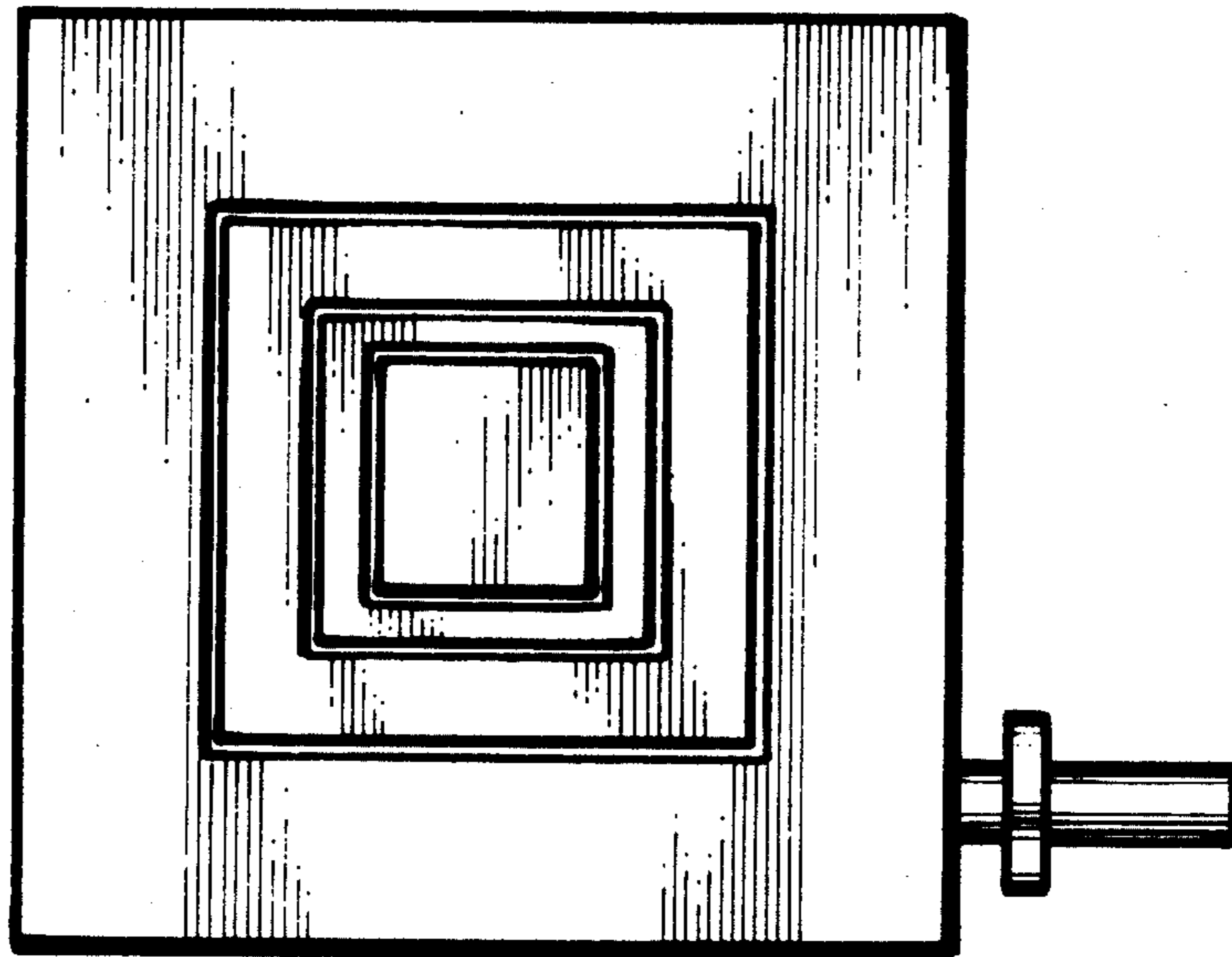

