FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a caddy for notions embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view.

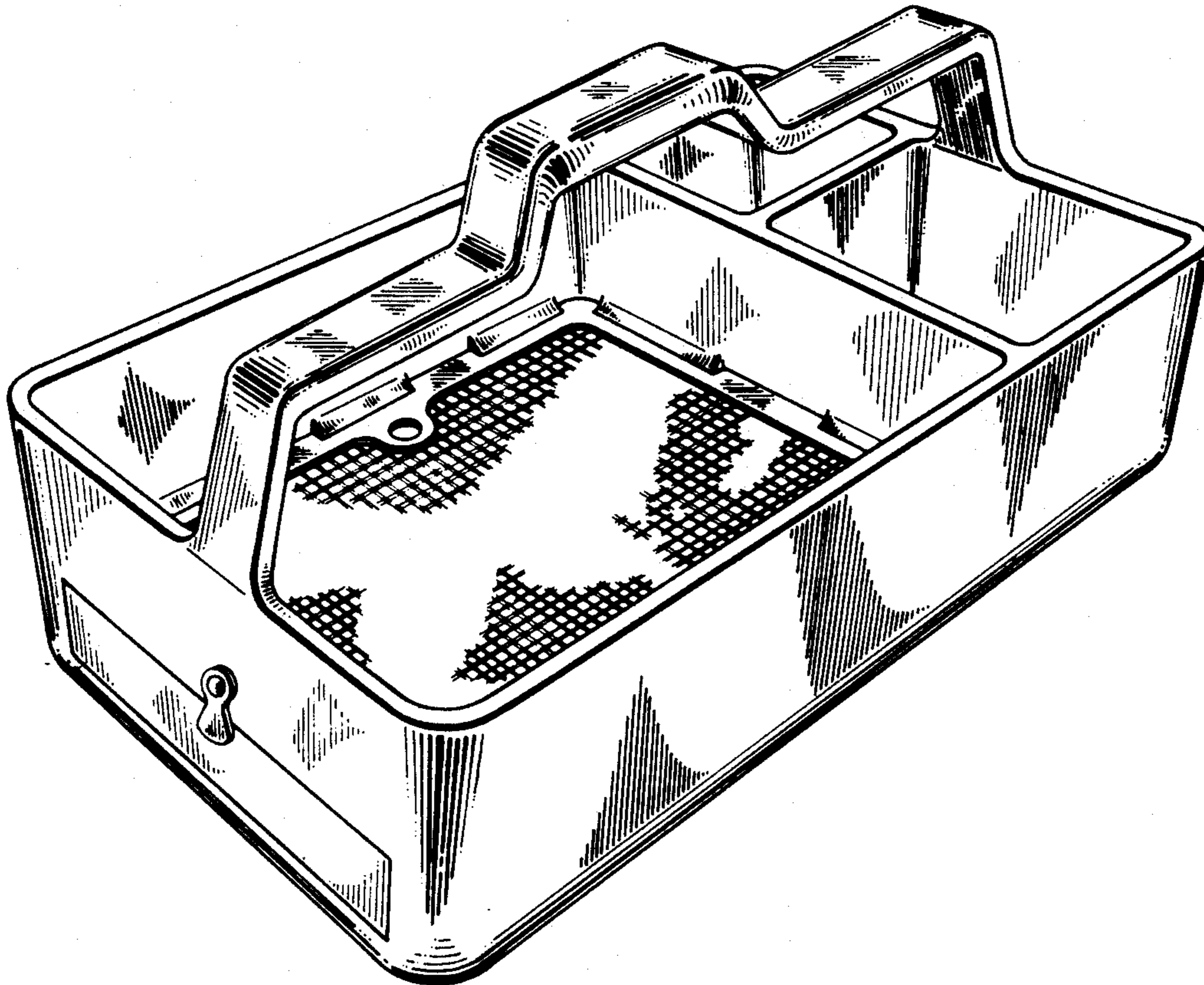
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

The partial showing of mesh at the bottom of the large compartment in FIGS. 1 and 2 is understood to be continuous within the boundaries shown.



