DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevation view of the fence.


FIG. 2 is a section view of the fence taken on line 2—2 in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged view of the portion of the fence illustrated in FIG. 1, substantially within the circle in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a section view of the fence illustrated in FIG. 1, taken substantially on the line 4—4 in FIG. 3.

FIG. 5 is a section view of the fence illustrated in FIG. 1, taken substantially on the line 5—5 in FIG. 3.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the fence coupling member shown in FIGS. 1 through 4.






