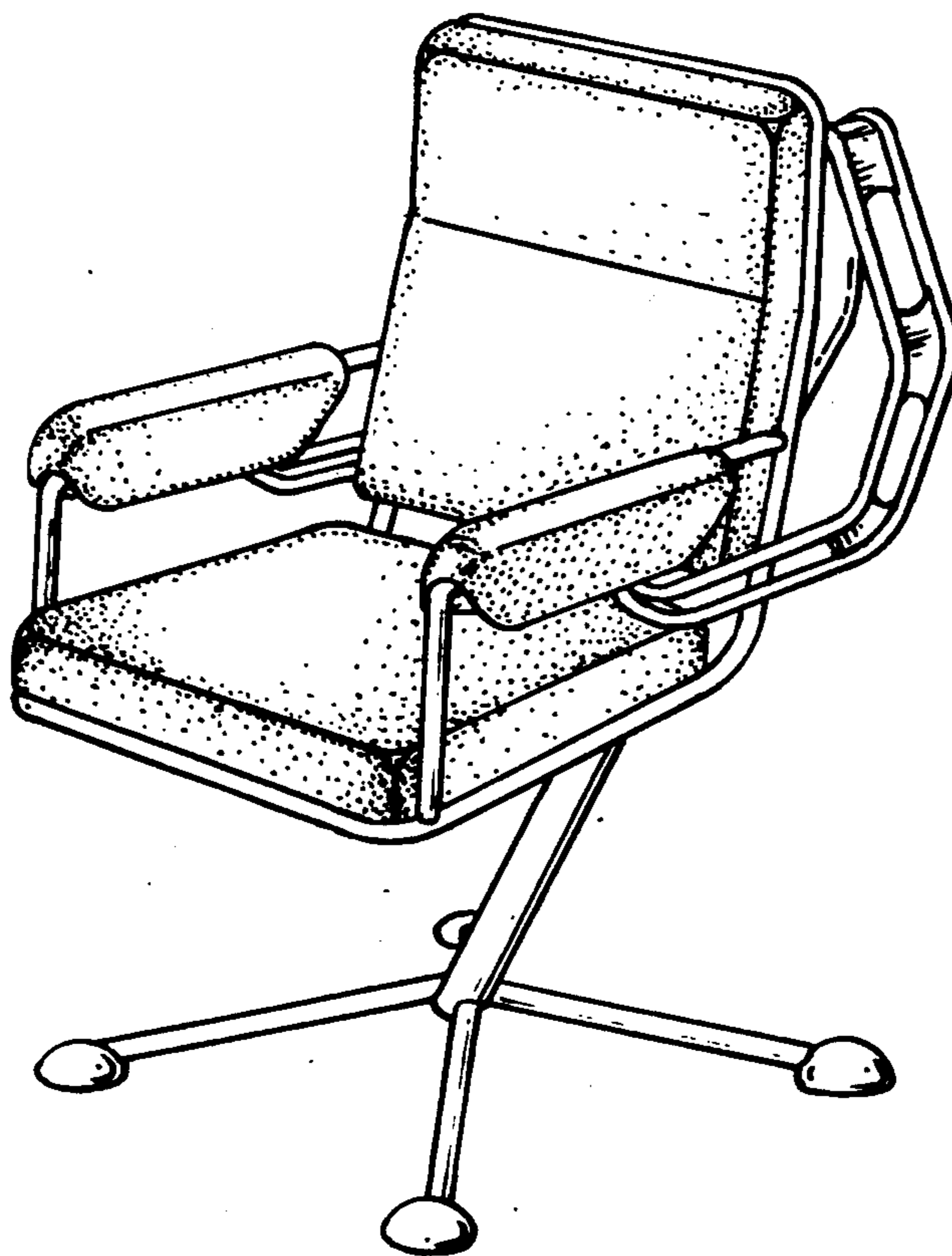

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.