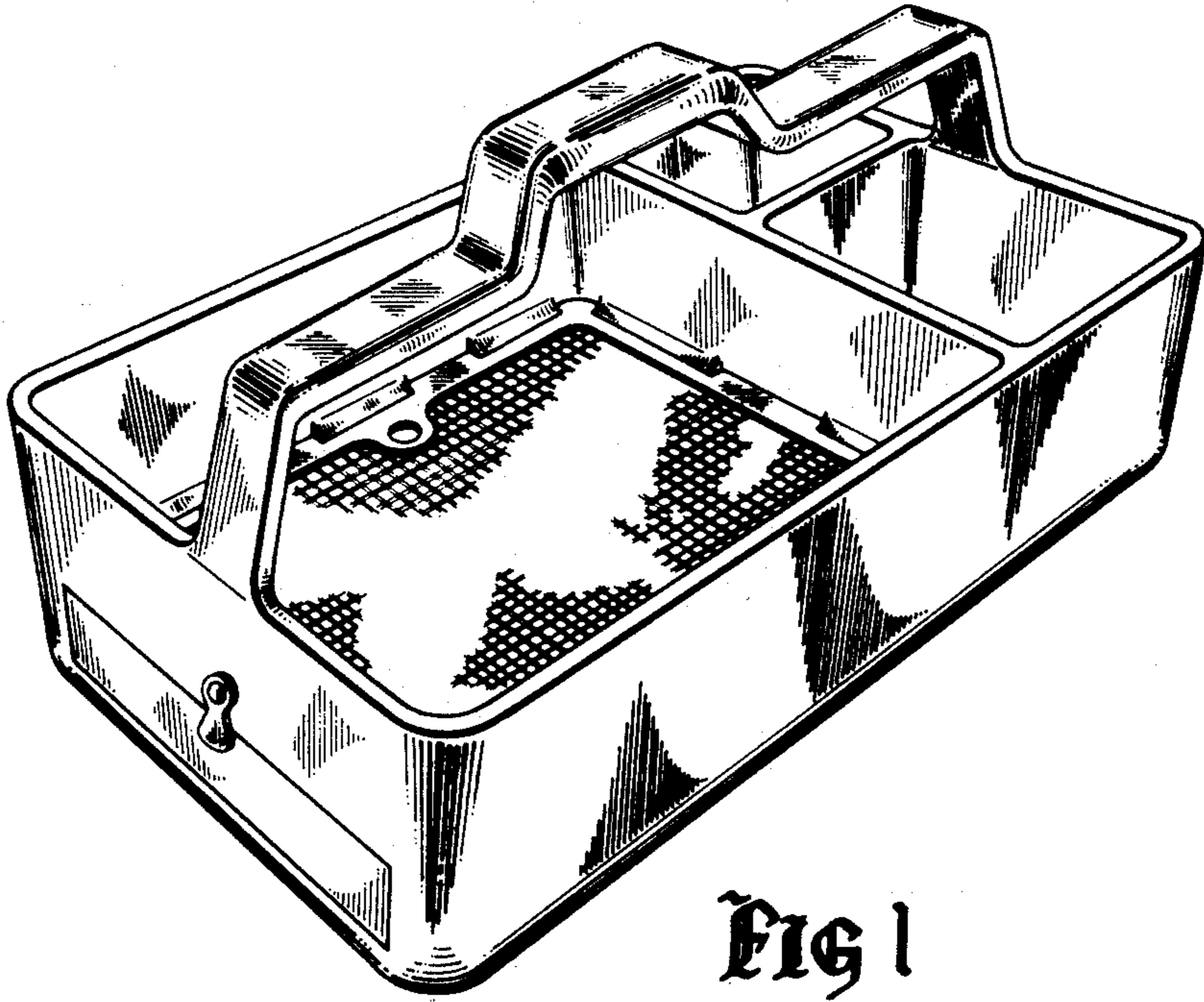

