The ornamental design for a tiltable frying pan structure and support therefor, as shown and described.

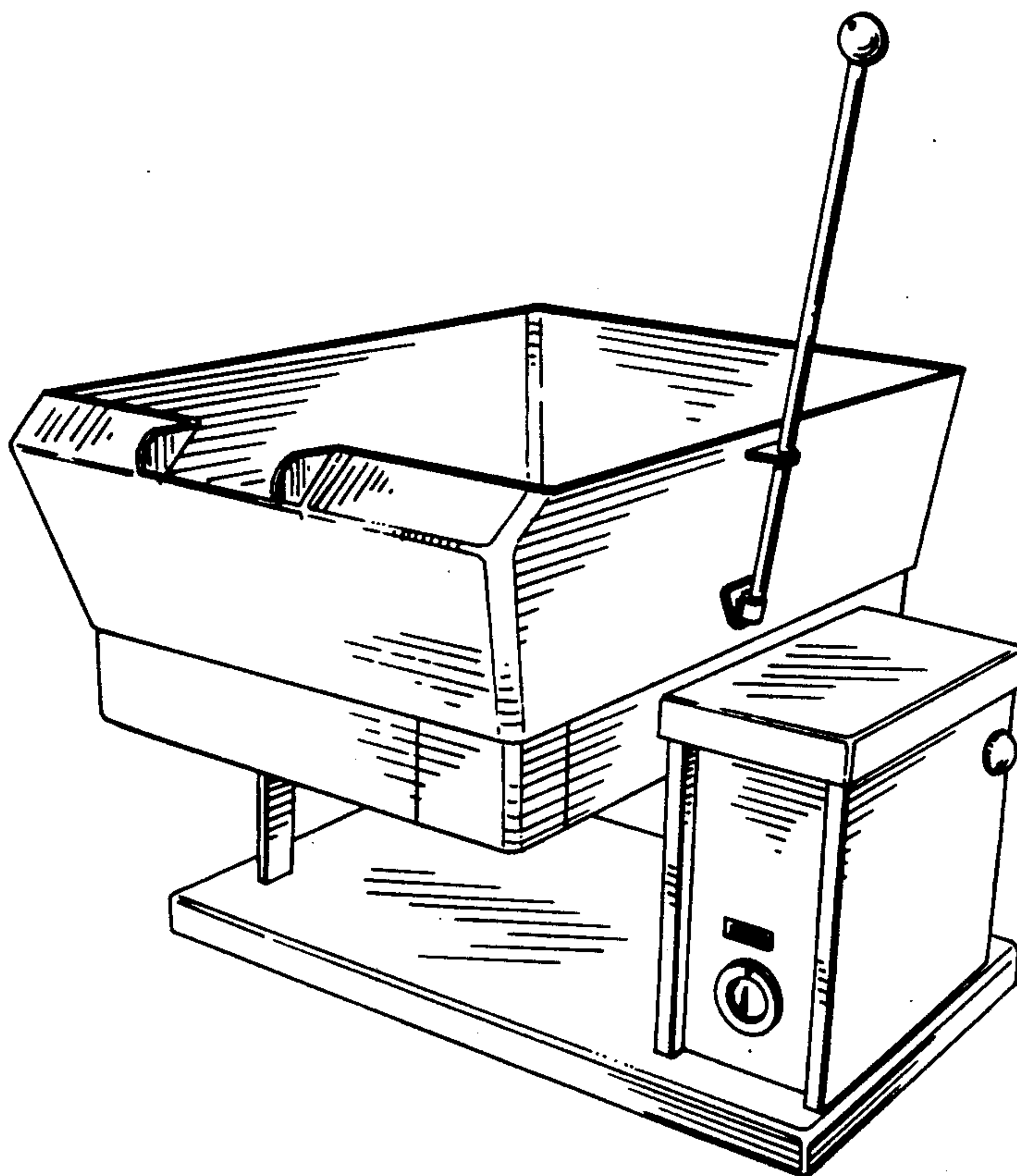
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper right front perspective view of said tiltable frying pan and support therefor, showing my new design;

The interior bottom surface of the frying pan is substantially planar and unornamented.



