DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fork or similar article of flatware showing my new design;

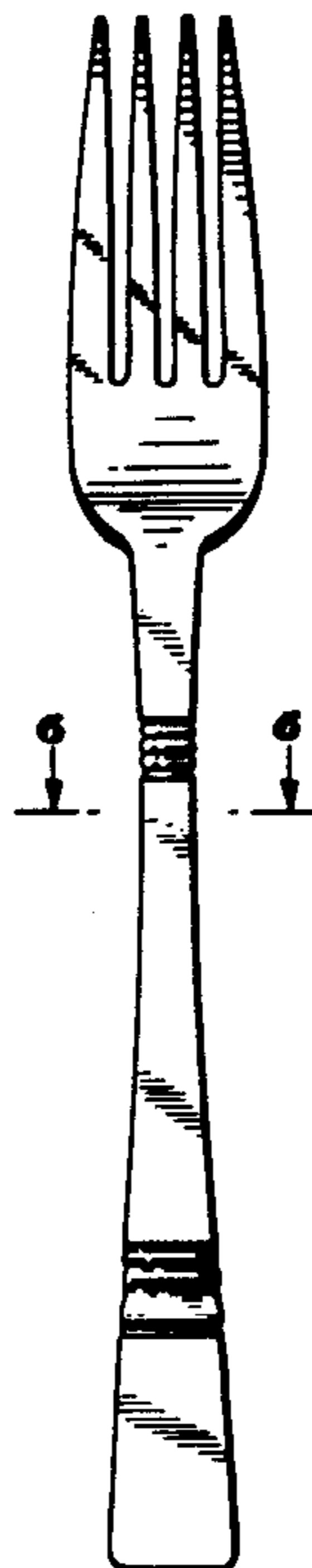
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view of FIG. 2 along line 6-6.



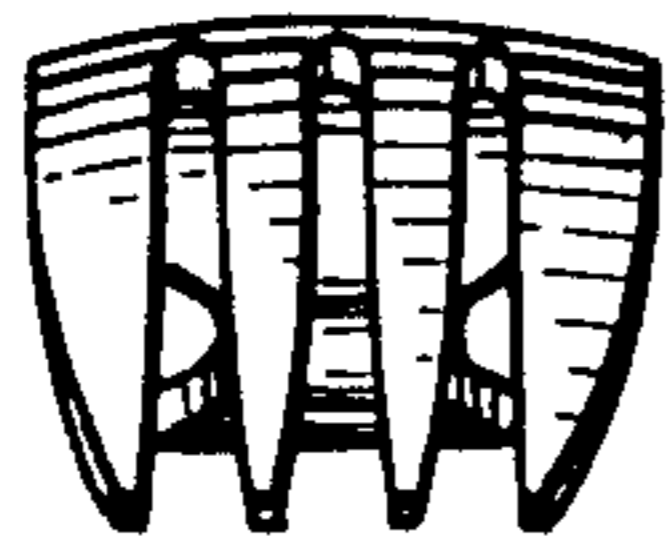

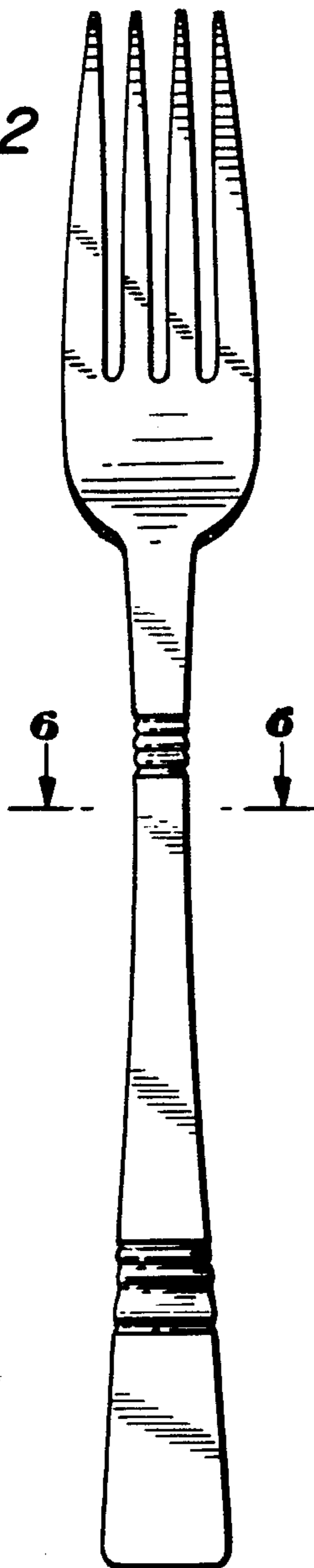

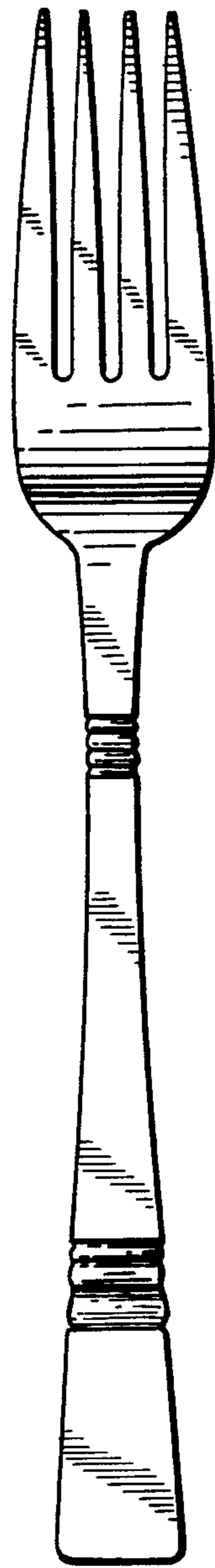

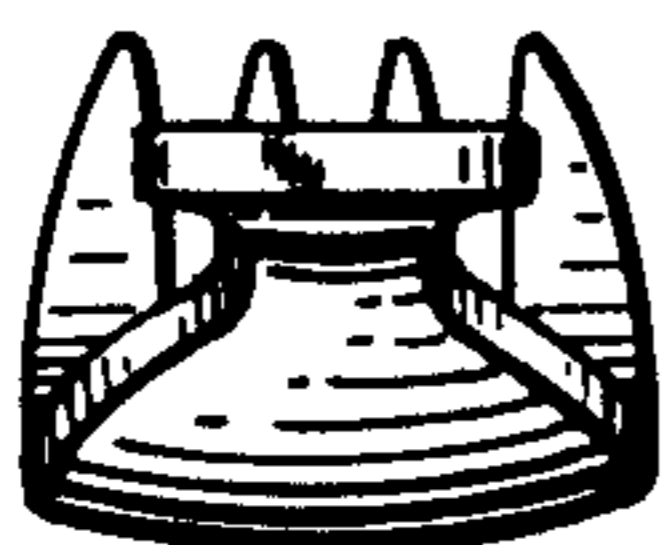