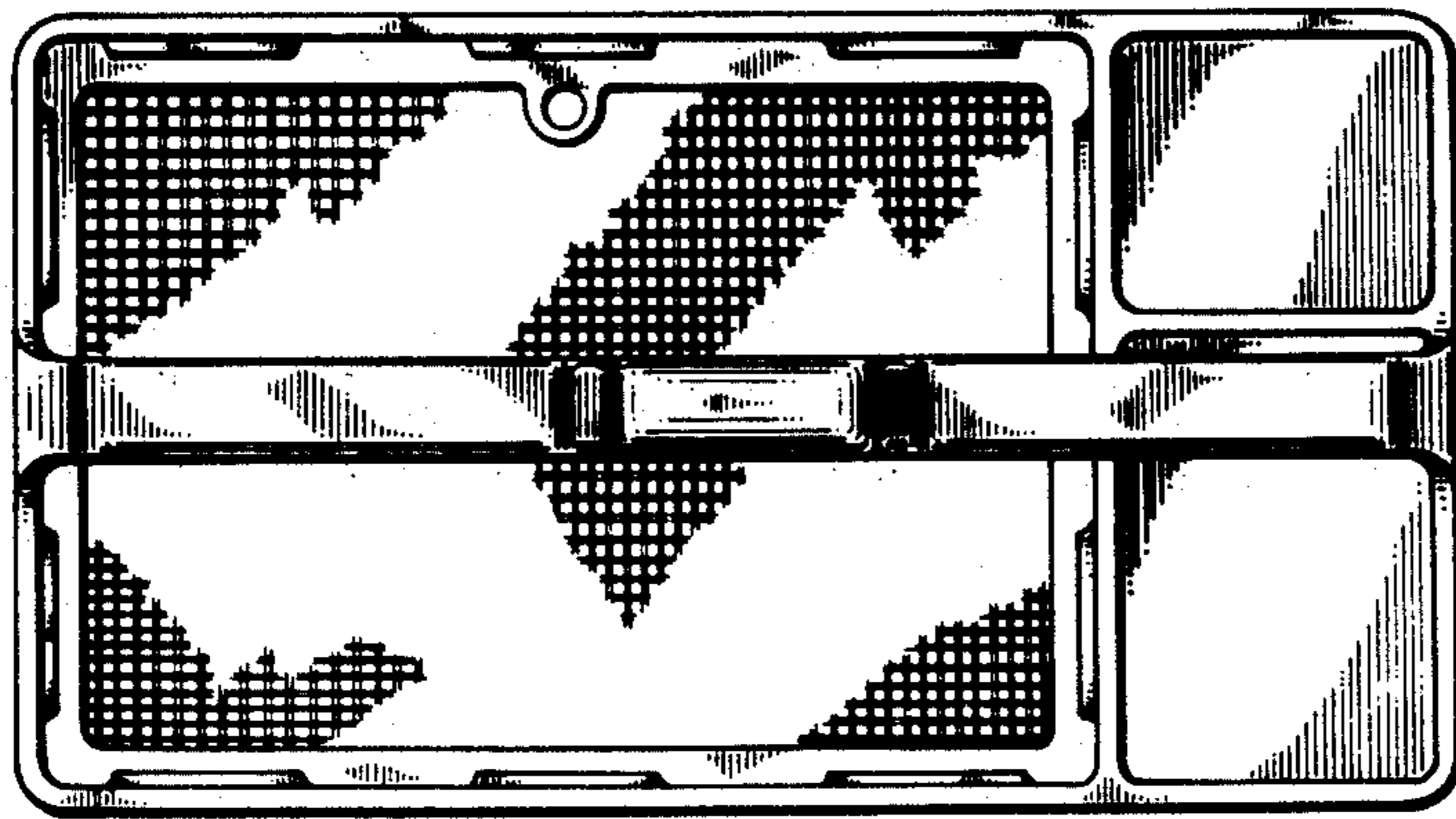