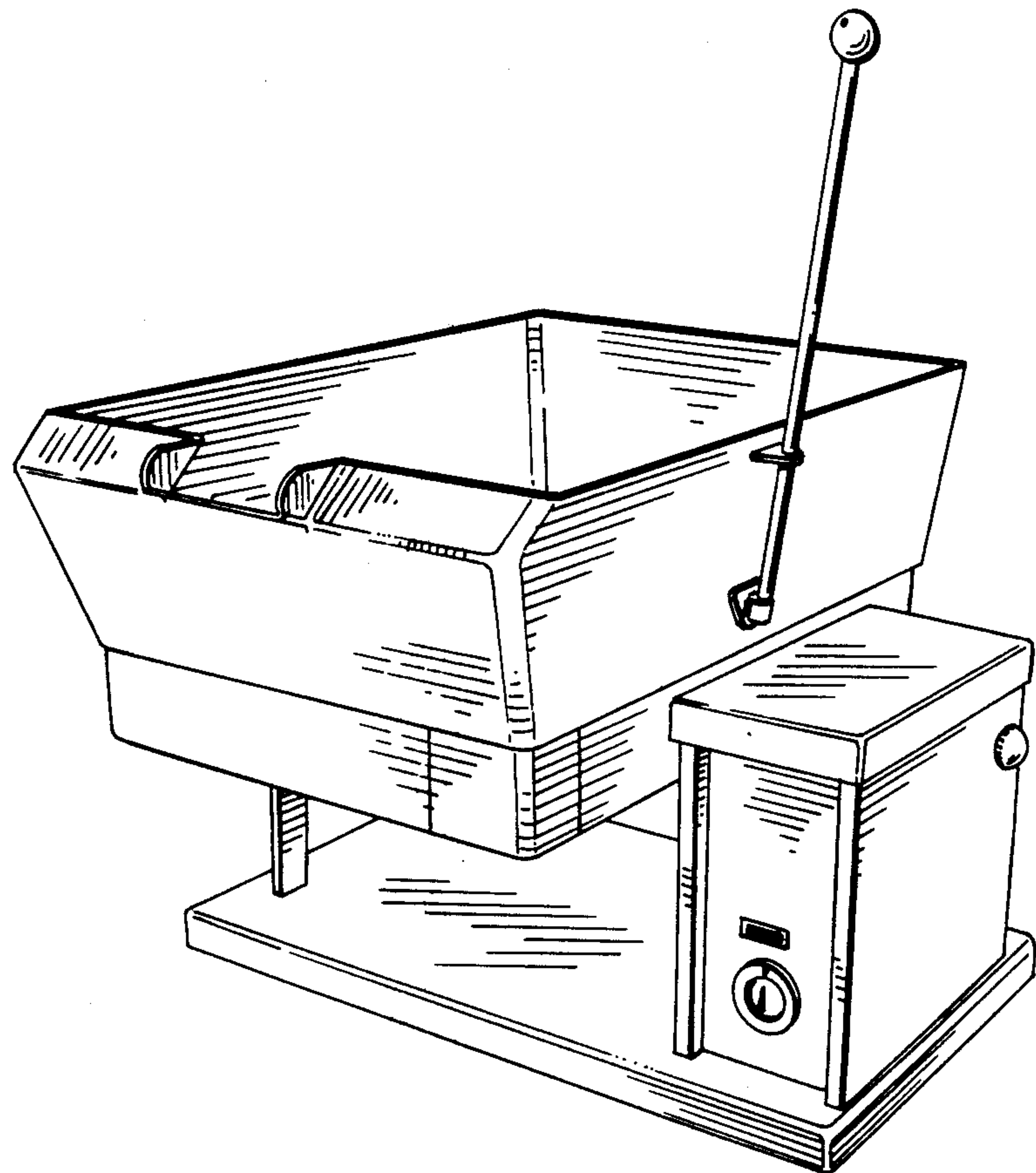

