FIG. 6 is the other end view of the tubing cutter.

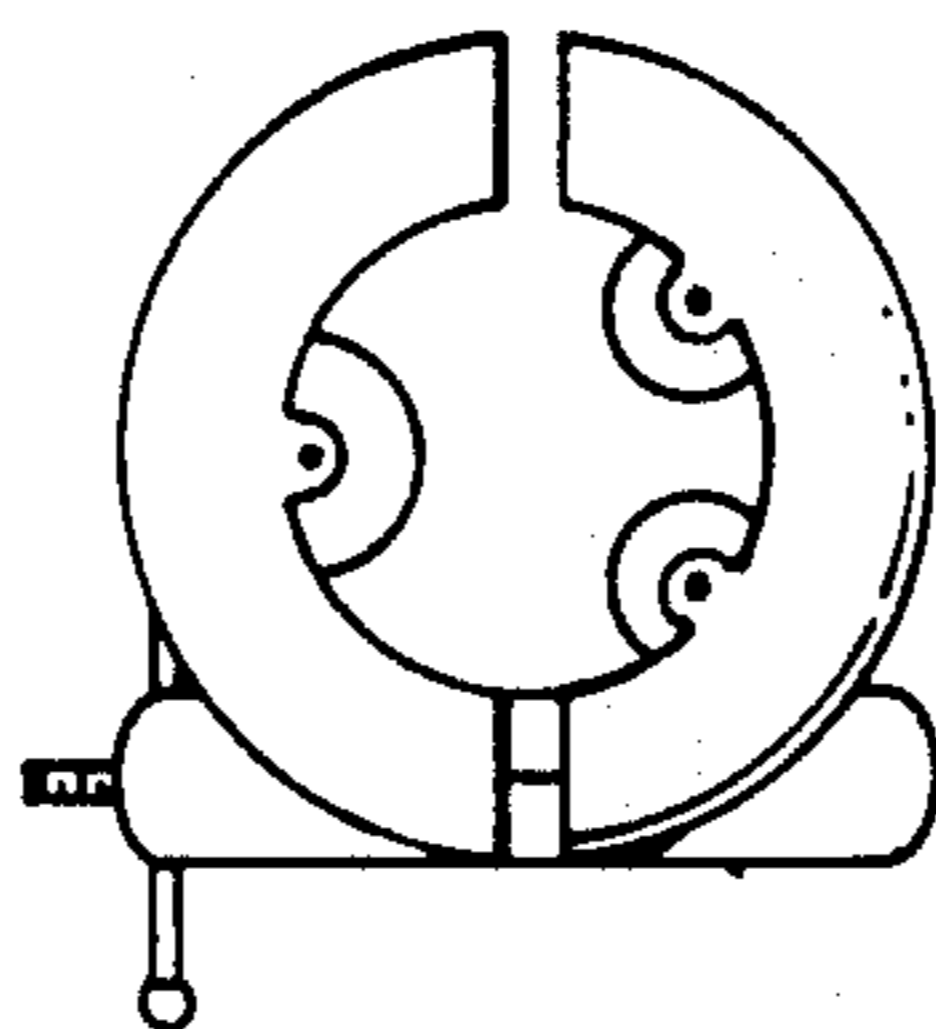