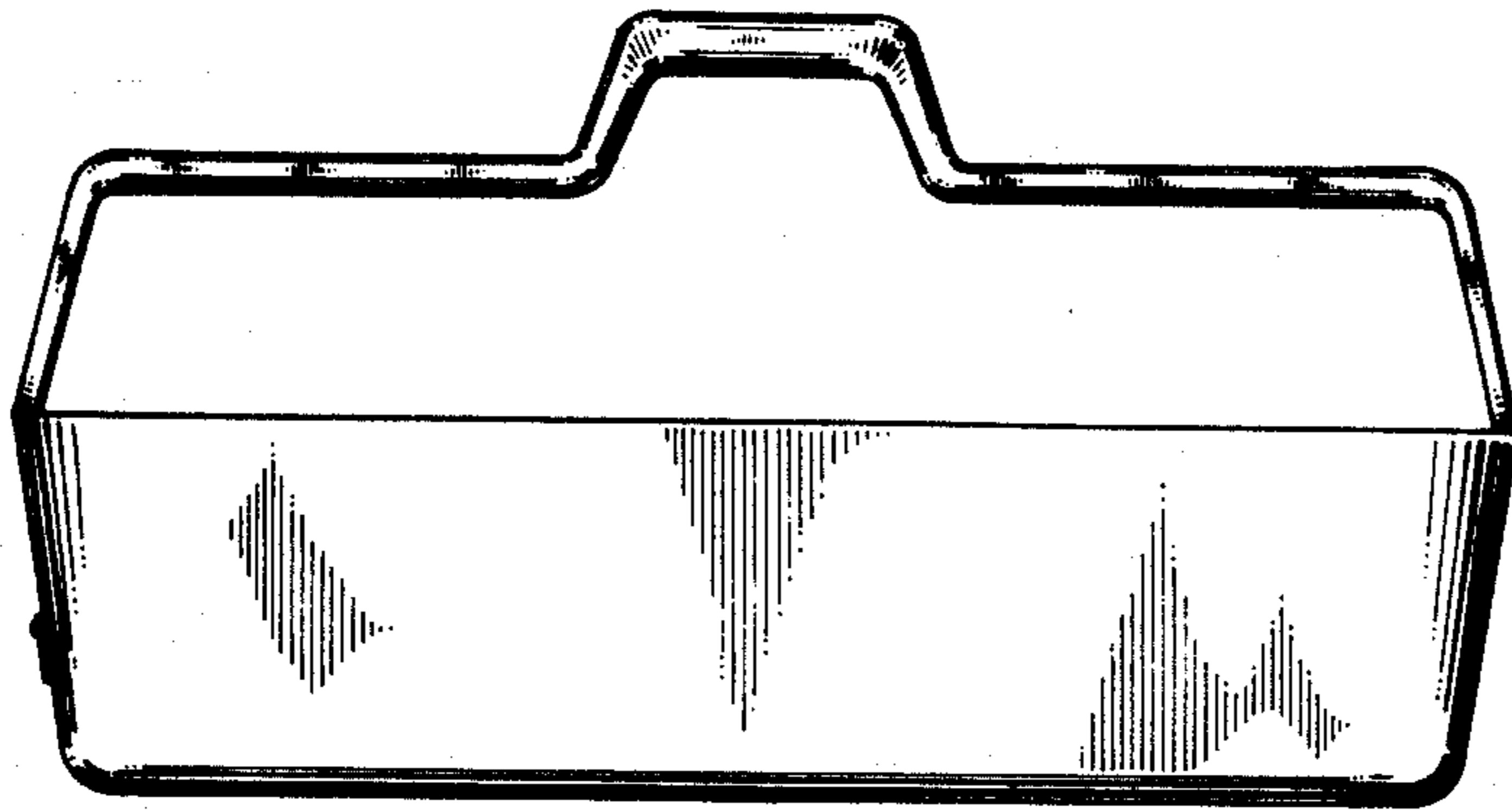

