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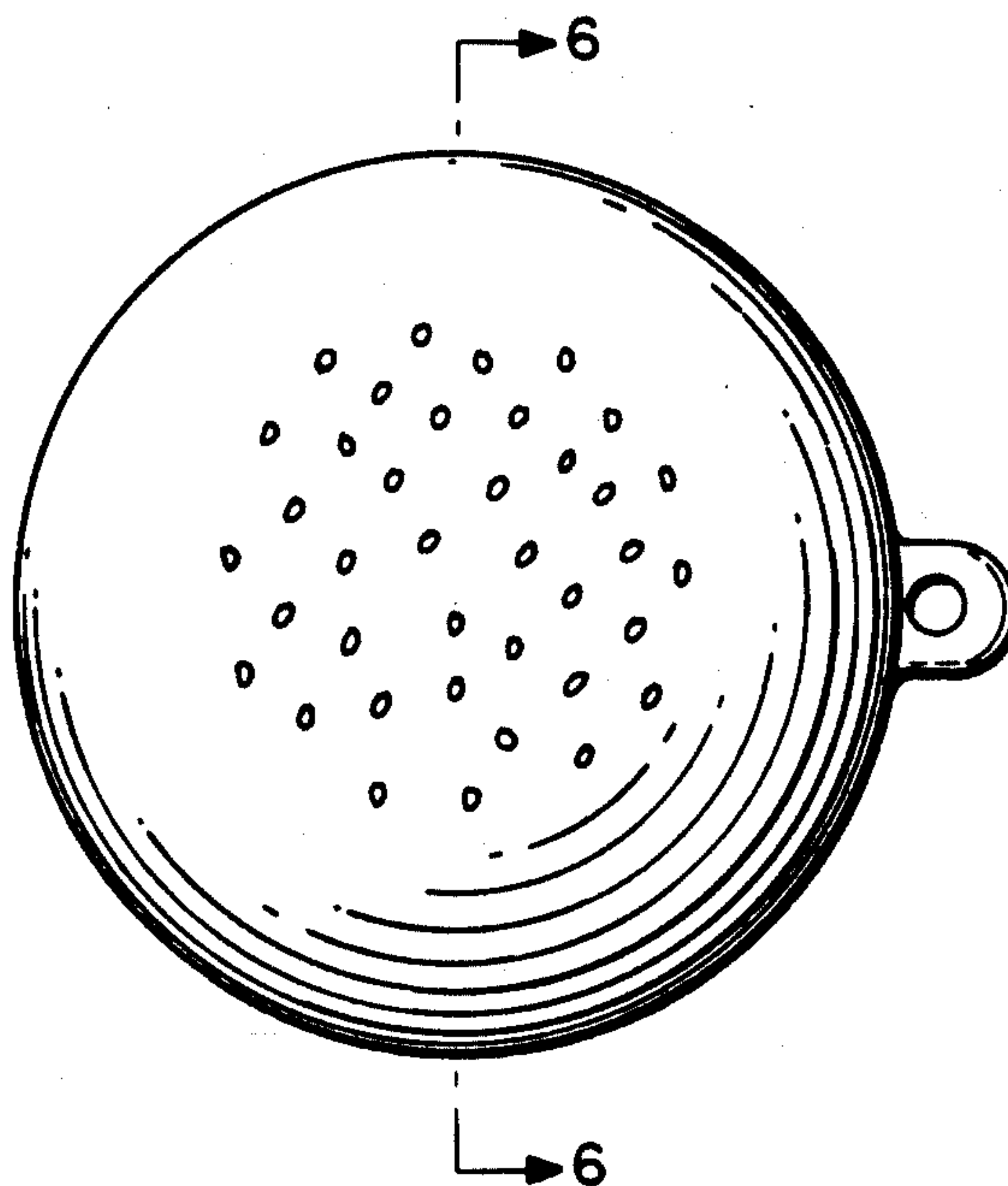
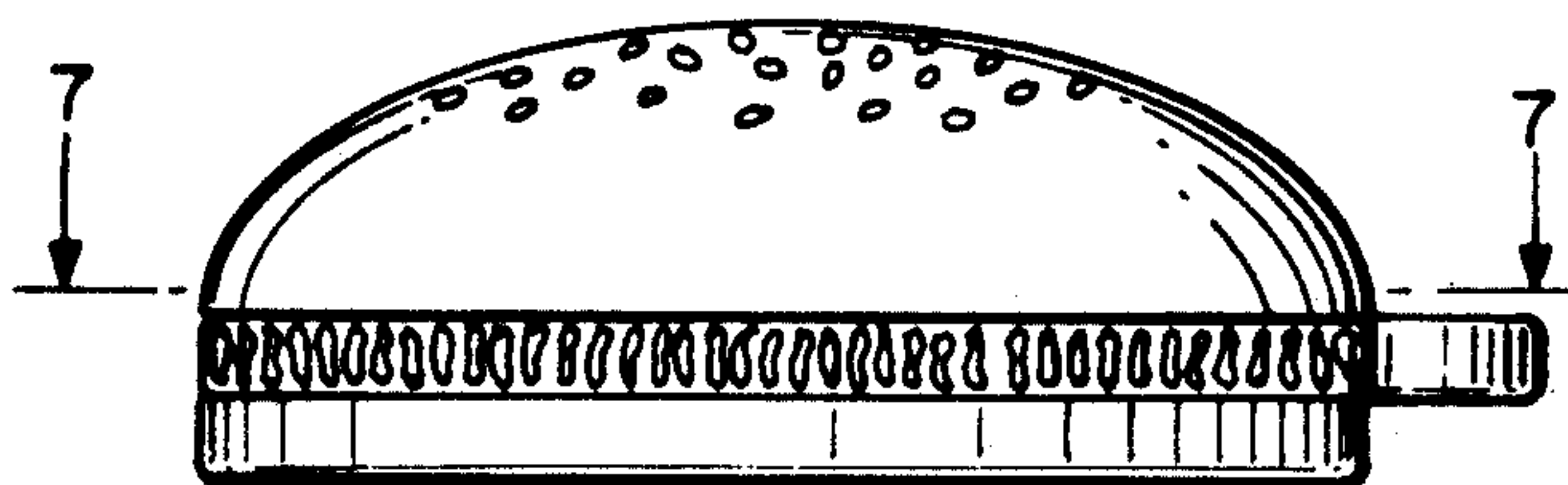
