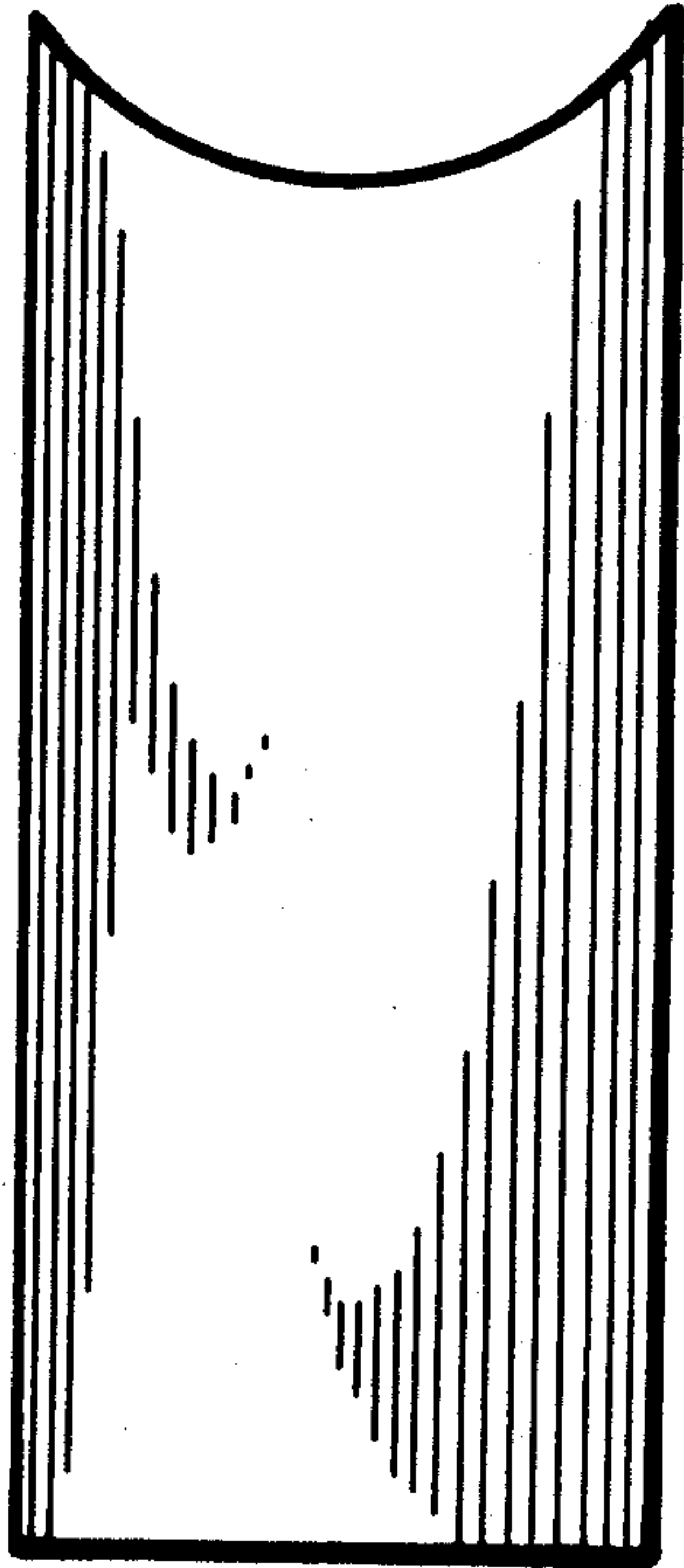

FIG. 1 is a front view of a queen chess piece showing my new design; and

The side views of the queen chess piece are identical to its front view illustrated in FIG. 1.



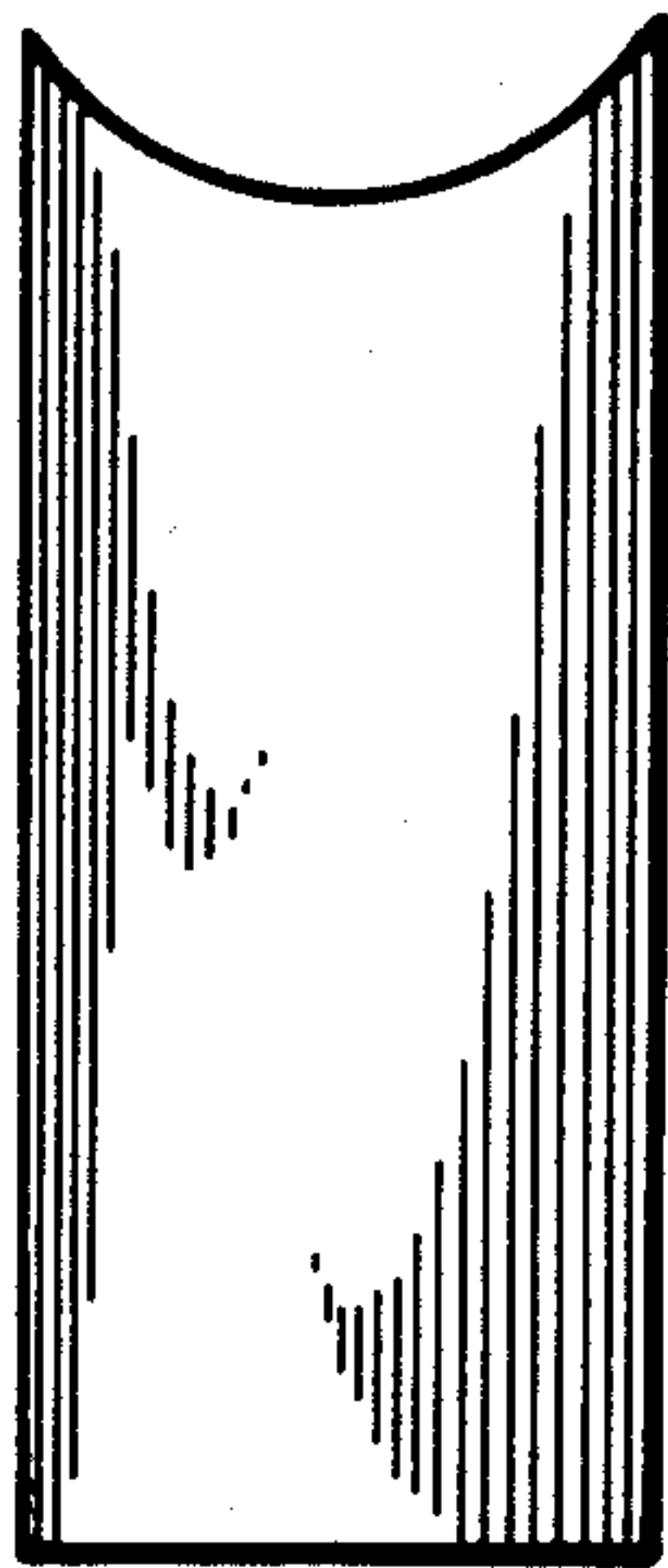