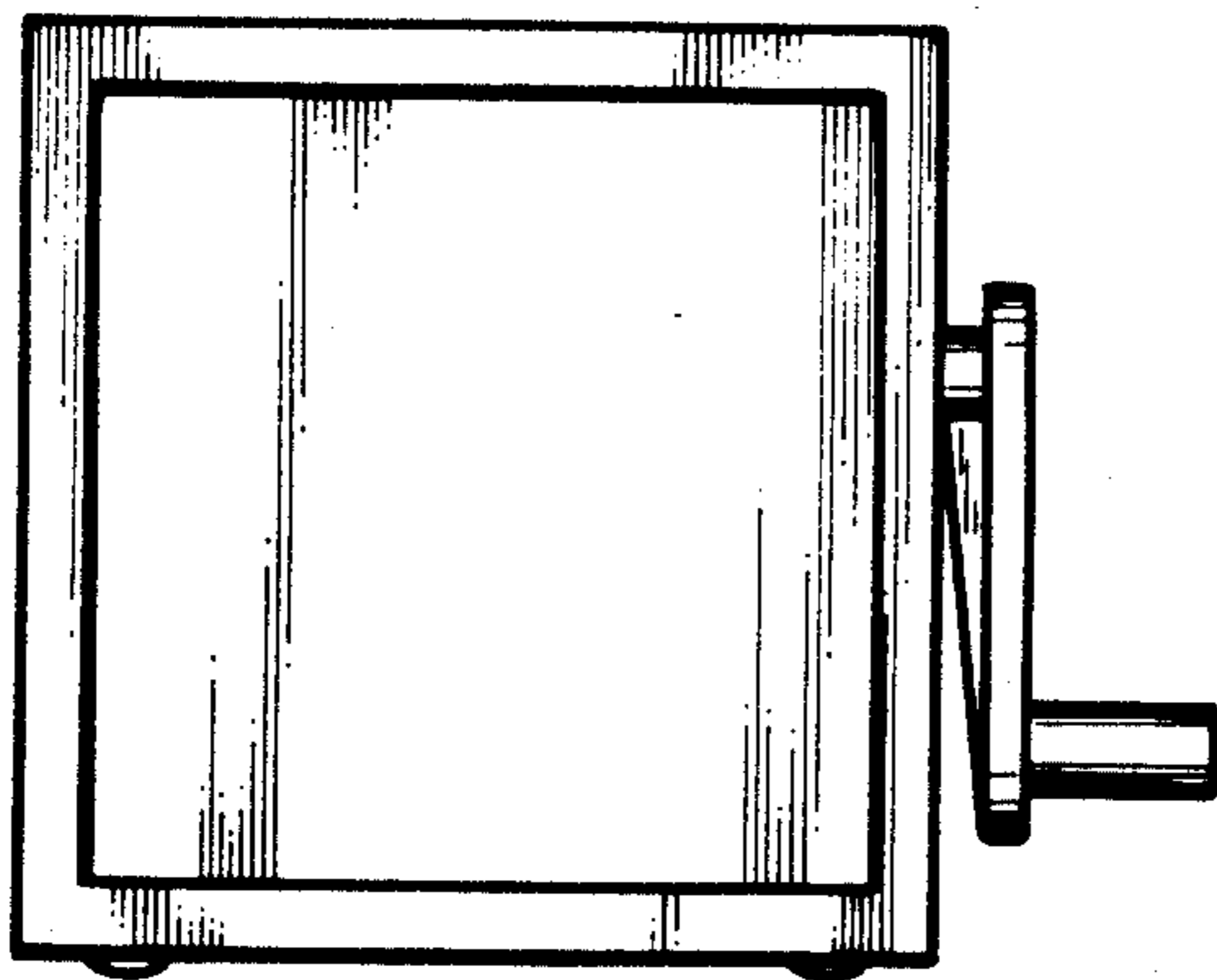
The ornamental design for a toy jack