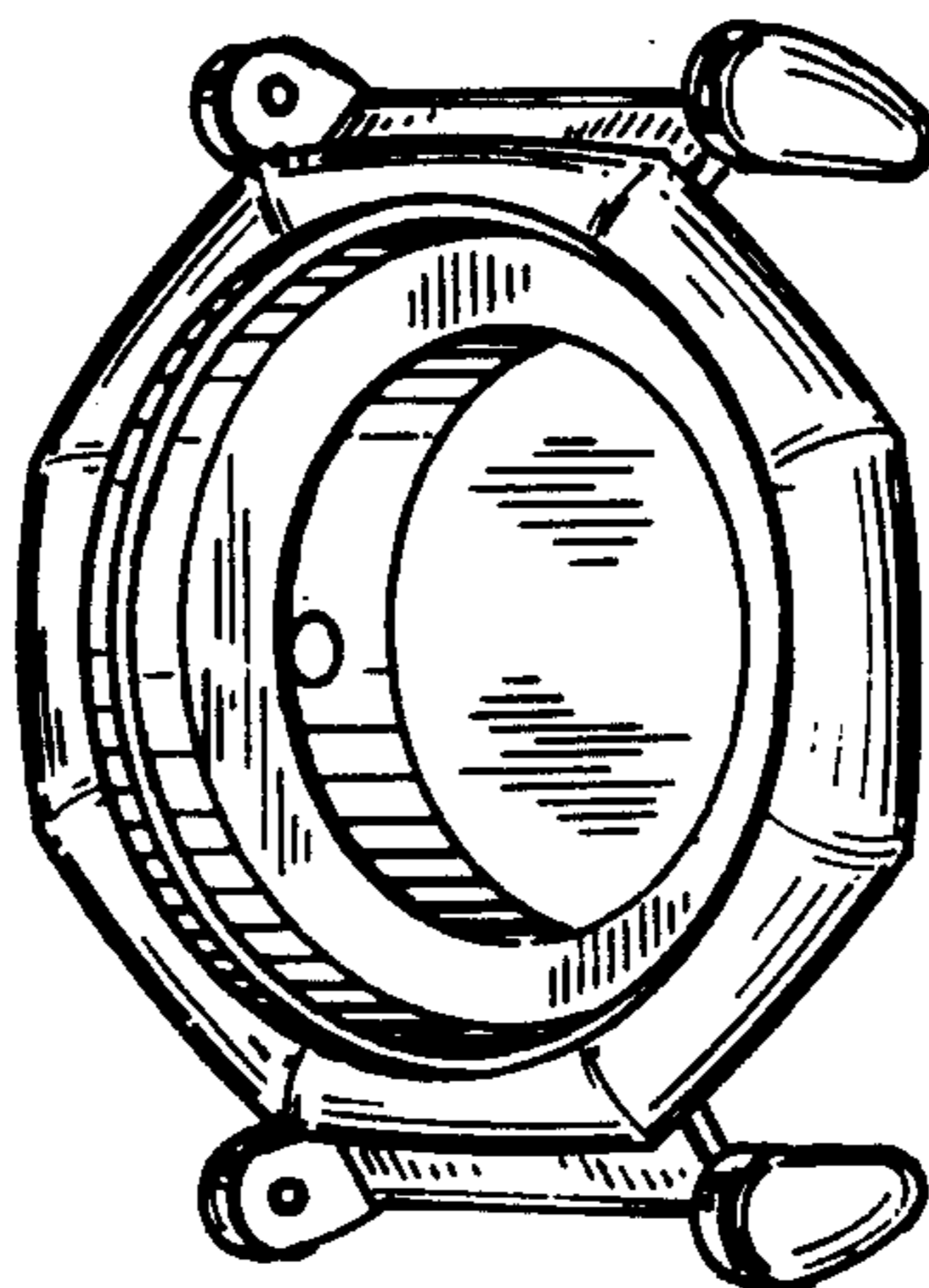

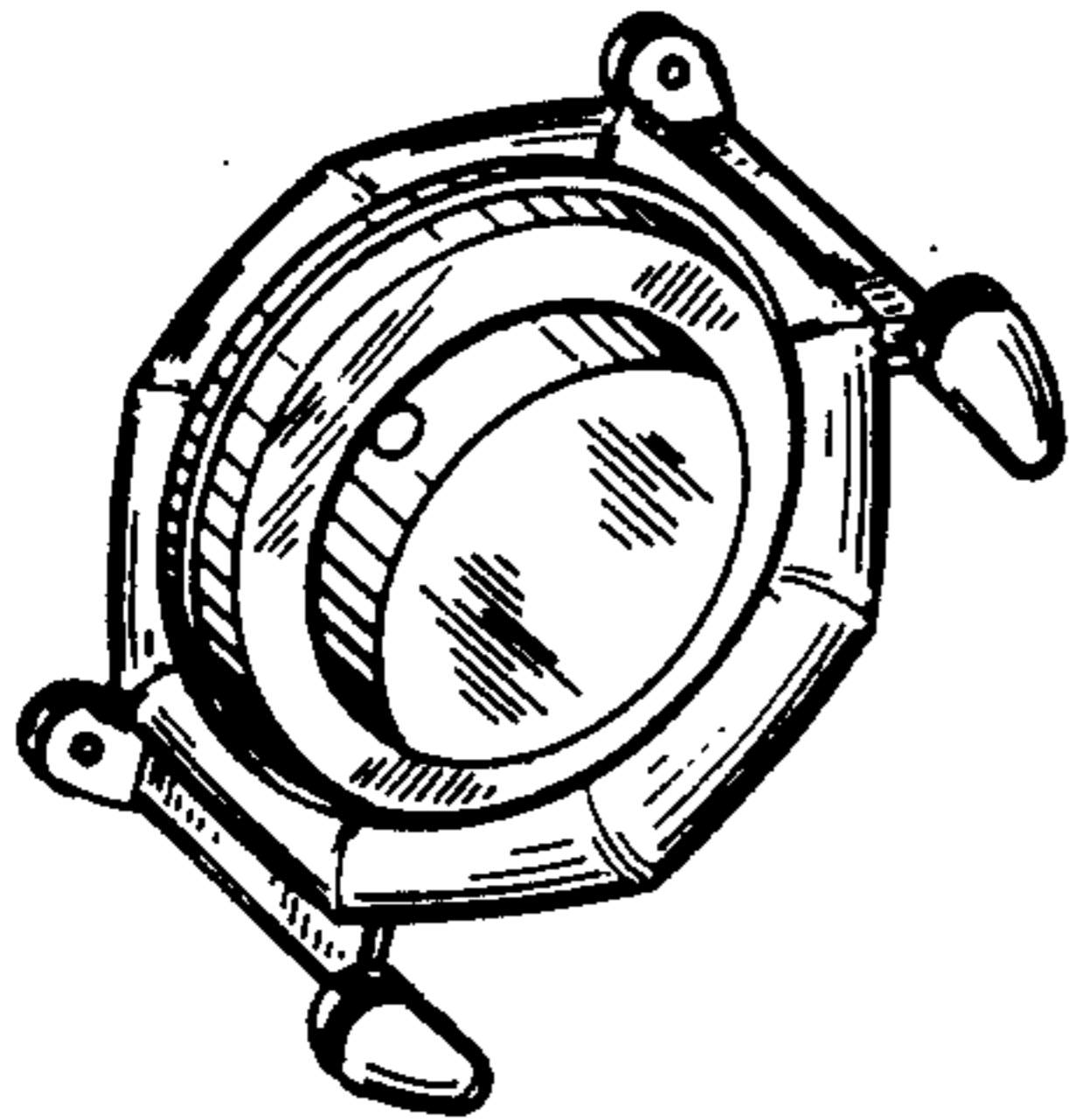
The ornamental design for a wristwatch case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

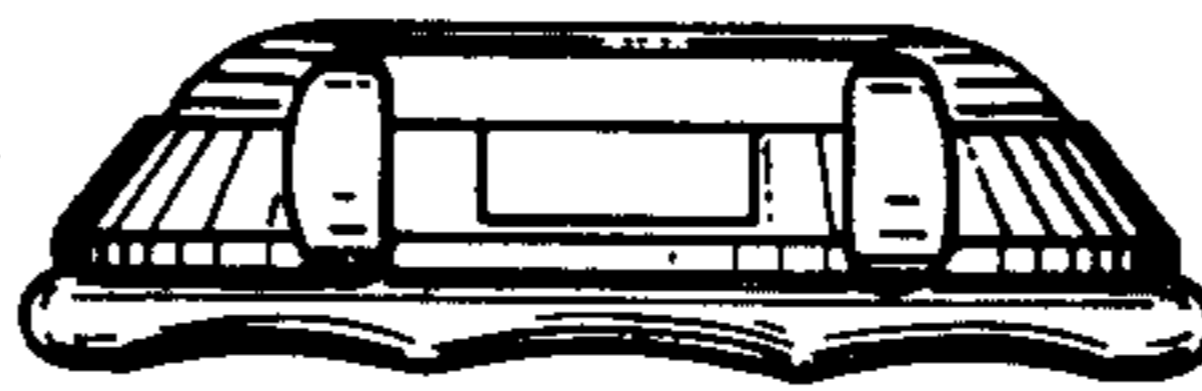
FIG. 1 is a top right side perspective view of a wristwatch case showing my new design on a reduced scale; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom end elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 2.

