FIG. 5 is a right end elevation thereof, the undisclosed left end is a mirror image of the end disclosed;

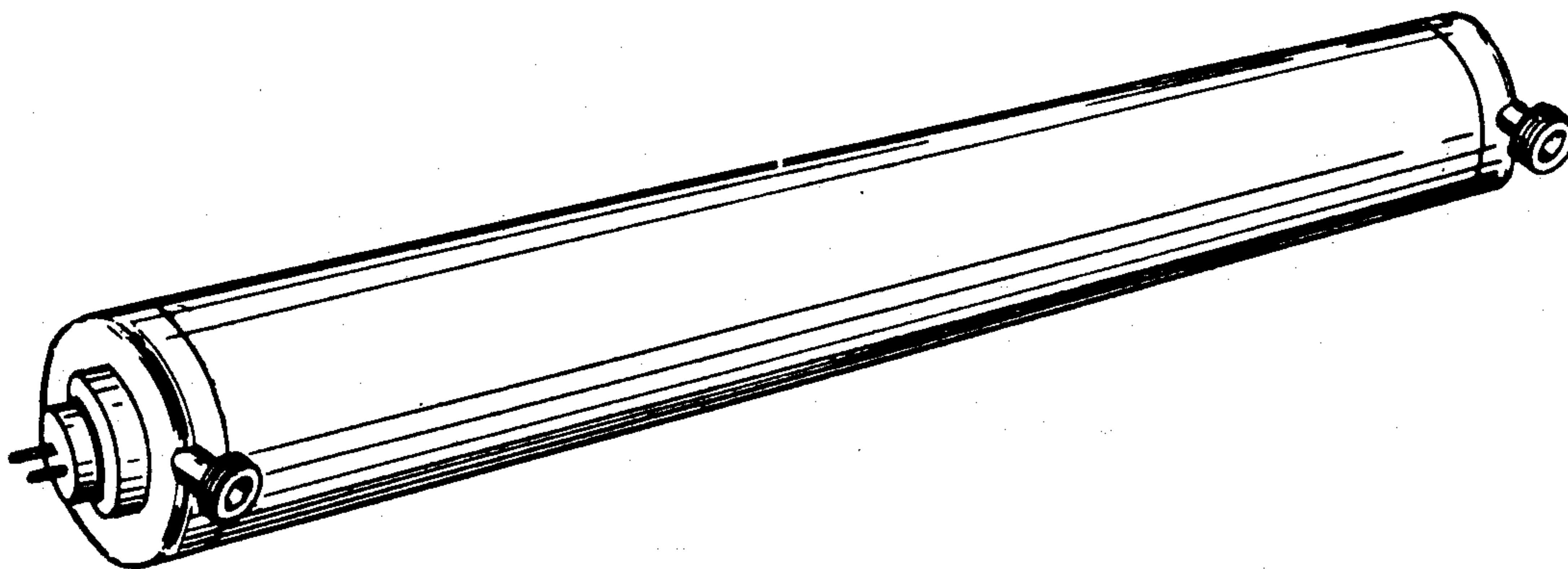
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a modified form of the sterilizer unit illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a right end elevation thereof, the undisclosed left end is a mirror image of the end disclosed.



