FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a cake pan showing my new design;

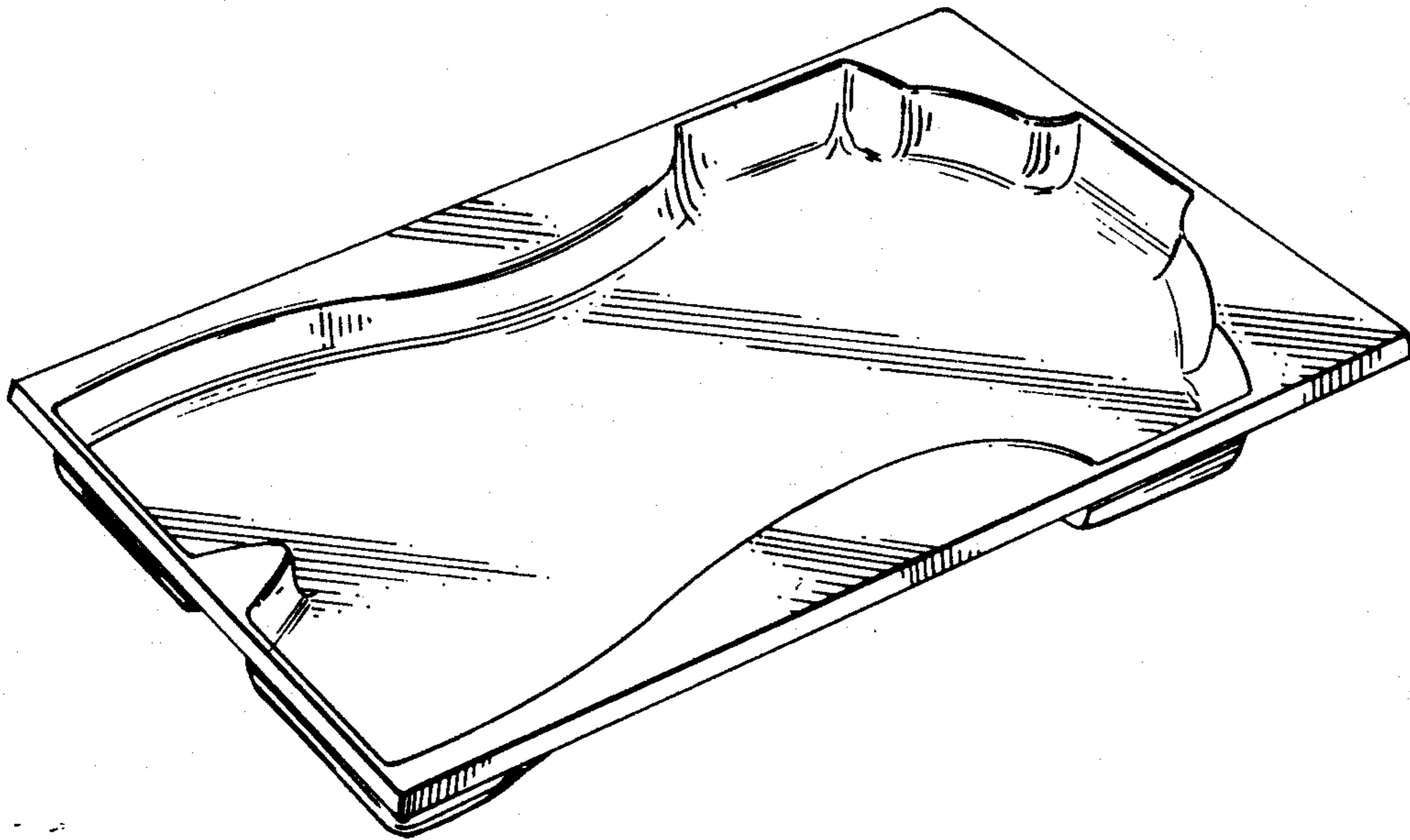
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left end elevational view thereof.