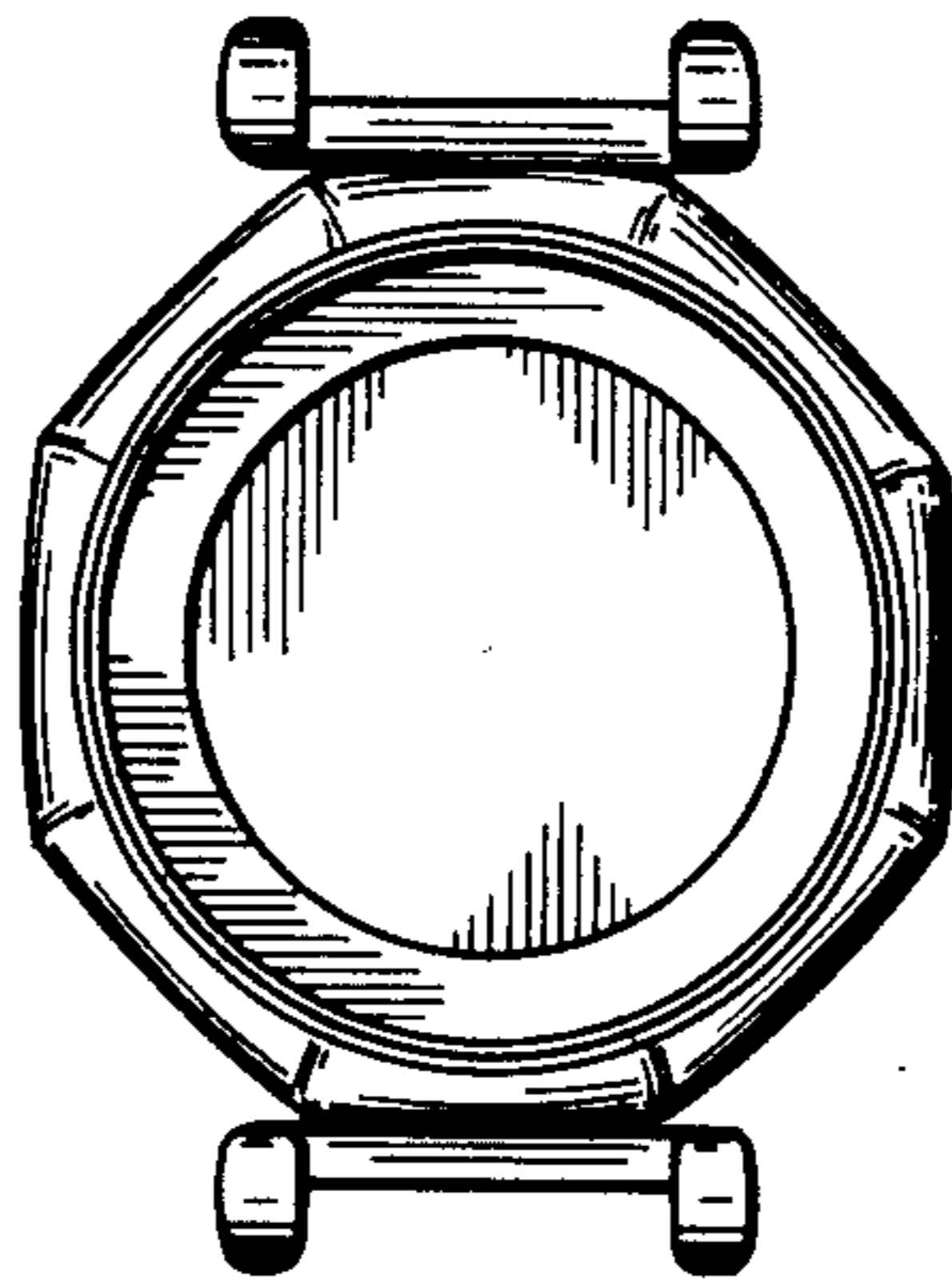