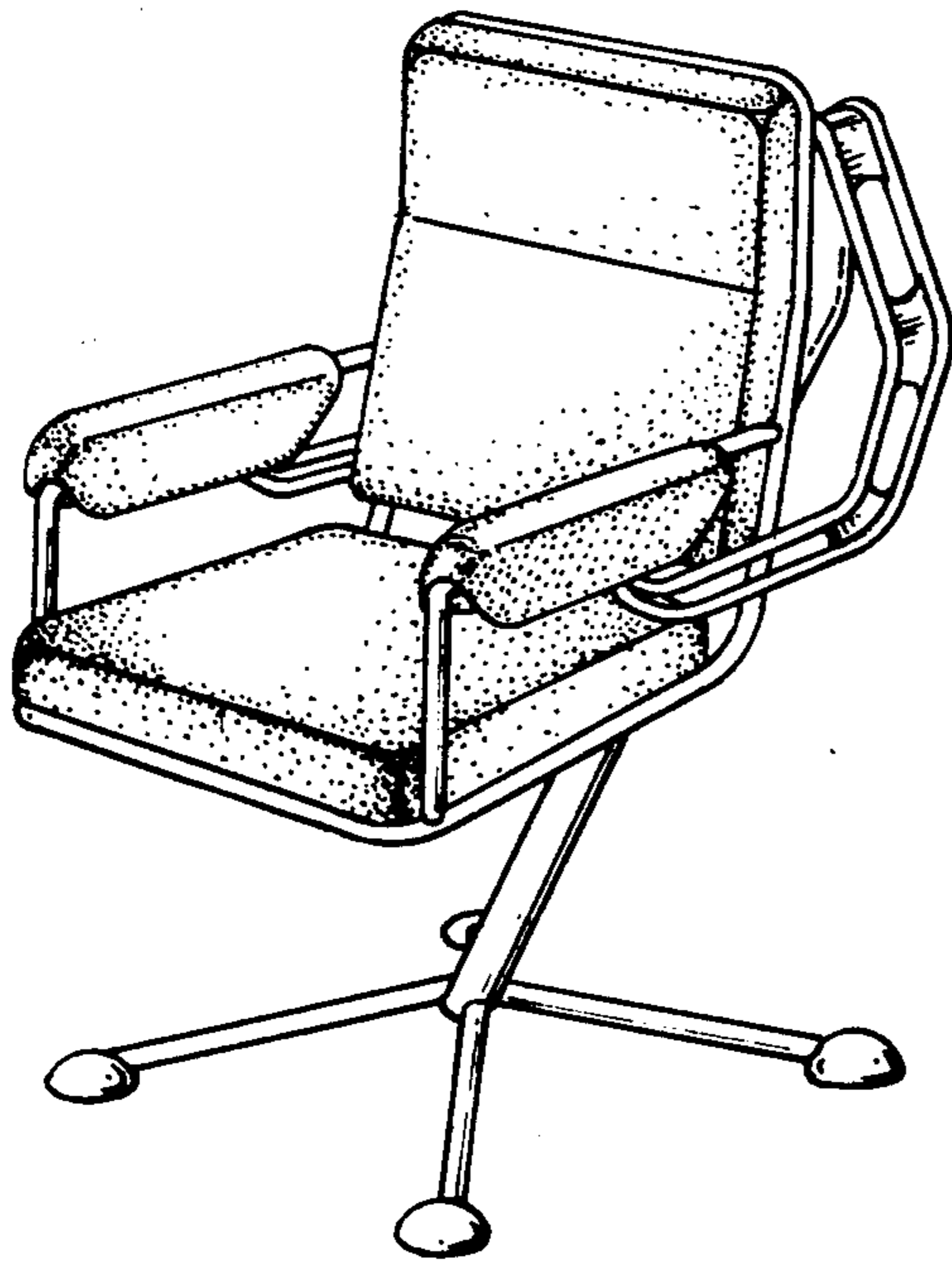

