


FIG. 1 is an illustration, in perspective, of the pair of spectacles showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the spectacles;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the pair of spectacles, the opposite side having substantially the same appearance; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the pair of spectacles, its temples being broken away for convenience of illustration.