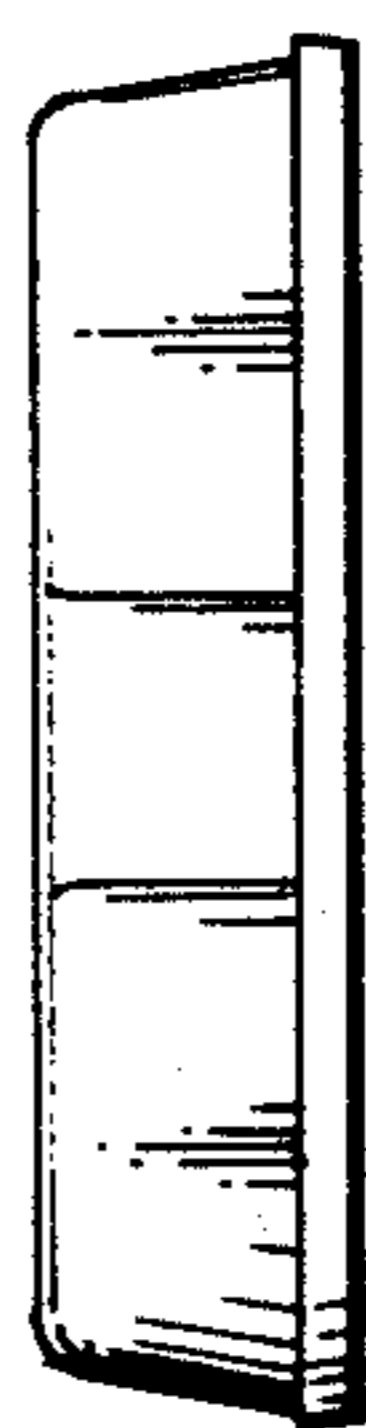
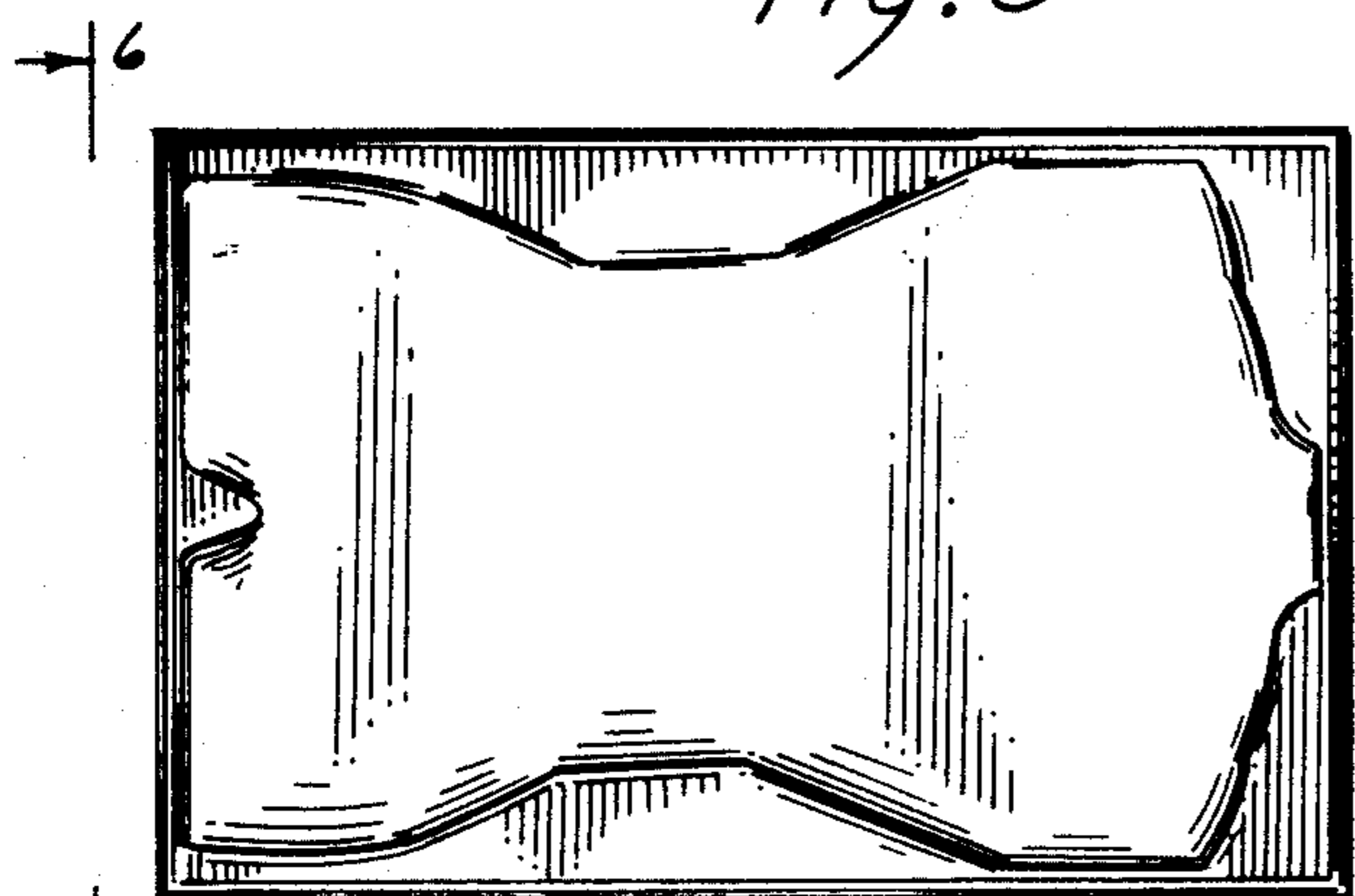
