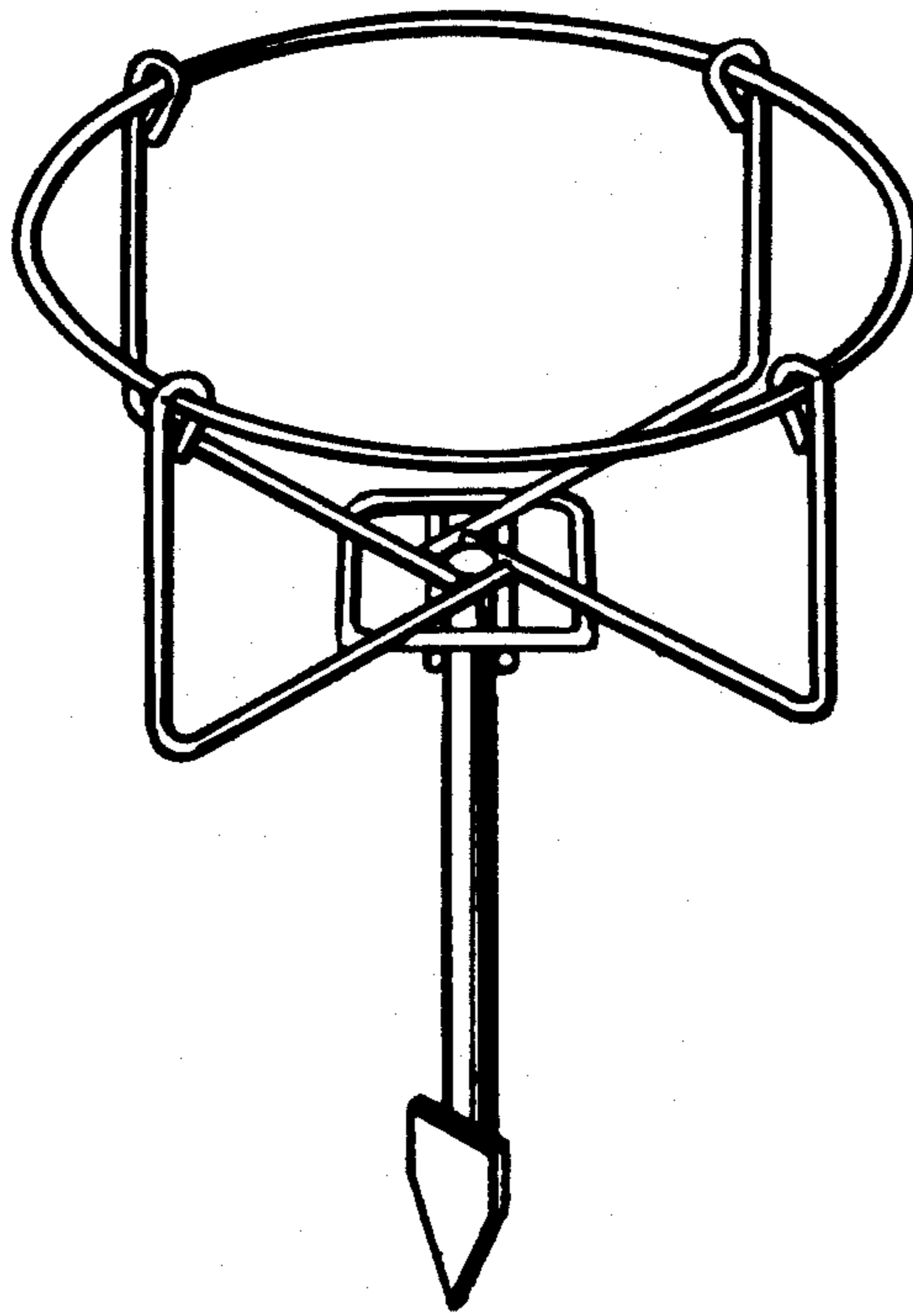

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pedestal type garbage can holder showing my new design. FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.