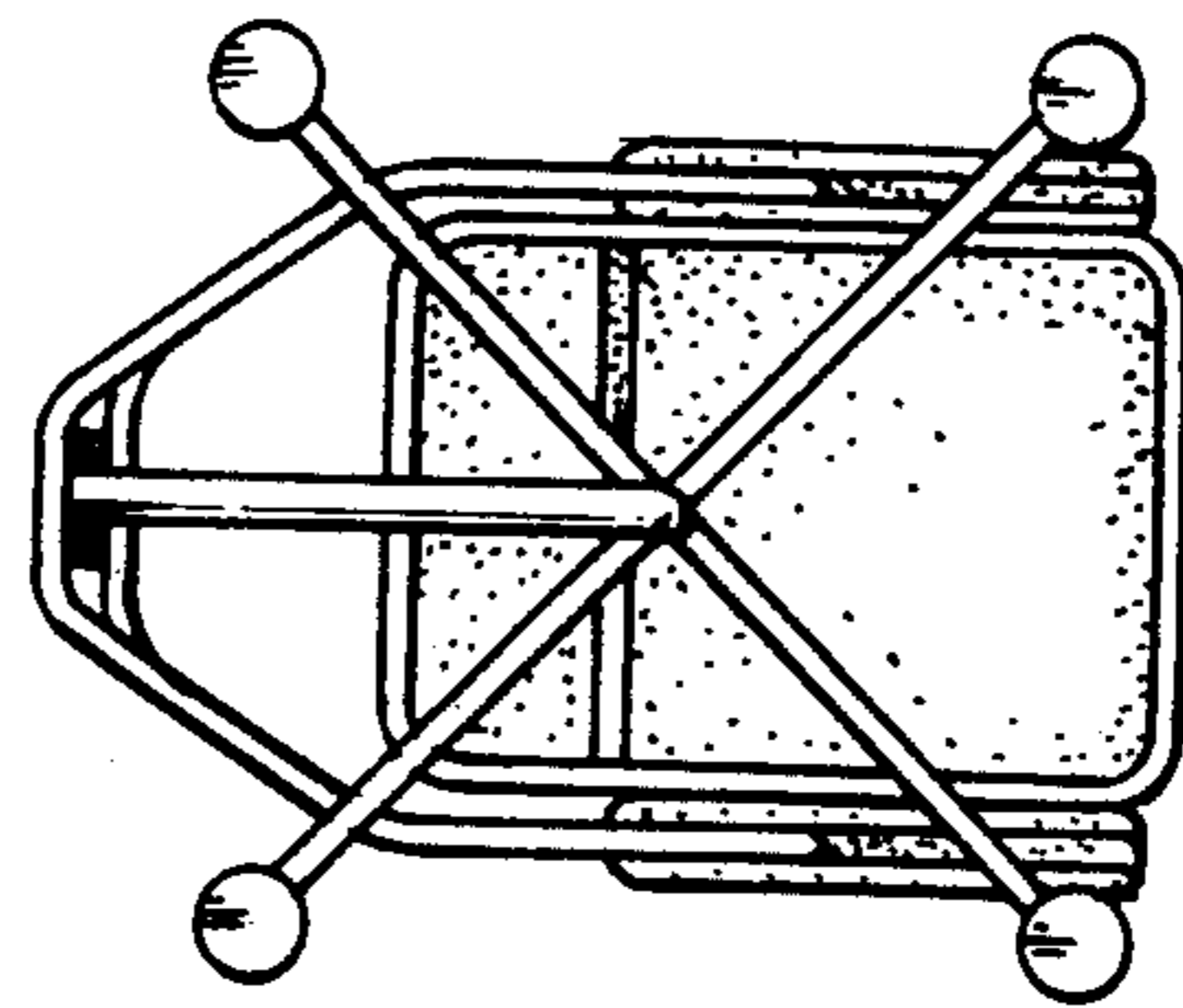

