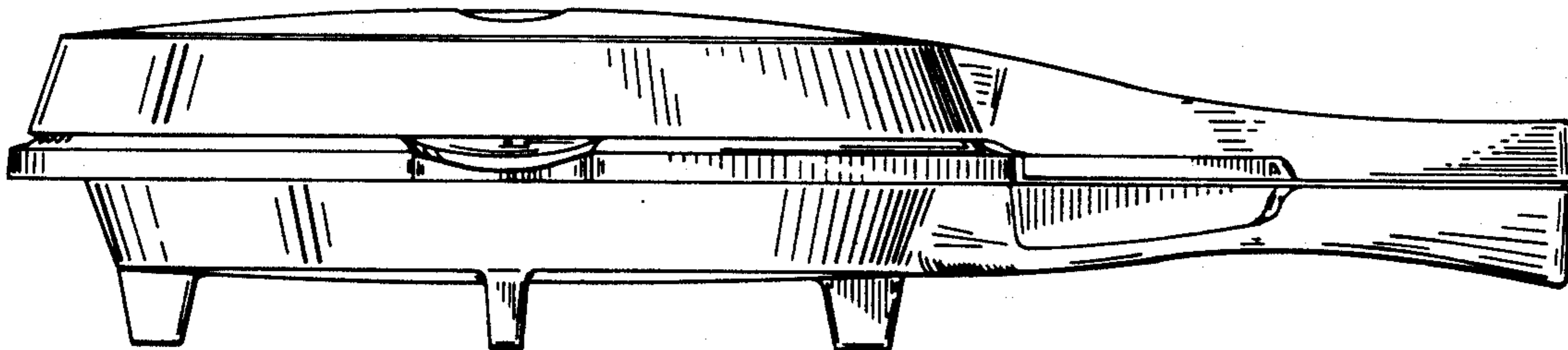
