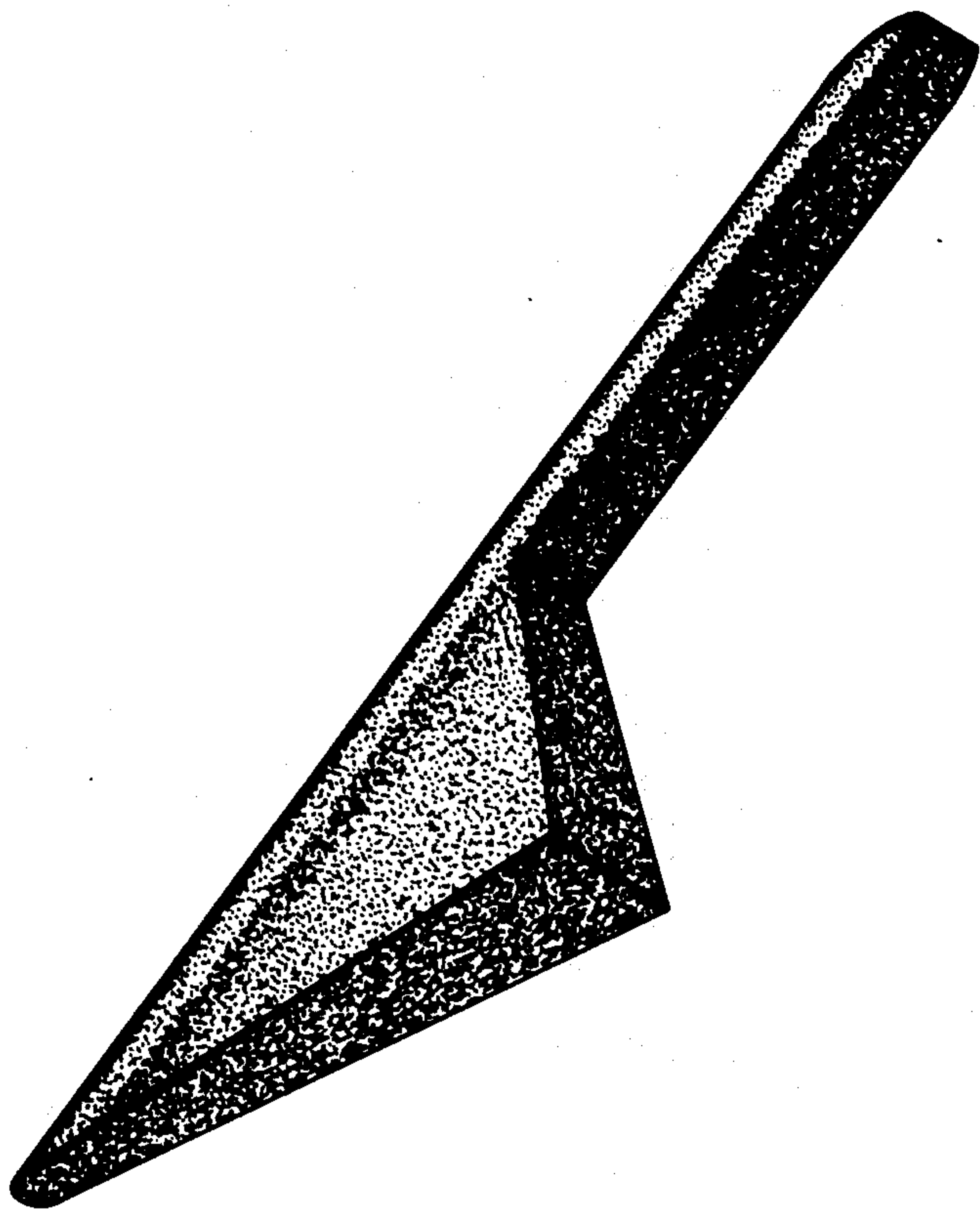

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wear point for agricultural fertilizer shank, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wearpoint for agricultural fertilizer shank showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown herein; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a view thereof looking in the direction of the arrows 5—5 in FIG. 2.