in the box, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

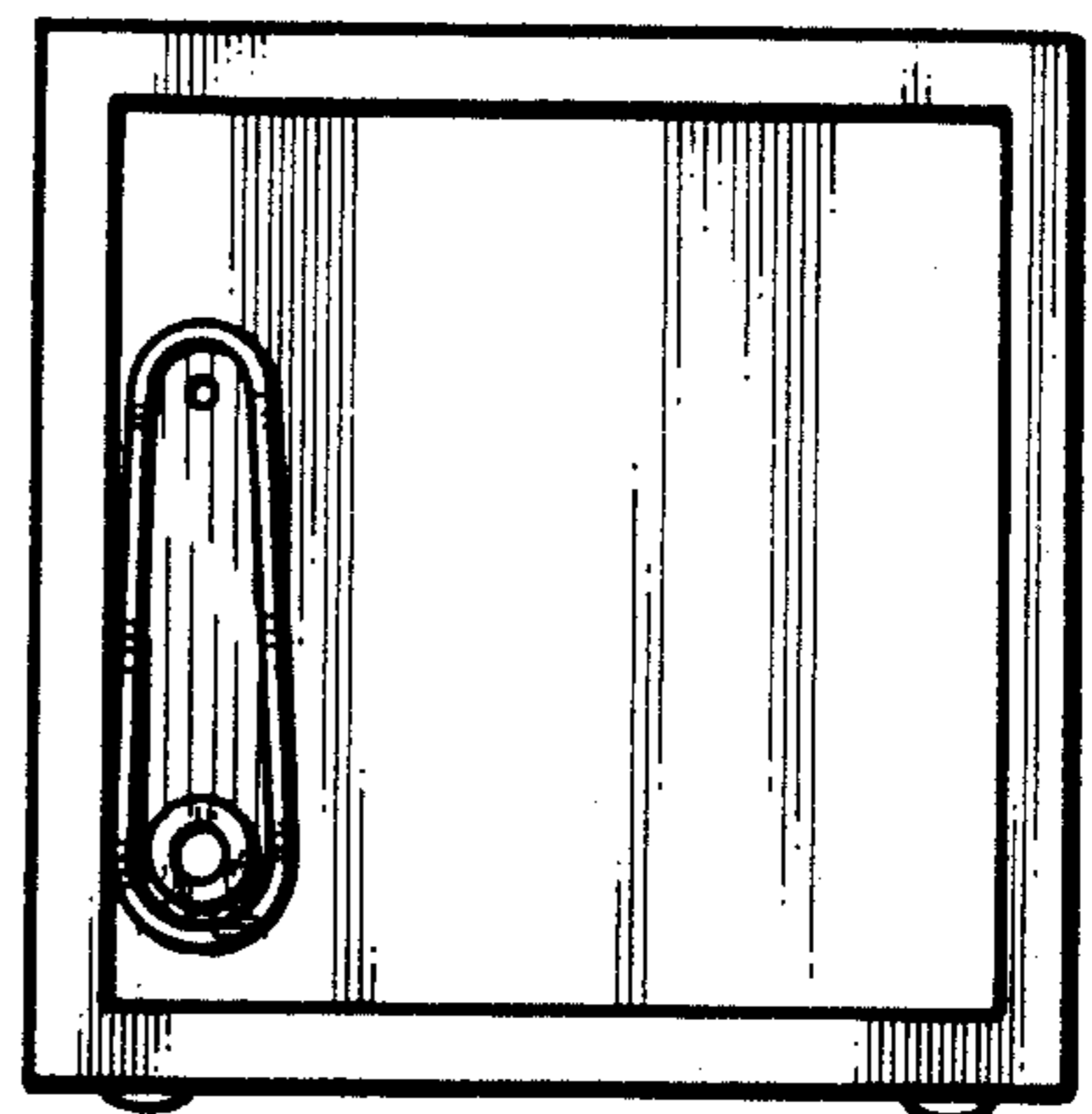

