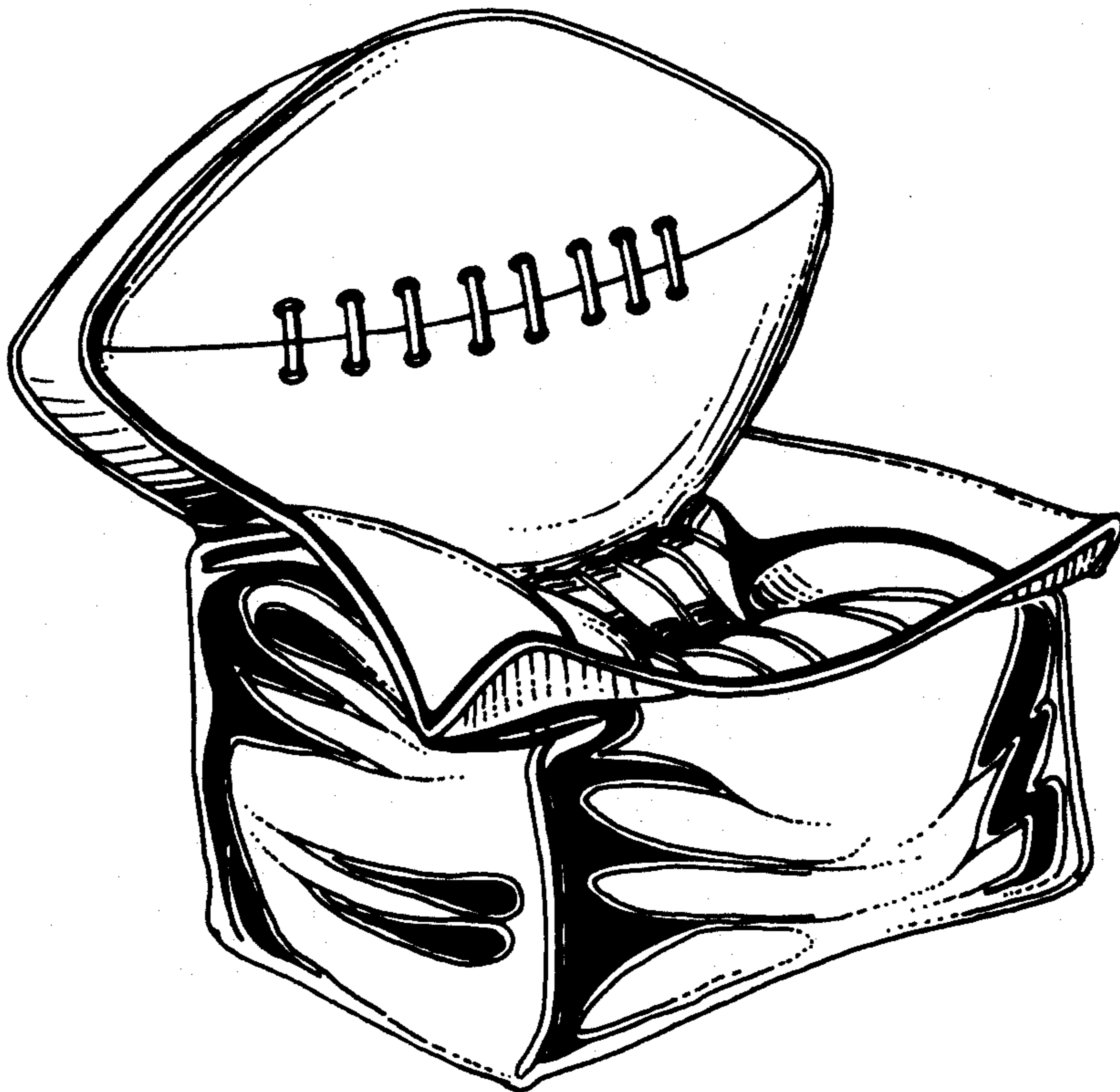

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the novelty chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view of my invention shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of my novel and ornamental novelty chair;
FIG. 4 is a top view of my invention; and
FIG. 5 is a rear view of my invention.