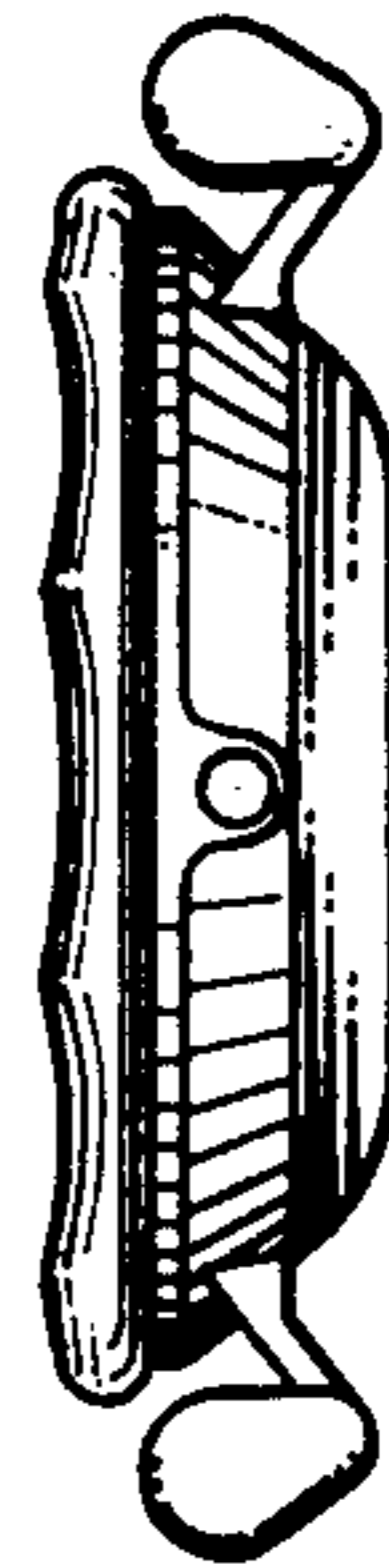

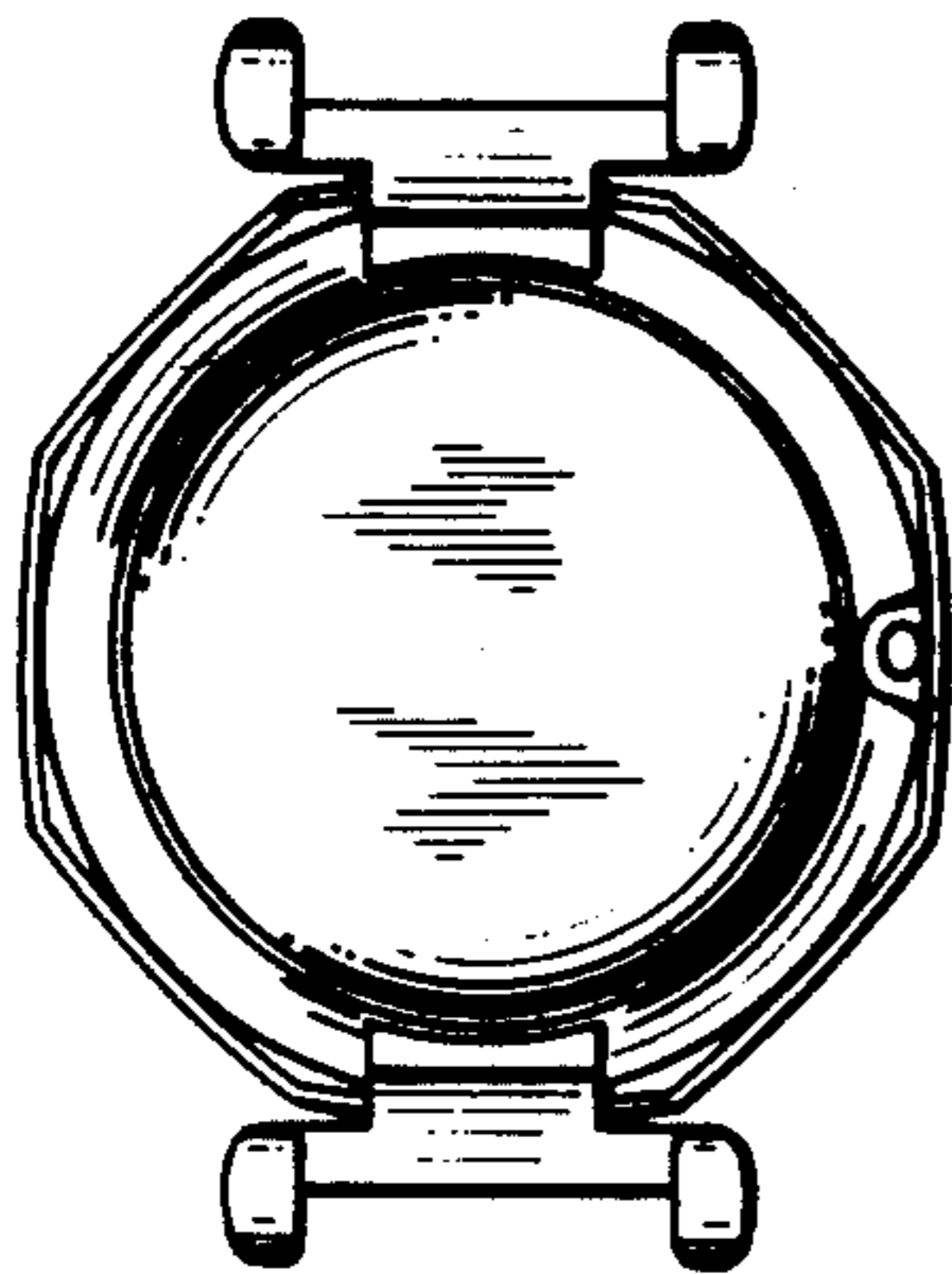

