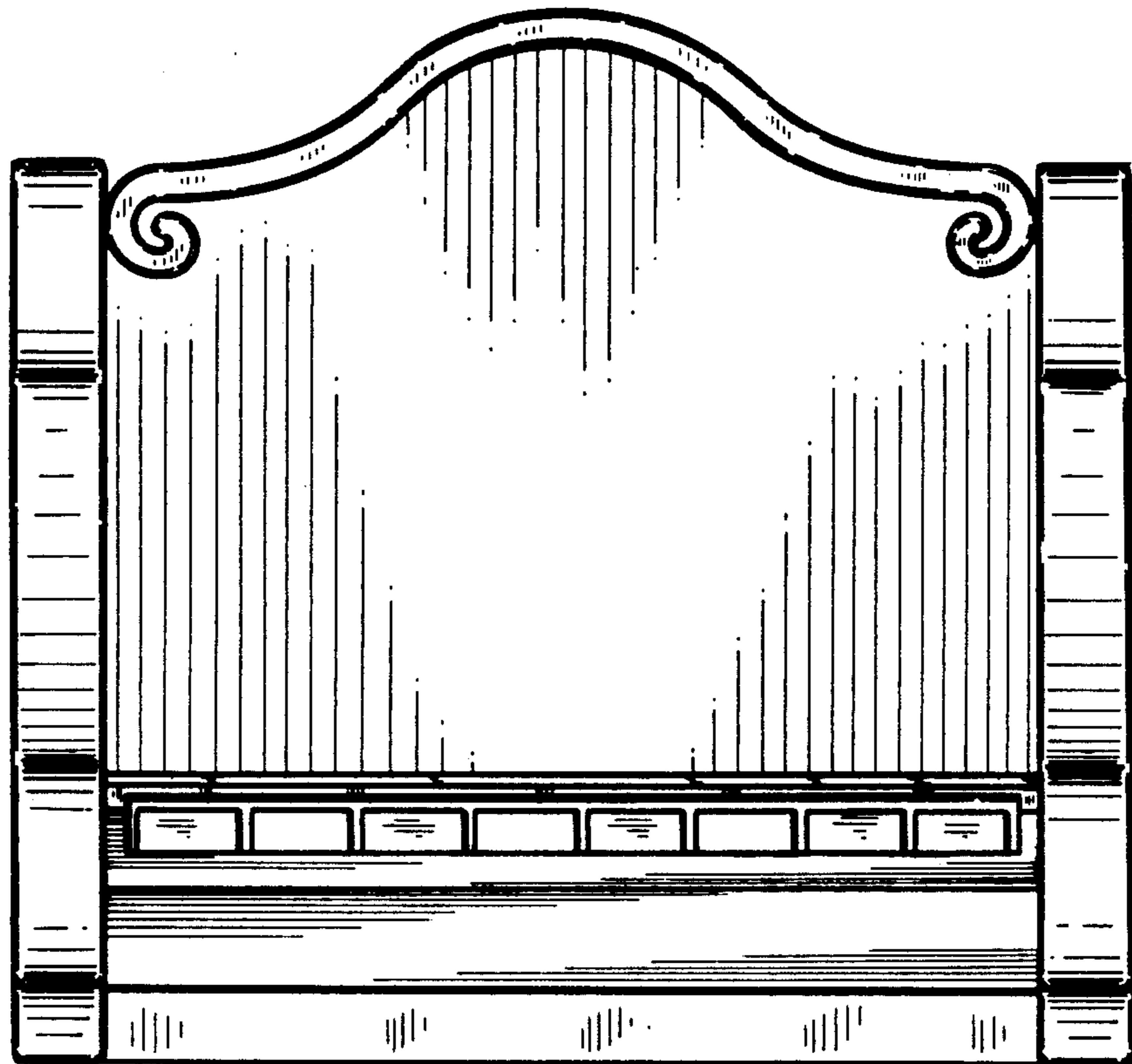

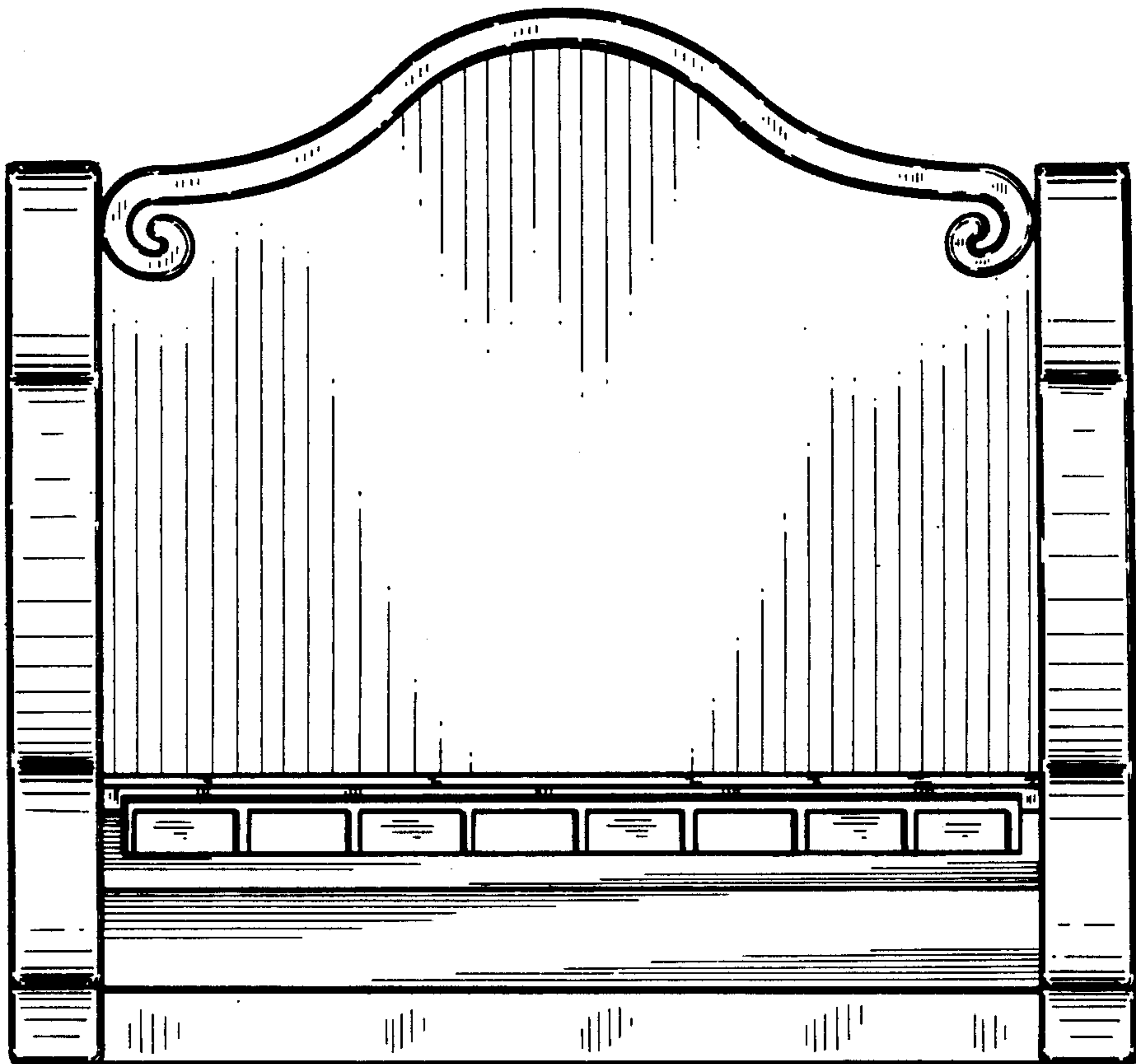
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy piano, as shown and described.

