
[57] CLAIM

as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a surface-cleaning  
apparatus showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof; and  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.


The handle, which is shown in broken lines in FIG. 1