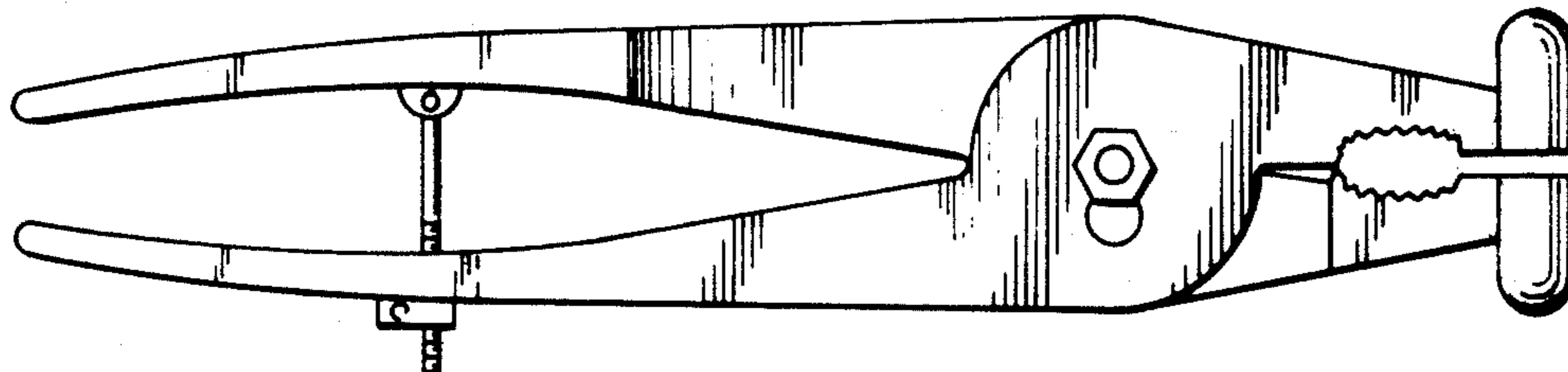

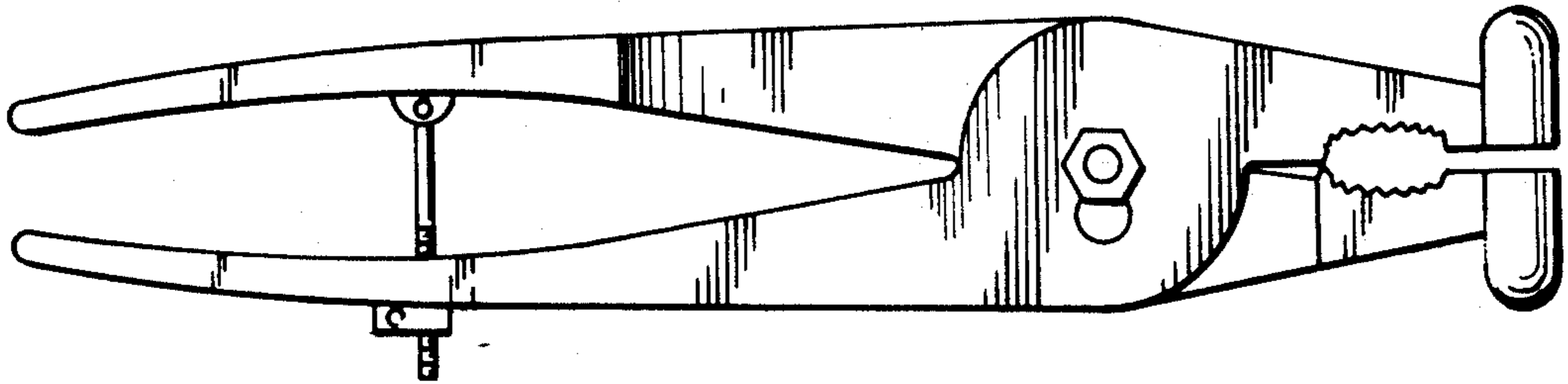