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a key chain fob showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1.



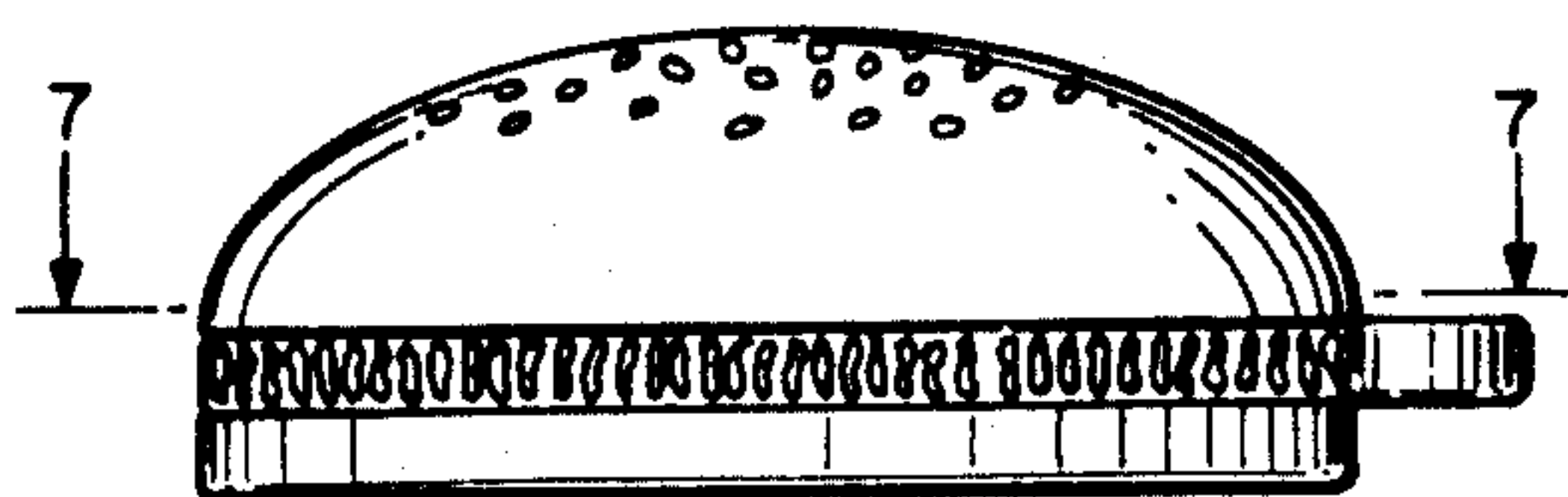

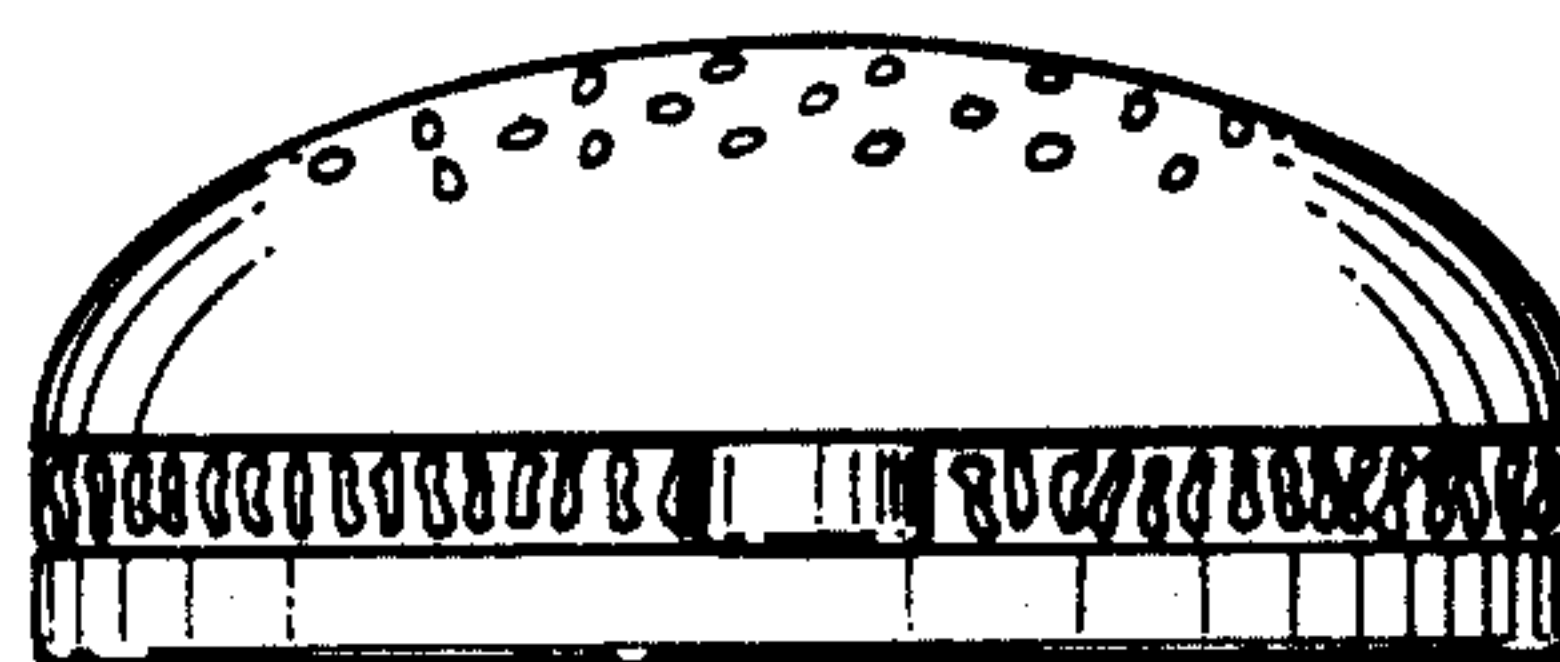

