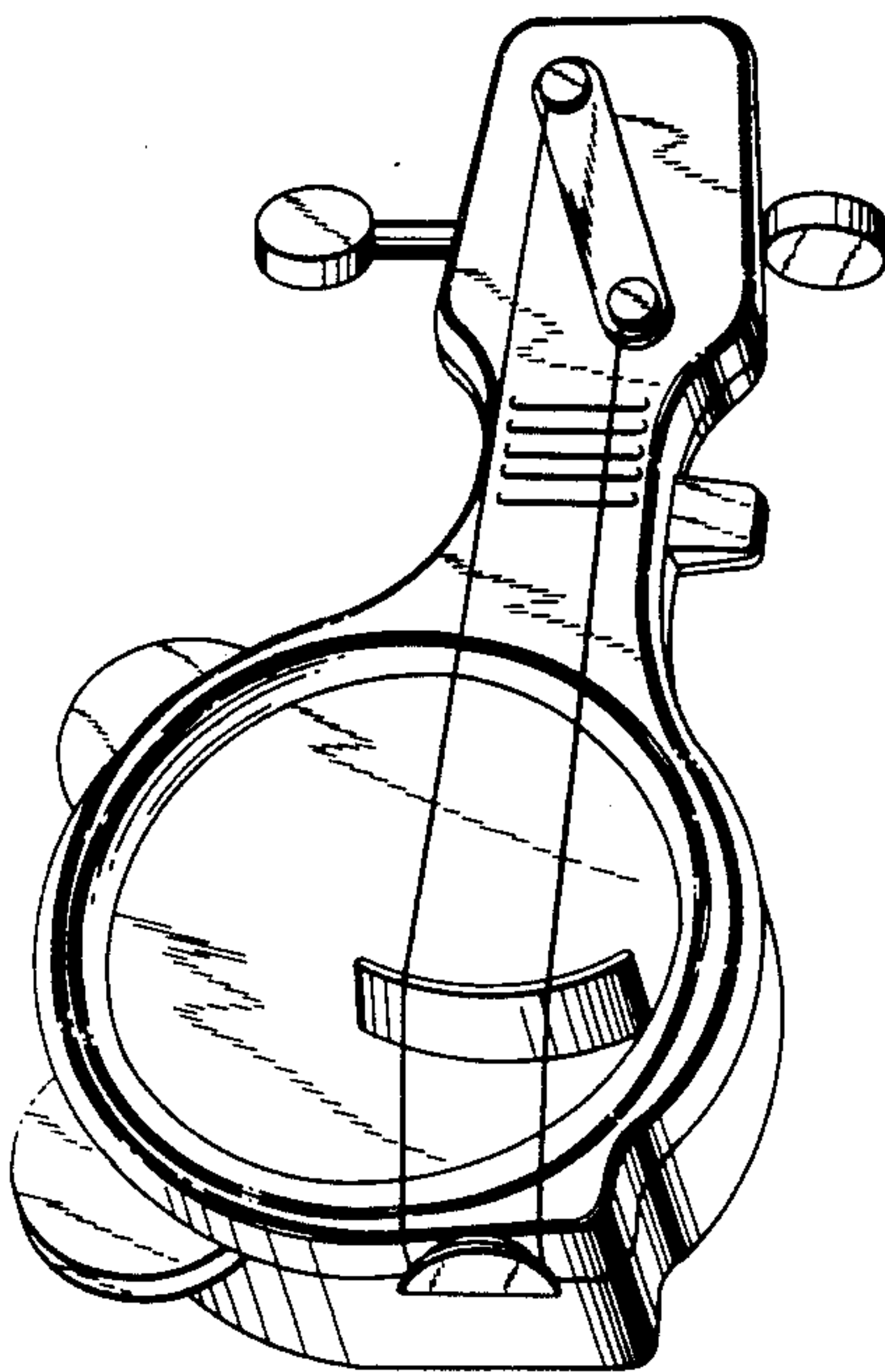

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy musical instrument, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

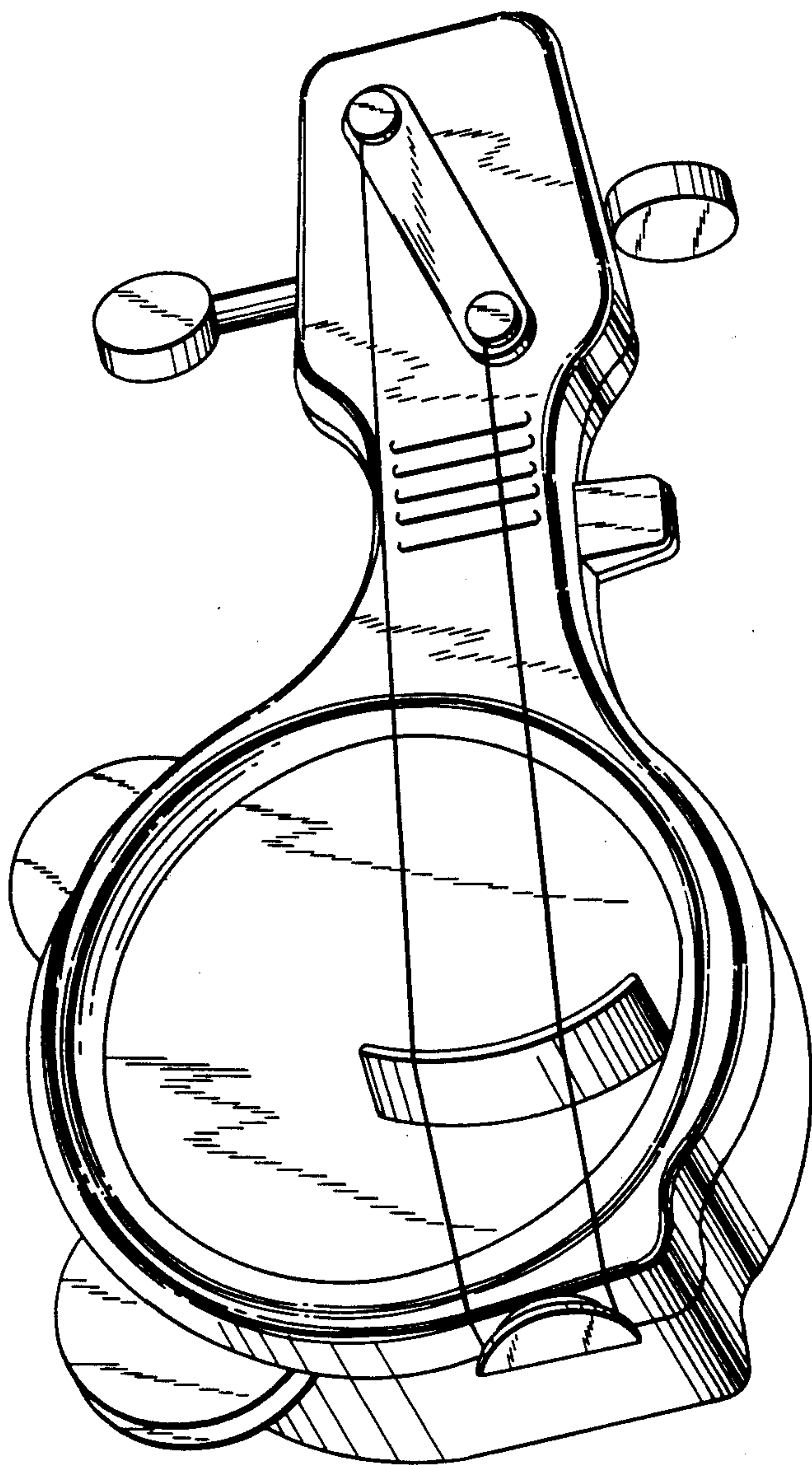

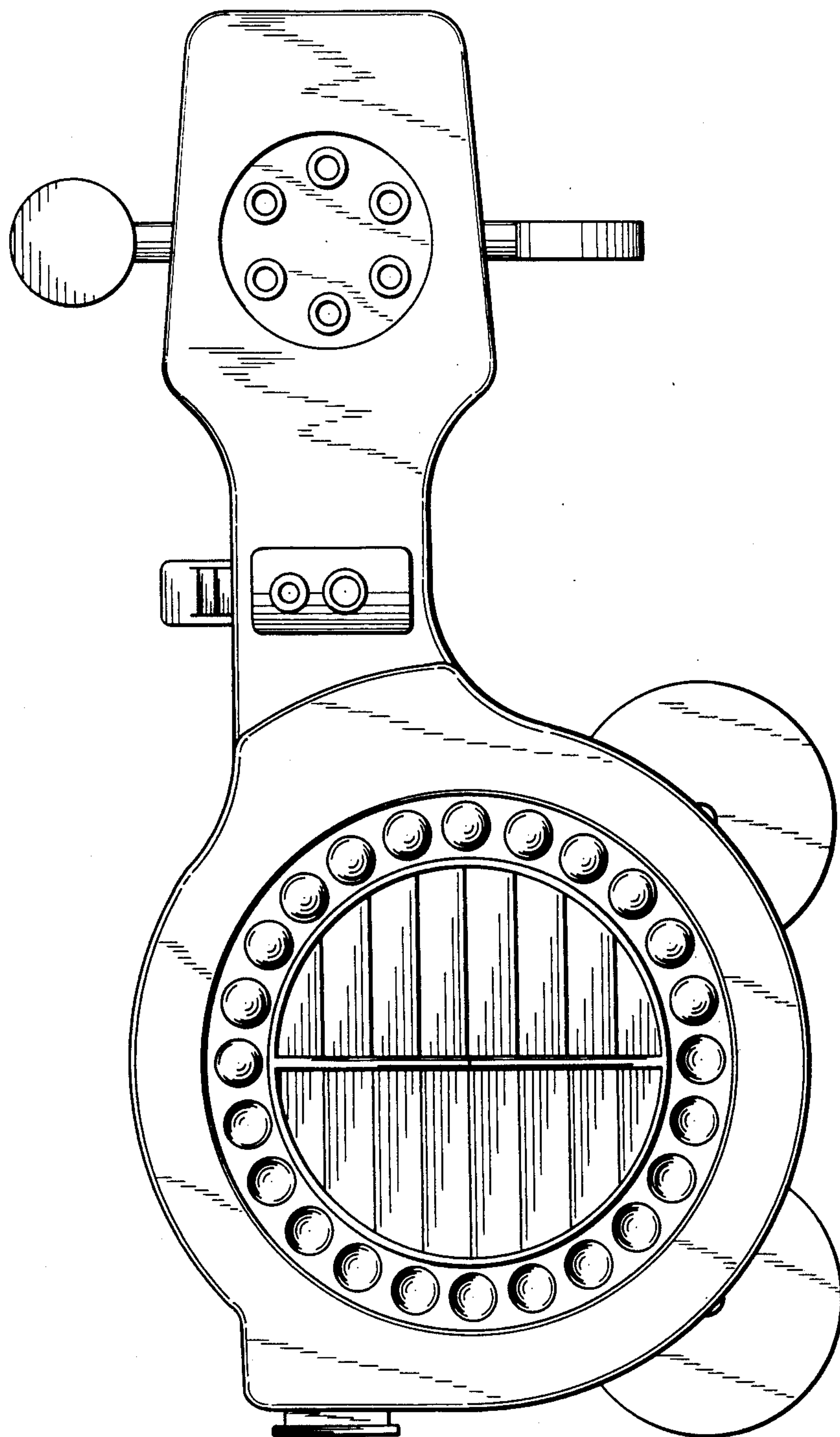

