The ornamental design for a tubseat, as shown and described.

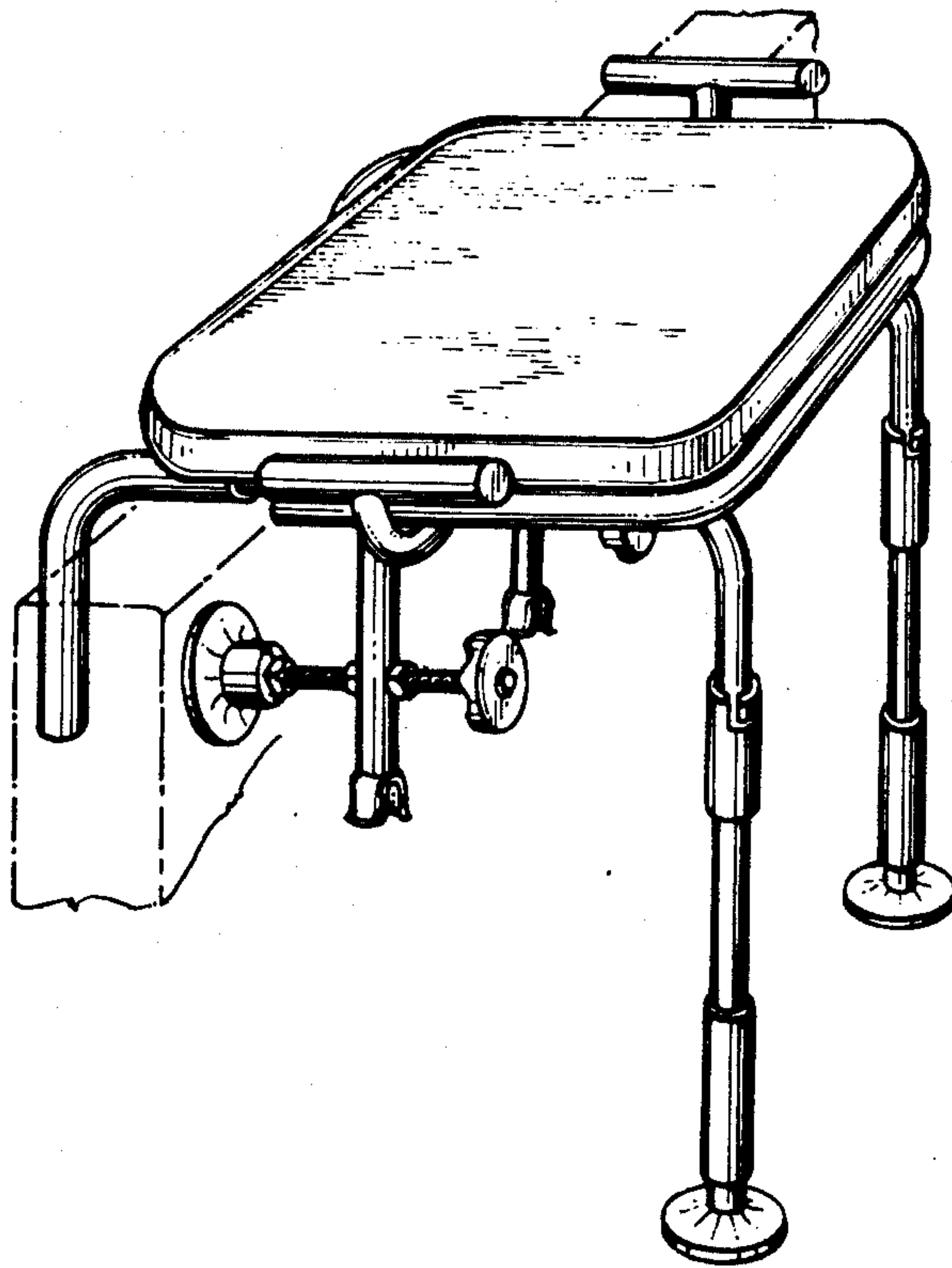