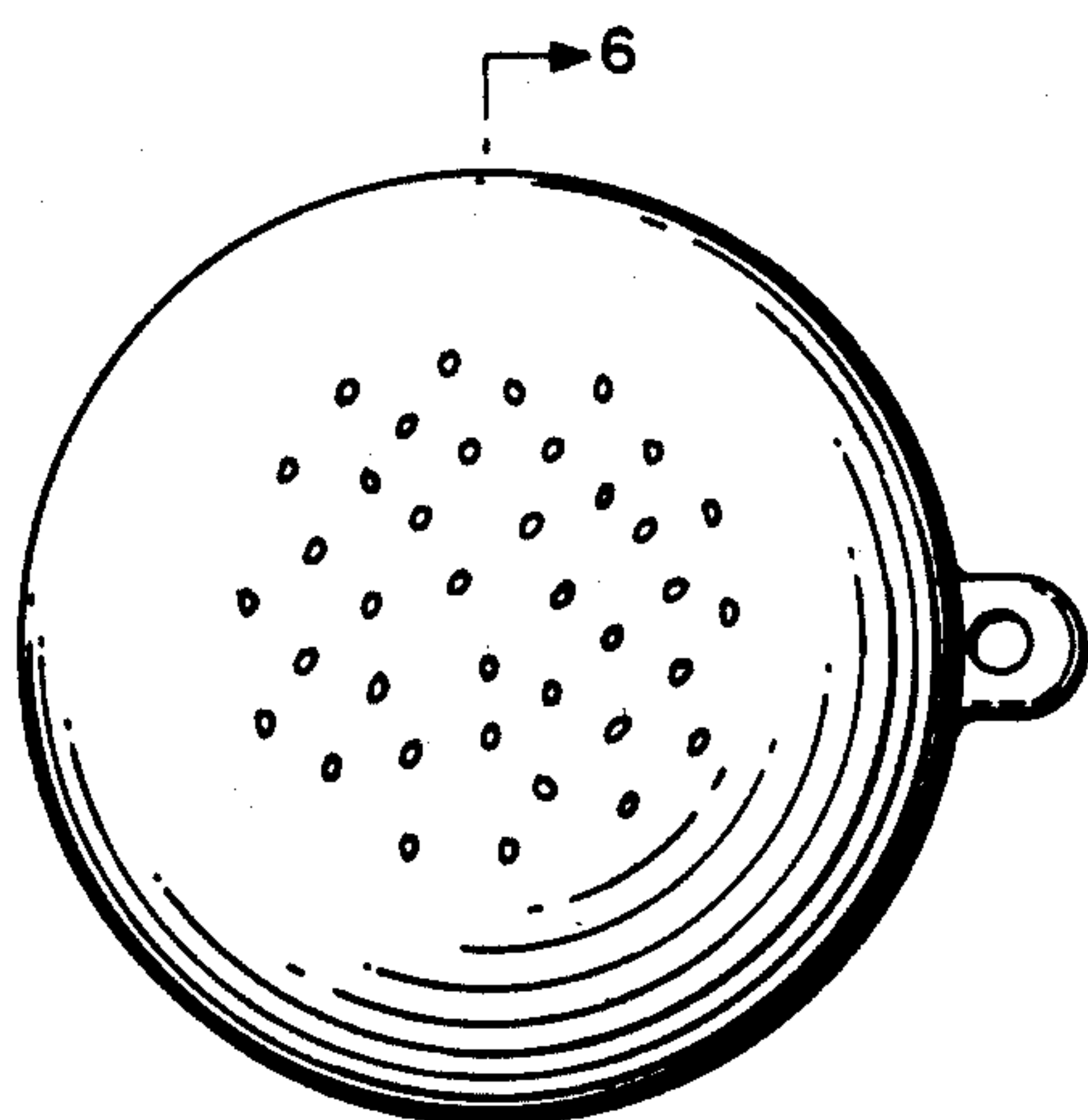

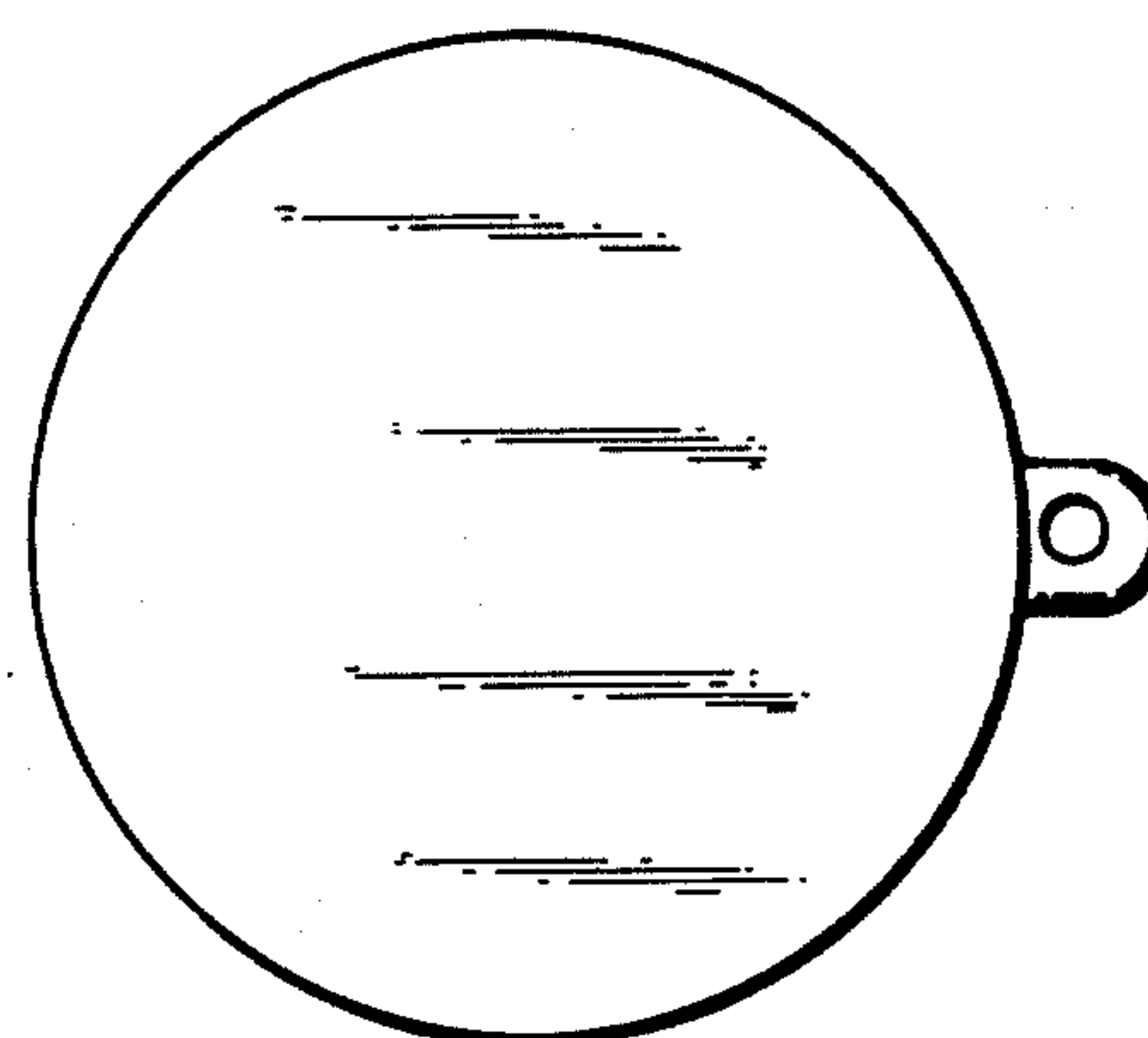