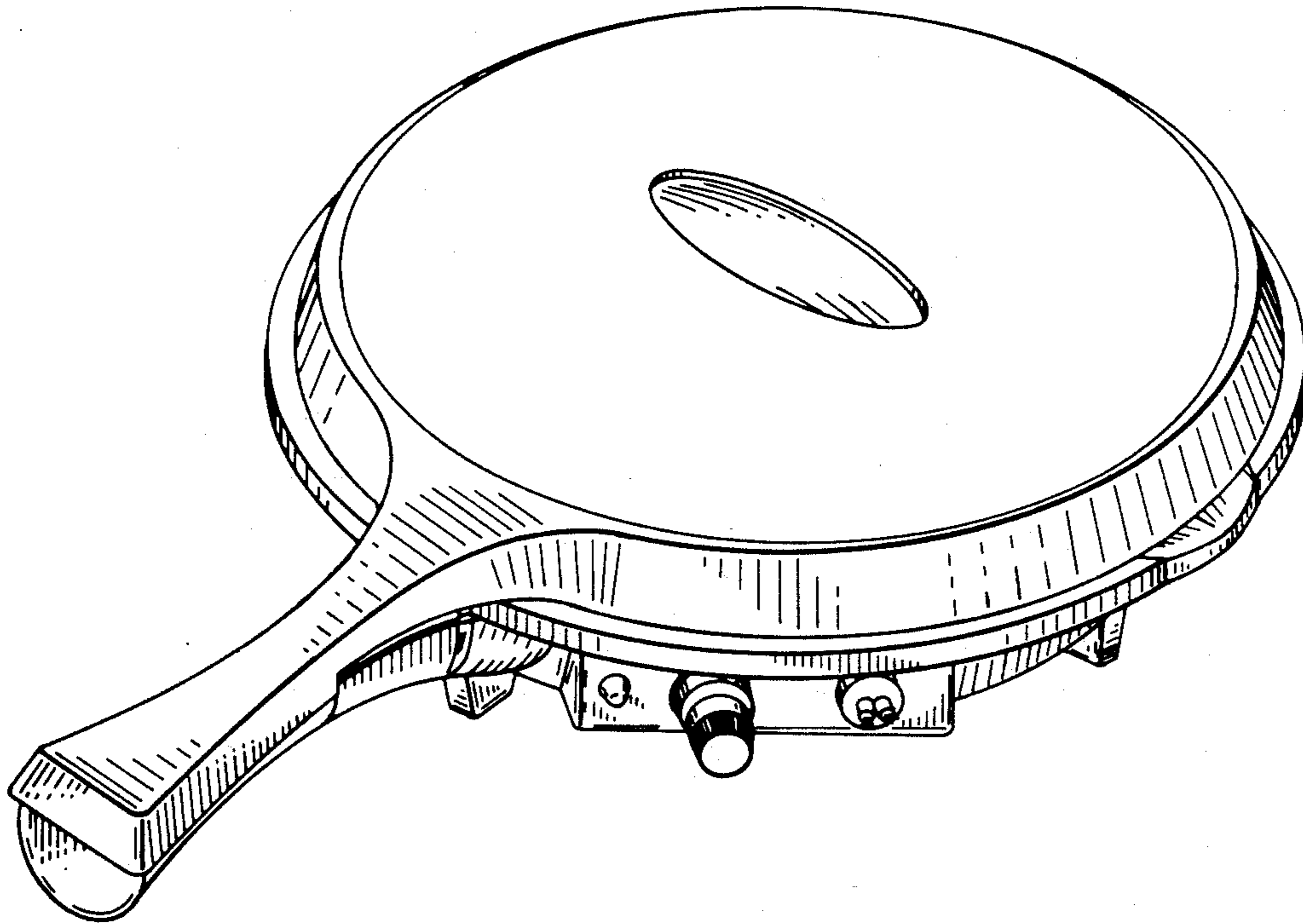

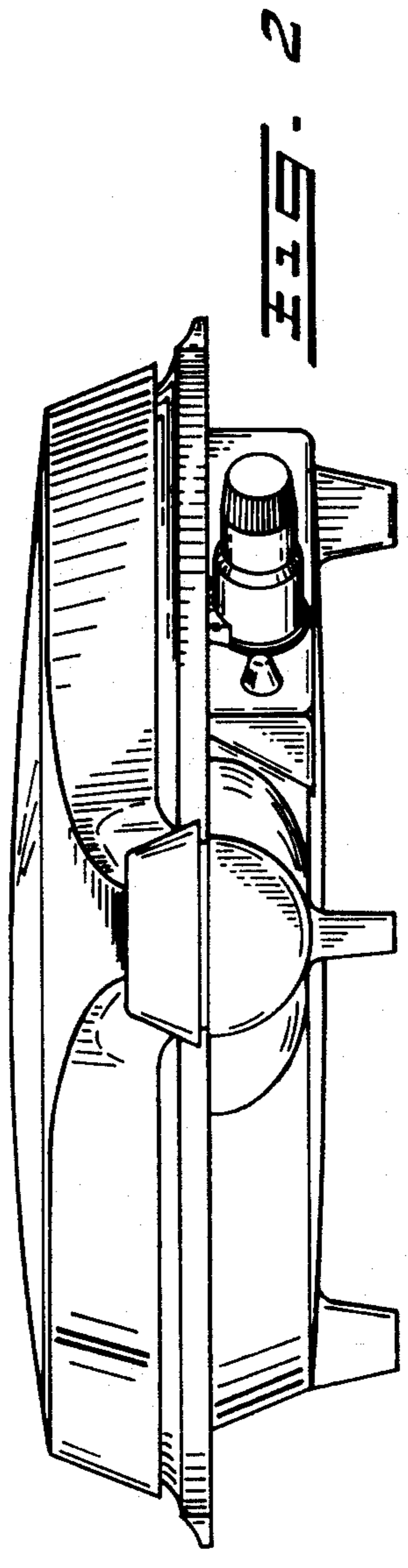