DESCRIPTION

The broken line representation of a portion of a bathtub in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



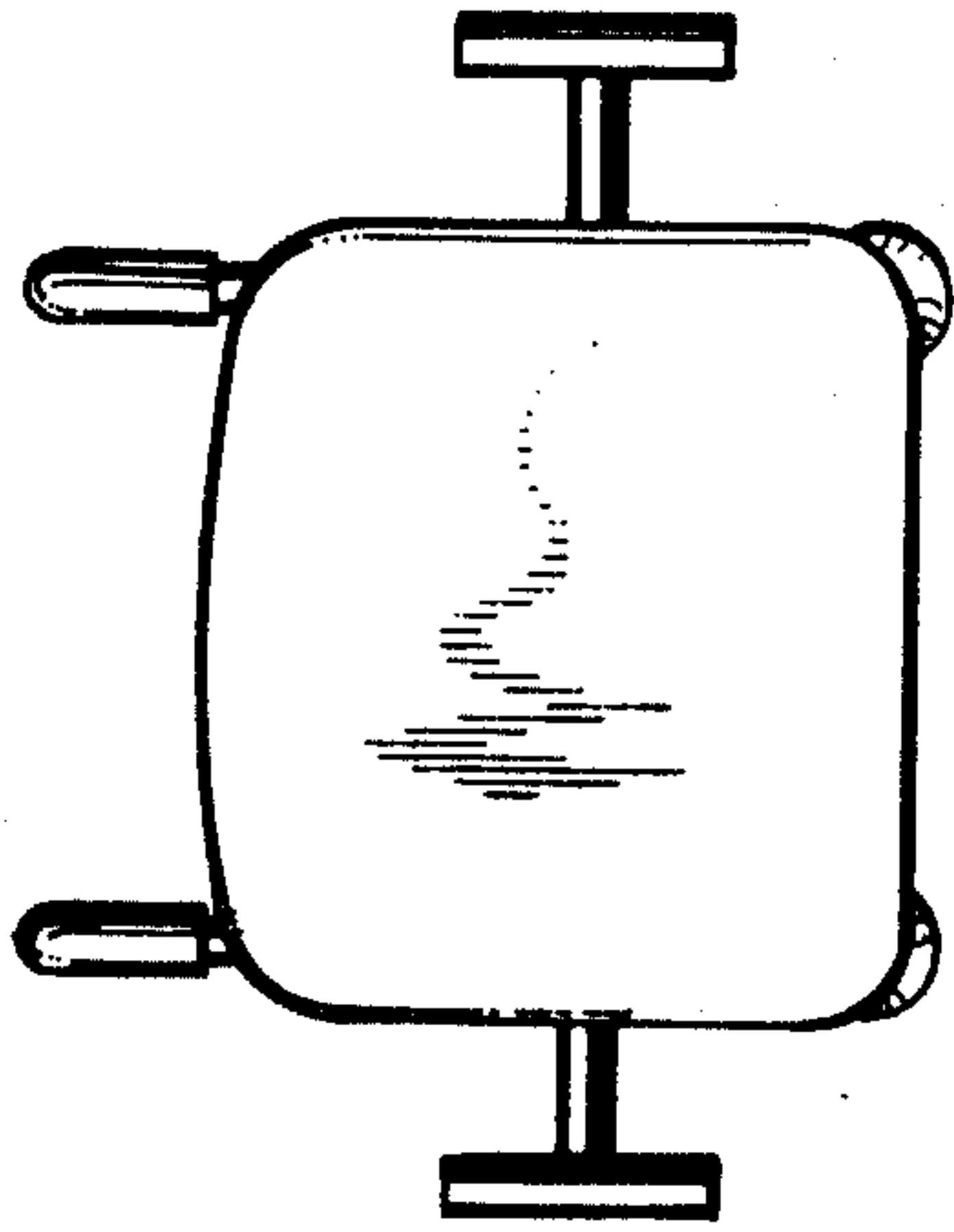

