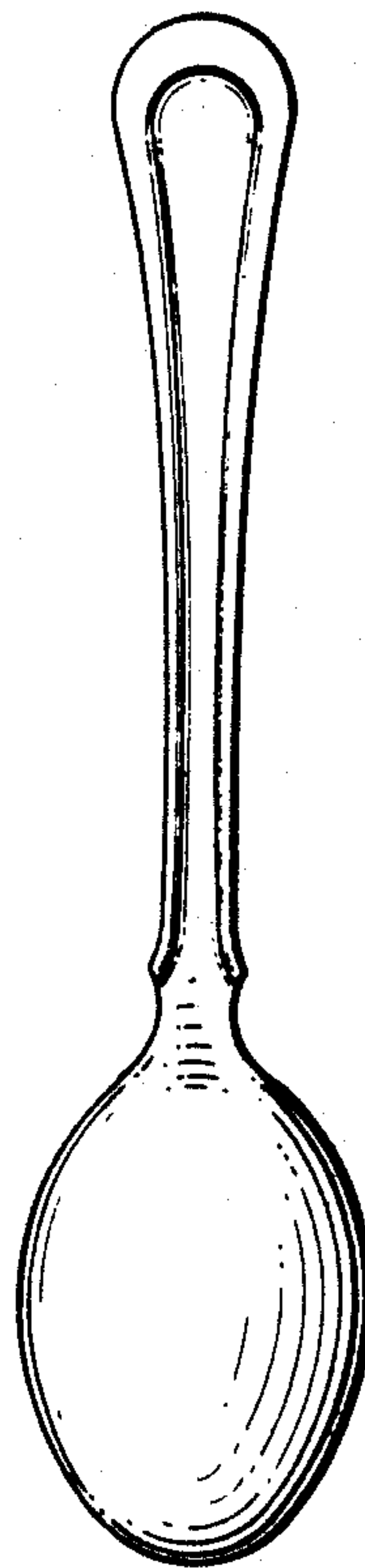
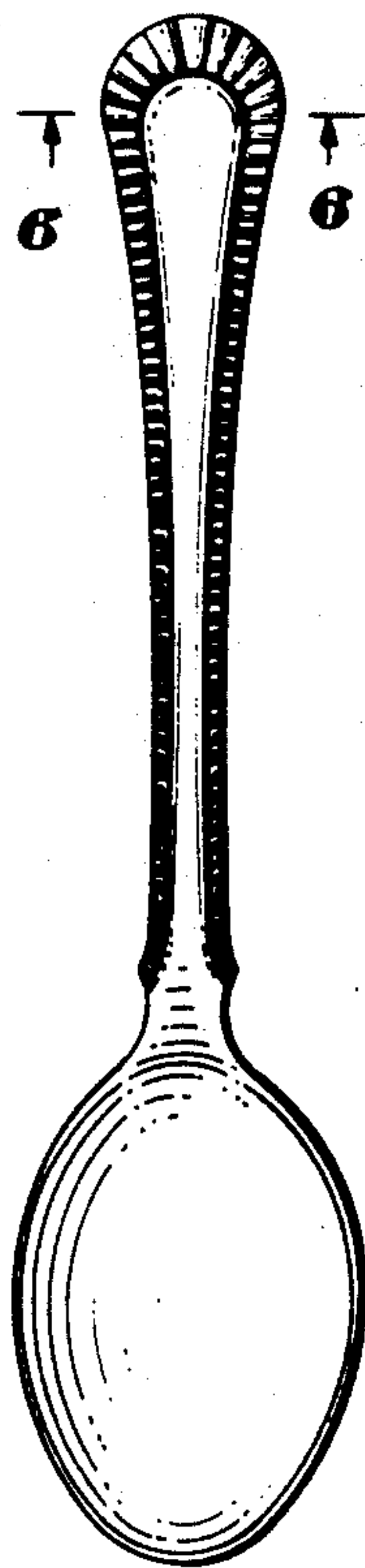