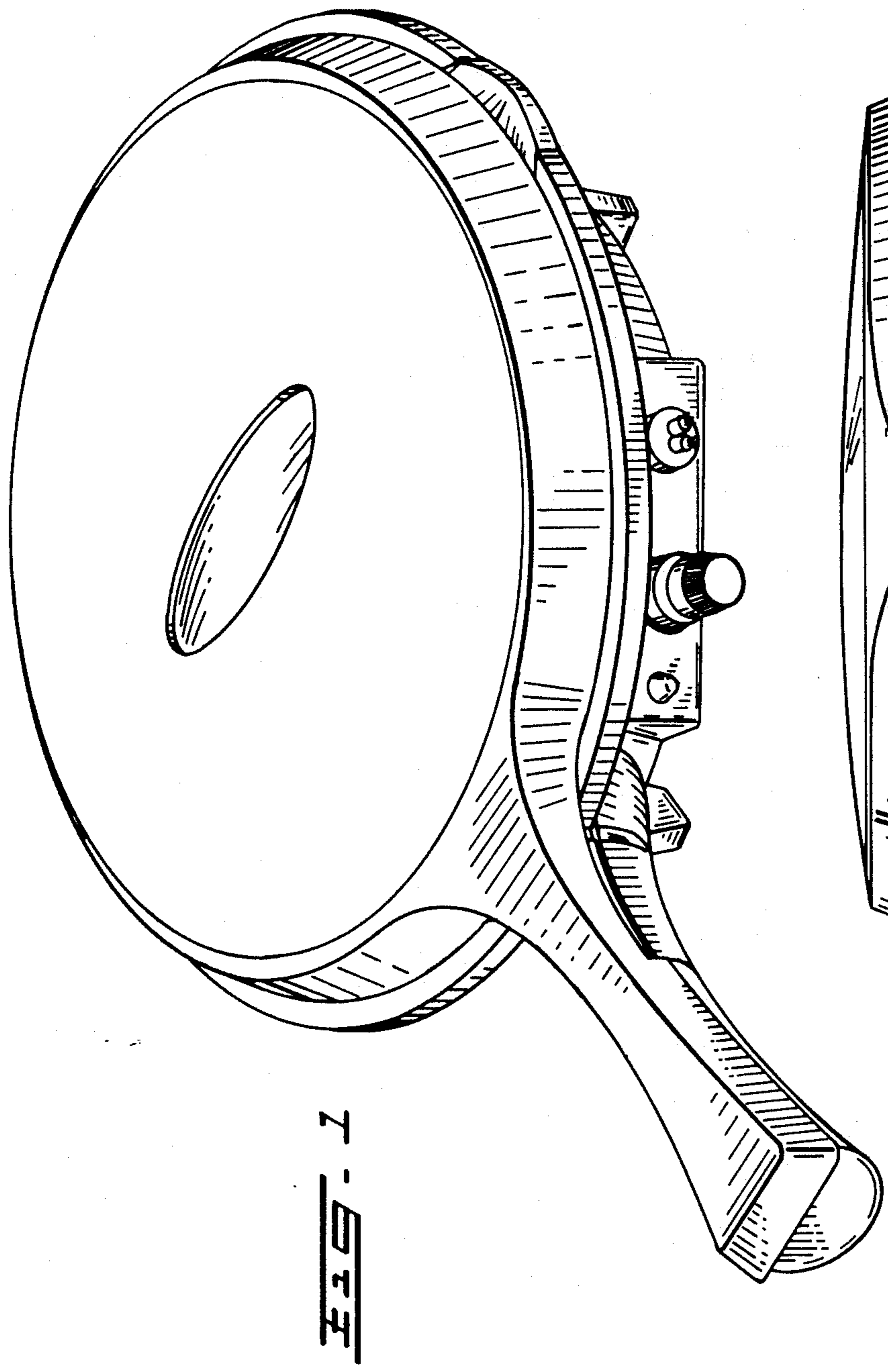