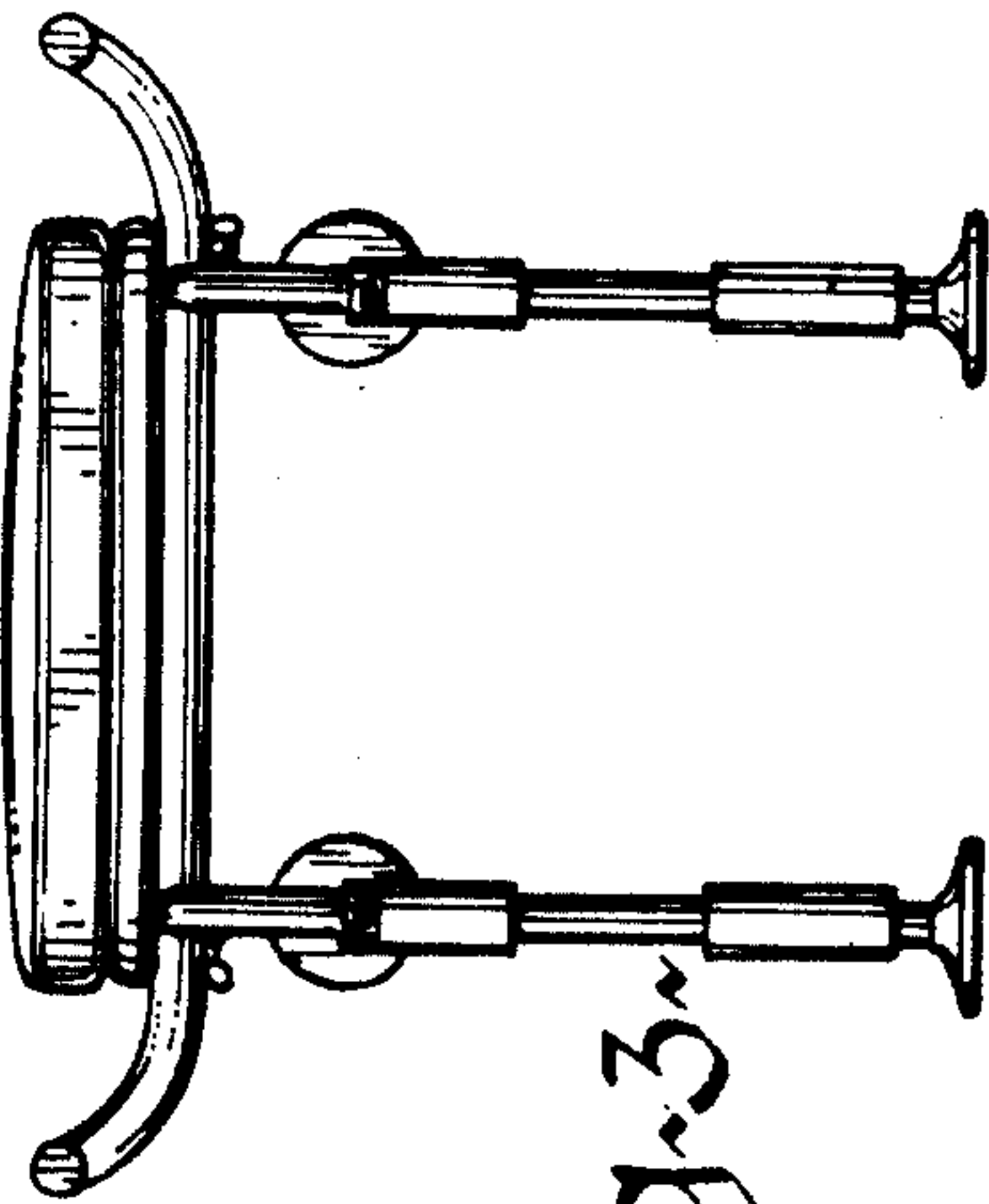

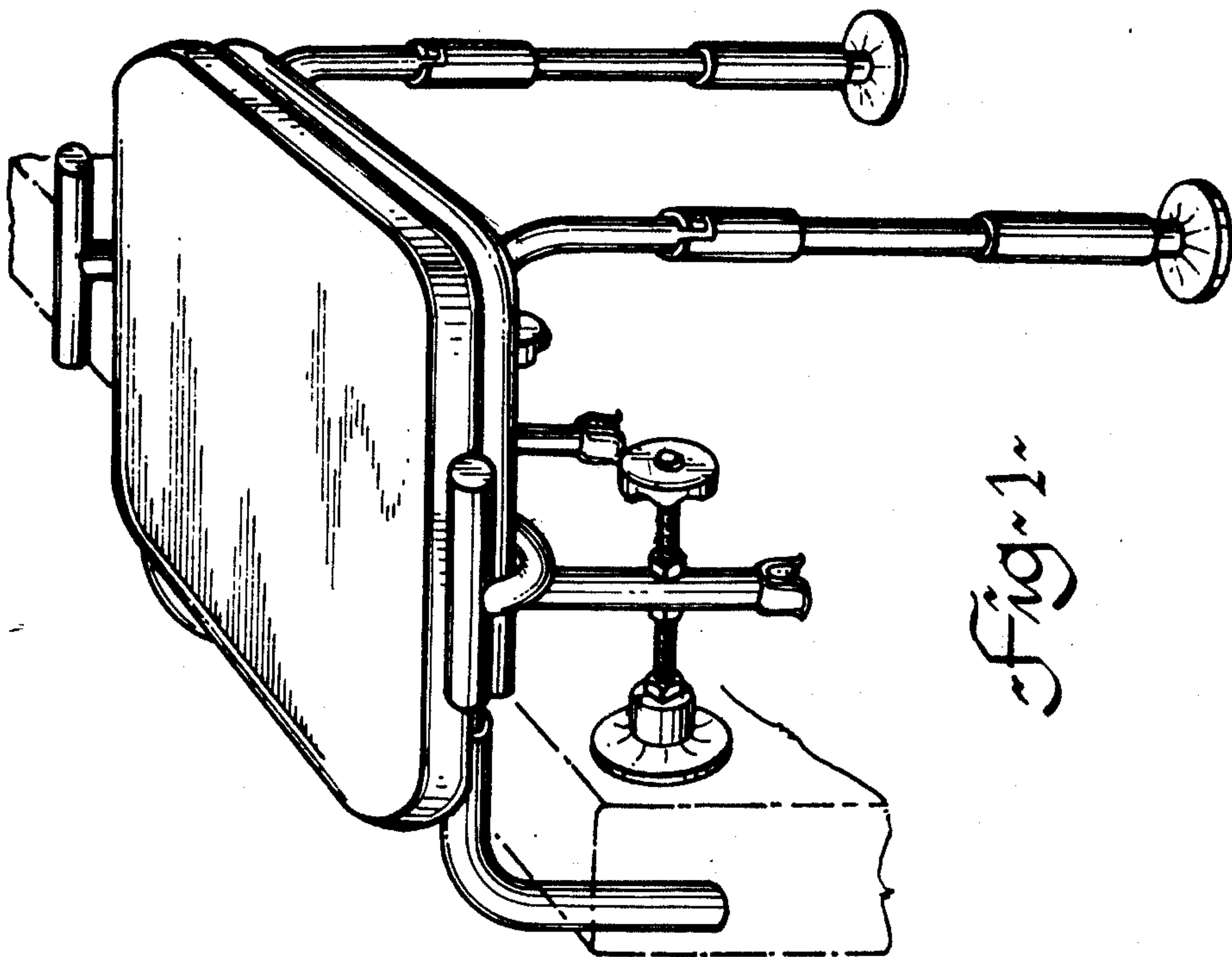