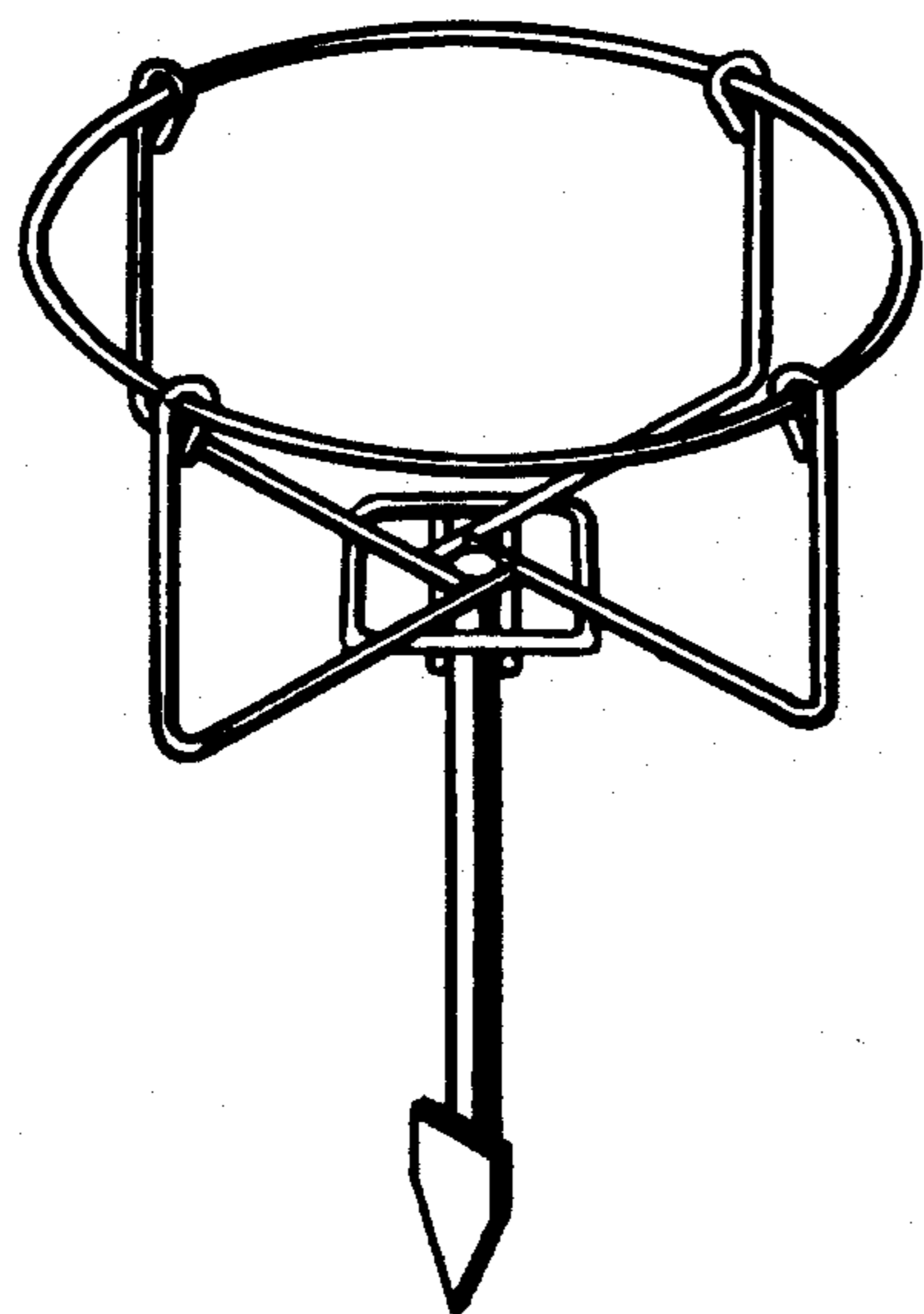