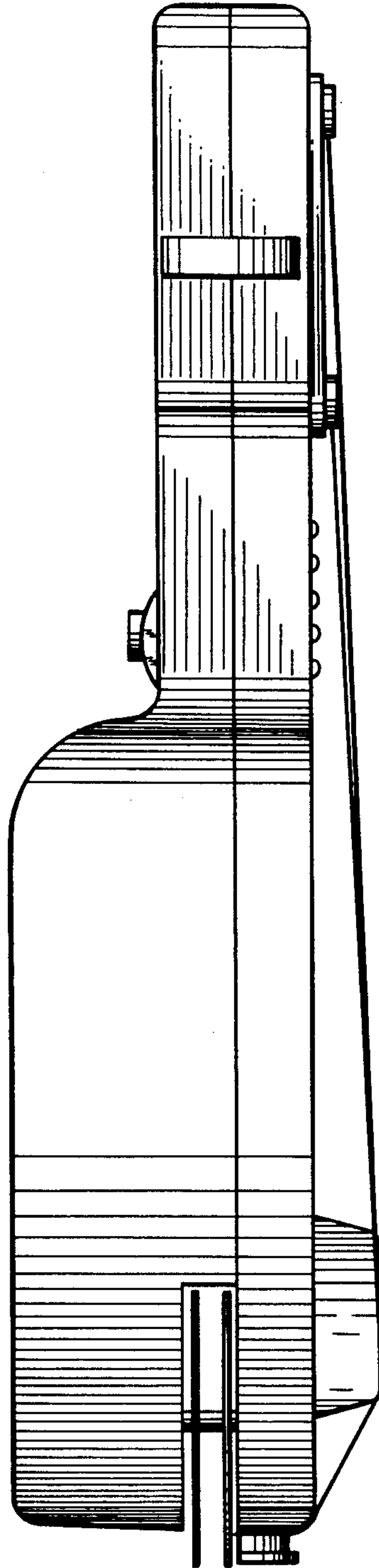

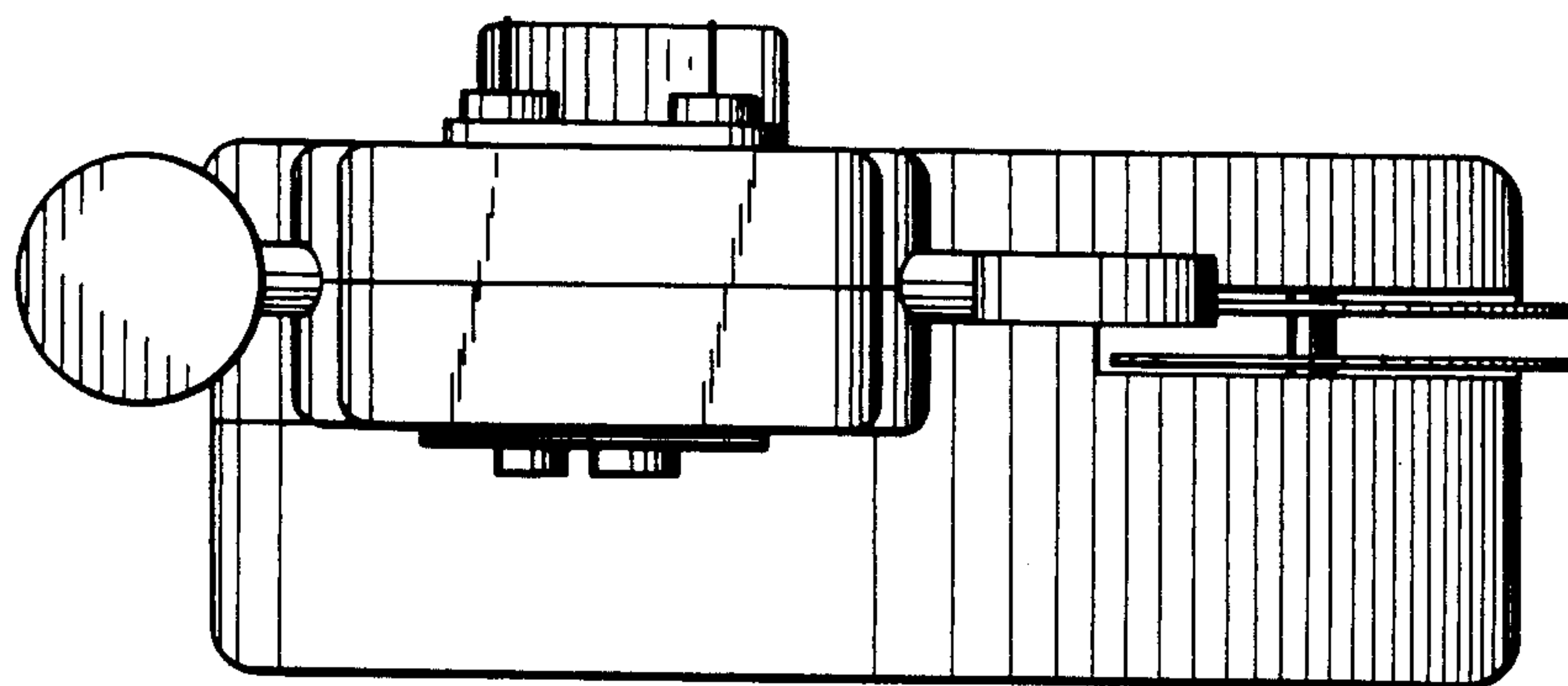