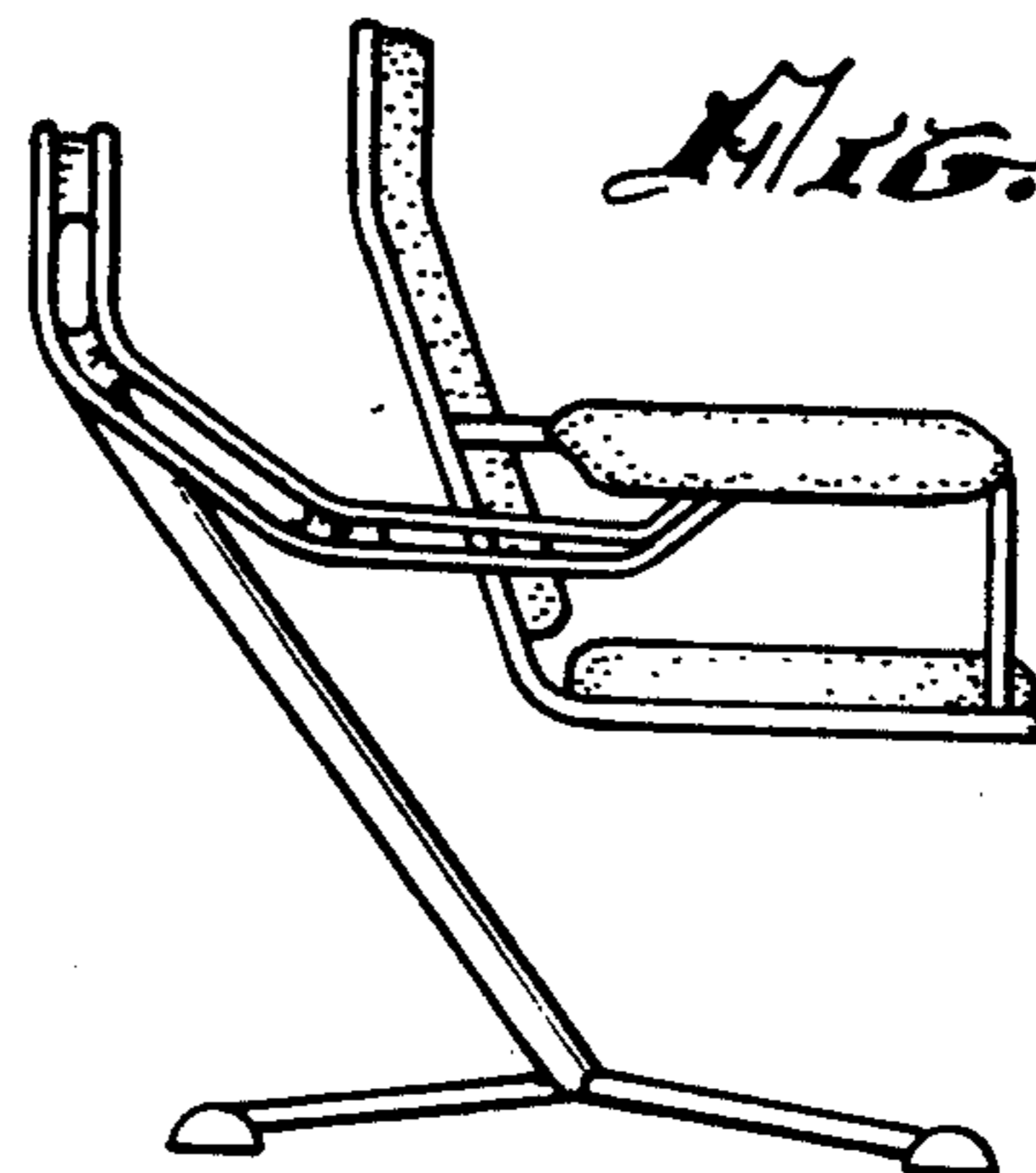