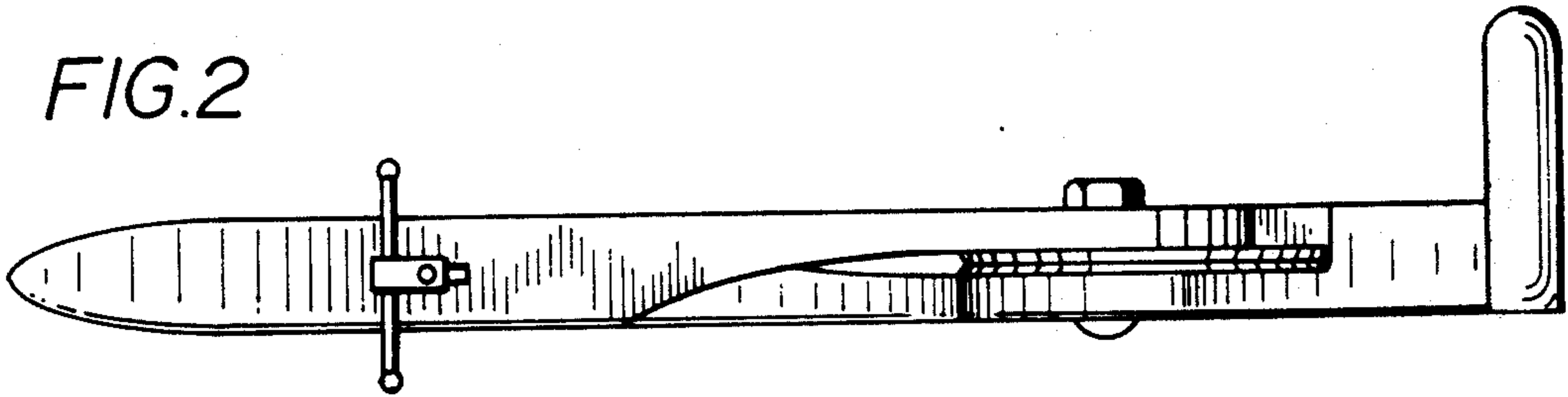

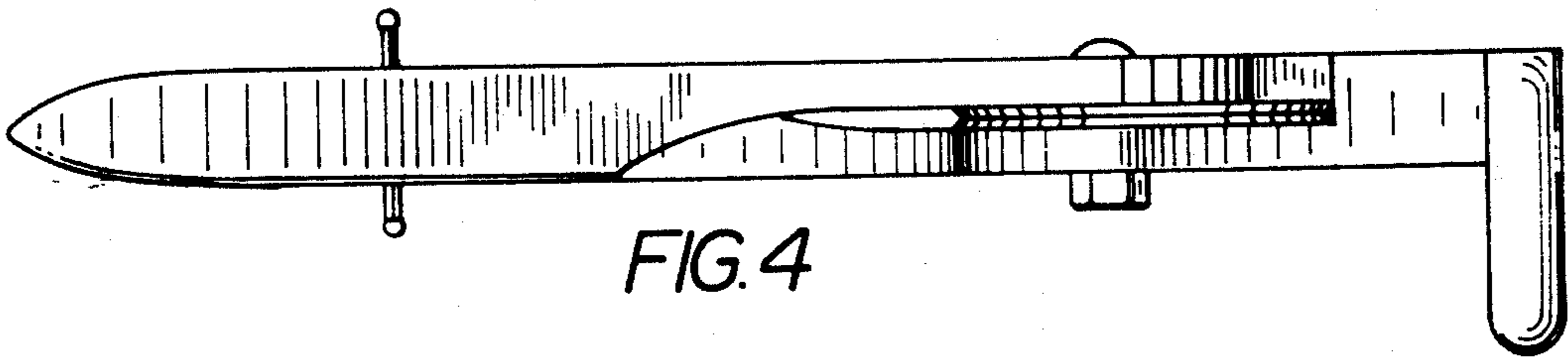