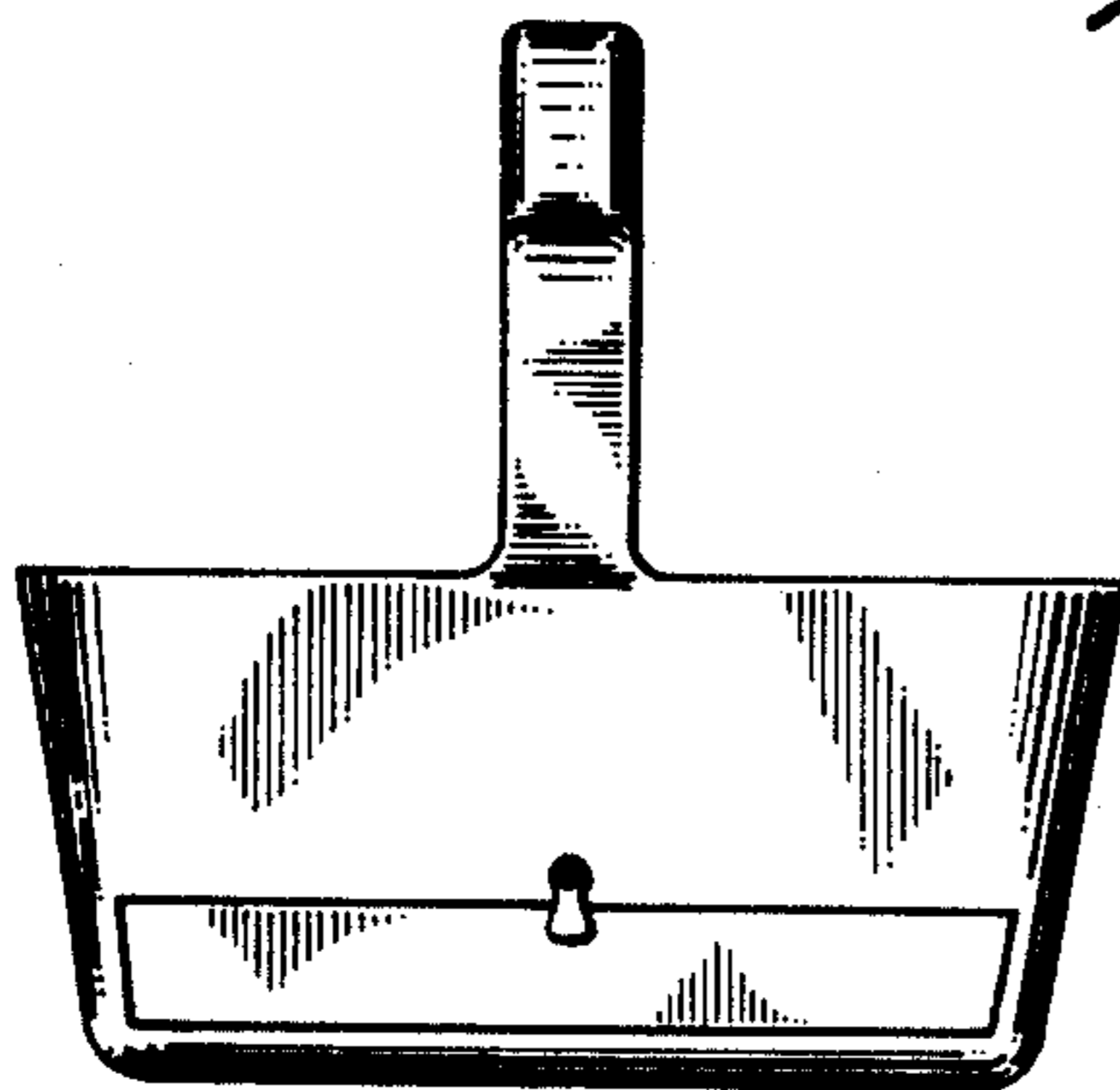