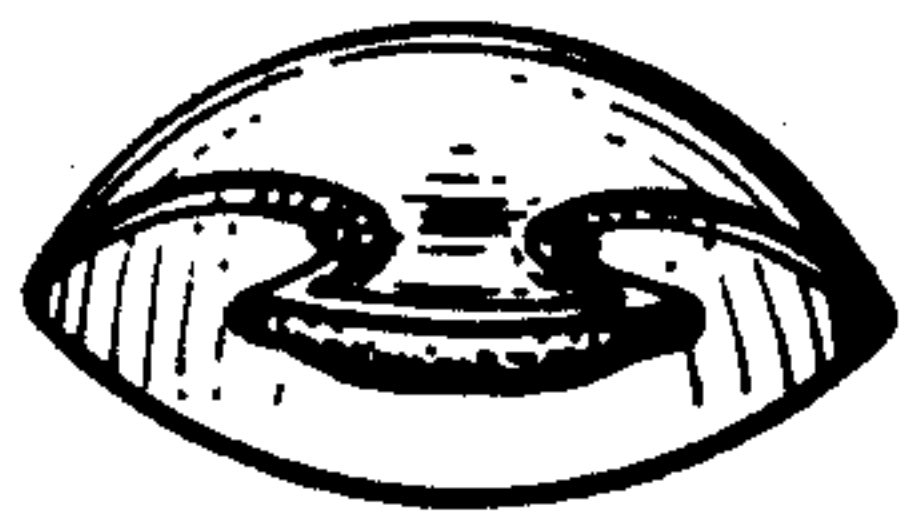
The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article of

DESCRIPTION

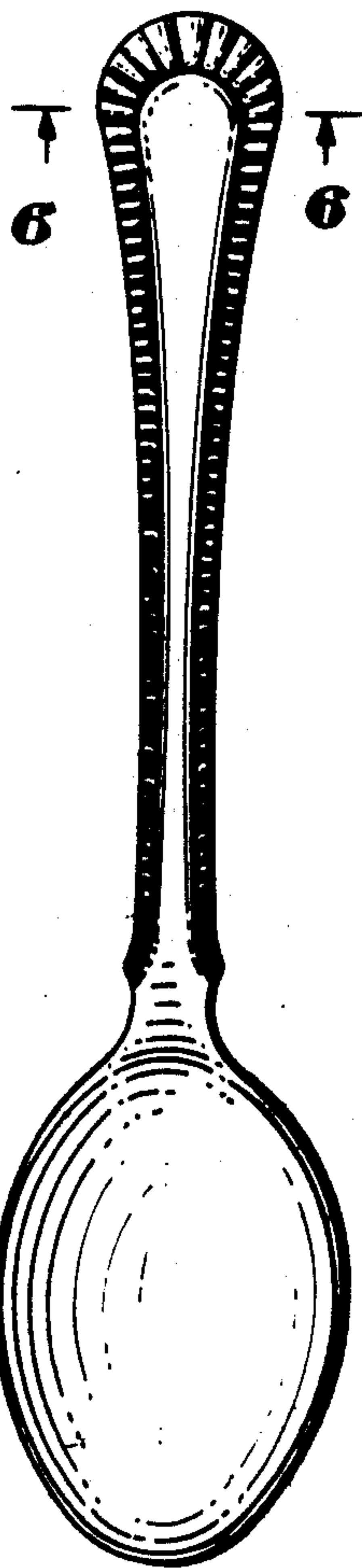
FIG. 1 is a top end view of a spoon or similar article of

knives, forks and other articles of flatware.