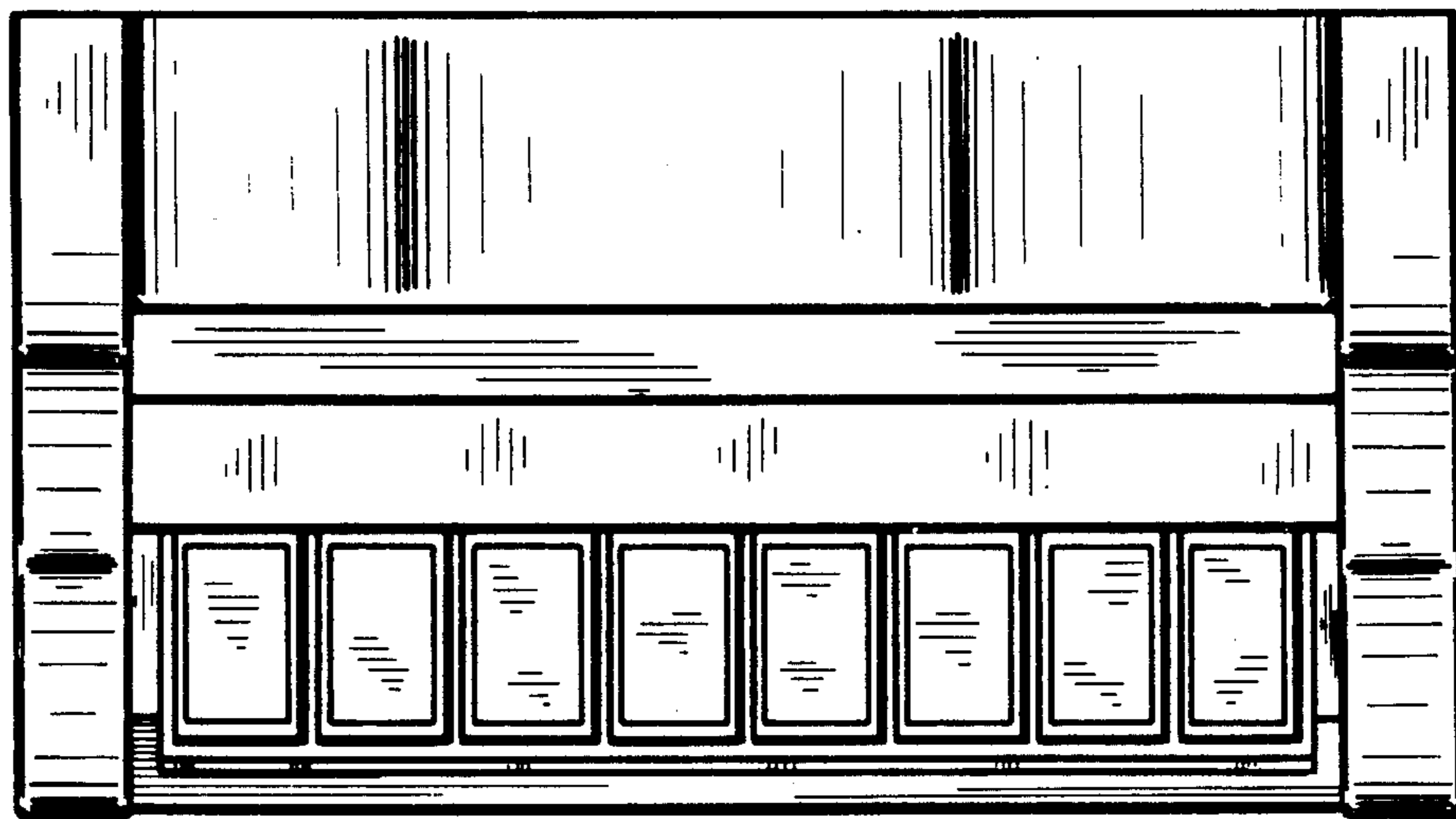
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy piano showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image.