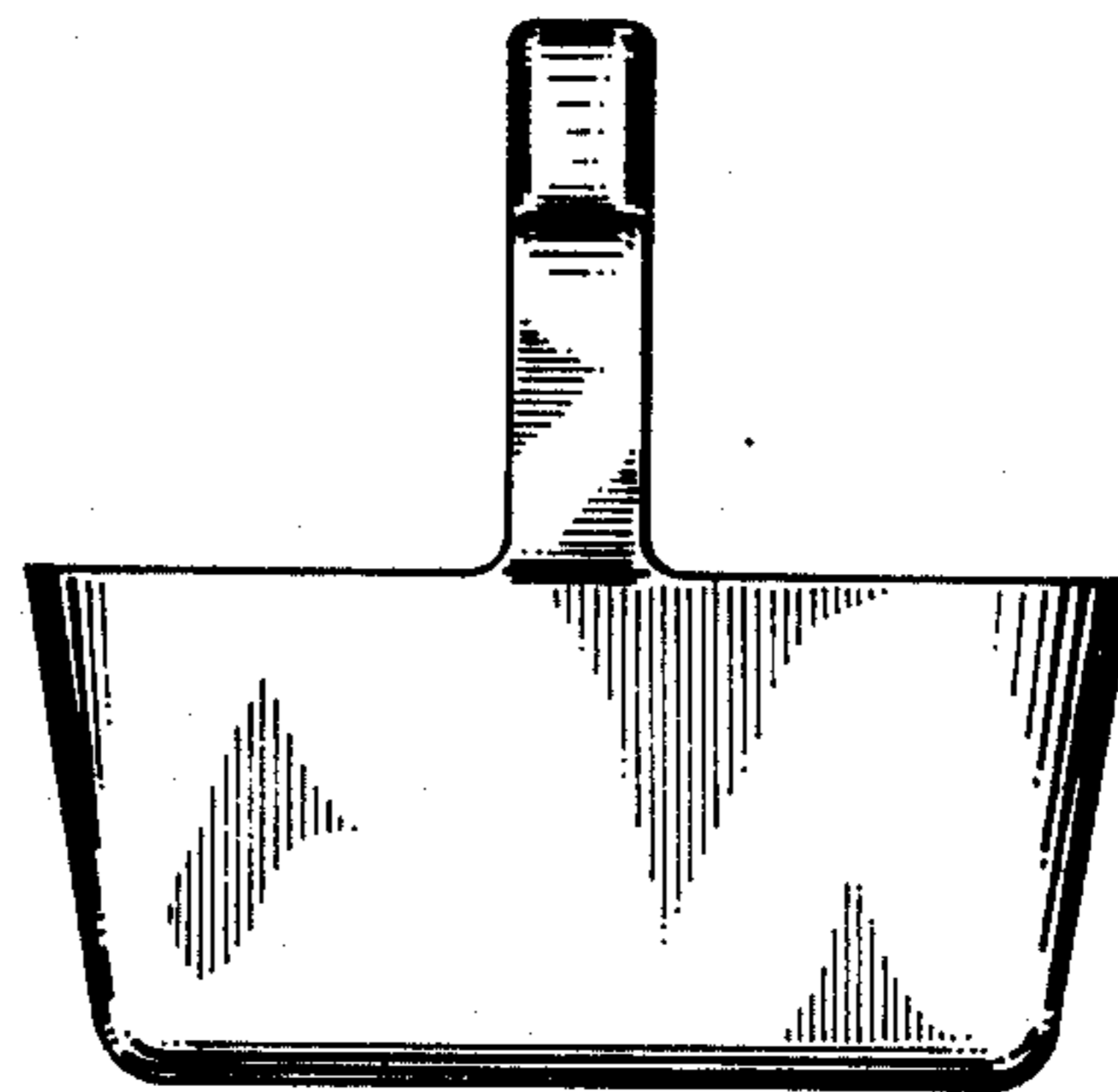