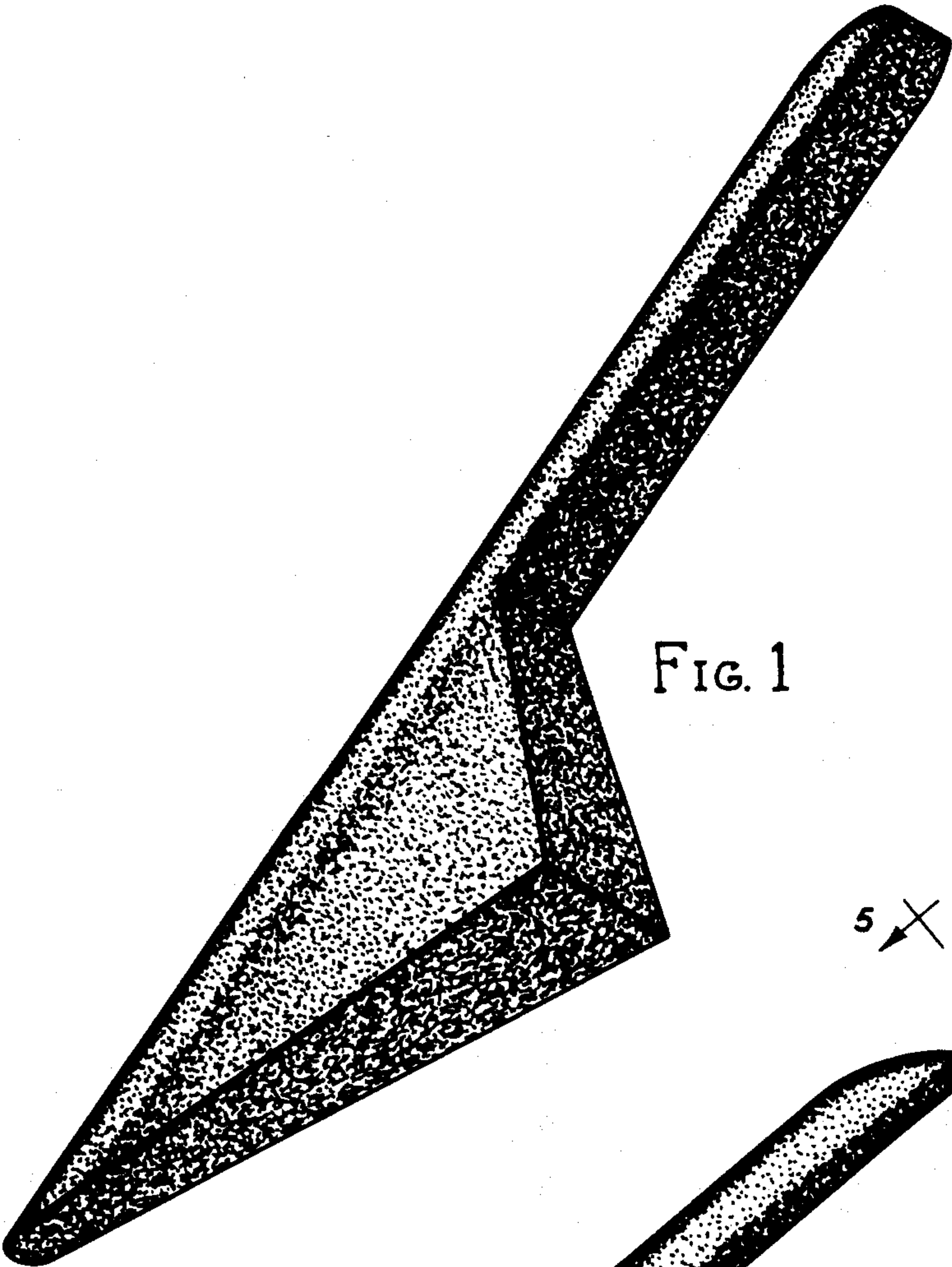

