The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

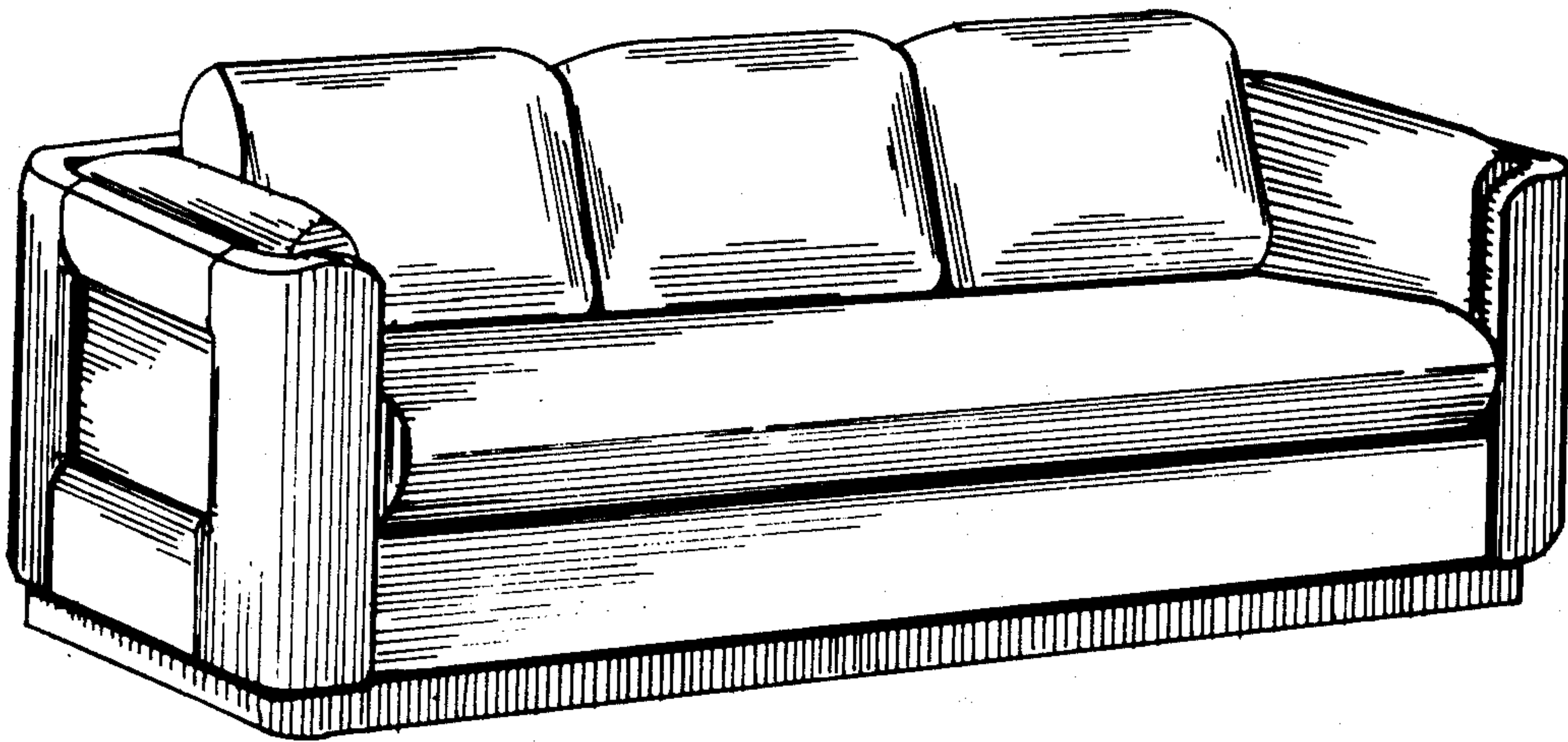
DESCRIPTION

The back of the seat is conventionally flat and unornamented.



