[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tennis charm pendant or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

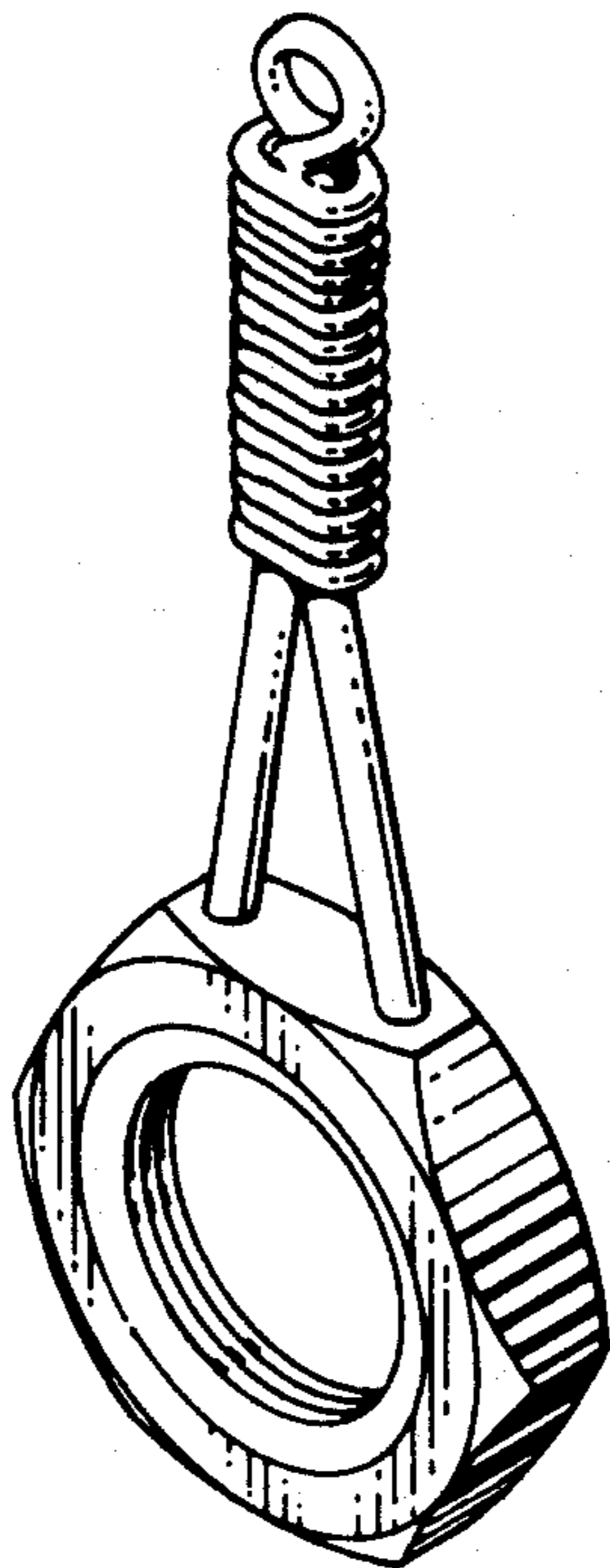

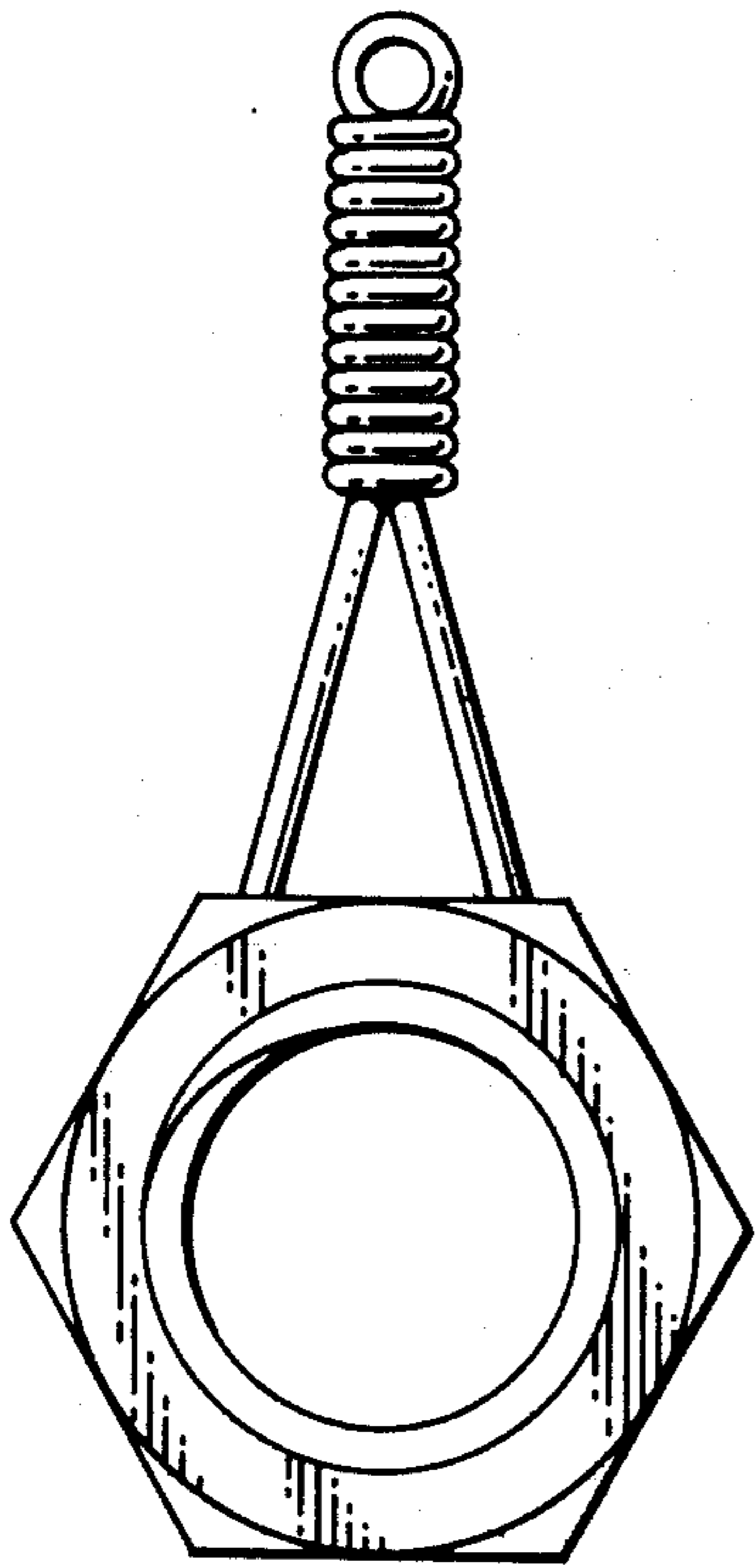