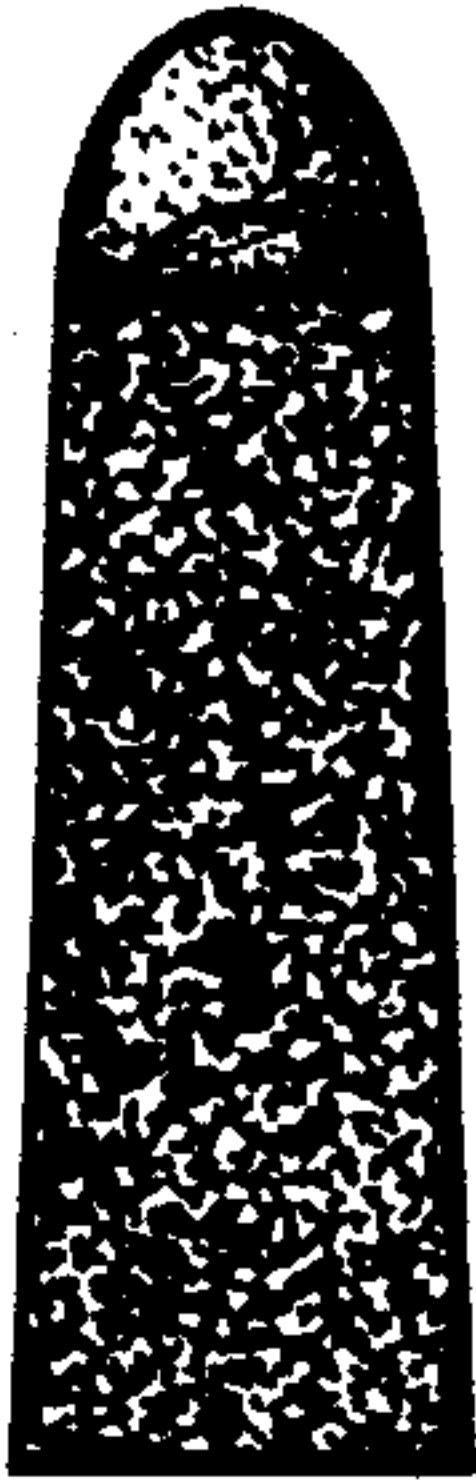

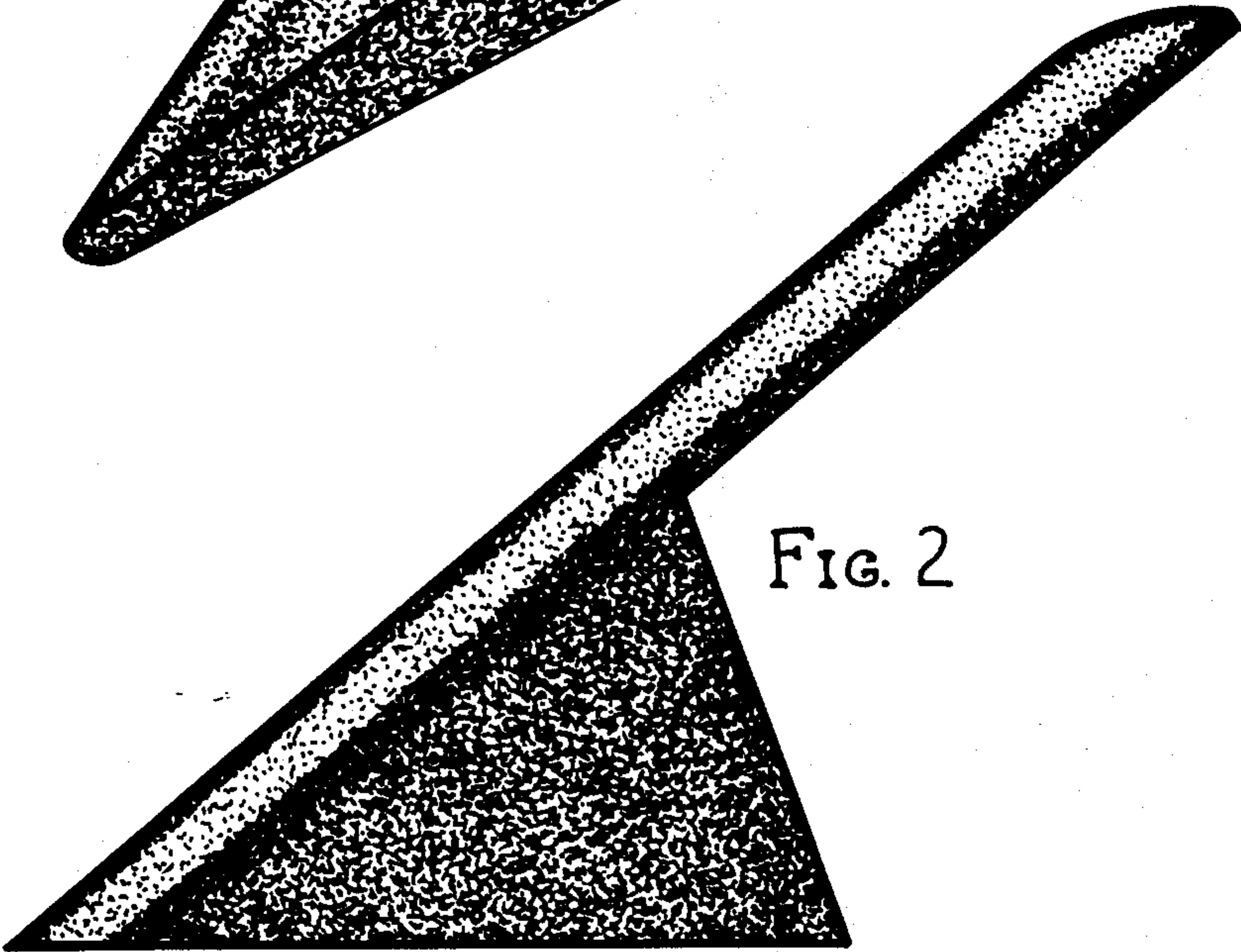