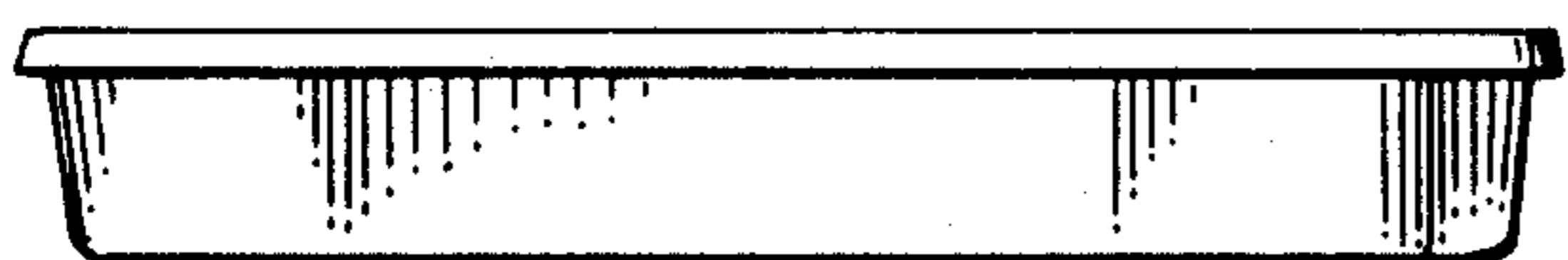