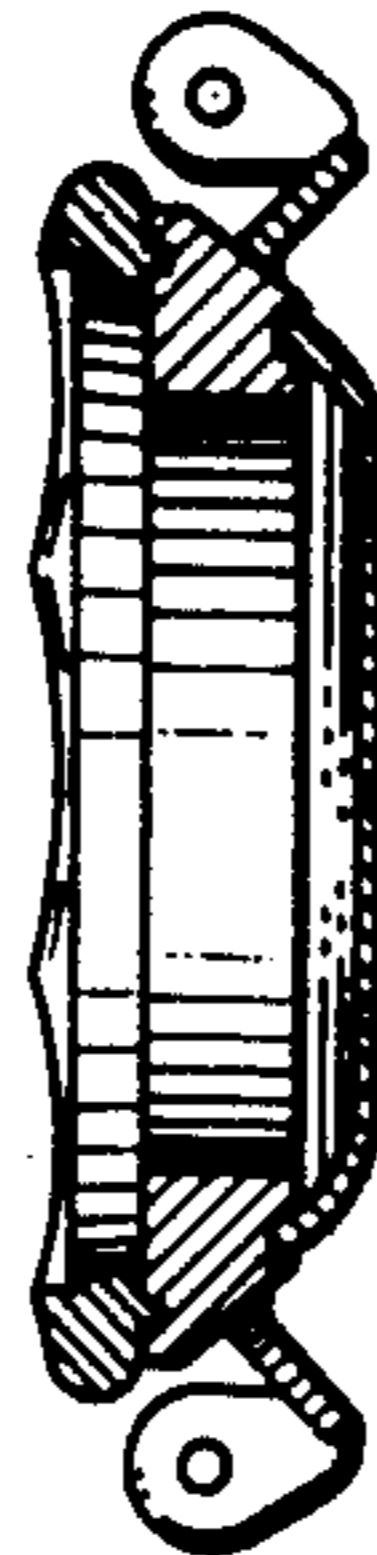