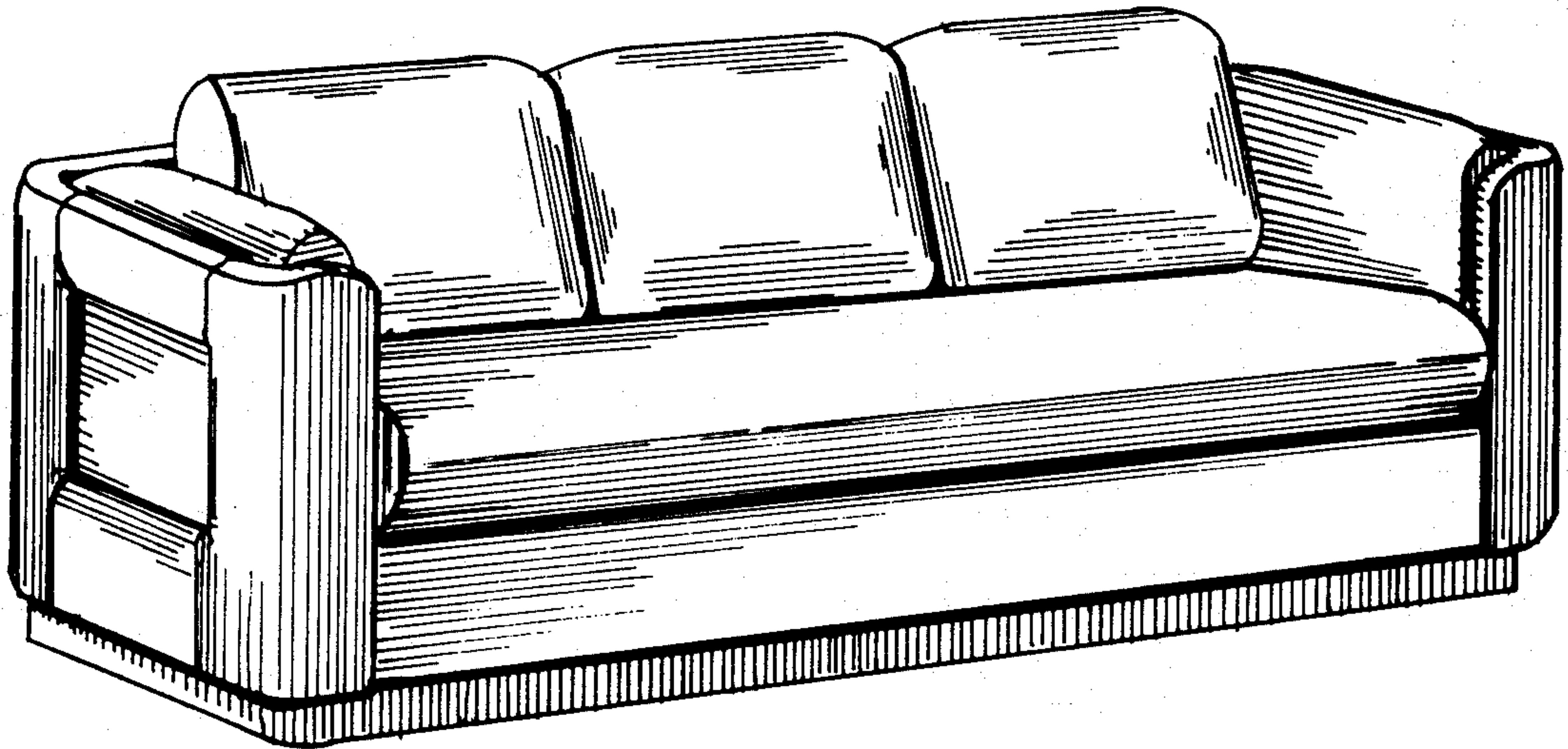

