FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the new design taken in an alternate position as shown in FIG. 1;

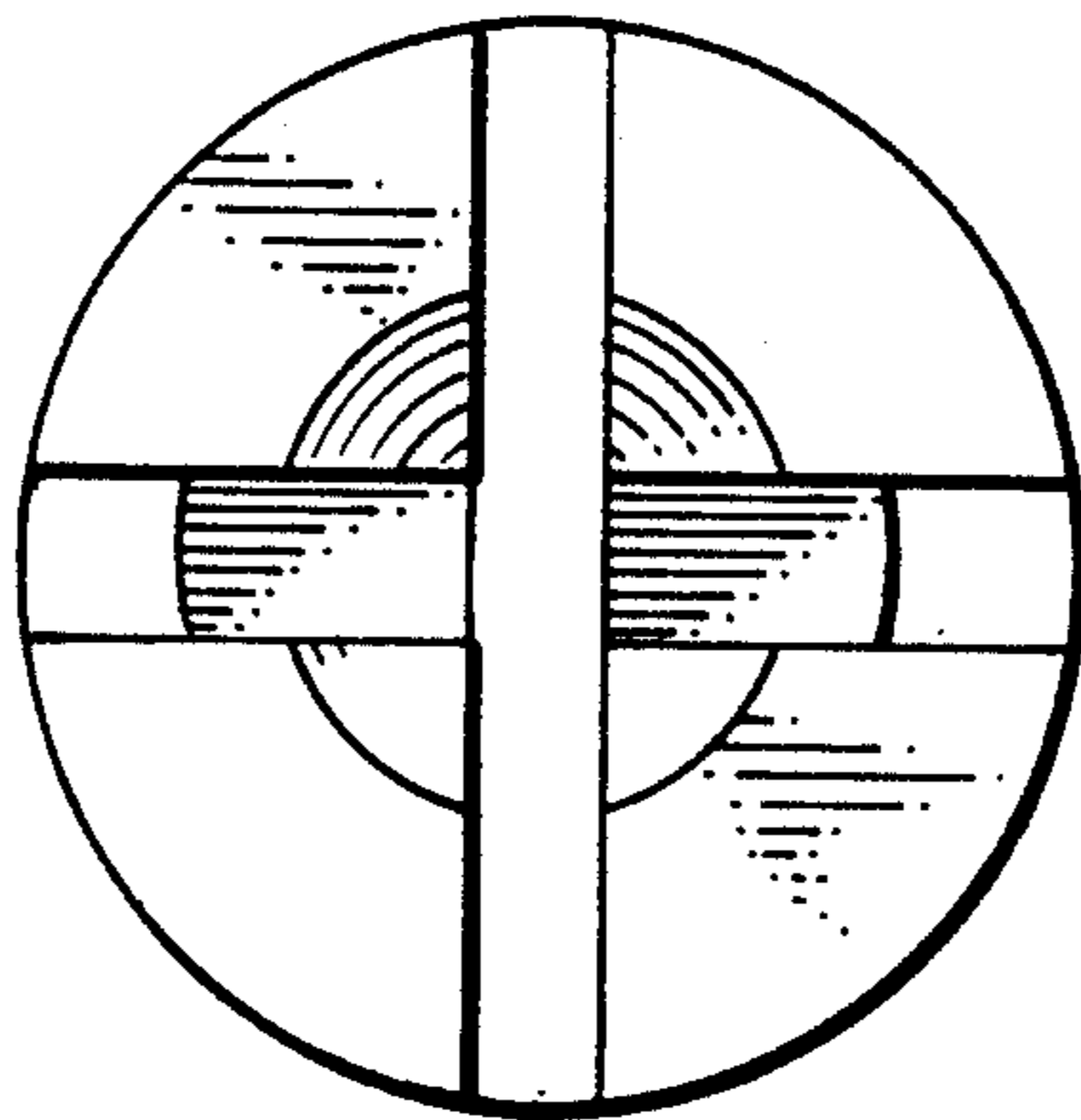