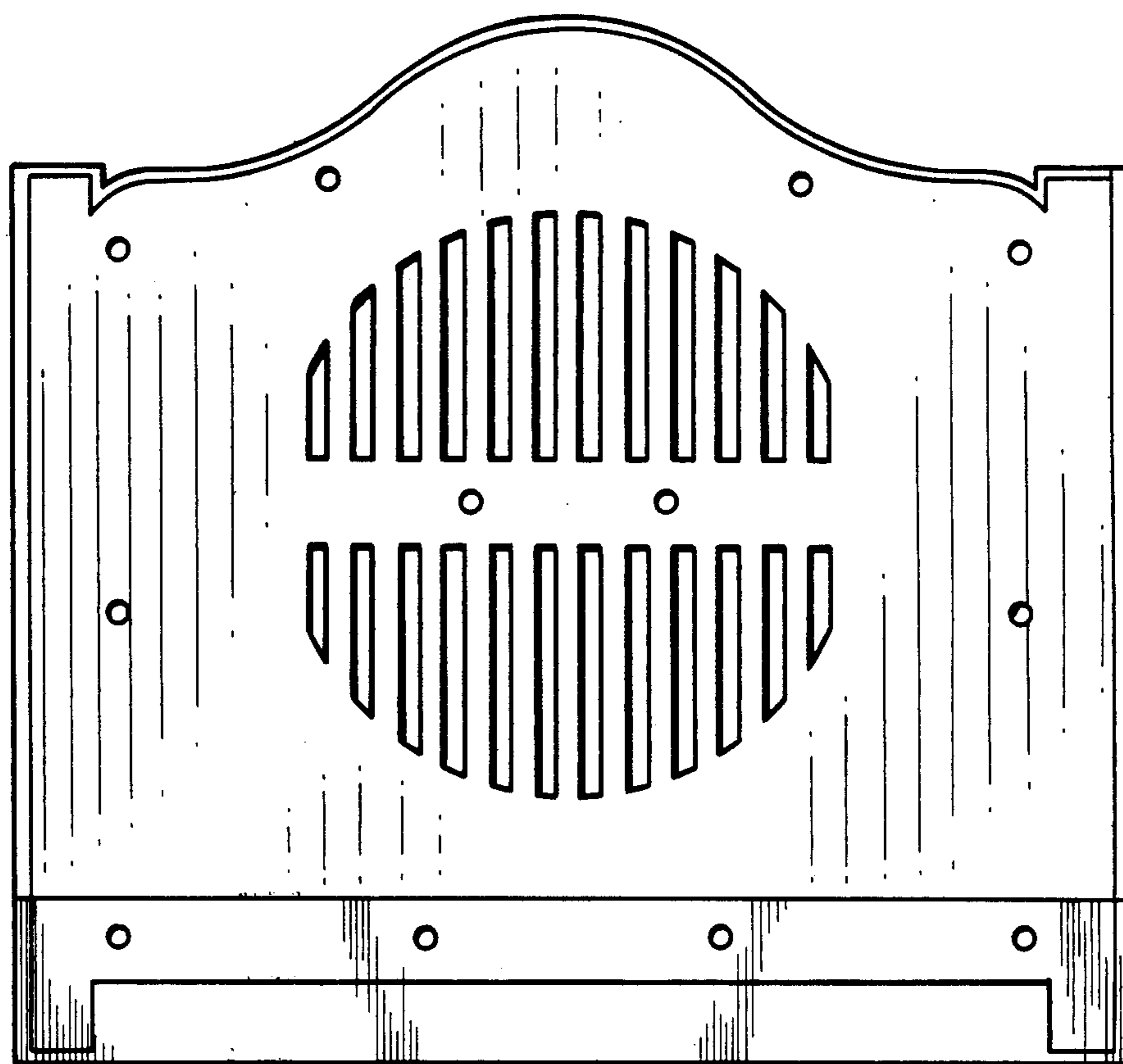