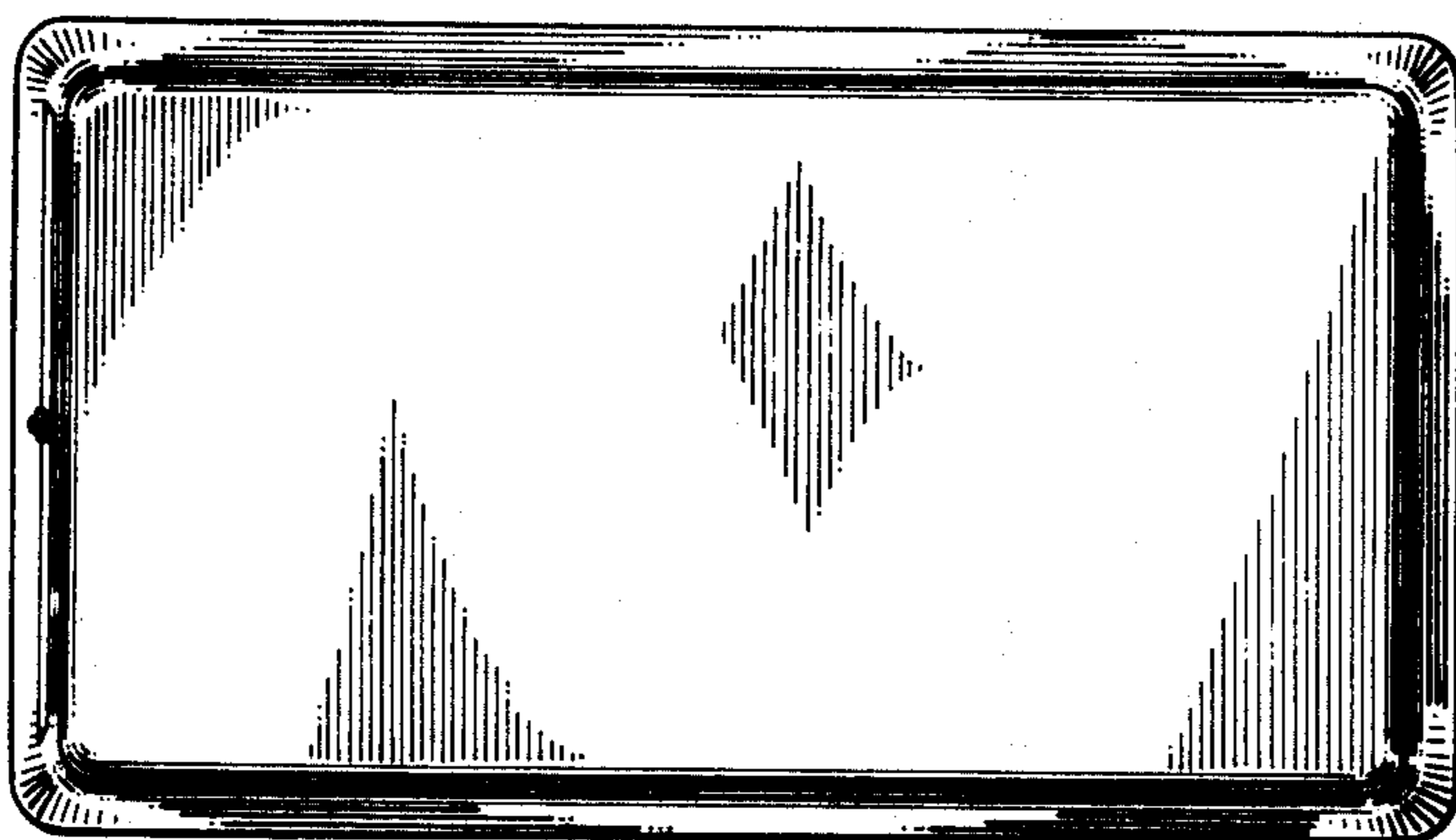