The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.



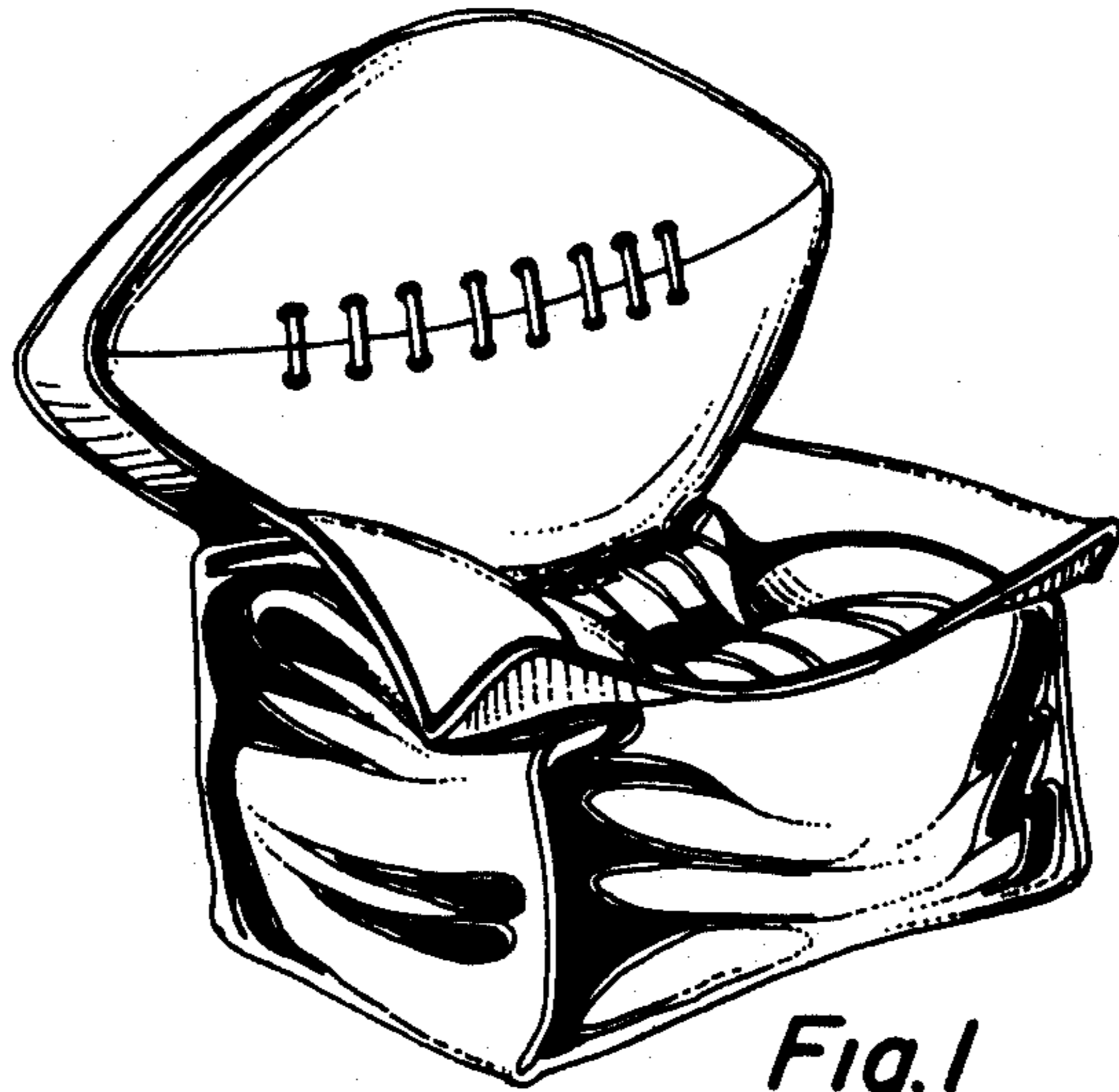

