FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the candy.

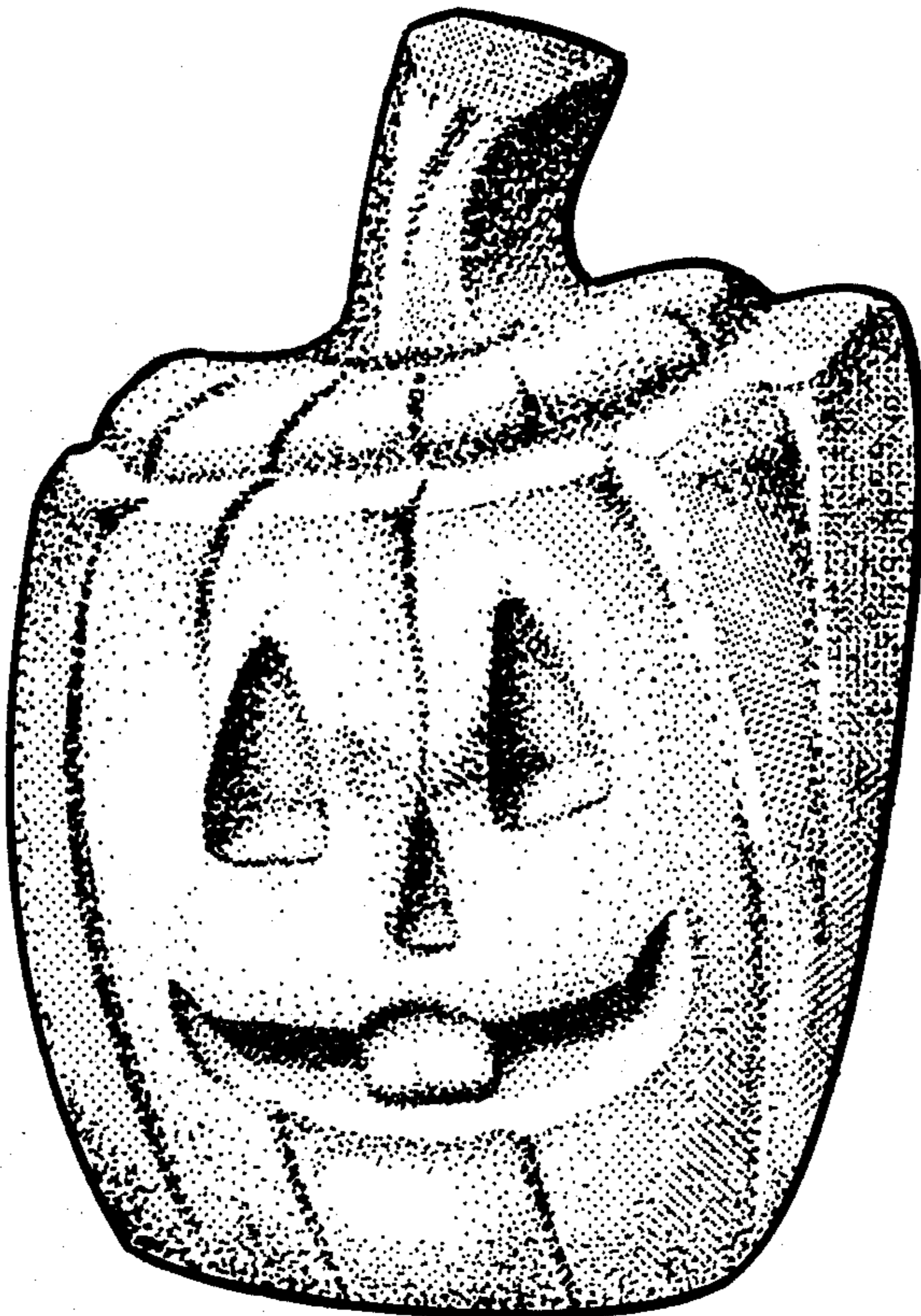

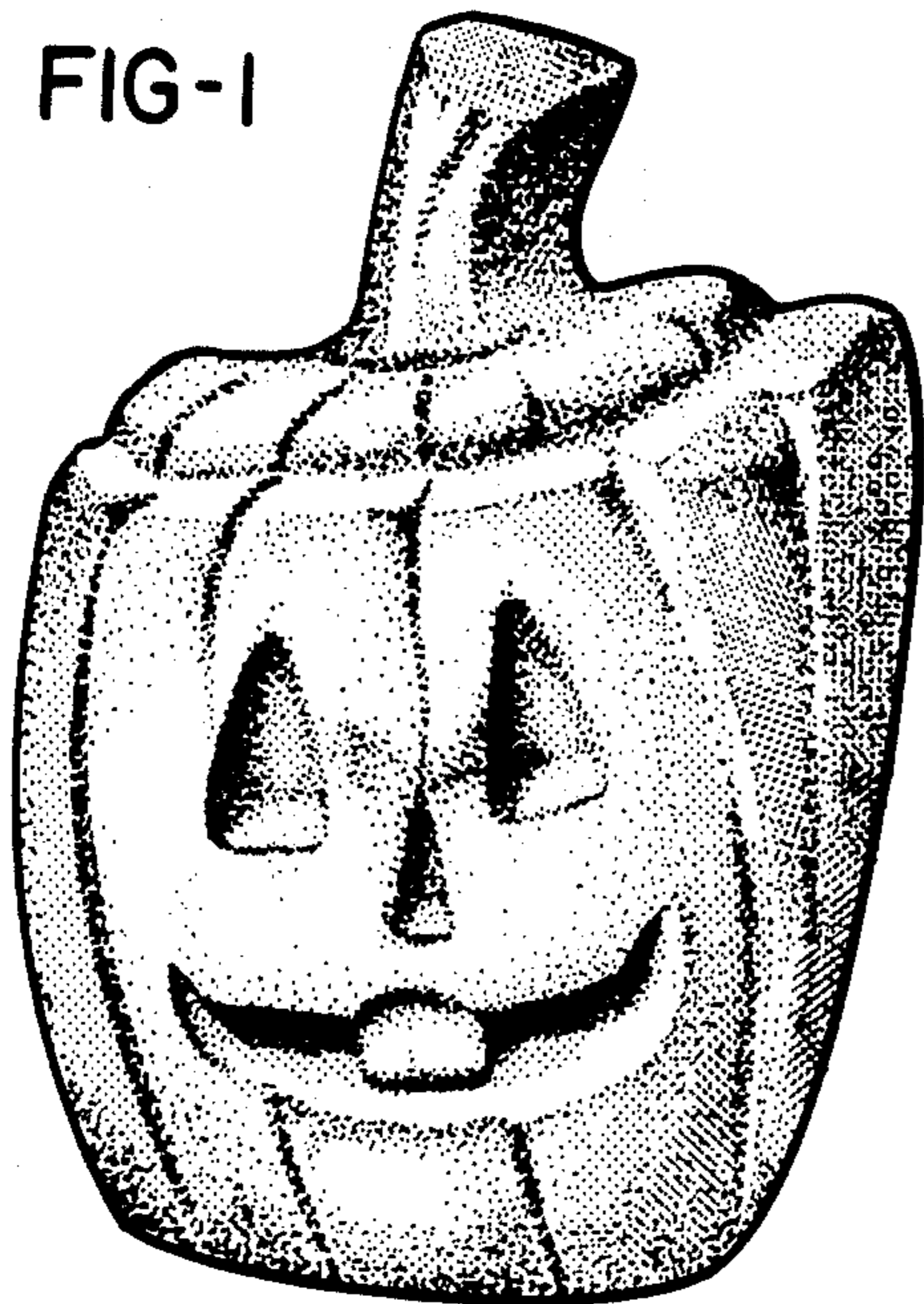

