FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.

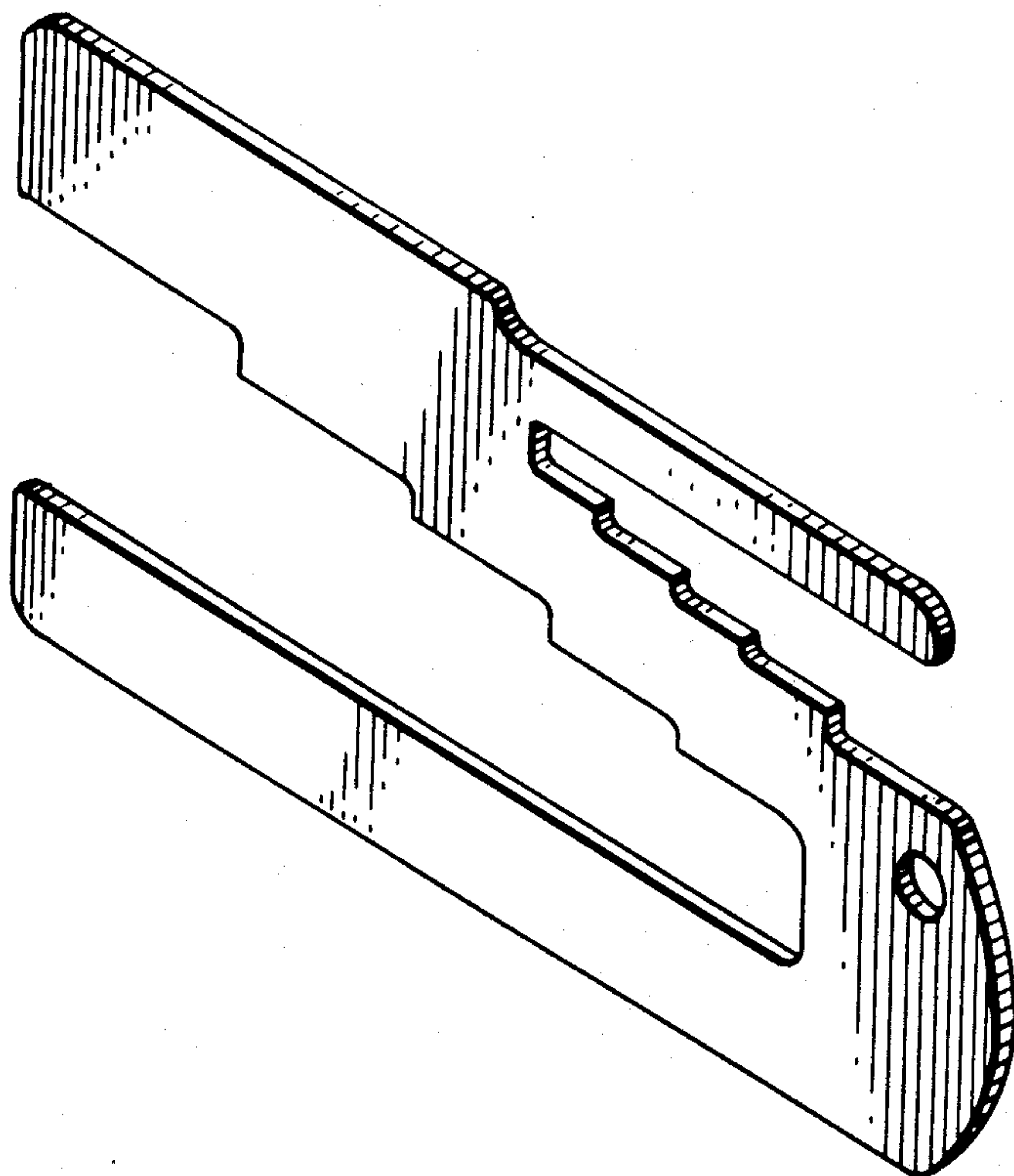