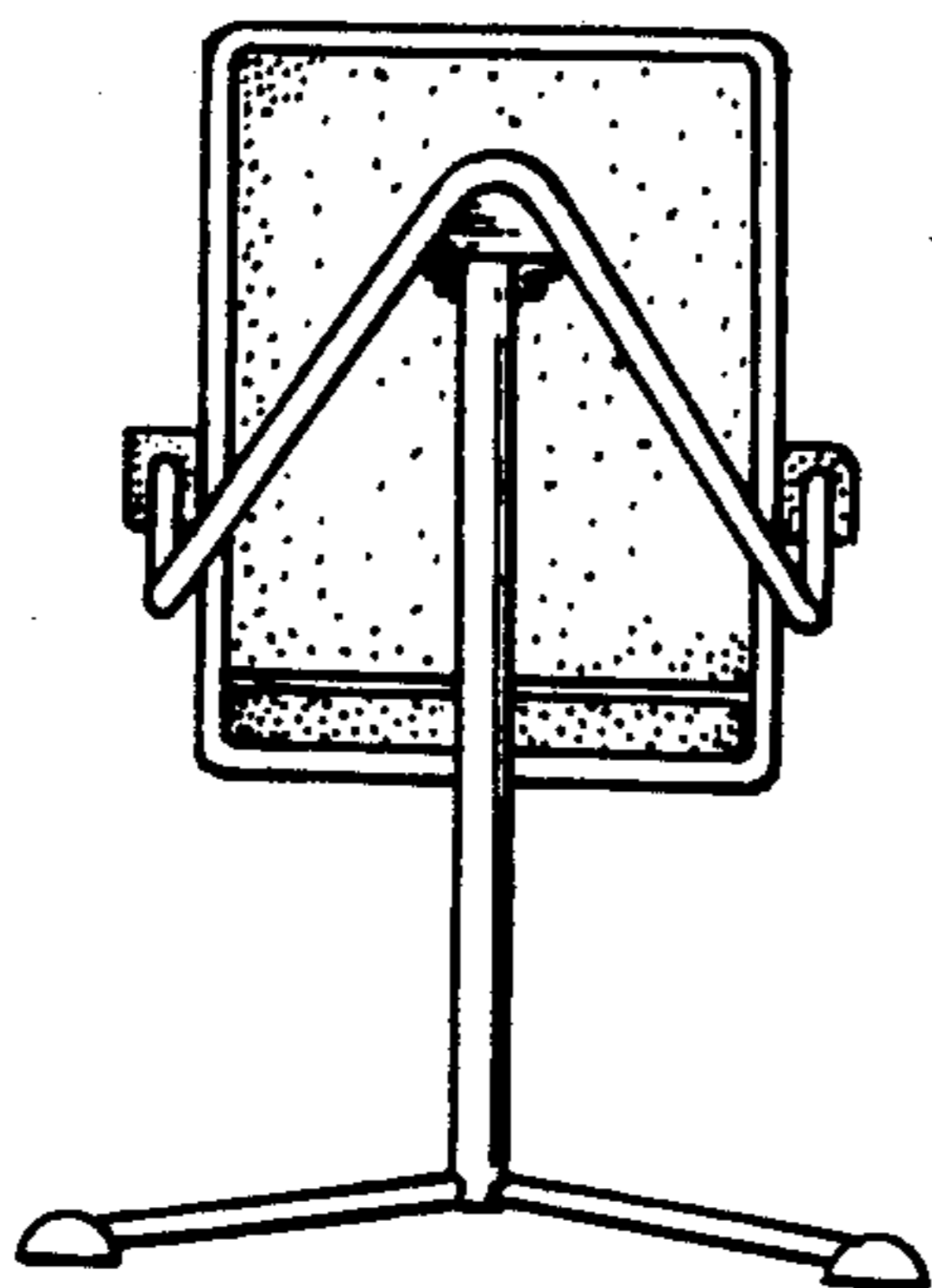