DESCRIPTION

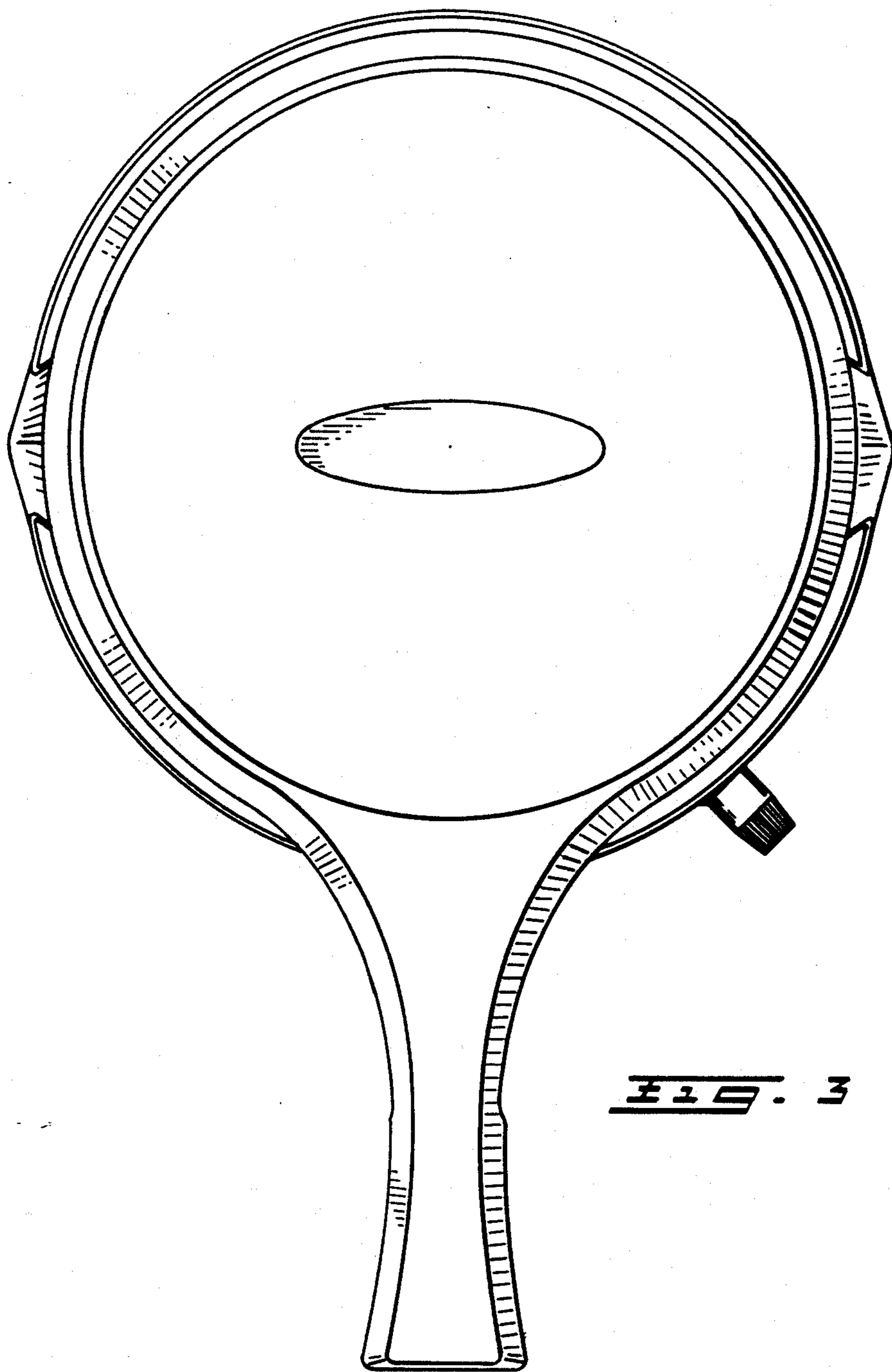