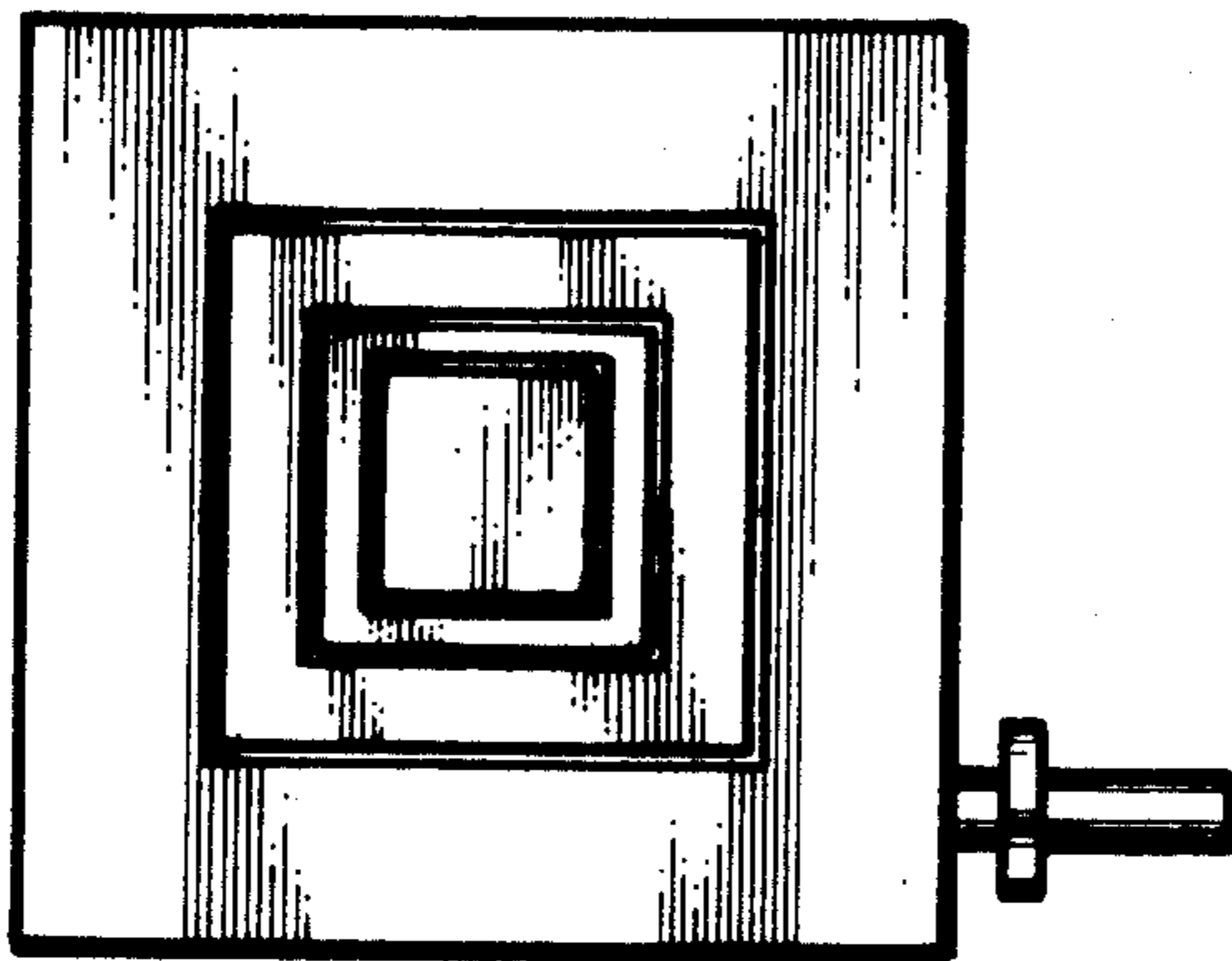




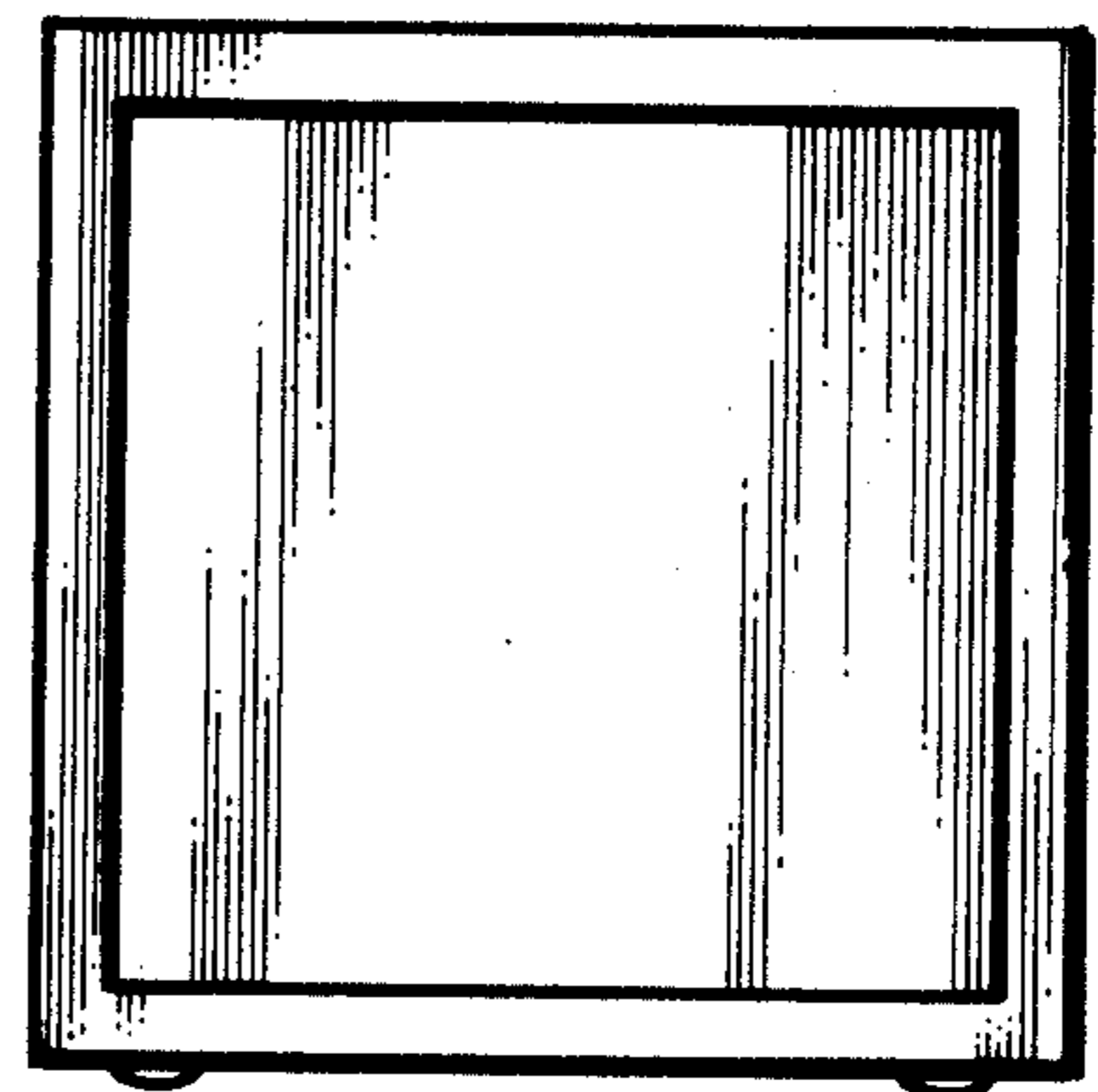