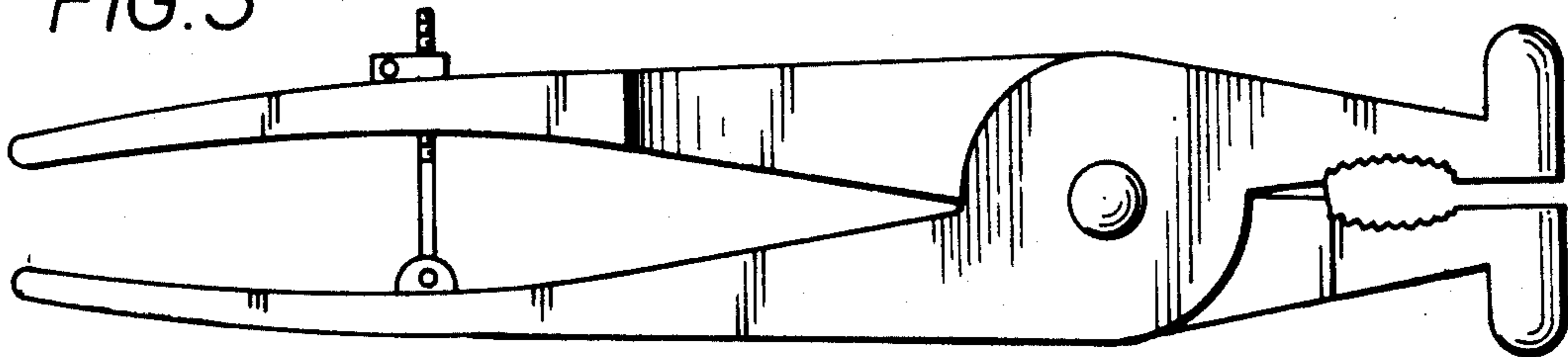

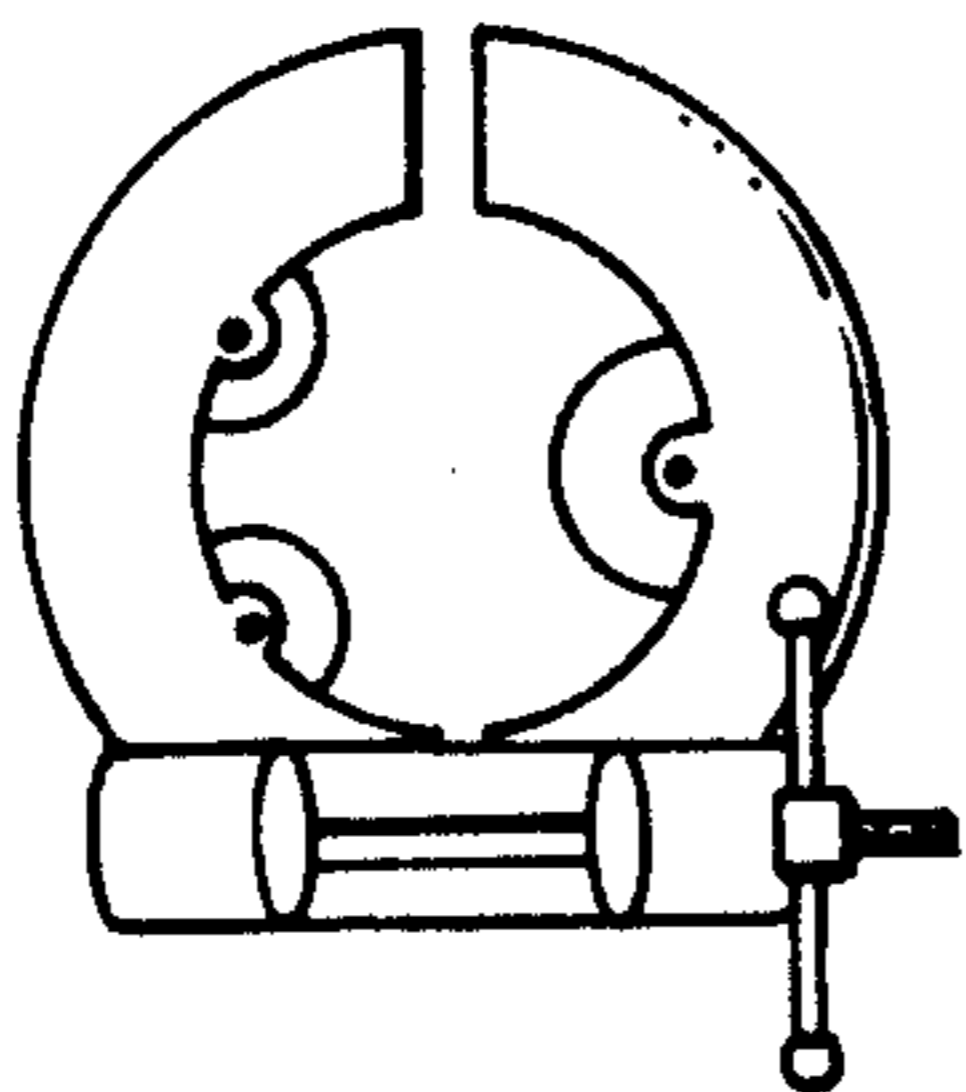