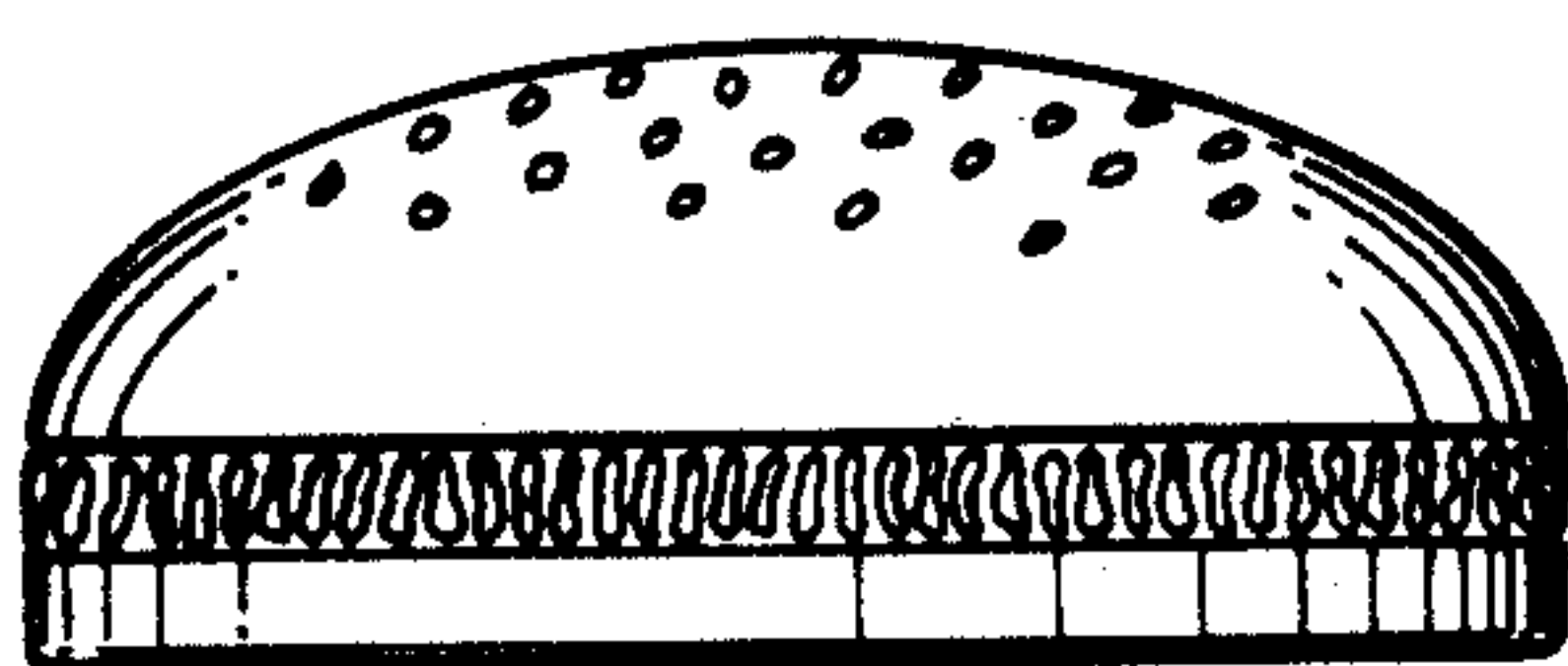