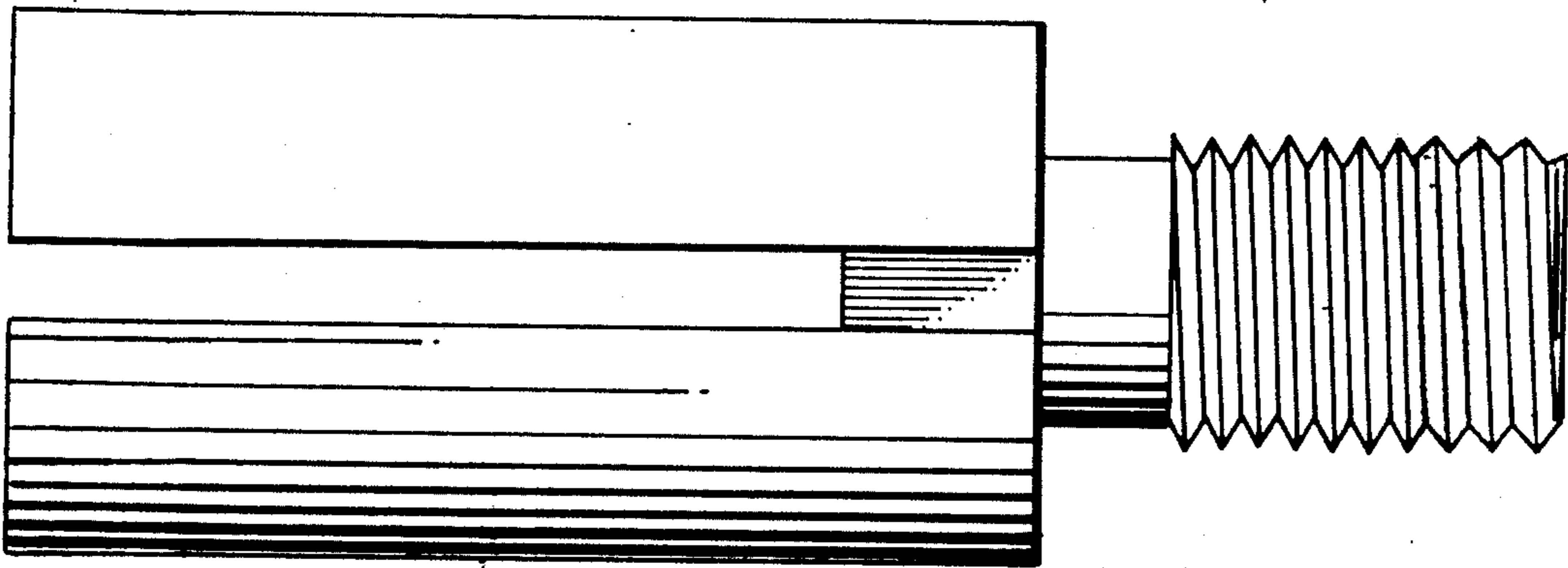
FIG. 3 is a front end view of the new design shown in FIG. 1; and