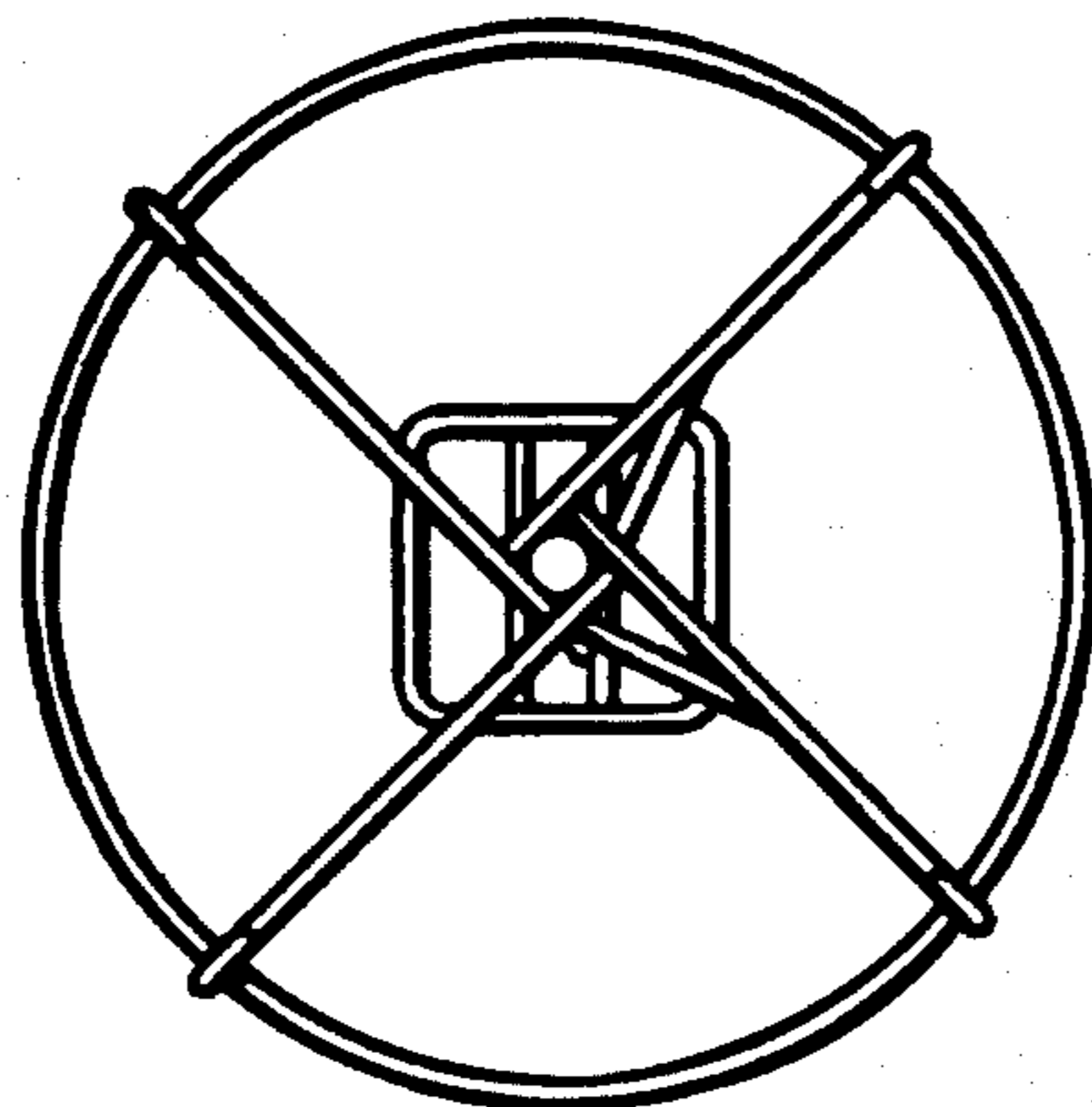