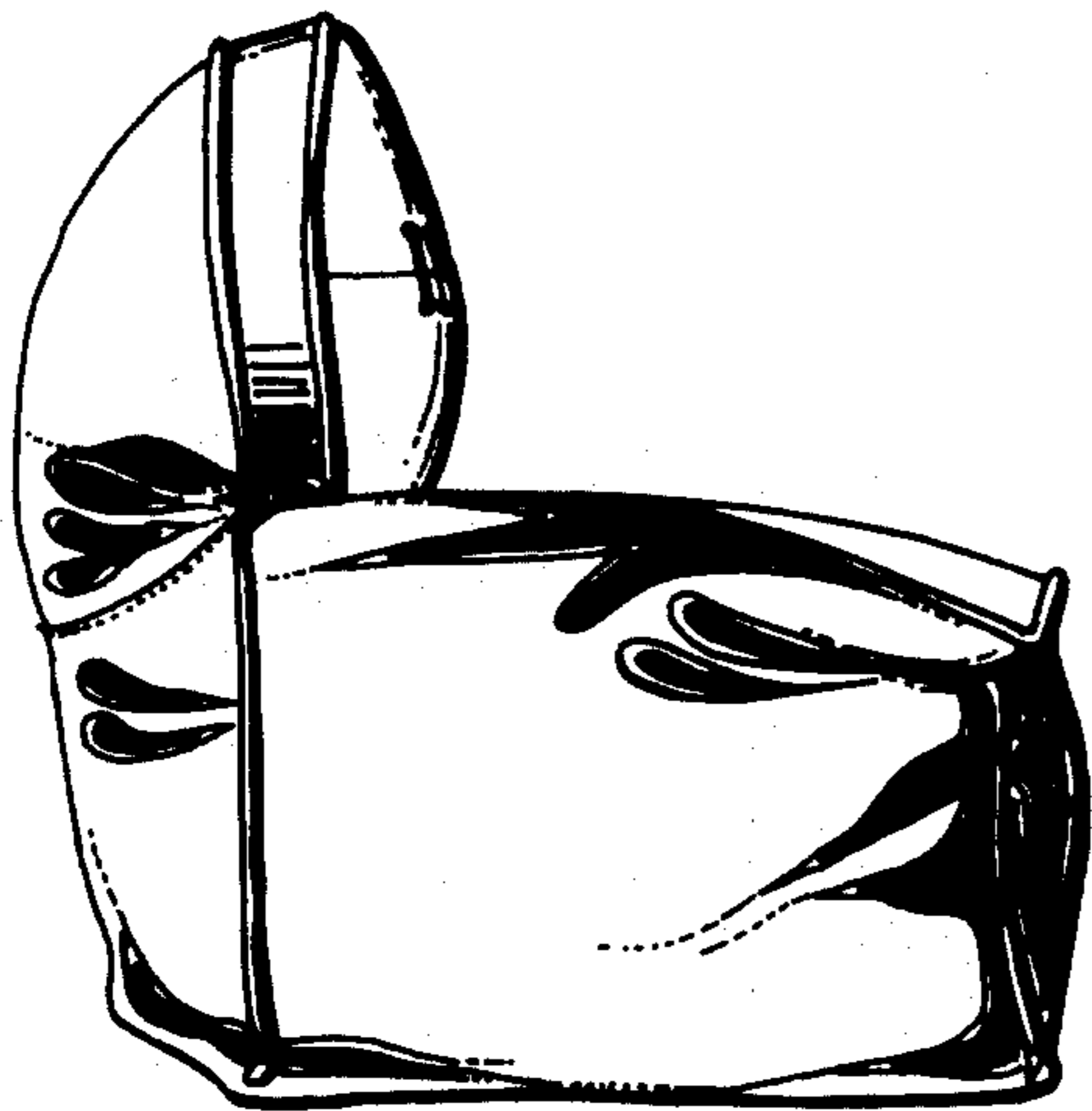