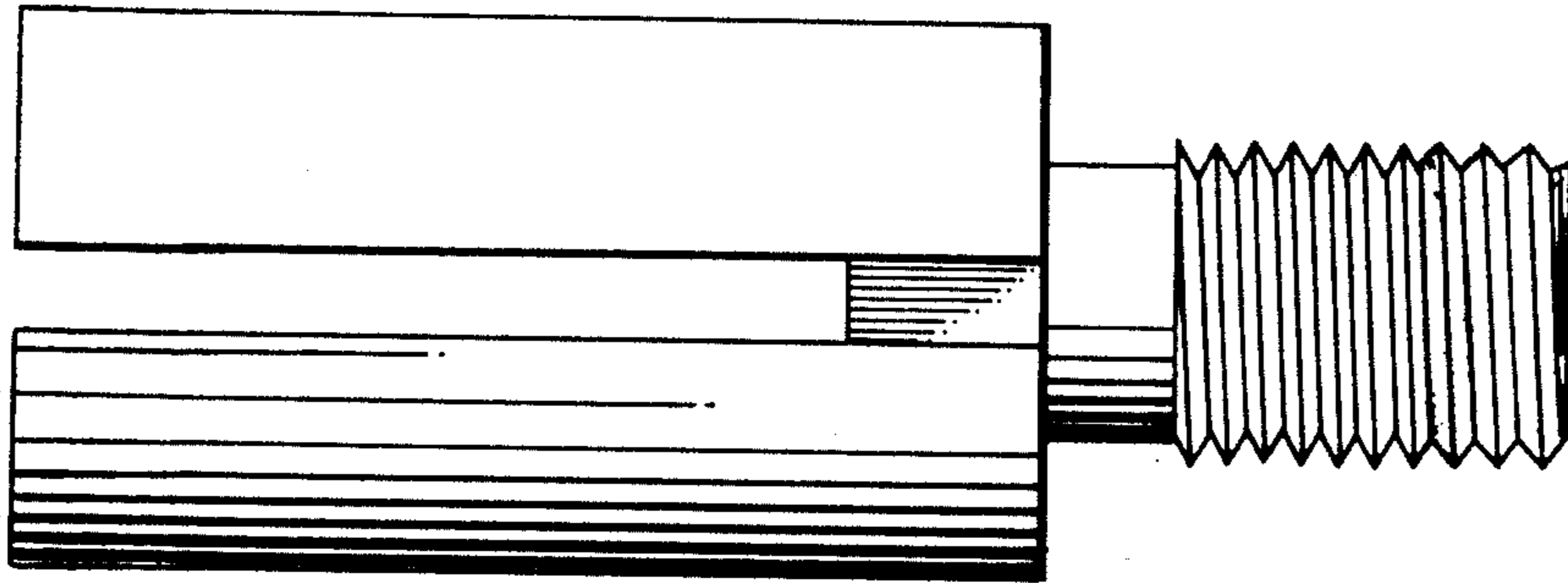

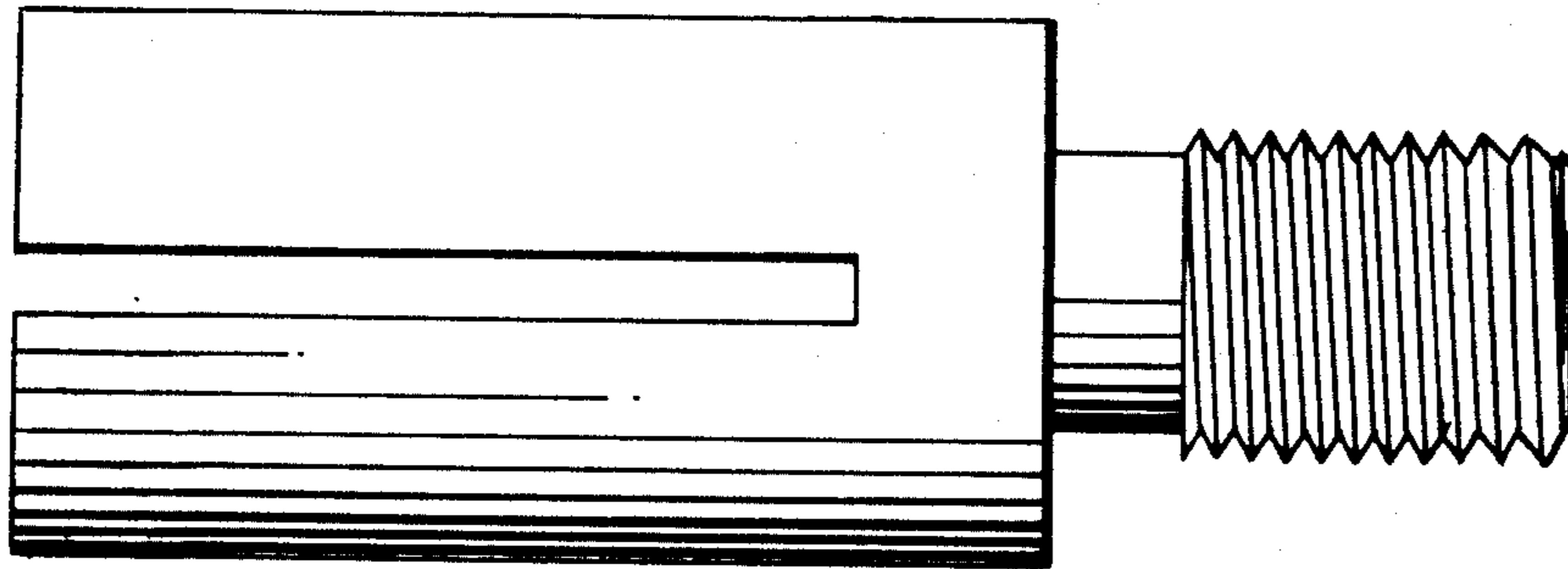