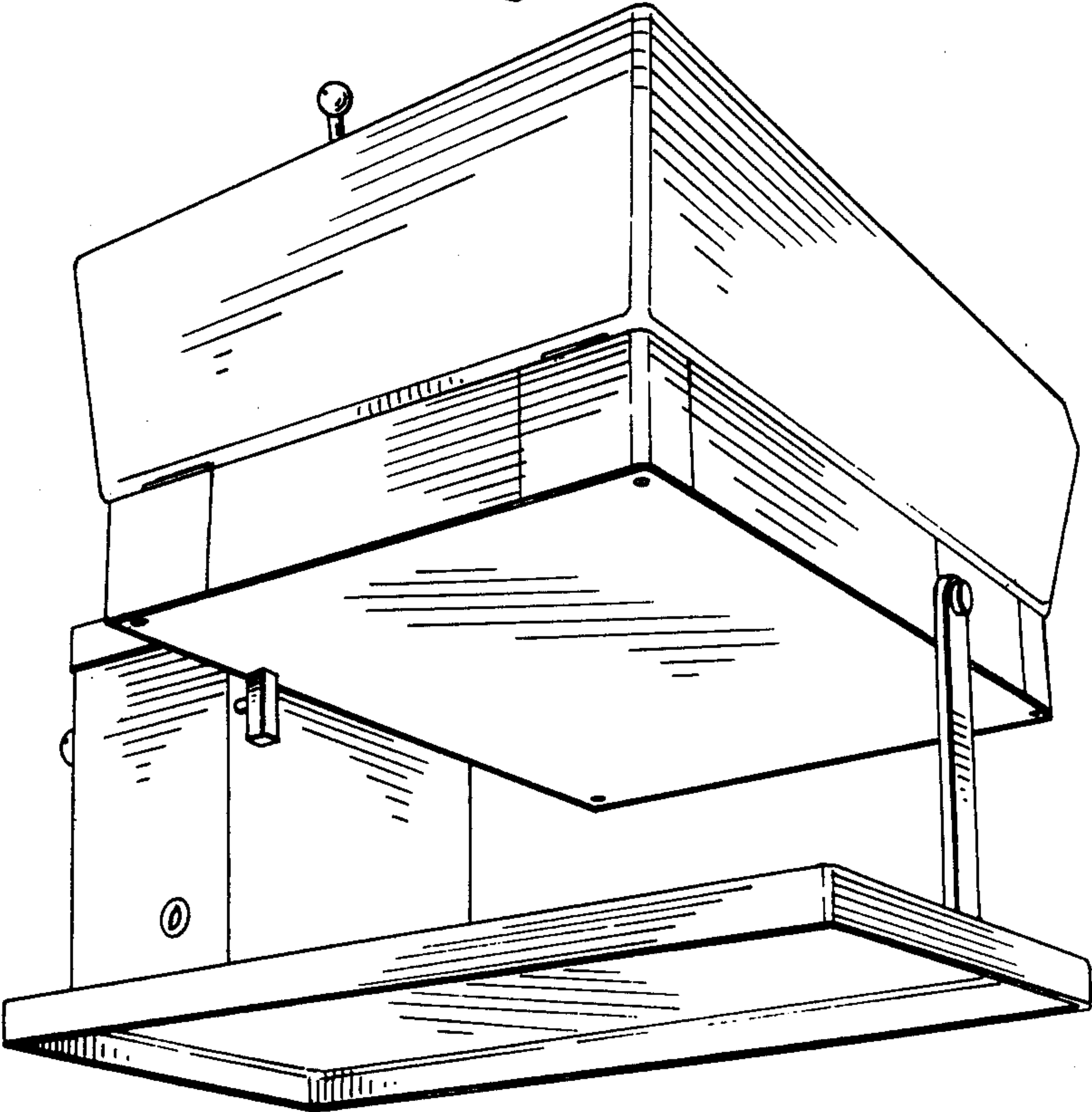