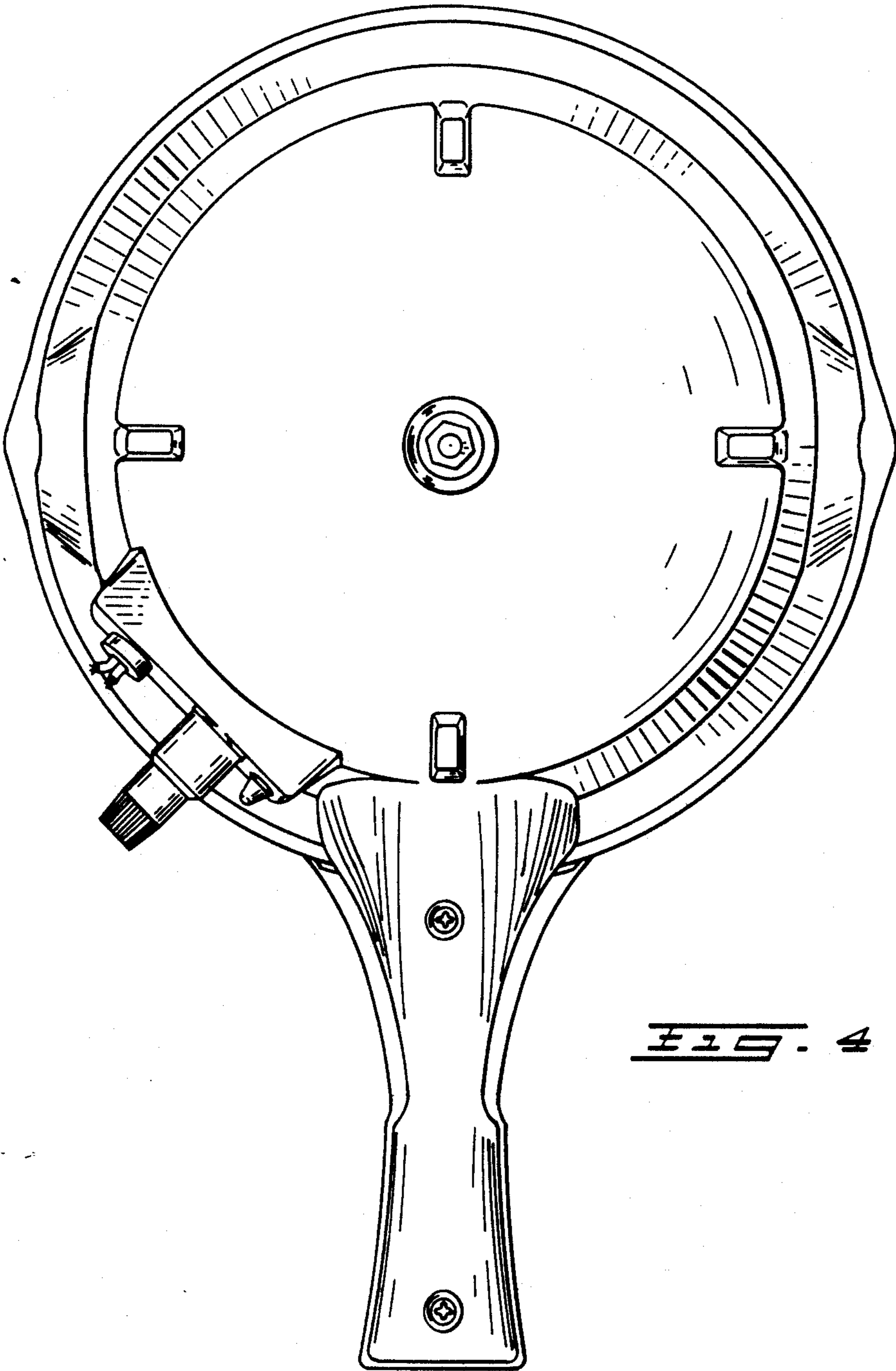