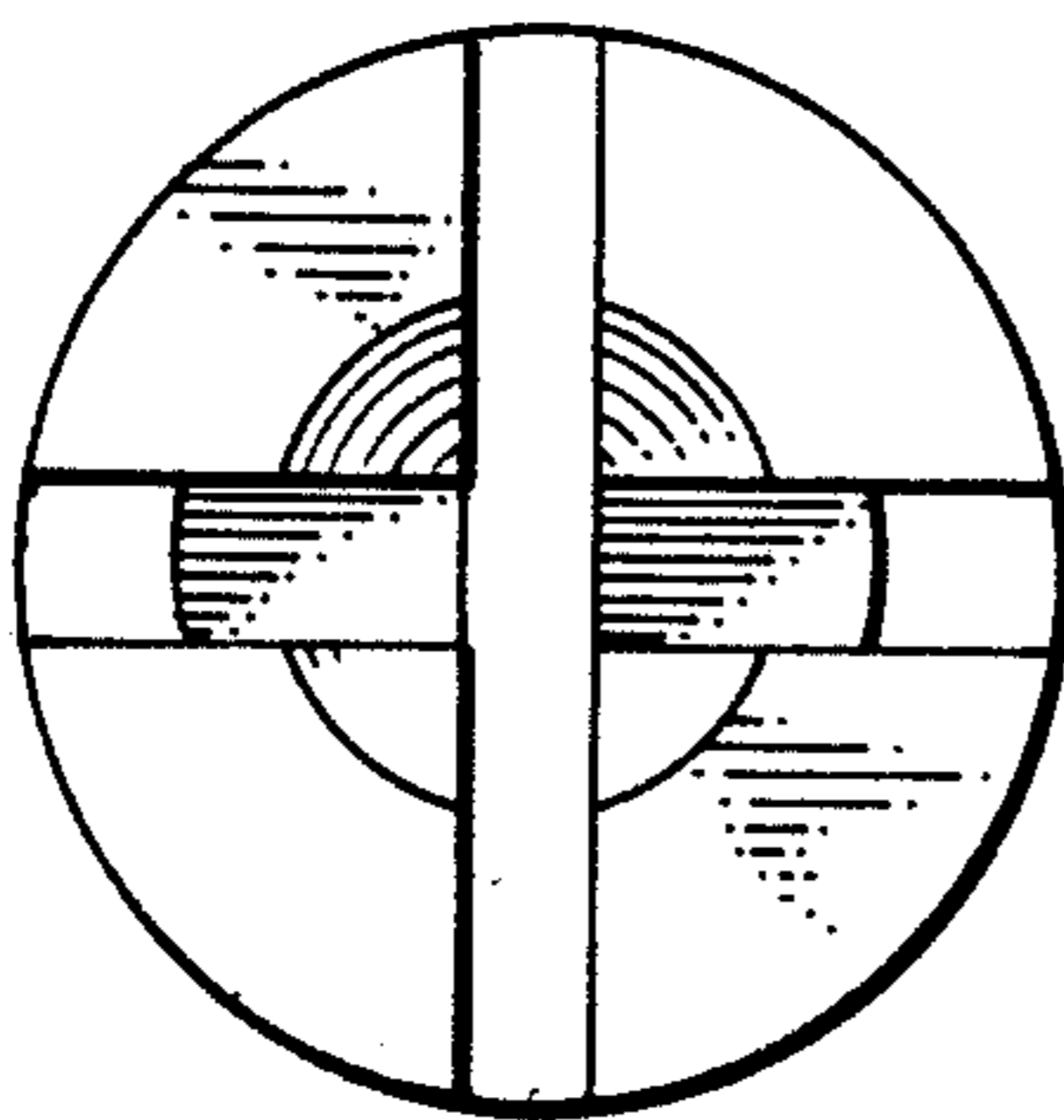

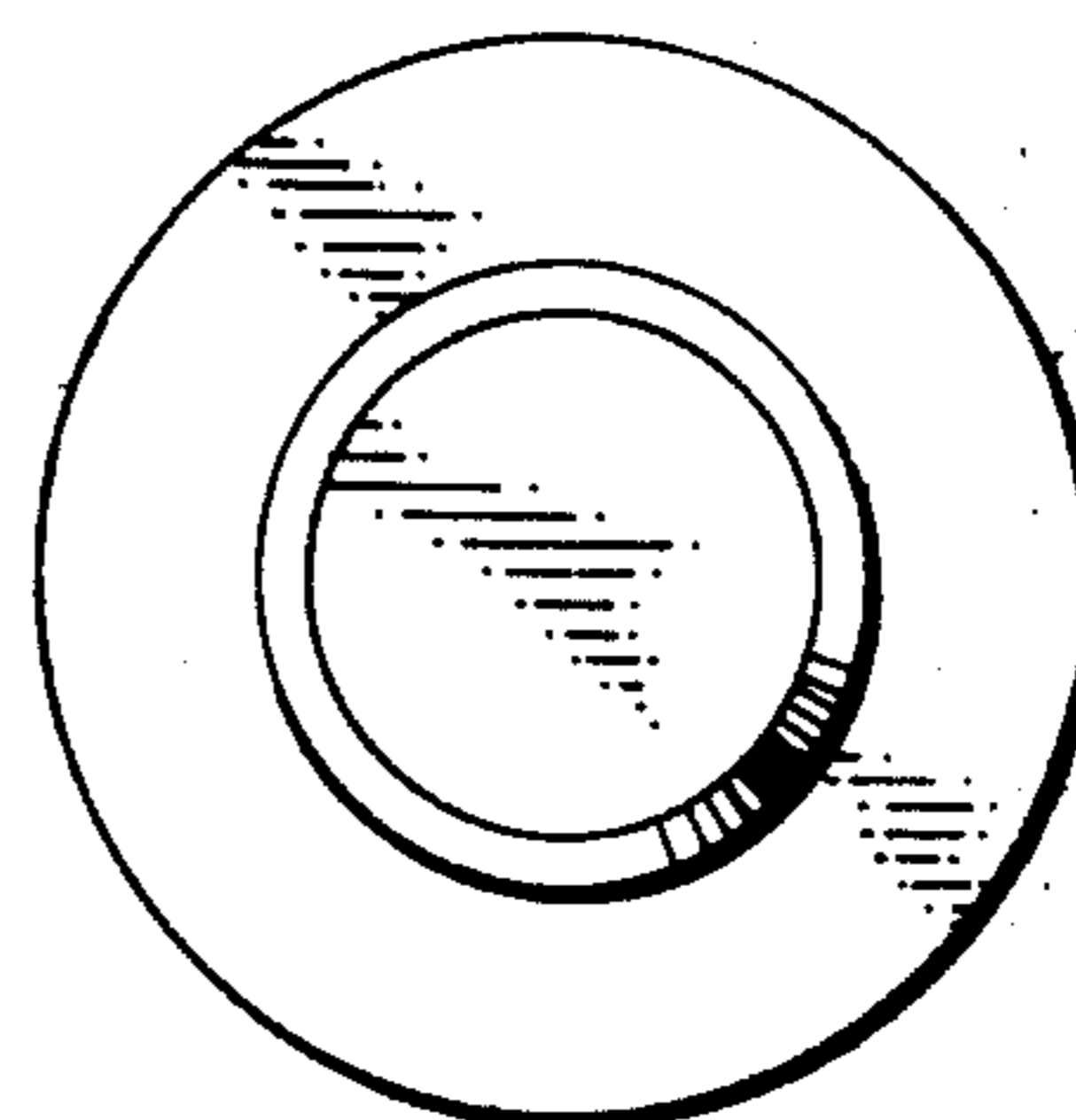