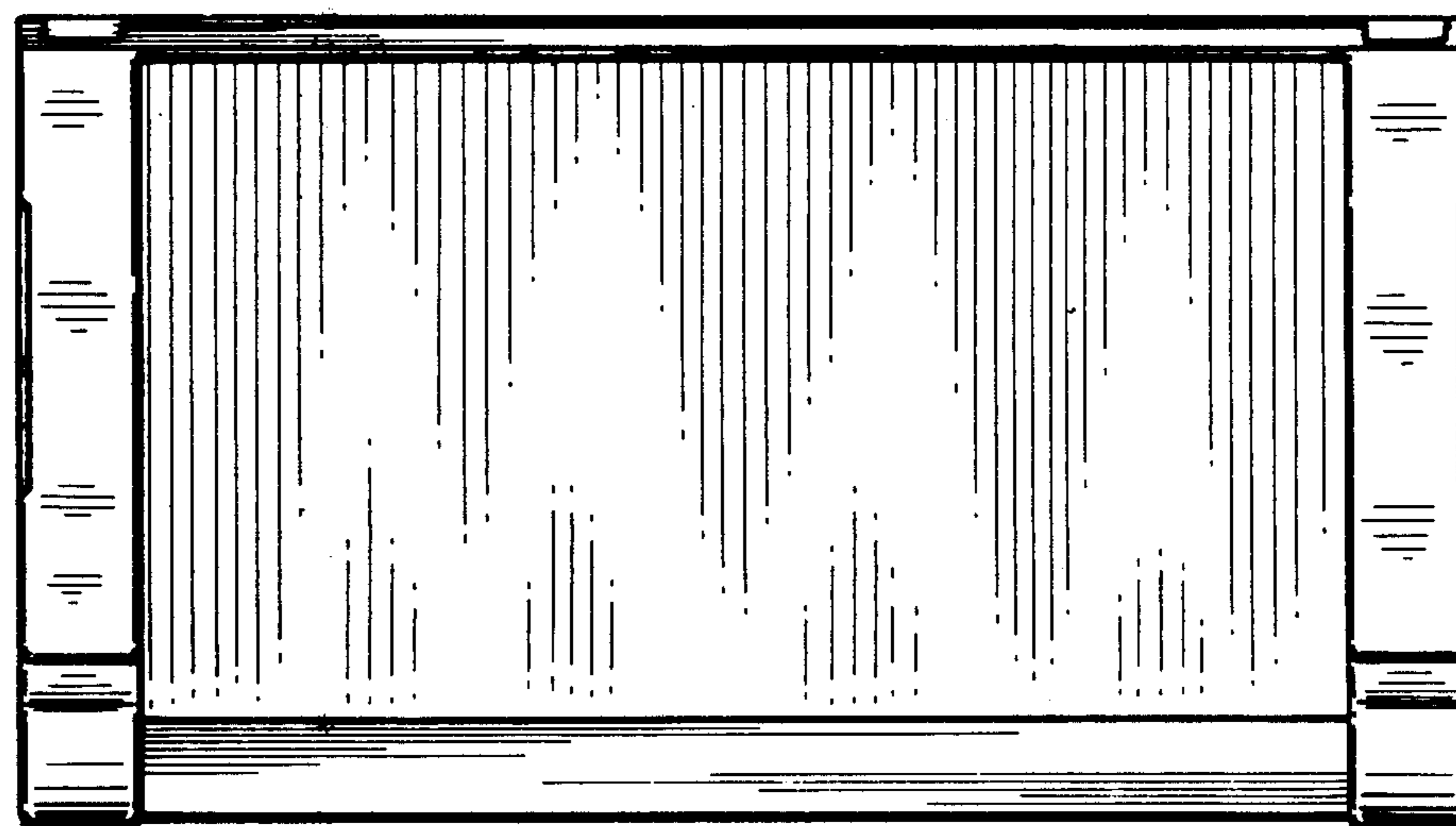