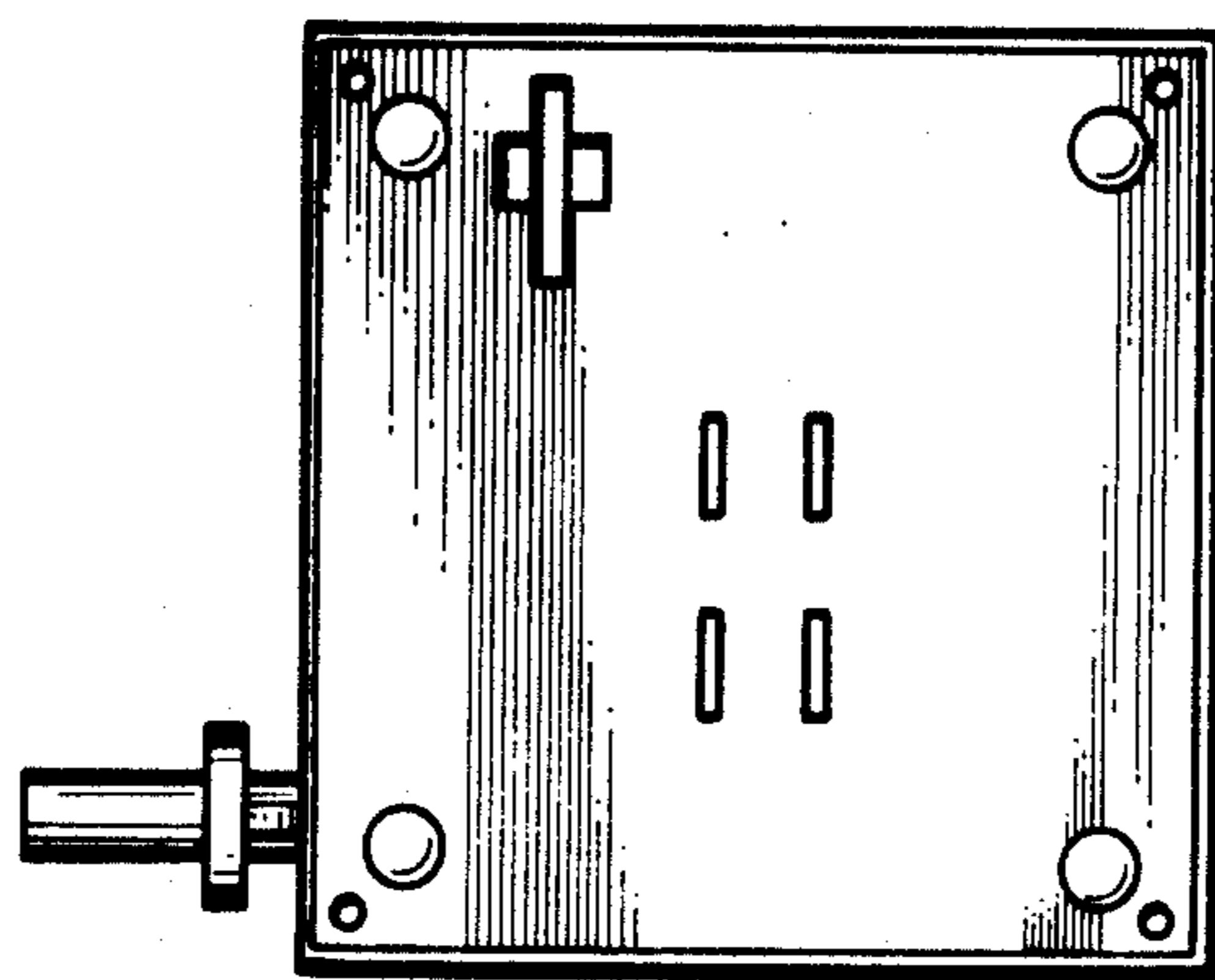