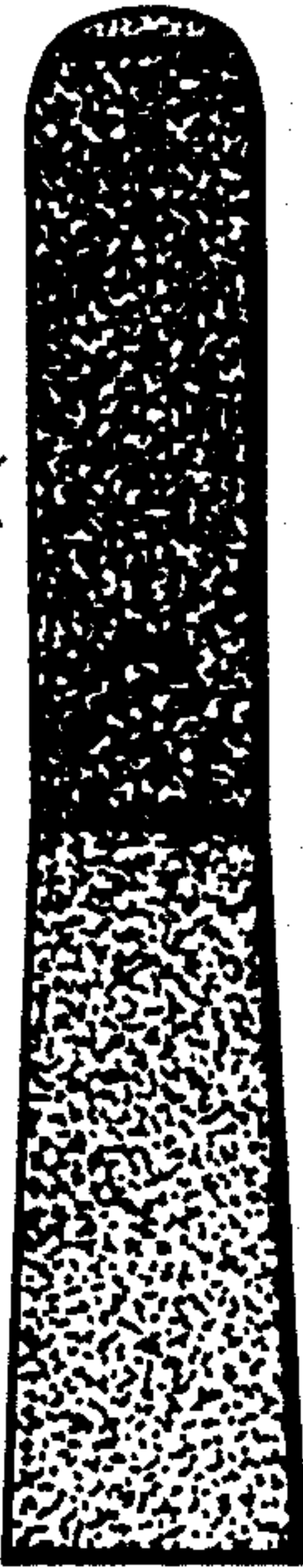