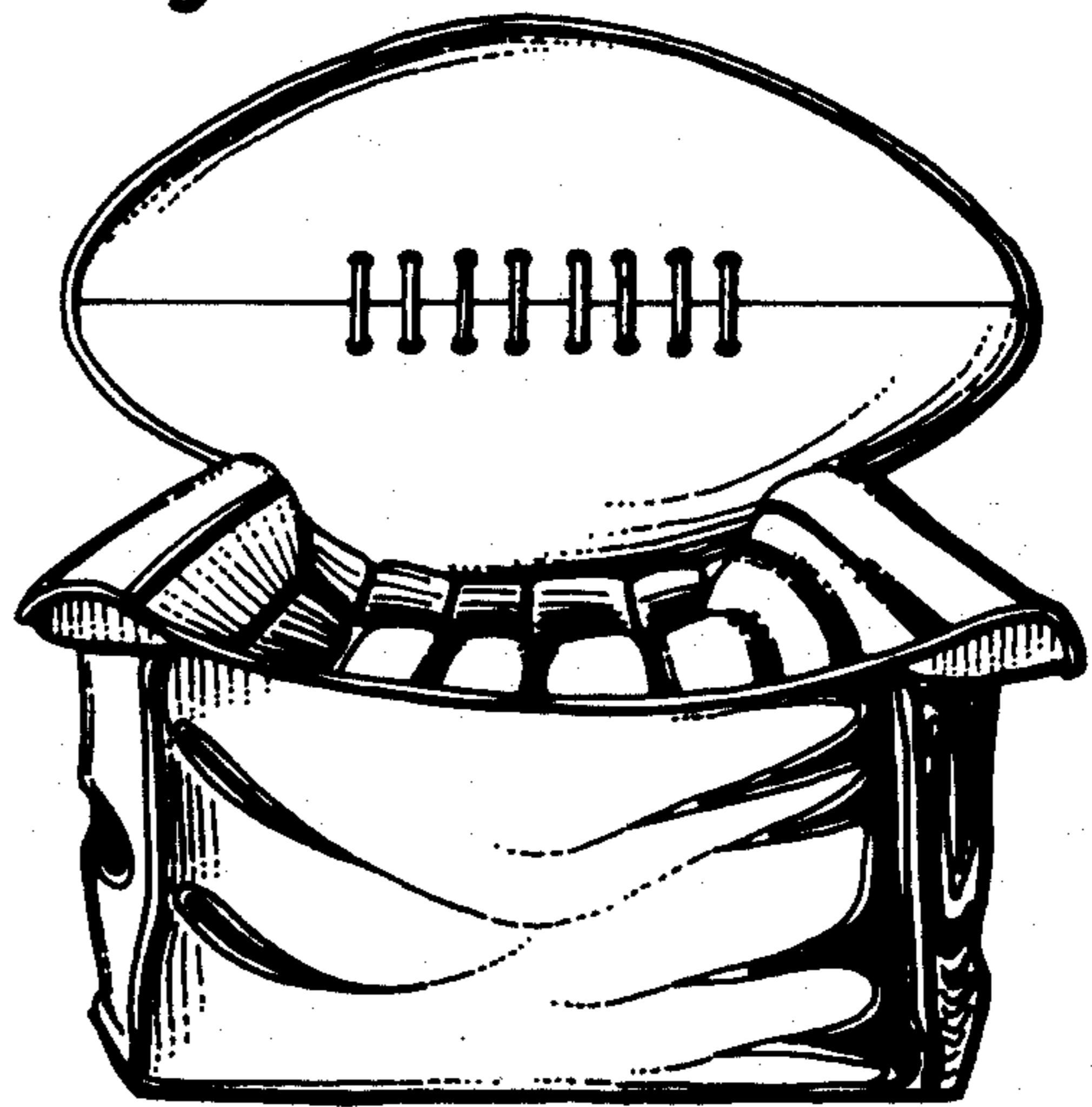

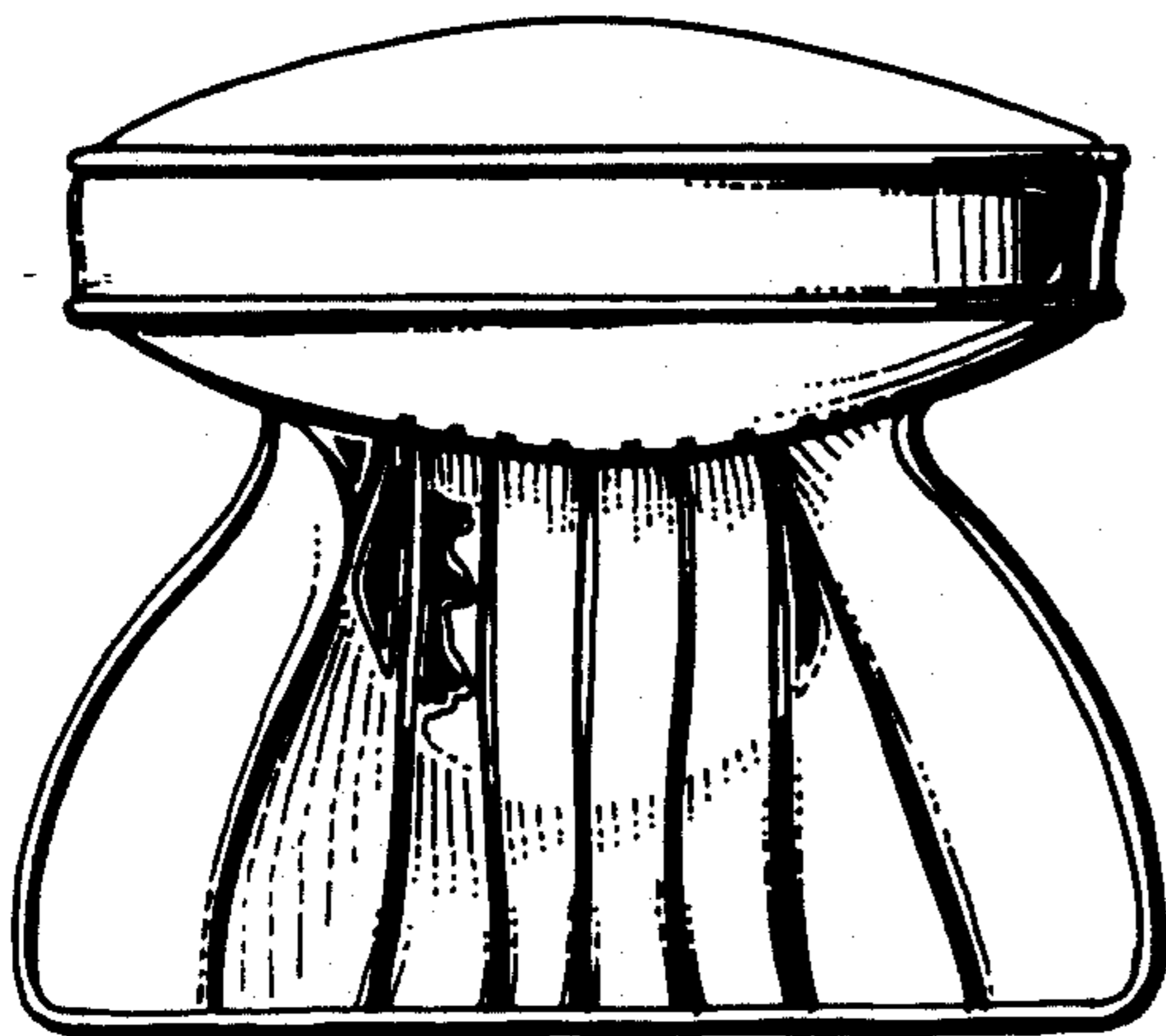