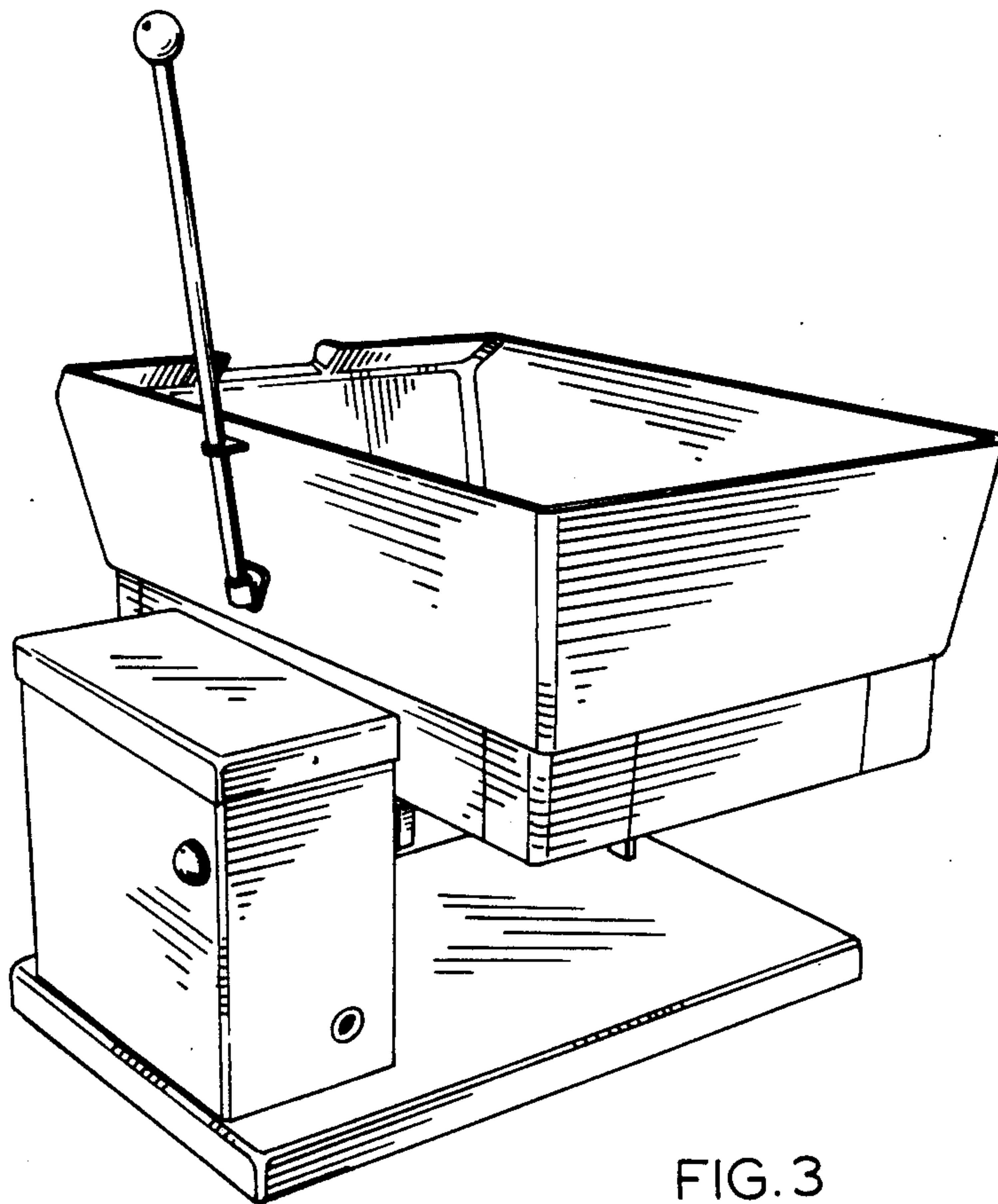
