[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a timepiece dial, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a front elevational view of a timepiece dial showing my new design, the rear being flat, plain, and unornamented. Said dial is conventionally of no appreciable thickness.