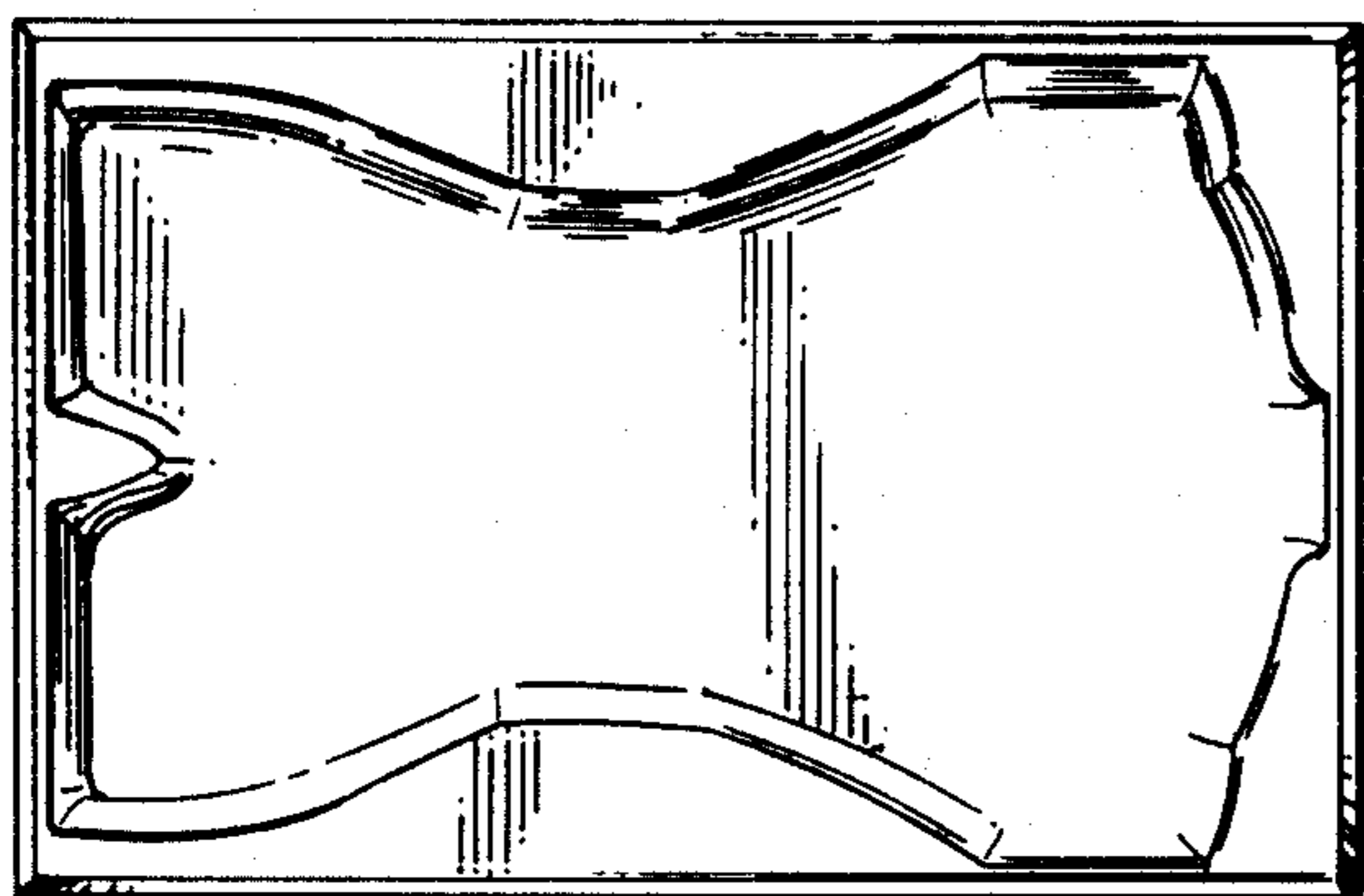
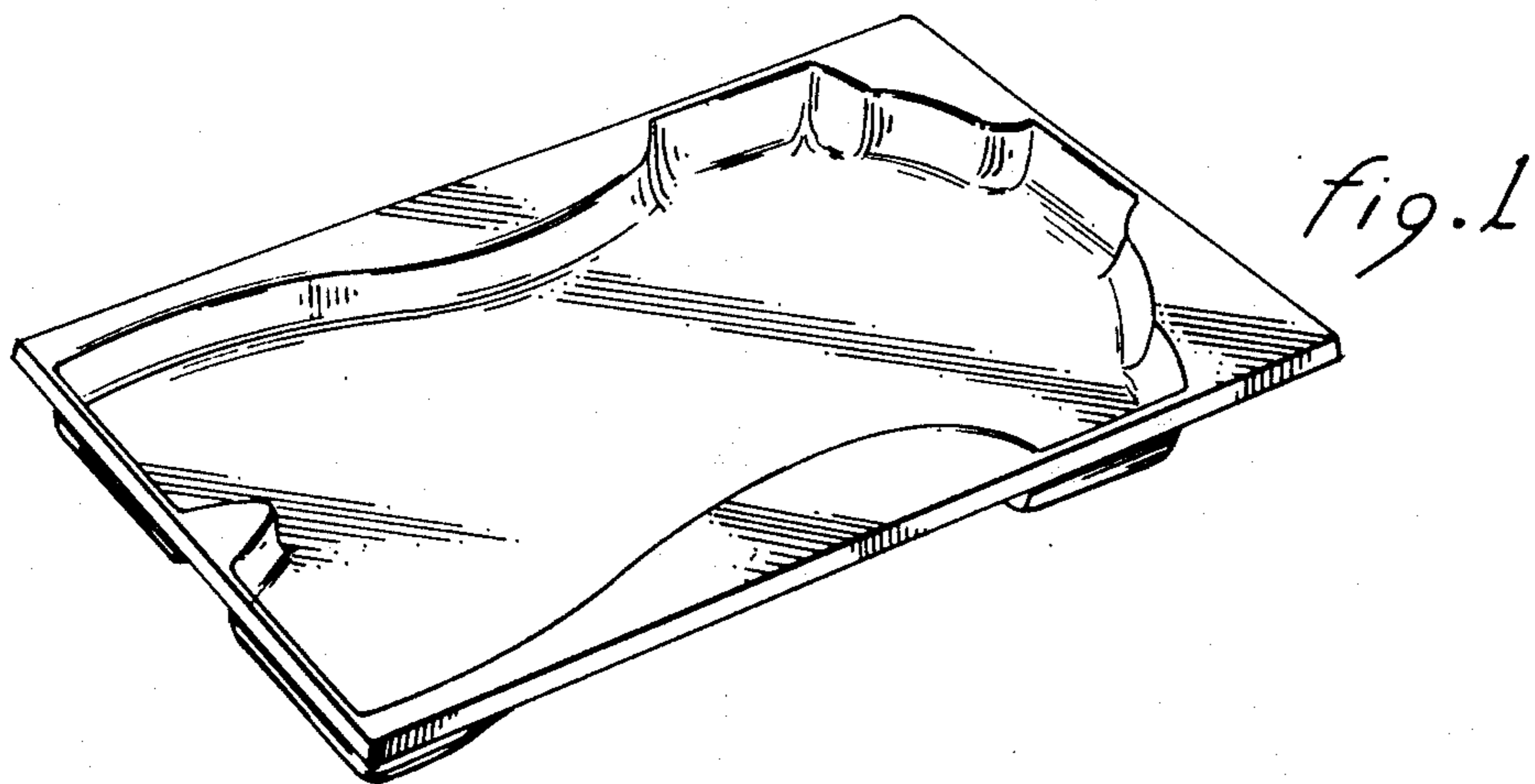