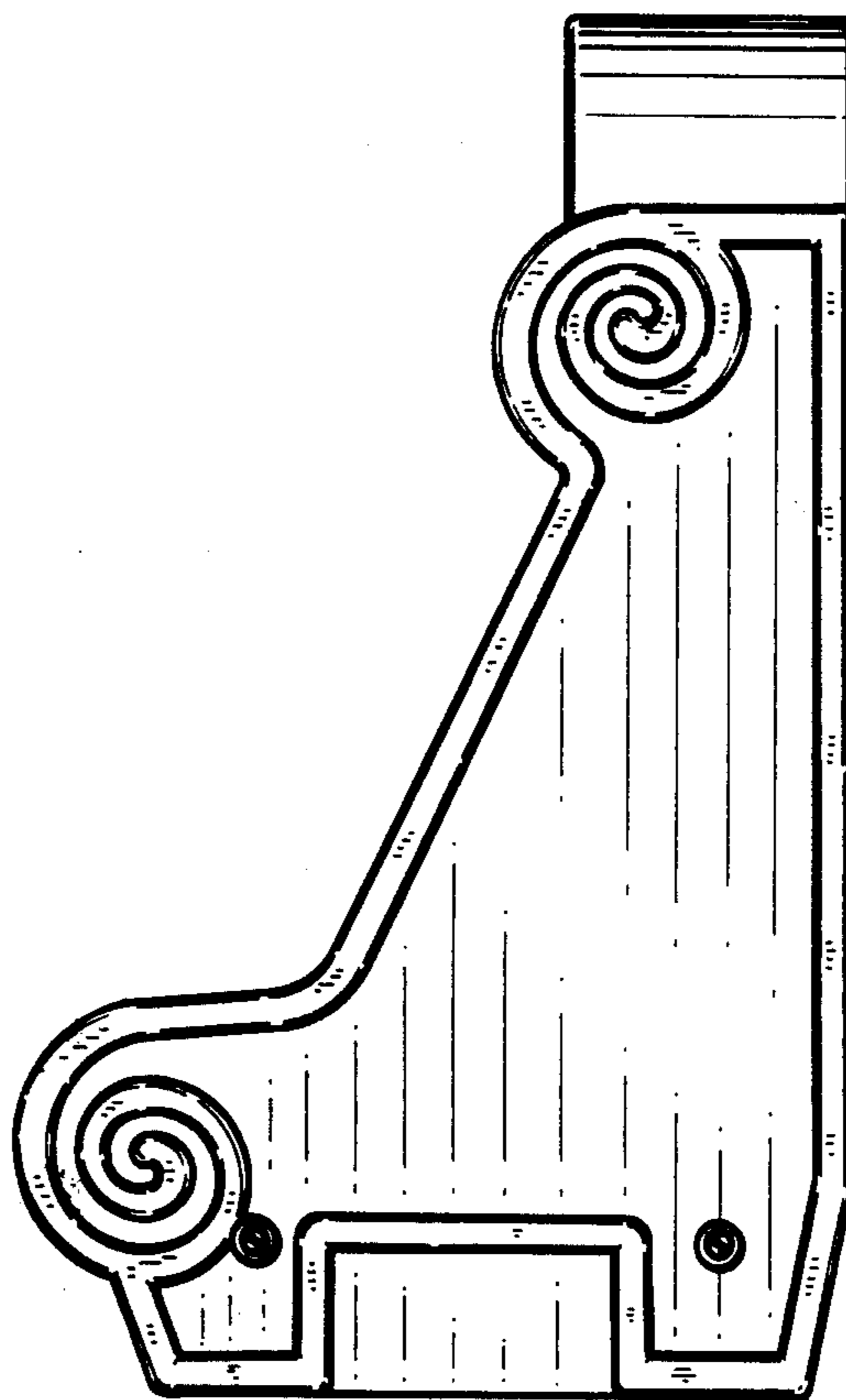