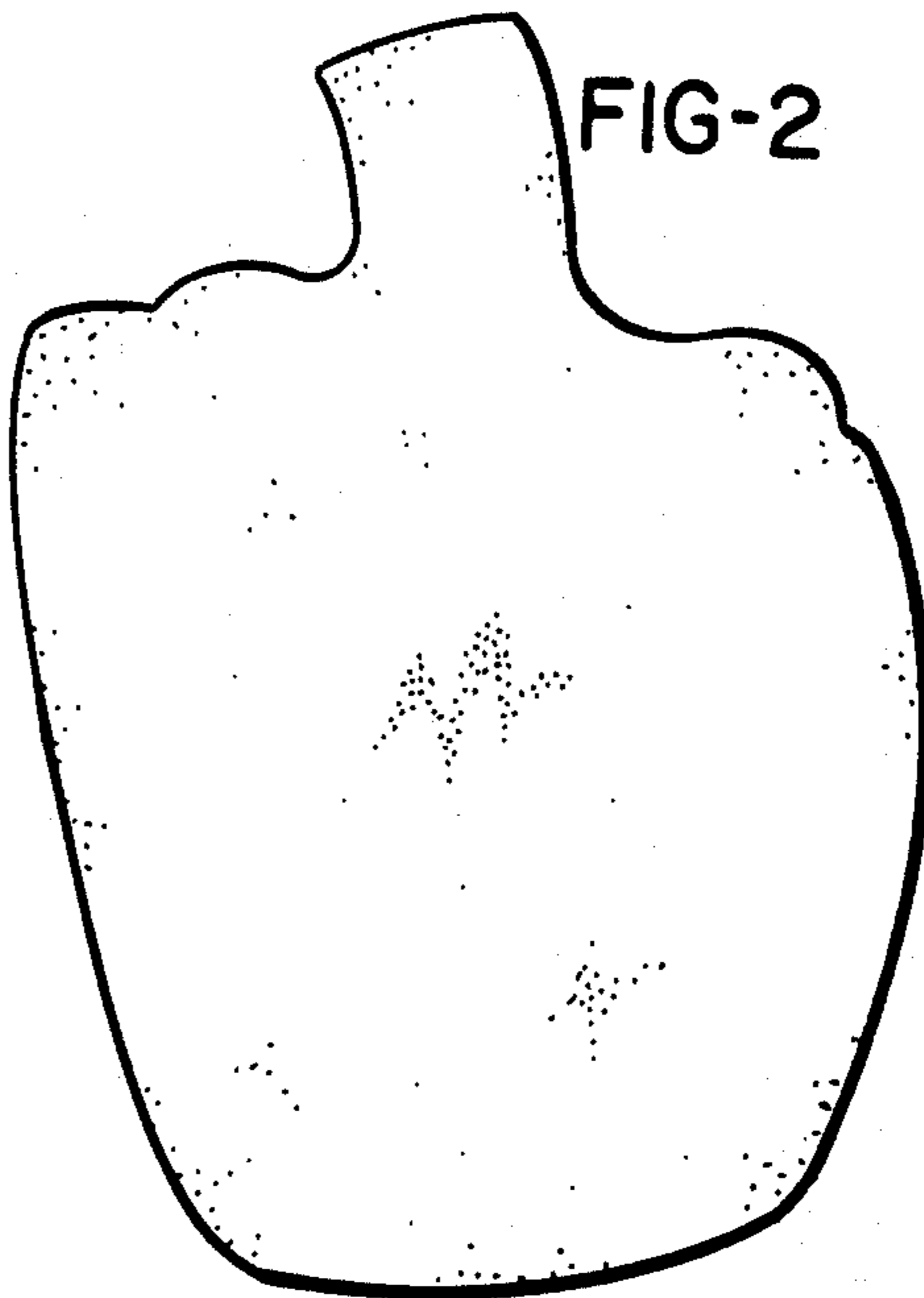

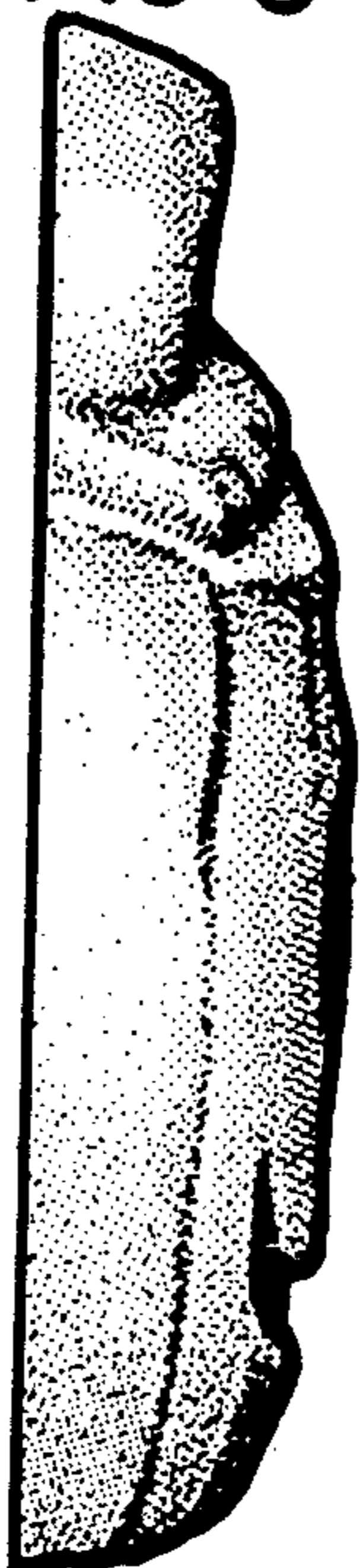