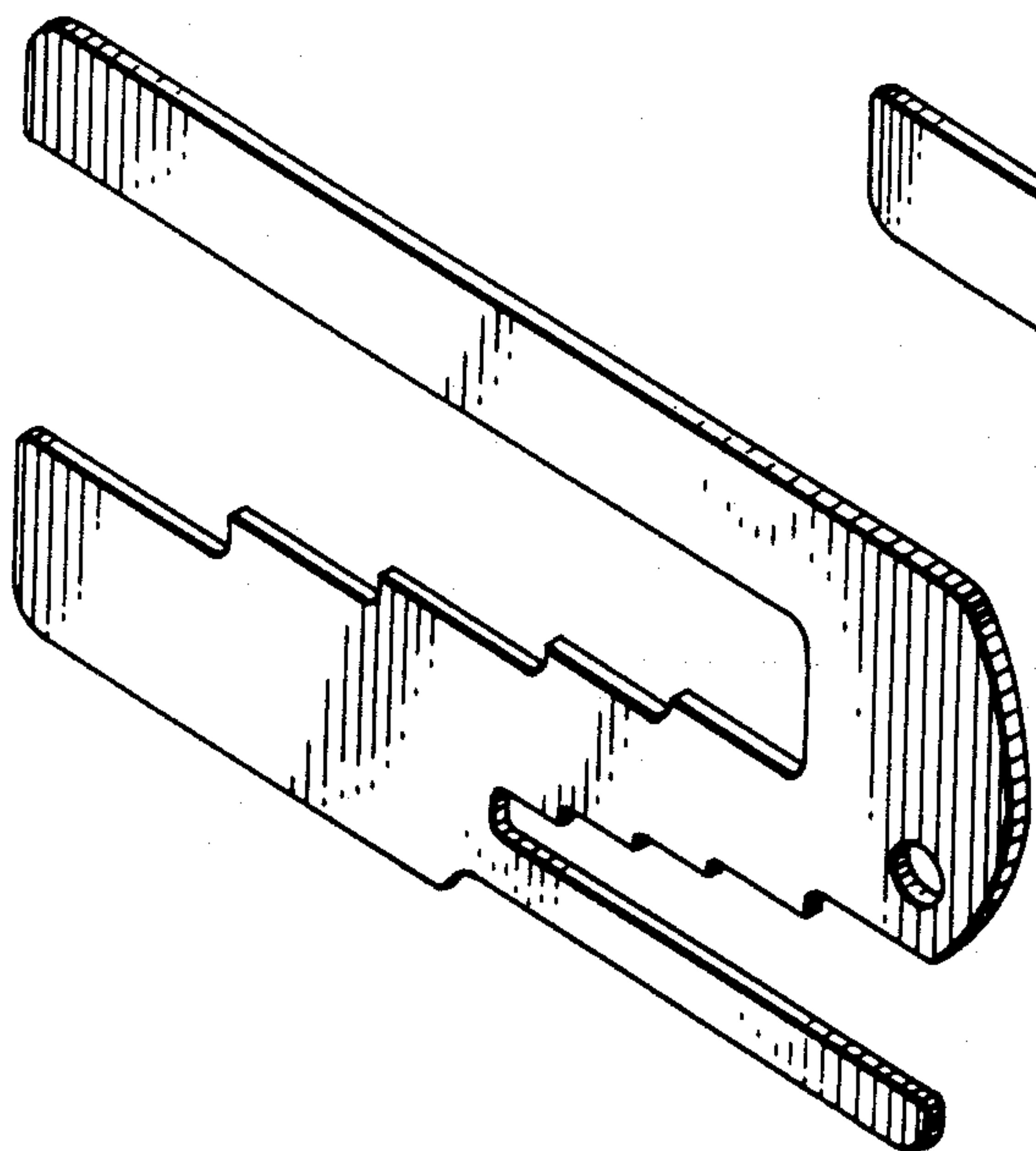

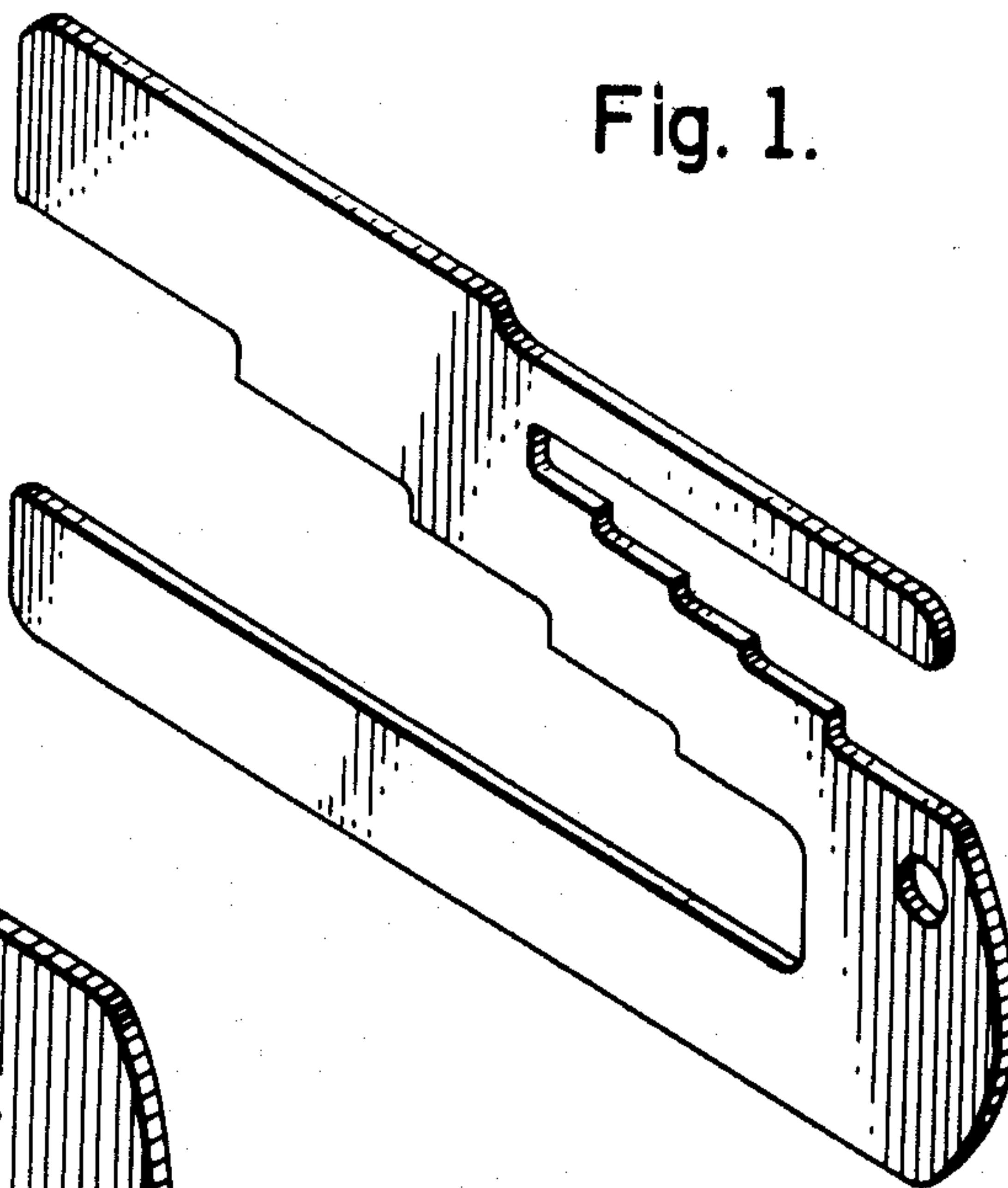