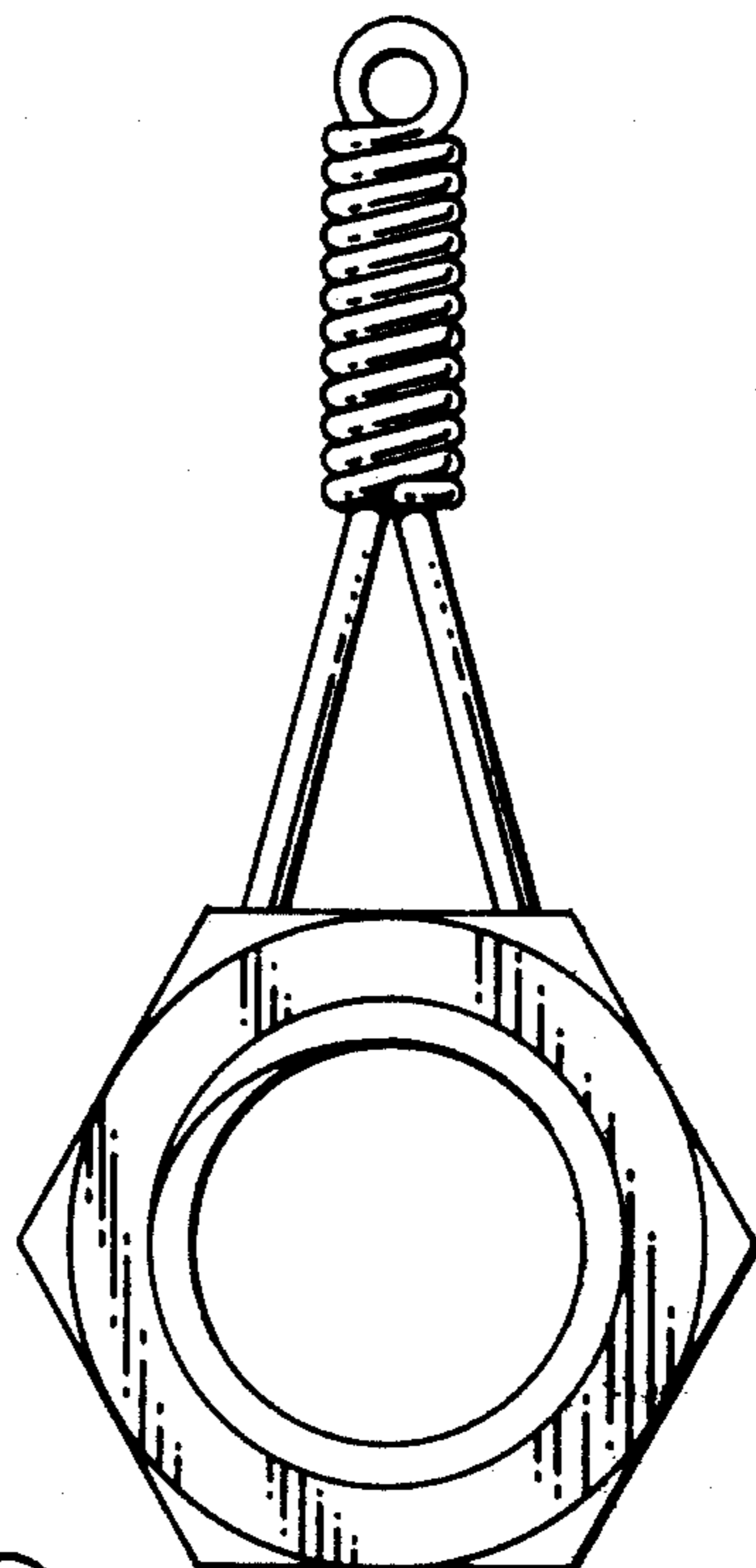

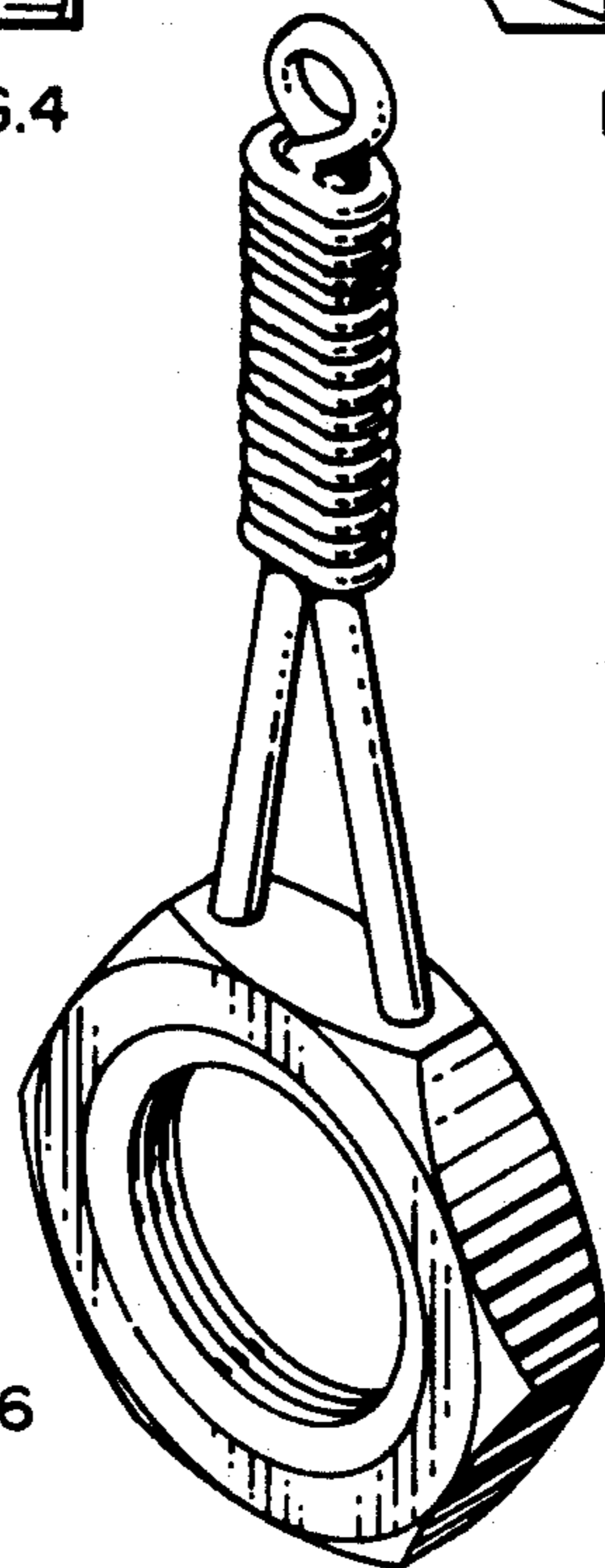