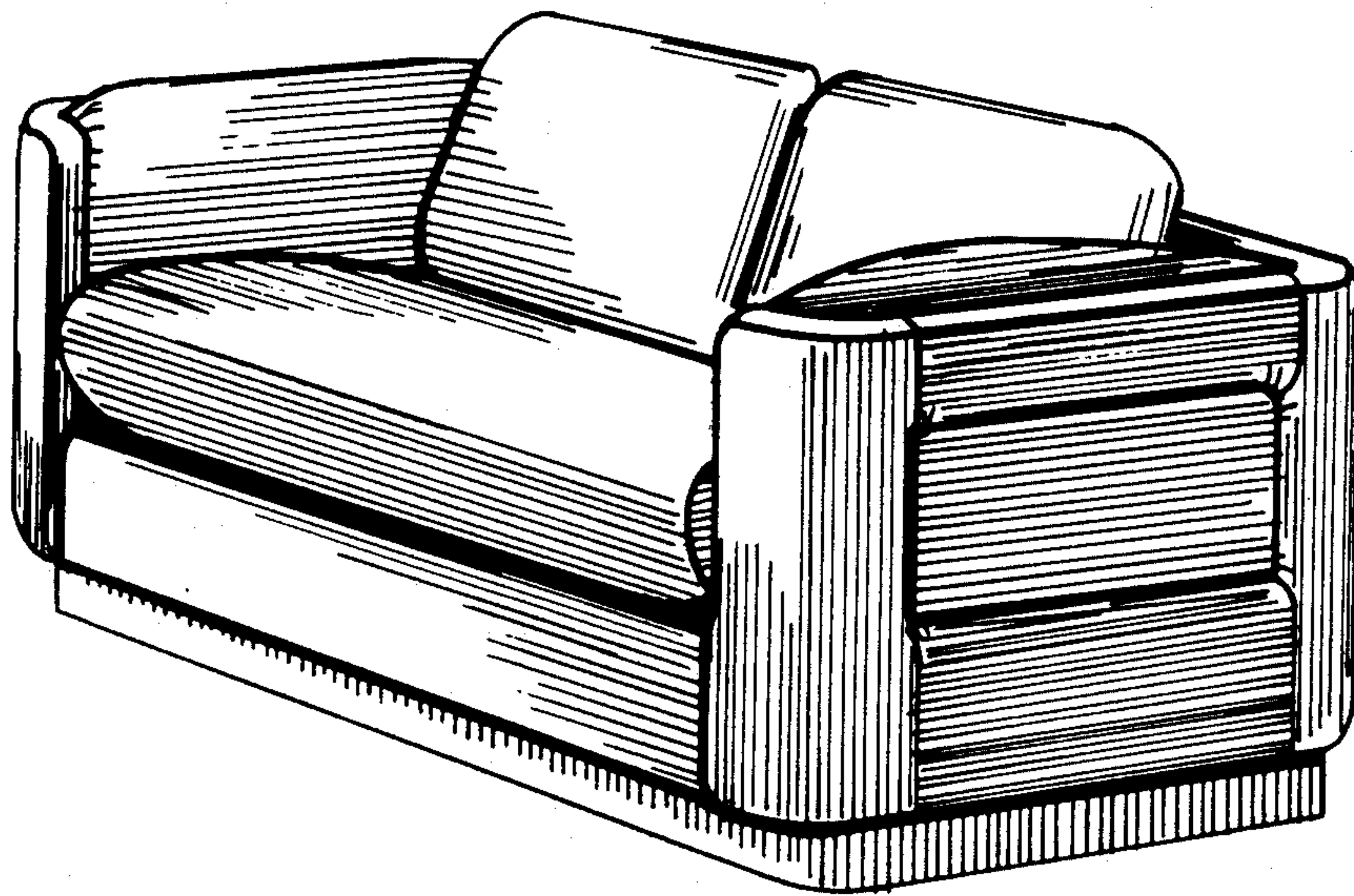