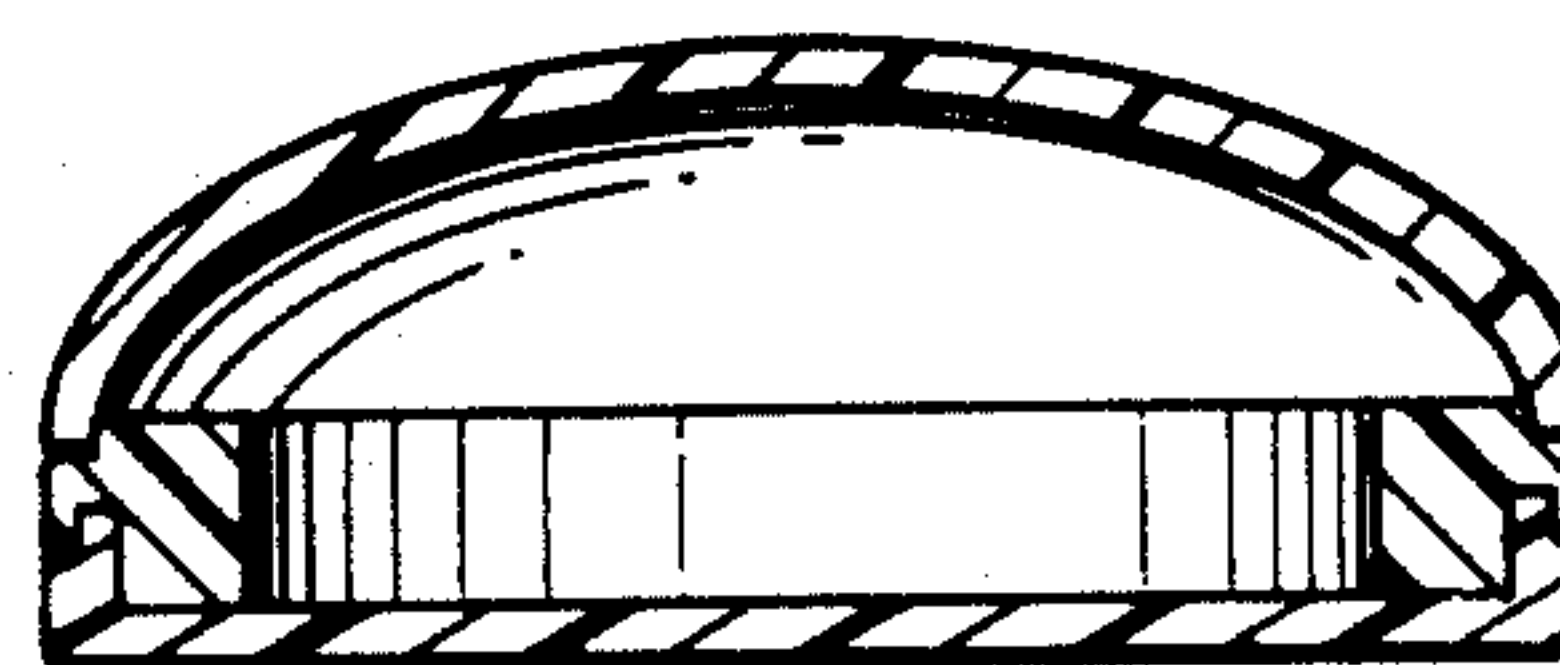

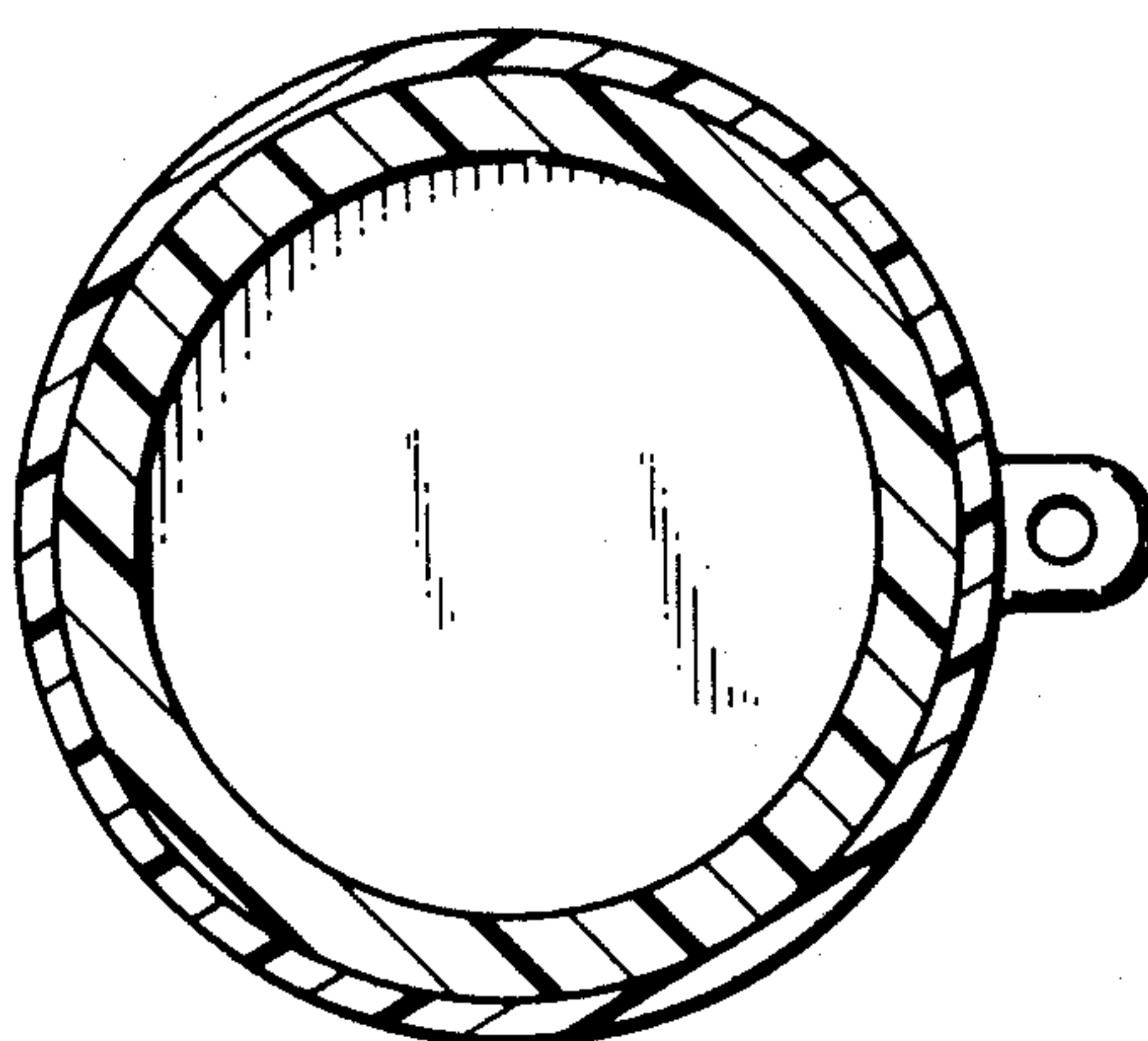