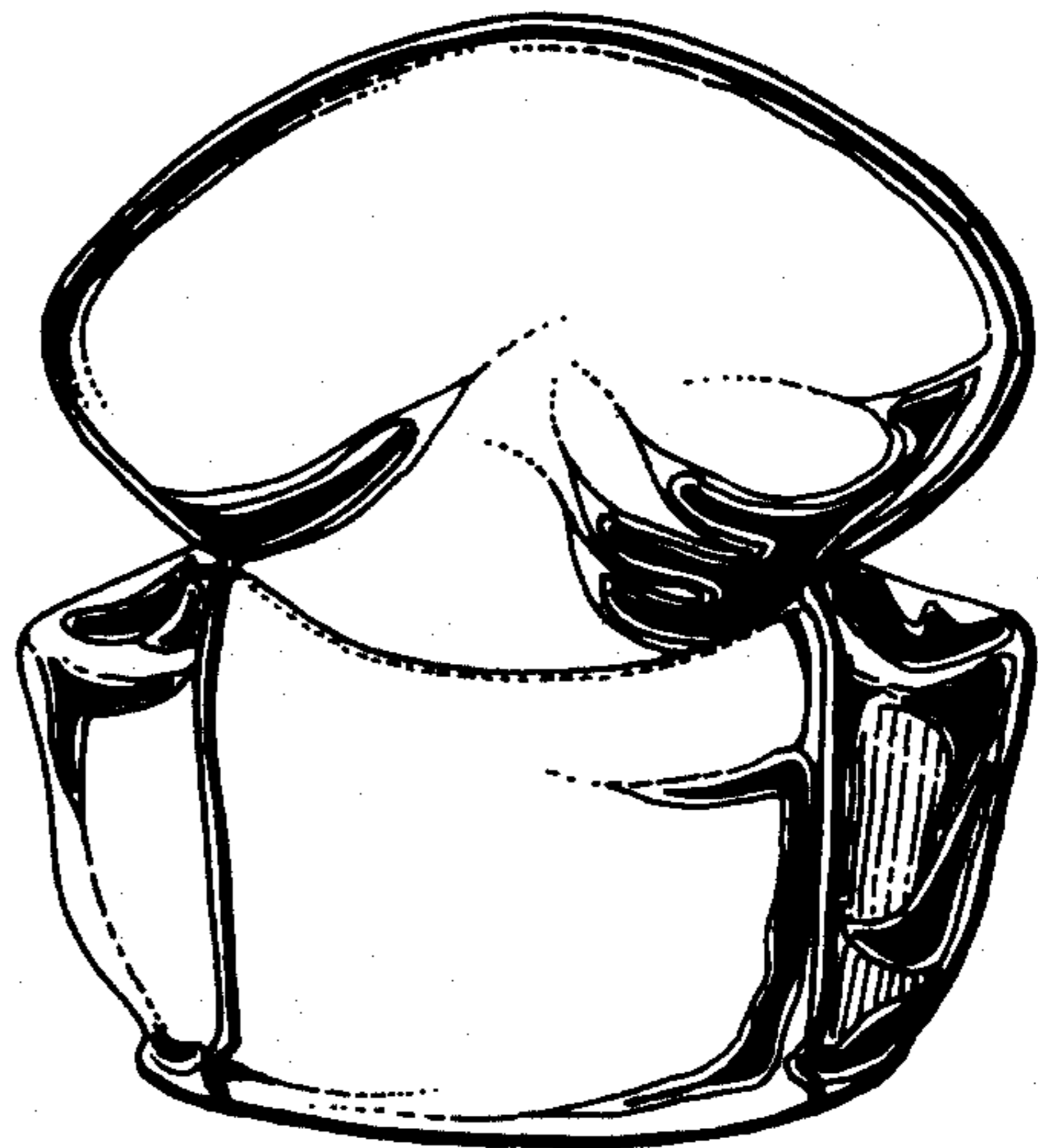