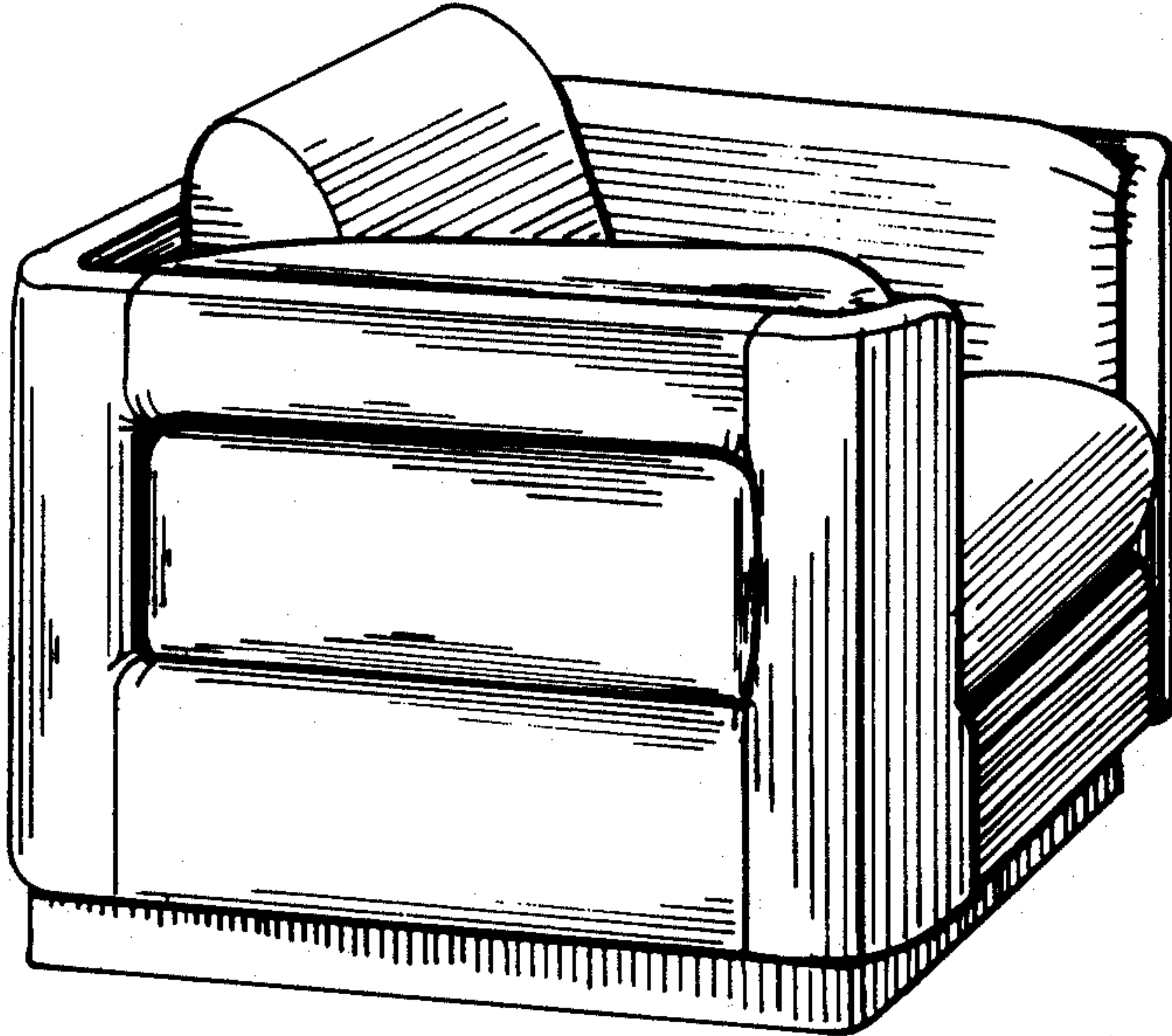