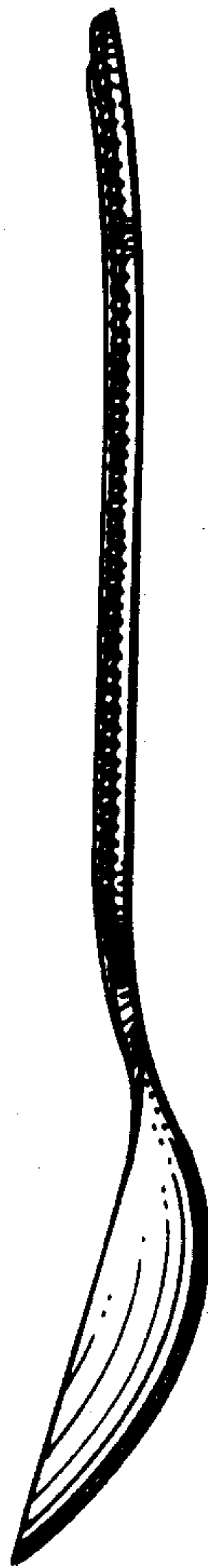




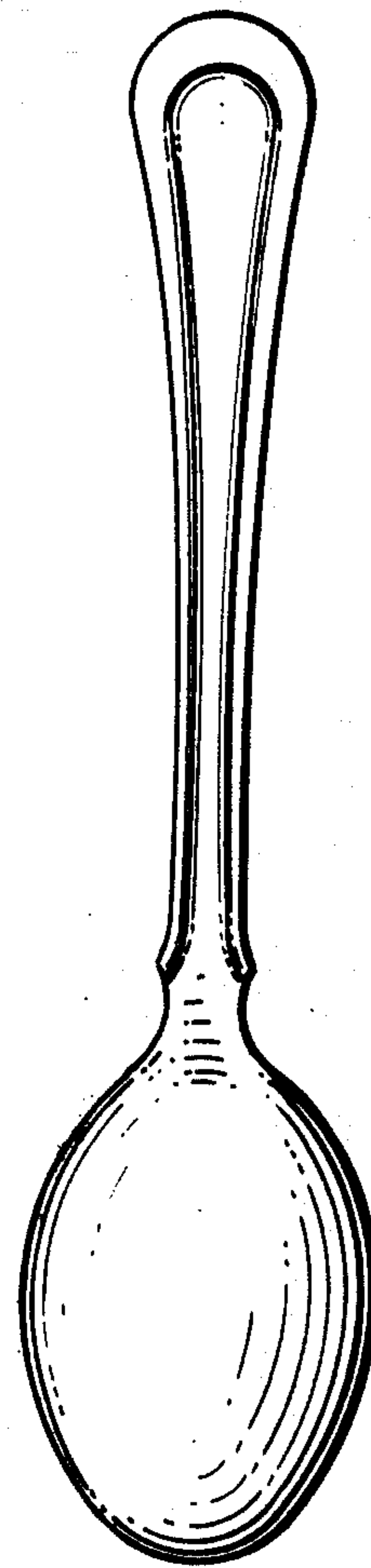

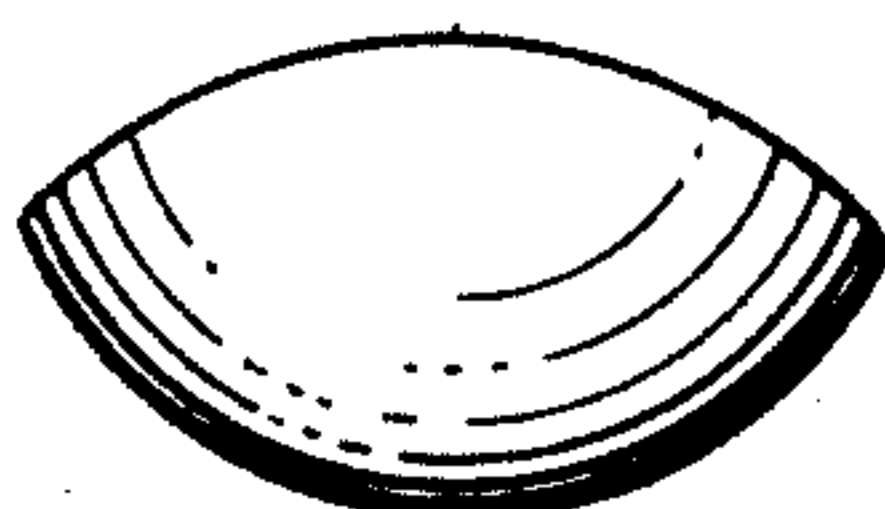
