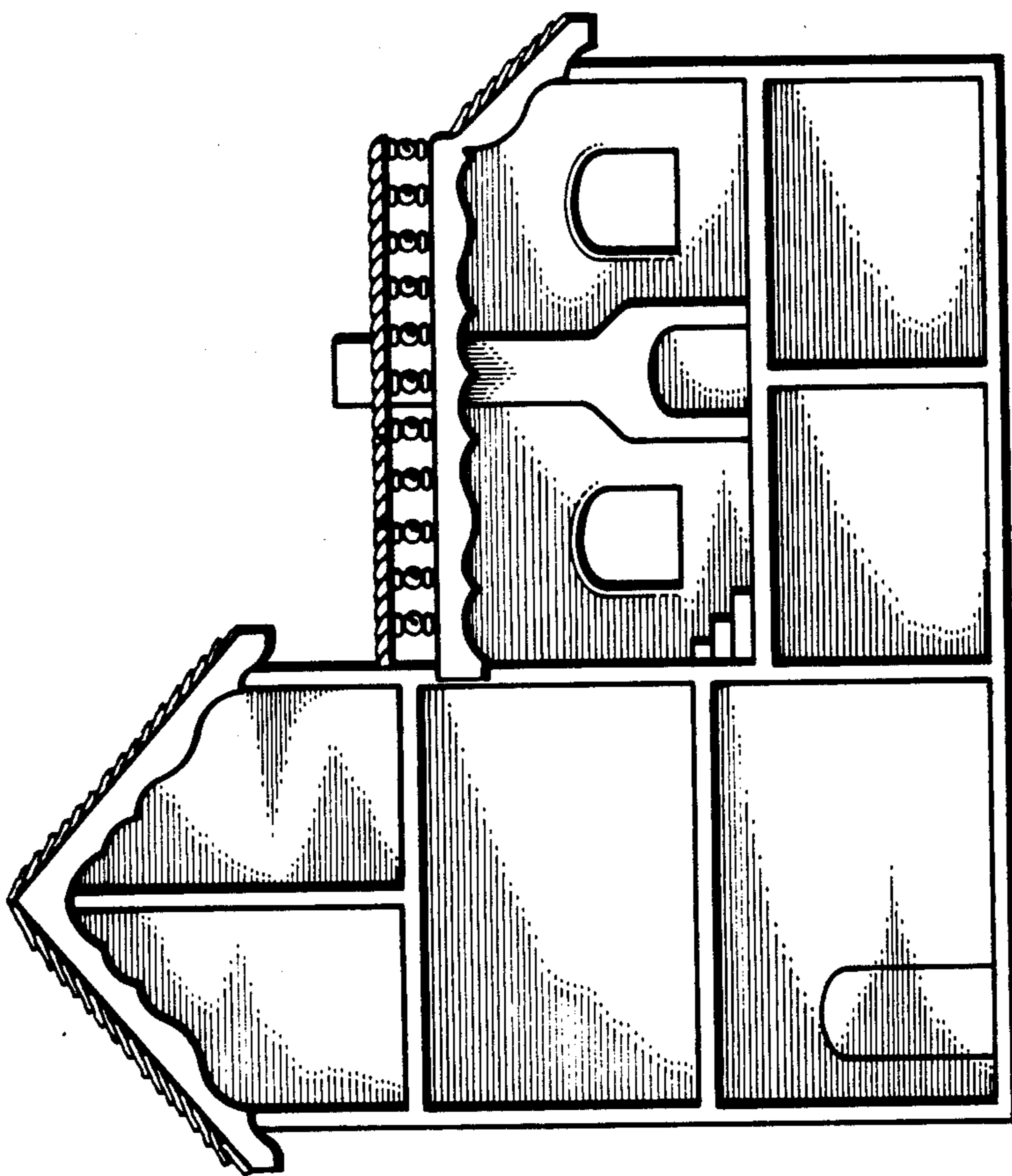

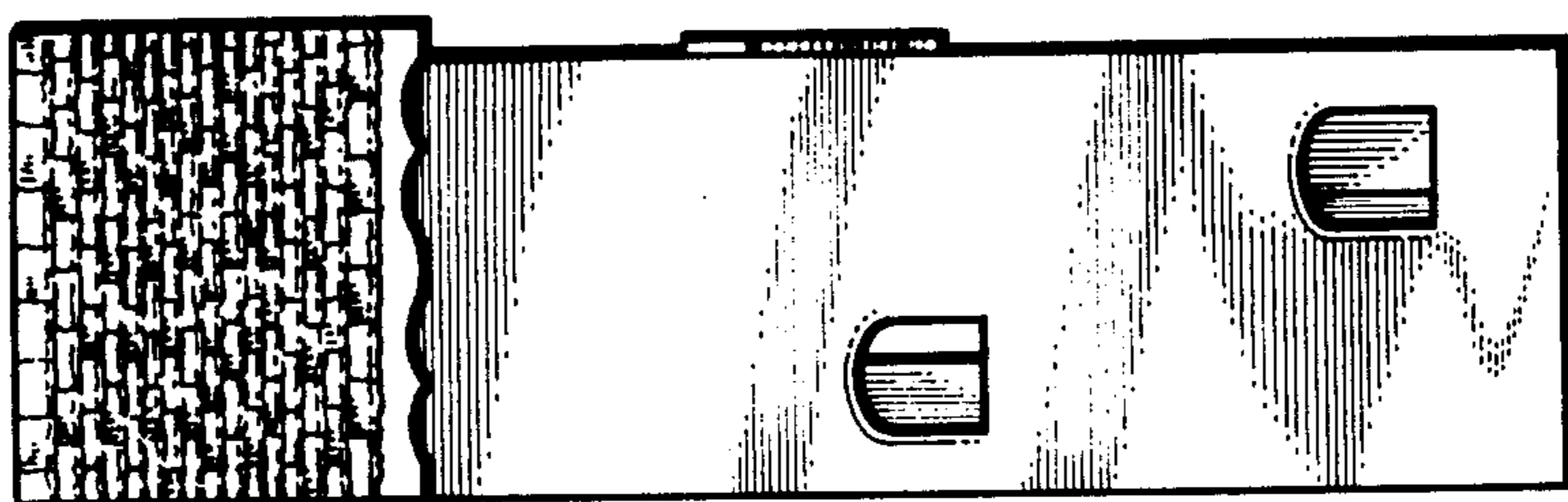