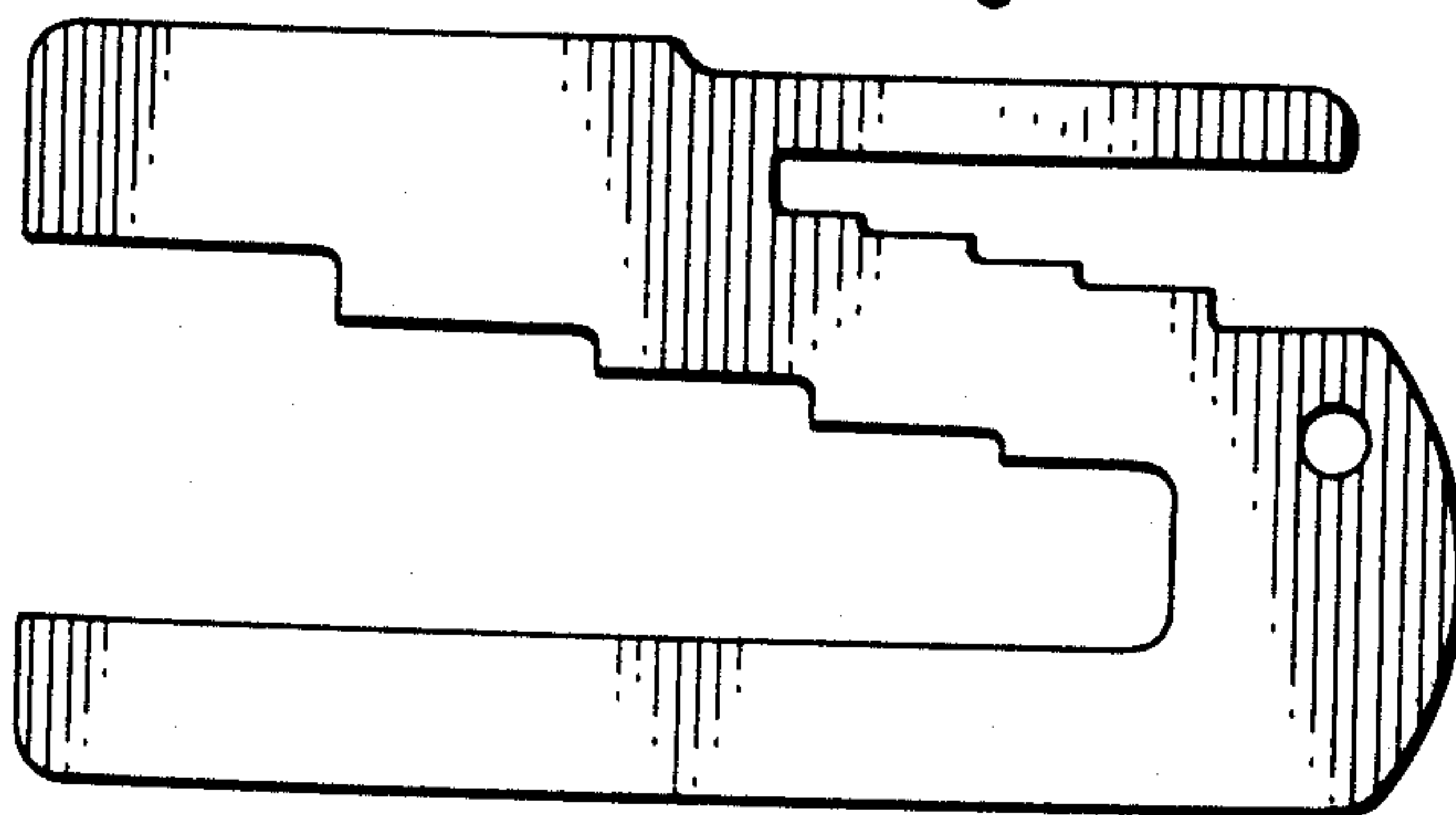