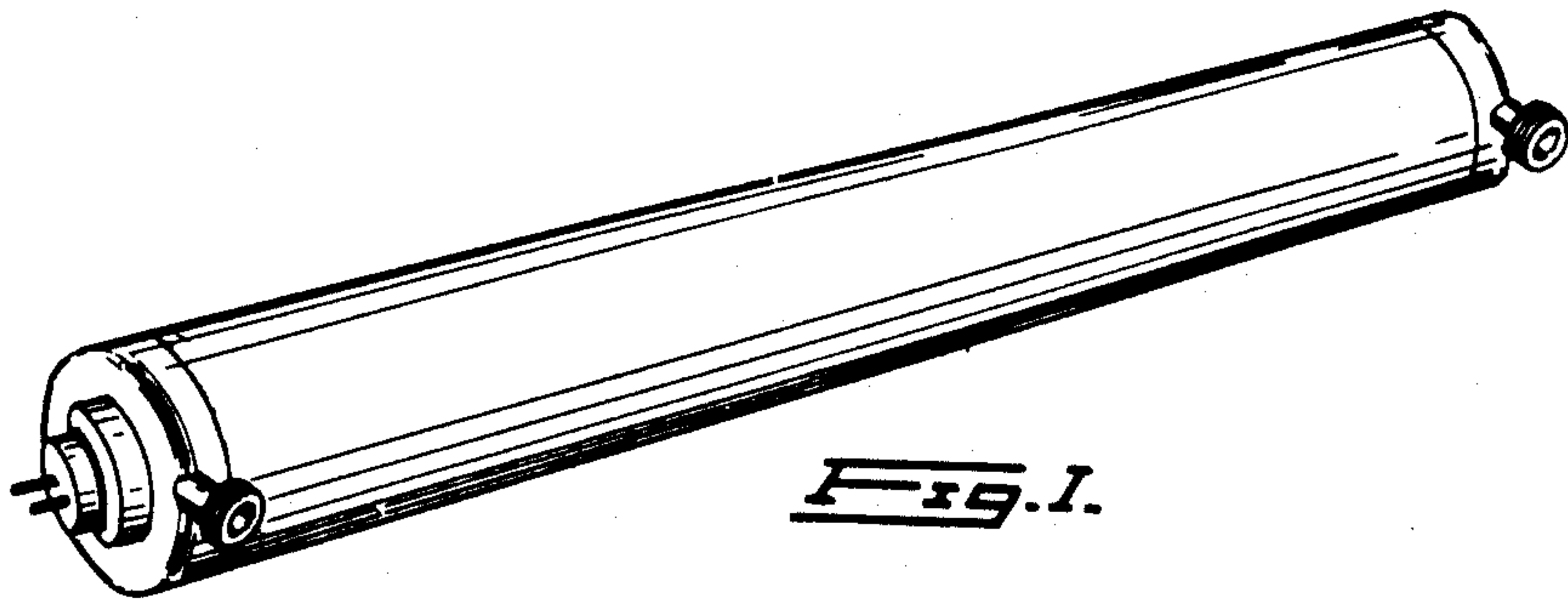

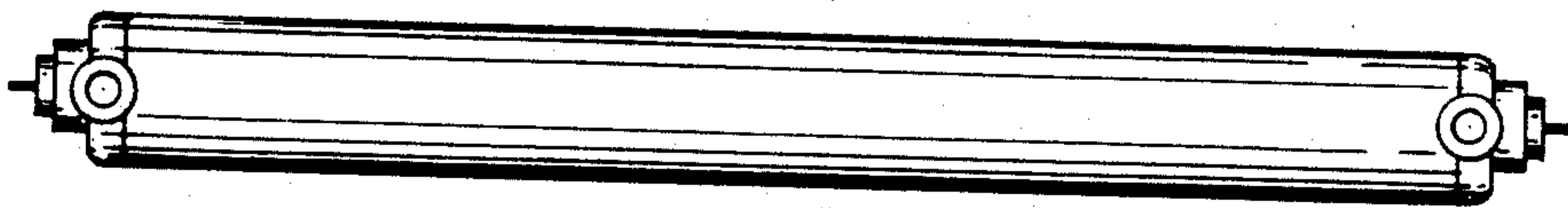

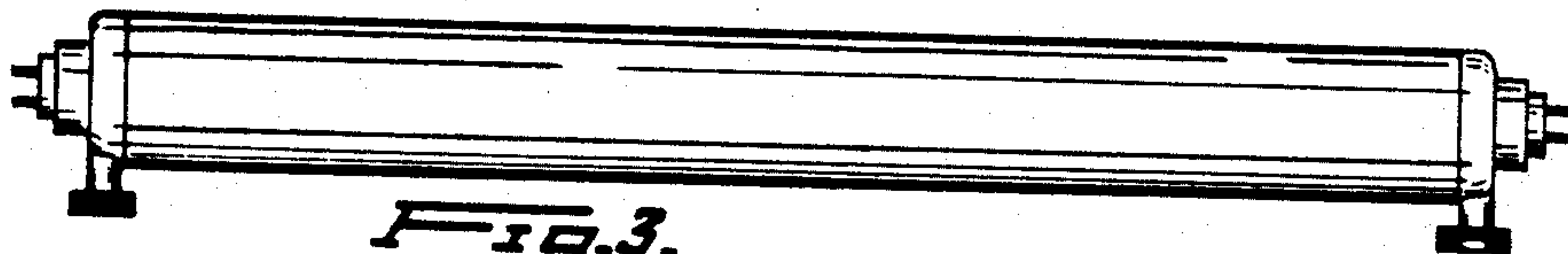

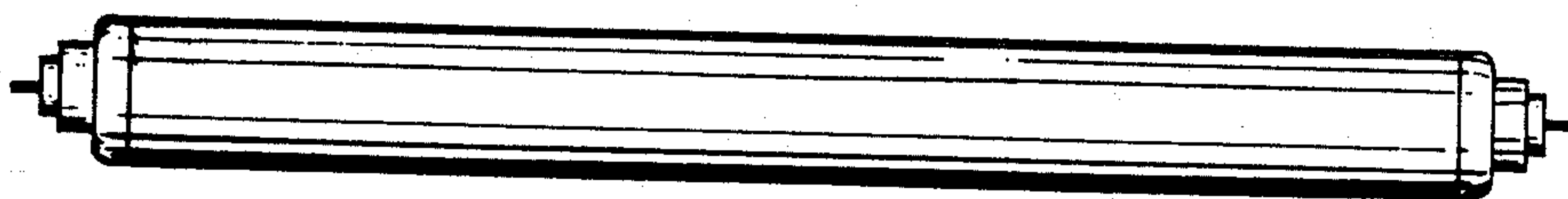

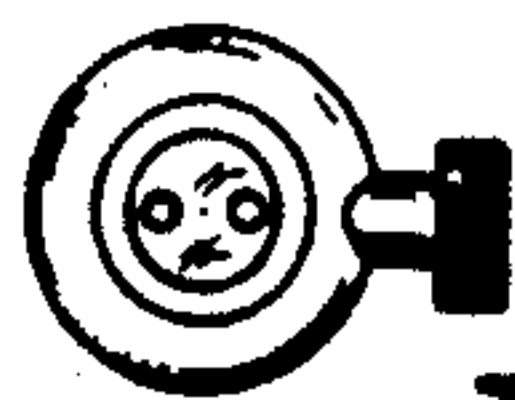
